

#### #FASTEST40 FACTS »

- Arkansas and Texas will renew a storied rivalry on Saturday, meeting for the 154th time in program history and the first time in six years.
- Arkansas has recorded runs of at least 10-0 on 11 different occasions this year, including a season-high 21-0 run against Austin Peay on Dec. 3. The Razorbacks have multiple 10-0 runs in five of nine games this year.
- The Razorbacks have held opponents scoreless for three-plus minutes 19 times this year, including at least once in all nine games. Arkansas held UT Arlington scoreless for a season-best 7:11 during the second half, going on a 15-0 run.
- Arkansas has recorded 20-plus assists in three of the last five games and is currently tied for fifth in the country with five games of at least 20 assists this season. The Razorbacks are 37-3 in the Mike Anderson era when dishing out 20-plus assists.
- The Razorbacks have pulled down 10-plus offensive rebounds in 10 straight games, the longest streak under Anderson. Arkansas is scoring 16.4 percent of its points on second chance opportunities, good for 14.0 points a game.
- Arkansas has yet to trail this season in fast break points and holds a commanding 148-48 (+100) edge in the transition game. The Razorbacks have scored 20-plus fast break points in four of the nine games this year.
- Arkansas is second in the SEC in field goal percentage at 48.2 percent and in scoring offense, averaging 85.0 points per game.



#### #FASTEST40 STARTS »

- The Razorbacks are looking to win nine of their first 10 games for the second time in the last seven years and just the seventh time since joining the SEC for the 1991-92 season. Arkansas has started at least 9-1 in 14 of the last 42 years dating back to the start of the Eddie Sutton era in 1974-75.
- In those 14 times starting 9-1 since the beginning of Eddie Sutton's tenure, Arkansas has made nine NCAA Tournament appearances, seven Sweet Sixteen's, six Elite Eight's, five Final Four's, two Championship Games and captured one National Title.

#### NEWS & NOTES »

#### THE NON-CON SLATE »

- Arkansas is slated to play 13 non-conference games this year, with eight of those picked to finish in the top three of their respective league standings.
- The Razorbacks defeated the Summit League preseason favorite 92-83 in the season opener and knocked off the Sun Belt favorite 71-67 a week later.
- Arkansas has defeated three top 20 teams in the CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25 Poll with then No. 5 UT Arlington, No. 15 Fort Wayne and No. 16 Stephen F. Austin.

#### THE ART OF ORGANIZED CHAOS »

• During the Mike Anderson era over the last five-plus years, Arkansas is tied for sixth in the country and ranks second the nation among high major programs in forcing the opponent to 25-plus turnovers in a game. It's happened nine times and the Razorbacks are 9-0 in those contests. During the same span, Arkansas is 27-2 when forcing 20 turnovers in a game.

#### THE SPLASH ZONE EFFECT »

- Arkansas ranks tied for third in the SEC in 3-point field percentage at .371, but is tied for the fourth fewest attempts in the league at 151, which is 86 fewer than league-leader Vanderbilt.
- The Razorbacks have made at least one 3-pointer in 915 consecutive games dating back to Jan. 7, 1989 against Texas.

#### **CHARITY STRIPE** »

- The Razorbacks are third in the SEC in free throw percentage at 76.9 percent, while averaging 18.1 made free throws per game, good for fourth in the league.
- Dusty Hannahs is shooting 92.9 percent (39-42) from the charity stripe this season, tied for 21st in the nation. He has made 25 straight free throws over the last seven games and is 55-of-59 (.932) from the free throw line over the last 12 games.

#### **BUILDING BLOCKS** »

• Moses Kingsley is T-17th in the country with 2.9 blocks per game this season and has recorded at least one block in 39 of his last 42 contests.

#### DOUBLE-DOUBLE MOJO »

• Moses Kingsley posted 16 double-doubles last season, the second-most of any returning highmajor player in the country. He is currently the SEC's active leader with 19 double-doubles in his career.

#### THE MODEL OF EFFICIENCY »

• Of the 780 players in the country with 20-plus assists, Manuale Watkins is second in assist/ turnover ratio at 6.0. He ranks second in the SEC and second among high-major players. He has four turnovers in 198 minutes of action.

