#FASTEST40 FACTS »

- Arkansas is 21-17 all-time against Houston, including winning seven of the last eight meetings. The Razorbacks are 13-2 in Fayetteville against their old rival from the Southwest Conference.
- The Razorbacks are 52-1 (.981) against unranked non-conference opponents in Bud Walton Arena under head coach Mike Anderson. The only loss came on Nov. 18, 2015 against Akron.
- Arkansas has outscored all seven of its opponents in fast break points and holds a commanding 126-34 (+92) edge in the transition game. The Razorbacks have scored 20-plus fast break points in four of the seven games this year.
- Arkansas recorded 20-plus assists twice last week against Mount St. Mary's and Austin Peay. The Razorbacks are tied for 4th in the country with four games of 20-plus assists this season and are 36-3 in the Mike Anderson era when dishing out 20-plus assists.
- In the second half of the last three games, Arkansas has combined to commit just nine turnovers, averaging one per seven minutes of action.
- The Razorbacks have single-digit turnovers in two of the last three games and limited Austin Peay to just one steal on Saturday, marking the eighth time in the last 10 years an Arkansas opponent only has one steal in a game.
- Arkansas is second in the SEC in scoring offense, averaging 84.3 points per game. The Razorbacks are also second in field goal percentage at 48.1 percent.

- The Razorbacks are looking to win seven of their first eight games for the sixth time in the last 13 years and just the 10th time since joining the SEC for the 1991-92 season. Arkansas has started at least 7-1 in 20 of the last 42 years dating back to the start of the Eddie Sutton era in 1974-75.
- In those 20 times starting 7-1 since the beginning of Eddie Sutton's tenure, Arkansas has made 15 NCAA Tournament appearances, eight Sweet Sixteen's, six Elite Eight's, three Final Four's, two Championship Games and captured one National Title.

NEWS & NOTES »

THE NON-CON SLATE »

- Arkansas is slated to play 13 non-conference games this year, with eight of those picked to finish in the top three of their respective league standings.
- The Razorbacks defeated the Summit League preseason favorite 92-83 in the season opener and knocked off the Sun Belt favorite 71-67 a week later.
- Arkansas has already defeated three top 20 teams in the CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25 Poll with No. 5 UT Arlington, No. 15 Fort Wayne and No. 16 Stephen F. Austin. The Razorbacks will also tip it up against No. 22 North Dakota State.

THE ART OF ORGANIZED CHAOS »

• During the Mike Anderson era over the last five-plus years, Arkansas is tied for sixth in the country and ranks second the nation among high major programs in forcing the opponent to 25-plus turnovers in a game. It's happened nine times and the Razorbacks are 9-0 in those contests. During the same span, Arkansas is 27-2 when forcing 20 turnovers in a game.

THE SPLASH ZONE EFFECT »

- Arkansas ranks third in the SEC in 3-point field percentage at .385, but has the second fewest attempts in the league at 117, which is 69 fewer than league-leader Vanderbilt.
- The Razorbacks have made at least one 3-pointer in 913 consecutive games dating back to Jan. 7, 1989 against Texas.

CHARITY STRIPE »

- The Razorbacks lead the SEC in free throw percentage at 77.6 percent, while averaging 17.3 made free throws per game, good for sixth in the league.
- Dusty Hannahs is shooting 91.2 percent (31-34) from the charity stripe this season, ranking tied for 32nd in the nation. He has made 17 straight free throws over the last five games and is 47-of-51 (.922) from the free throw line over the last 10 games.

BUILDING BLOCKS »

• Moses Kinaslev is tied for 11th in the country with 3.3 blocks per game this season and has recorded at least one block in 37 of his last 40 contests.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE MOJO »

• Moses Kingsley posted 16 double-doubles last season, the second-most of any returning highmajor player in the country. He is currently the SEC's active leader with 18 double-doubles in his career.

THE MODEL OF EFFICIENCY »

- Manuale Watkins is third in the country in assist/ turnover ratio at 8.0 among players with 15-plus assists. He ranks second in the SEC and second among high-major players. He has two turnovers in 149 minutes of action.
- Of the 546 Division I players with 20-plus assists, Anton Beard is tied for the 21st best assist to turnover ratio at 3.8, which is the second-best mark in the SEC and 6th among high-major programs.

THE 90-POINT PLATEAU »

- Arkansas opened the season with consecutive 90plus point games for the first time in 20 years and just the sixth time in program history.
- In the five previous times Arkansas scored 90-plus points in the first two games, the Razorbacks won an NCAA Tournament game each season, advanced to the Elite 8 three times, lost in the 1990 Final Four and won the 1994 National Championship.

ELITE COMPANY »

• With 10 points and 10 rebounds at Minnesota, Moses Kingsley became the eighth player in program history to reach 800 points, 500 rebounds and 100 blocks as a Razorback.

MOSES KINGSLEY »

- 160 points shy of becoming the 40th player in school history to eclipse the 1,000 career points at Arkansas.
- 93 made free throws shy tying Darrell Walker for 10th all-time in school history with 333 career free throws made.
- 116 free throw attempts shy of tying Ronnie Brewer for 10th all-time in school history with 486 free throws attempted in a career.
- 101 rebounds shy of tying Corliss Williamson for 10th all-time in school history with 647 career rebounds.
- Currently ranks 5th all-time in school history with 186 career blocks and is eight shy of tying Darian Townes for 4th all-time.

DUSTY HANNAHS »

- On pace to finish in the top-three in school history for career free throw percentage.



6TH SEASON AT ARKANSAS 15TH SEASON OVERALL



The Razorback Nation welcomed home one of its own on March 23, 2011, when Mike Anderson was named the 12th head men's basketball coach in Arkansas history. Charged with bringing back the winning tradition that was synonymous with the Razorback program throughout the '80s and '90s, Anderson enters his sixth season at Arkansas and 15th year as a head coach in 2016-17.

After losing 72 percent of scoring production heading into the 2015-16 season, Anderson continued his history of developing players as Arkansas finished third in the Southeastern Conference in scoring at 78.2 points per game and paced the league in three-point field goal percentage, turnover margin and assist/turnover ratio. Despite dropping eight games by four points or less, Arkansas never wavered and caught fire toward the end of the season to win four of its final five regular season games and finish eighth in the SEC. The Razorbacks became one of five teams to post a .500 or better record in conference play each of the last four years.

A longtime assistant and associate head coach at Arkansas, Anderson spent a combined nine years as a head coach at the University of Alabama-Birmingham and the University of Missouri before returning to the Razorbacks.

One of just 10 current Division I head coaches with 10-plus years of experience and no losing seasons, Anderson's 14 years at the helm of a program have resulted in a 302-162 record, nine 20win campaigns, seven NCAA Tournament appearances, two Sweet Sixteen berths and a run to the 2009 Elite Eight.

During his first five seasons at Arkansas, Anderson produced a 102-64 record and was the first head coach in program history to win 18 or more games in each of his first four years. Anderson has also re-established Bud Walton Arena as one of the toughest places to play and brought excitement back to the tradition-rich program. In his first five years, Arkansas has won 80 games (80-12) in Bud Walton Arena, including an arena-record 17 during each of his first three years. The 2012-13 squad posted just the third unbeaten SEC home record (9-0) in program history and the first since 1998. The success on-and-off the court has translated into fan support as Arkansas returned to the top 25 in national attendance the first four years, including No. 11 in 2014-15.

CONSISTENCY

Head coach Mike Anderson is one of just 10 current Division I coaches with 10-plus years of head coaching experience and no losing seasons. Anderson and Thad Matta are the only coaches to accomplish the feat during stops at three different institutions.


