

- Ospreys are 0-18 all-time against teams from the SEC having faced 7 different teams // Hogs mark the 4th game vs SEC foe this year (Auburn, Florida & LSU)
- UNF is playing its 50th game against a Power Conference foe under head coach Matthew-Driscoll today vs Arkansas // Osprey seniors will be playing in 26th game vs high-major opponent (2-23) with wins at Purdue and Illinois
- Ospreys are 31-11 under Driscoll against non-conference D1 mid-major opponents (like size programs)
- Dallas Moore needs just 3 assists to become UNF's all-time leader... Moore's 37-point effort vs EWC (Nov. 14) is the tops in the ASUN this season