#### THE 90-POINT PLATEAU »

- Arkansas opened the season with consecutive 90-plus point games for the first time in 20 years and just the sixth time in program history. The Razorbacks have scored 90-plus points in four of the first nine games for the first time since the 2000-01 season.
- In the five previous times Arkansas scored 90-plus points in the first two games, the Razorbacks won an NCAA Tournament game each season, advanced to the Elite 8 three times, lost in the 1990 Final Four and won the 1994 National Championship.

#### **ELITE COMPANY »**

• With 10 points and 10 rebounds at Minnesota, Moses Kingsley became the eighth player in program history to reach 800 points, 500 rebounds and 100 blocks as a Razorback.

#### **MOSES KINGSLEY** »

- 133 points shy of becoming the 40th player in school history to eclipse the 1,000 career points at Arkansas.
- 88 made free throws shy tying Darrell Walker for 10th all-time in school history with 333 career free throws made.
- 109 free throw attempts shy of tying Ronnie Brewer for 10th all-time in school history with 486 free throws attempted in a career.
- 82 rebounds shy of tying Corliss Williamson for 10th all-time in school history with 647 career rebounds.
- Currently ranks 5th all-time in school history with 189 career blocks and is five shy of tying Darian Townes for 4th all-time.

#### **DUSTY HANNAHS** »

- On pace to finish in the top-three in school history for career free throw percentage.
- On pace to break the school record for 3-point field goal percentage in a career.

- Reached the 1,000-point mark for his career in the season opener against Fort Wayne with 462 coming at Texas Tech and now 676 coming at Arkansas.

### PERFECTION IN THE PALACE »

- Since Mike Anderson came back to Arkansas, the Razorbacks have the third-most home victories in the country with 88.
- Arkansas is one of 10 teams with 80-plus wins and fewer than 15 losses at home over the last six seasons.

#### THE TEXAS RIVALRY »

- In postseason play, when it matters most, the Razorbacks are 6-1 against Texas. Arkansas won the Southwest Conference Tournament Championship three times at the hands of the Longhorns and advanced to the 1990 Final Four at the expense of its then conference foe.
- The Razorbacks have a decisive 16-3 edge against Texas on a neutral court, including a 5-1 advantage in Houston, where Saturday's game will be held.
- Arkansas holds the three longest winning streaks in the all-time series, putting together runs of 12, eight and seven consecutive wins against the Longhorns.



### **6TH SEASON AT ARKANSAS** 15TH SEASON OVERALL



The Razorback Nation welcomed home one of its own on March 23, 2011, when Mike Anderson was named the 12th head men's basketball coach in Arkansas history. Charged with bringing back the winning tradition that was synonymous with the Razorback program throughout the '80s and '90s, Anderson enters his sixth season at Arkansas and 15th year as a head coach in 2016-17.

After losing 72 percent of scoring production heading into the 2015-16 season, Anderson continued his history of developing players as Arkansas finished third in the Southeastern Conference in scoring at 78.2 points per game and paced the league in three-point field goal percentage, turnover margin and assist/turnover ratio. Despite dropping eight games by four points or less, Arkansas never wavered and caught fire toward the end of the season to win four of its final five regular season games and finish eighth in the SEC. The Razorbacks became one of five teams to post a .500 or better record in conference play each of the last four years.

A longtime assistant and associate head coach at Arkansas, Anderson spent a combined nine years as a head coach at the University of Alabama-Birmingham and the University of Missouri before returning to the Razorbacks.

One of just 10 current Division I head coaches with 10-plus years of experience and no losing seasons, Anderson's 14 years at the helm of a program have resulted in a 302-162 record, nine 20win campaigns, seven NCAA Tournament appearances, two Sweet Sixteen berths and a run to the 2009 Elite Eight.

During his first five seasons at Arkansas, Anderson produced a 102-64 record and was the first head coach in program history to win 18 or more games in each of his first four years. Anderson has also re-established Bud Walton Arena as one of the toughest places to play and brought excitement back to the tradition-rich program. In his first five years, Arkansas has won 80 games (80-12) in Bud Walton Arena, including an arena-record 17 during each of his first three years. The 2012-13 squad posted just the third unbeaten SEC home record (9-0) in program history and the first since 1998. The success on-and-off the court has translated into fan support as Arkansas returned to the top 25 in national attendance the first four years, including No. 11 in 2014-15.

### CONSISTENCY

Head coach Mike Anderson is one of just 10 current Division I coaches with 10-plus years of head coaching experience and no losing seasons. Anderson and Thad Matta are the only coaches to accomplish the feat during stops at three different institutions.
