#### > #FASTEST40 FACTS »

- Arkansas is off to its best 11-game start in the Mike Anderson era with a 10-1 record.
- The Razorbacks are 3-2 at Verizon Arena under head coach Mike Anderson, including wins in three of the last four visits to the capital city.
- Arkansas' current seven-game winning streak is the fifth such streak under head coach Mike Anderson in the last six years. The program's previous five seven-game winning streaks came during a span of 15 seasons.
- Over the last two contests, Arkansas has combined to go 43-of-47 (.915) from the free throw line, including Saturday's 29-of-31 (.935) performance against Texas, which was the second best percentage in school history with 30-plus attempts. Arkansas went 30-of-32 (.938) against Rice in 1982.
- Arkansas has recorded runs of at least 10-0 on 12 different occasions this year, including a seasonhigh 21-0 run against Austin Peay on Dec. 3. The Razorbacks have multiple 10-0 runs in five of 11 games this year.
- The Razorbacks have held opponents scoreless for three-plus minutes 22 times this year, including at least once in 10 of 11 games this season. Arkansas held UT Arlington scoreless for a season-best 7:11 during the second half, going on a 15-0 run.
- The Razorbacks have pulled down 10-plus offensive rebounds in 12 straight games, the longest streak under Anderson. Arkansas is scoring 16.8 percent of its points on second chance opportunities, good for 13.9 points a game.



#### > #FASTEST40 STARTS »

- The Razorbacks are looking to win 11 of their first 12 games for the third time in the last 13 years and the sixth time since joining the SEC for the 1991-92 season. Arkansas has started at least 11-1 in 10 of the last 42 years dating back to the start of the Eddie Sutton era in 1974-75.
- In those 10 times starting at least 11-1 since the beginning of Eddie Sutton's tenure, Arkansas has made eight NCAA Tournament appearances, six Sweet Sixteen's, four Elite Eight's, three Final Four's, two Championship Games and captured one National Title.

#### NEWS & NOTES »

#### THE NON-CON SLATE »

- Arkansas is slated to play 13 non-conference games this year, with eight of those picked to finish in the top three of their respective league standings.
- The Razorbacks defeated the Summit League preseason favorite 92-83 in the season opener and knocked off the Sun Belt favorite 71-67 a week later.
- Arkansas has defeated three top 20 teams in the CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25 Poll with then No. 5 UT Arlington, No. 15 Fort Wayne and No. 16 Stephen F. Austin.

#### THE ART OF ORGANIZED CHAOS »

• During the Mike Anderson era over the last five-plus years, Arkansas is tied for sixth in the country and ranks second the nation among high major programs in forcing the opponent to 25-plus turnovers in a game. It's happened nine times and the Razorbacks are 9-0 in those contests. During the same span, Arkansas is 27-2 when forcing 20 turnovers in a game, including 1-0 this season.

#### THE SPLASH ZONE EFFECT »

- Arkansas ranks fifth in the SEC in 3-point field percentage at .367, but has the second fewest attempts in the league at 188, which is 83 fewer than league-leader Auburn.
- The Razorbacks have made at least one 3-pointer in 917 consecutive games dating back to Jan. 7, 1989 against Texas.

#### **CHARITY STRIPE** »

- The Razorbacks lead the SEC and rank 7th in the country in free throw percentage at 79.5 percent, averaging 18.7 made free throws per game. Arkansas has made 82.6 percent of its free throws over the last 5 games.
- Dusty Hannahs is shooting 91.1 percent (41-45) from the charity stripe this season, good for 25th in the nation. Hannahs had made 26 straight free throws before missing against Texas.
- Daryl Macon has made 21 straight free throws, including a 14-for-14 performance against Texas.

#### BUILDING BLOCKS »

- Moses Kingsley is 11th in the country with 2.9 blocks per game this season and has recorded at least one block in 41 of his last 44 contests.
- Has multiple blocks in seven games, and is T-8th in the country with three games of 5+ blocks.

#### **DOUBLE-DOUBLE MOJO »**

• Moses Kingsley posted 16 double-doubles last season, the second-most of any returning high-major player in the country. He is currently the SEC's active leader with 19 double-doubles in his career.

#### TRANSITION GAME ON POINT »

• Arkansas has yet to trail this season in fast break points and holds a commanding 166-61 (+105) edge in the transition game. The Razorbacks have scored 20+ fast break points in 4 of the 11 games this year.

#### THE MODEL OF EFFICIENCY »

• Of the 942 players in the country with 20-plus assists, Manuale Watkins is 10th in assist/turnover ratio at 4.3. He ranks second in the SEC and sixth among high-major players. He has six turnovers in 243 minutes of action.

#### THE 90-POINT PLATEAU »

- Arkansas opened the season with consecutive 90-plus point games for the first time in 20 years and just the sixth time in program history. The Razorbacks have scored 90-plus points in four of the first 11 games for the first time since the 2001-02 season.
- In the five previous times Arkansas scored 90-plus points in the first two games, the Razorbacks won an NCAA Tournament game each season, advanced to the Elite 8 three times, lost in the 1990 Final Four and won the 1994 National Championship.

#### **ELITE COMPANY »**

• With 10 points and 10 rebounds at Minnesota, Moses Kingsley became the eighth player in program history to reach 800 points, 500 rebounds and 100 blocks as a Razorback.



#### HEAD COACH 6TH SEASON AT ARKANSAS 15TH SEASON OVERALL



The Razorback Nation welcomed home one of its own on March 23, 2011, when Mike Anderson was named the 12th head men's basketball coach in Arkansas history. Charged with bringing back the winning tradition that was synonymous with the Razorback program throughout the '80s and '90s, Anderson enters his sixth season at Arkansas and 15th year as a head coach in 2016-17.

After losing 72 percent of scoring production heading into the 2015-16 season, Anderson continued his history of developing players as Arkansas finished third in the Southeastern Conference in scoring at 78.2 points per game and paced the league in three-point field goal percentage, turnover margin and assist/turnover ratio. Despite dropping eight games by four points or less, Arkansas never wavered and caught fire toward the end of the season to win four of its final five regular season games and finish eighth in the SEC. The Razorbacks became one of five teams to post a .500 or better record in conference play each of the last four years.

A longtime assistant and associate head coach at Arkansas, Anderson spent a combined nine years as a head coach at the University of Alabama-Birmingham and the University of Missouri before returning to the Razorbacks.

One of just 10 current Division I head coaches with 10-plus years of experience and no losing seasons, Anderson's 14 years at the helm of a program have resulted in a 302-162 record, nine 20-win campaigns, seven NCAA Tournament appearances, two Sweet Sixteen berths and a run to the 2009 Elite Eight.

During his first five seasons at Arkansas, Anderson produced a 102-64 record and was the first head coach in program history to win 18 or more games in each of his first four years. Anderson has also re-established Bud Walton Arena as one of the toughest places to play and brought excitement back to the tradition-rich program. In his first five years, Arkansas has won 80 games (80-12) in Bud Walton Arena, including an arena-record 17 during each of his first three years. The 2012-13 squad posted just the third unbeaten SEC home record (9-0) in program history and the first since 1998. The success on-and-off the court has translated into fan support as Arkansas returned to the top 25 in national attendance the first four years, including No. 11 in 2014-15.

### CONSISTENCY

Head coach Mike Anderson is one of just 10 current Division I coaches with 10-plus years of head coaching experience and no losing seasons. Anderson and Thad Matta are the only coaches to accomplish the feat during stops at three different institutions.


