#FASTEST40 FACTS »

- Arkansas is 4-0 all-time against Stephen F. Austin, including three of those wins coming in the last 10 years. The Razorbacks have a 17.3 average margin of victory in those four wins.
- The Razorbacks are 50-1 (.980) against unranked non-conference opponents in Bud Walton Arena under head coach Mike Anderson. The only loss came on Nov. 18, 2015 against Akron.
- Arkansas has outscored all five of its opponents in fast break points and holds a commanding 78-23 edge in the transition game.
- Arkansas recorded 20 assists Monday against Mount St. Mary's and is tied for eighth in the country with three games of 20-plus assists this season. The Razorbacks are 35-3 in the Mike Anderson era when dishing out 20-plus assists.
- After turning the ball over on its first two possessions Monday night, Arkansas committed just five turnovers the rest of the game and finished with fewer than eight turnovers for the 21st time in the last 20 years.
- The Razorbacks committed less than half of their season average in turnovers against Mount St. Mary's and went from a -0.2 turnover margin to +0.6 in 40 minutes of action.
- Moses Kingsley is tied for fourth in the country with 4.0 blocks per game and his 20 total blocks are more than 172 of the 351 Division I college basketball teams in the nation.



- The Razorbacks are looking to win five of their first six games for the 16th time since joining the SEC for the 1991-92 season. Arkansas has started 5-1 in 31 of the last 43 years dating back to the start of the Eddie Sutton era in 1974-75.
- In those 31 times starting 5-1 since the beginning of Eddie Sutton's tenure, Arkansas has made 21 NCAA Tournament appearances, eight Sweet Sixteen's, six Elite Eight's, three Final Four's, two Championship Games and captured one National Title.

NEWS & NOTES »

THE NON-CON SLATE »

- Arkansas is slated to play 13 non-conference games this year, with eight of those picked to finish in the top three of their respective league standings.
- The Razorbacks defeated the Summit League preseason favorite 92-83 in the season opener and knocked off the Sun Belt favorite 71-67 a week later.
- While Texas was picked to finish third in the Big 12, it was ranked in the top 25 of both preseason polls.
- Arkansas has already defeated two top 15 teams in the CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25 Poll with No. 5 UT Arlington and No. 15 Fort Wayne. The Razorbacks will also tip it up against No. 16 Stephen F. Austin and No. 22 North Dakota State.

THE ART OF ORGANIZED CHAOS »

• During the Mike Anderson era over the last five-plus years, Arkansas is tied for sixth in the country and ranks second the nation among high major programs in forcing the opponent to 25-plus turnovers in a game. It's happened nine times and the Razorbacks are 9-0 in those contests. During the same span, Arkansas is 26-2 when forcing 20 turnovers in a game.

THE 90-POINT PLATEAU »

- Arkansas opened the season with consecutive 90plus point games for the first time in 20 years and just the sixth time in program history.
- In the five previous times Arkansas scored 90-plus points in the first two games, the Razorbacks won an NCAA Tournament game each season, advanced to the Elite 8 three times, lost in the 1990 Final Four and won the 1994 National Championship.

THE SPLASH ZONE EFFECT »

- Arkansas leads the SEC in 3-point field percentage at .407, but have the fewest attempts in the league at 81, 12 fewer than the next closest team.
- The Razorbacks have made at least one 3-pointer in 911 consecutive games dating back to Jan. 7, 1989 against Texas.

PERFECTION IN THE PALACE »

- Since Mike Anderson came back to Arkansas, the Razorbacks have the third-most home victories in the country with 84.
- Arkansas is one of nine teams with 80-plus wins and fewer than 15 losses at home over the last six seasons.
- The Razorbacks are 50-1 against unranked nonconference opponents inside Bud Walton Arena under Anderson.

BUILDING BLOCKS »

• Moses Kingsley is tied for fourth in the country with 4.0 blocks this season and has recorded at least one block in 23 straight games and in 36 of his last 37 contests.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE MOJO »

• Moses Kingsley posted 16 double-doubles last season, the second-most of any returning high-major player in the country. He is currently the SEC's active leader with 18 double-doubles in his career.

THE MODEL OF EFFICIENCY »

- Of the 1,557 Division I players with 20-plus rebounds, Trey Thompson has accomplished the feat in the seventh fewest amount of minutes, averaging 0.33 boards per 60 seconds.
- Of the 604 Division I players with 15-plus assists, Anton Beard is tied for the 10th best assist to turnover ratio at 5.33, which is the second-best mark in the SEC and ranks tied for fourth among high-major programs.
- Beard also has the fifth-best assist to turnover efficiency rating in the nation when taking minutes played into account.

ELITE COMPANY »

• With 10 points and 10 rebounds at Minnesota, Moses Kingsley became the eighth player in program history to reach 800 points, 500 rebounds and 100 blocks as a Razorback.

- 185 points shy of becoming the 40th player in school history to eclipse the 1,000 career points at Arkansas.
- 101 made free throws shy tying Darrell Walker for 10th all-time in school history with 333 career free throws made.



6TH SEASON AT ARKANSAS 15TH SEASON OVERALL



The Razorback Nation welcomed home one of its own on March 23, 2011, when Mike Anderson was named the 12th head men's basketball coach in Arkansas history. Charged with bringing back the winning tradition that was synonymous with the Razorback program throughout the '80s and '90s, Anderson enters his sixth season at Arkansas and 15th year as a head coach in 2016-17.

After losing 72 percent of scoring production heading into the 2015-16 season, Anderson continued his history of developing players as Arkansas finished third in the Southeastern Conference in scoring at 78.2 points per game and paced the league in three-point field goal percentage, turnover margin and assist/turnover ratio. Despite dropping eight games by four points or less, Arkansas never wavered and caught fire toward the end of the season to win four of its final five regular season games and finish eighth in the SEC. The Razorbacks became one of five teams to post a .500 or better record in conference play each of the last four years.

A longtime assistant and associate head coach at Arkansas, Anderson spent a combined nine years as a head coach at the University of Alabama-Birmingham and the University of Missouri before returning to the Razorbacks.

One of just 10 current Division I head coaches with 10-plus years of experience and no losing seasons, Anderson's 14 years at the helm of a program have resulted in a 302-162 record, nine 20win campaigns, seven NCAA Tournament appearances, two Sweet Sixteen berths and a run to the 2009 Elite Eight.

During his first five seasons at Arkansas, Anderson produced a 102-64 record and was the first head coach in program history to win 18 or more games in each of his first four years. Anderson has also re-established Bud Walton Arena as one of the toughest places to play and brought excitement back to the tradition-rich program. In his first five years, Arkansas has won 80 games (80-12) in Bud Walton Arena, including an arena-record 17 during each of his first three years. The 2012-13 squad posted just the third unbeaten SEC home record (9-0) in program history and the first since 1998. The success on-and-off the court has translated into fan support as Arkansas returned to the top 25 in national attendance the first four years, including No. 11 in 2014-15.

CONSISTENCY

Head coach Mike Anderson is one of just 10 current Division I coaches with 10-plus years of head coaching experience and no losing seasons. Anderson and Thad Matta are the only coaches to accomplish the feat during stops at three different institutions.






