#FASTEST40 **FACTS** »

• Friday's win over UT Arlington marked the 4th time in the last five years Arkansas has started the season 3-0.

• With a victory at Minnesota, the Razorbacks are looking to start 4-0 for the second time in the last 10 years after a 6-0 start in 2014-15.

• Arkansas will play just its second true road game against a Big Ten opponent in the last 31 years. The Razorbacks most recently lost at No. 3 Michigan on Dec. 8, 2012 and fell at Minnesota on Dec. 7, 1985 during Nolan Richardson's first year with Arkansas.

• The Razorbacks are 2-2 against Big Ten teams in the Mike Anderson era, splitting a home-and-home series with Michigan, falling to Wisconsin in Las Vegas and defeating Minnesota in the Maui Classic.

• Arkansas has outscored all three of its opponents in fast break points and holds a commanding 51-10 edge in the transition game.

• Moses Kingsley is tied for second in the country with 16 total blocks. He has more blocks than 279 of the 351 Division I college basketball teams in the nation.

• Arkansas opened the season with consecutive 90plus point games for the first time in 20 years and just the sixth time in program history.

• In the five previous times Arkansas scored 90-plus points in the first two games, the Razorbacks won an NCAA Tournament game each season, advanced to the Elite 8 three times, lost in the 1990 Final Four and won the 1994 National Championship.



THE NON-CON SLATE »

• Arkansas is slated to play 13 non-conference games this year, with eight of those picked to finish in the top three of their respective league standings.

• The Razorbacks defeated the Summit League preseason favorite 92-83 in the season opener and knocked off the Sun Belt favorite 71-67 on Friday evening.

• While Texas was picked to finish third in the Big 12, it is ranked in the top 25 of both preseason polls.

• Arkansas has already defeated two top 15 teams in the CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25 Poll with No. 5 UT Arlington and No. 15 Fort Wayne. The Razorbacks will also tip it up against No. 20 Stephen F. Austin and No. 19 North Dakota State.

THE ART OF ORGANIZED CHAOS »

• During the Mike Anderson era over the last five years, Arkansas is tied for fifth in the country and leads the nation among high major programs in forcing the opponent to 25-plus turnovers in a game. It's happened nine times and the Razorbacks are 9-0 in those contests. During the same span, Arkansas is 26-2 when forcing 20 turnovers in a game.

IT'S ALL ABOUT EFFICIENCY »

• Anton Beard ranks 11th in the SEC in assists per game at 3.7, but has fewer minutes played than 29 of the top 30 assist leaders in the league. He also leads the SEC in assist/turnover ratio at 11.0.

• Among players that have 10-plus assists this season, Beard is No. 10 in the country in assists/ turnover ratio, including No. 2 amond high-major players.

EXPERIENCE MATTERS »

The starting five from the first three games of Kingsley, Thomas, Hannahs, Macon and Barford have combined to play in 386 collegiate games. The group has 13 years of college experience and four of the five players combined to average 82.5 points per game last year with Thomas sitting out due to NCAA transfer rules.

PERFECTION IN THE PALACE »

 Since Mike Anderson came back to Arkansas, the Razorbacks have the third-most home victories in the country with 83.

• Arkansas is one of seven teams with 80-plus wins and fewer than 15 losses at home over the last six seasons.

• The Razorbacks are 49-1 against unranked nonconference opponents inside Bud Walton Arena under Anderson.

BUILDING BLOCKS »

Moses Kingsley is second in the country with 16 blocks this season and has recorded at least one block in 21 straight games and in 34 of his last 35 contests.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE MOJO »

Moses Kingsley posted 16 double-doubles last season, the second-most of any returning highmajor player in the country. He is currently the SEC's active leader with 17 double-doubles in his career.



The Razorback Nation welcomed home one of its own on March 23, 2011, when Mike Anderson was named the 12th head men's basketball coach in Arkansas history. Charged with bringing back the winning tradition that was synonymous with the Razorback program throughout the '80s and '90s, Anderson enters his sixth season at Arkansas and 15th year as a head coach in 2016-17.

After losing 72 percent of scoring production heading into the 2015-16 season, Anderson continued his history of developing players as Arkansas finished third in the Southeastern Conference in scoring at 78.2 points per game and paced the league in three-point field goal percentage, turnover margin and assist/turnover ratio. Despite dropping eight games by four points or less, Arkansas never wavered and caught fire toward the end of the season to win four of its final five regular season games and finish eighth in the SEC. The Razorbacks became one of five teams to post a .500 or better record in conference play each of the last four years.

A longtime assistant and associate head coach at Arkansas, Anderson spent a combined nine years as a head coach at the University of Alabama-Birmingham and the University of Missouri before returning to the Razorbacks.

One of just 10 current Division I head coaches with 10-plus years of experience and no losing seasons, Anderson's 14 years at the helm of a program have resulted in a 302-162 record, nine 20-win campaigns, seven NCAA Tournament appearances, two Sweet Sixteen berths and a run to the 2009 Elite Eight.

During his first five seasons at Arkansas, Anderson produced a 102-64 record and was the first head coach in program history to win 18 or more games in each of his first four years. Anderson has also re-established Bud Walton Arena as one of the toughest places to play and brought excitement back to the tradition-rich program. In his first five years, Arkansas has won 80 games (80-12) in Bud Walton Arena, including an arena-record 17 during each of his first three years. The 2012-13 squad posted just the third unbeaten SEC home record (9-0) in program history and the first since 1998. The success on-and-off the court has translated into fan support as Arkansas returned to the top 25 in national attendance the first four years, including No. 11 in 2014-15.

CONSISTENCY

Head coach Mike Anderson is one of just 10 current Division I coaches with 10-plus years of head coaching experience and no losing seasons. Anderson and Thad Matta are the only coaches to accomplish the feat during stops at three different institutions.
