Setting the Scene

- After playing three of its last four contests away from home the Aggie return to the friendly confines of Reed Arena to host Arkansas Tuesday night.
- For the long-time Southwest Conference foes, the meeting will be the 154th all-time on the hardwood but just the seventh as SEC members.

Trends & Superlatives

- Sophomore **Tyler Davis** scored 16 points Saturday at Mississippi State to lead the Aggies, the 11th time he has paced the team in scoring during his two-year career.
- Freshman **Robert Williams** notched a pair of blocked shots at MSU to extend his blocked shot streak to 16 games as well as bringing his team-leading blocked shots total to 41 ... It stands as the longest such streak by an Aggie since Bryan Davis had a 17-game block streak from Nov. 29, 2009 to Feb. 3, 2010.
- In just his third career start last Wednesday vs. LSU, sophomore guard **Chris Collins** set career highs in points (12), assists (8), rebounds (4) and 3-point field goals (2) ... Collins' eight assists were the second most by an Aggie this season, trailing only DJ Hogg's nine against A&M-Corpus Christi (12/5/16).

Aggies Among the SEC & National Leaders (Through 1/14 games)

- The Aggies rank 14th nationally in blocked shots per game with an average of 5.9 per contest.
- On the offensive end, A&M has been efficient, ranking second in the SEC by shooting 47.6 percent from the field as a team as well as second in the SEC in assists with an average of 17.1 per contest ... The Aggies are third in the league with a 1.2 assist-to-turnover ratio.
- Defensively, A&M ranks third field goal percentage defense by allowing opponents to shoot just 39.6 from the field.
- In the SEC rebounding column, A&M leads the conference in rebounding margin at +6.6 and in offensive rebound percentage at 39.7 percent ... The Aggies are 16th nationally in offensive rebounds per game (13.75).
- Nationally, the Aggies rank 23rd in fewest fouls this season (267).
- Rookie **Robert Williams** continues to stand out as one of the SEC's brightest freshman, ranking second in the league (19th nationally) with 41 blocked shots for an average of 2.6 per game.
- Sophomore **Tyler Davis** leads the SEC and ranks 17th nationally in field goal percentage, shooting 60.9 percent from the field ... He also ranks seventh in the SEC in total rebounding at 6.9 per contest while checking at second on the offensive glass at 3.3 offensive rebounds per outing.
- Second-year guard **Admon Gilder** appears throughout the lists of SEC statistical leaders, ranking sixth in steals per game (1.9), eighth assists per game (4.2) and 10th minutes played (31.5).
- Sophomore **DJ Hogg** continues to rank among the SEC's top sharpshooters, checking in at sixth in the league shooting 40.7 percent from long range while making 2.5 3-point baskets per contest, third in the SEC.

Noting Arkansas

- Arkansas is coming off a 92-73 win over Missouri on Saturday in Fayetteville that gave the Razorbacks a 13-4 overall record with a 2-3 mark in SEC games.
- The Razorbacks are 10-2 at Bud Walton Arena this season but just 1-2 in road games.
- Senior forward Moses Kingsley, who was named SEC Preseason Player of the Year, is enjoying a solid campaign as he averages 11.6 points, 8.4 rebounds and 2.7 blocks per contest ... The Abuja, Nigeria, native ranks second in the SEC in rebounding and first in blocked shots.
- Senior guard Dusty Hannahs leads team in scoring at 14.2 points per outing, while shooting 43.2 percent from the field and 36.0 percent from 3-point range ... The Texas Tech transfer paces the SEC and ranks 10th nationally by shooting 91.2 percent from the free throw line.
- Veteran head coach Mike Anderson is in his sixth season at the helm in Fayetteville ... Anderson's Razorbacks went 16-16 last season with a 9-9 SEC record that saw them finish in a tie for eighth in the league.
- The Razorbacks were picked to finish in fifth in a preseason poll of media that cover the SEC.
- Razorback associate head coach Melvin Watkins served as the 18th head coach in Texas A&M men's basketball history from 1998-2004 ... In six seasons on the Aggie bench, Watkins compiled a 60-112 (.349) record.

Up Next After the Arkansas Game

Texas A&M continues its two-game homestand at Reed Arena by hosting Georgia at 11 a.m. on Saturday ... The game is slated to be televised on ESPN2.

SERIES HISTORY: ARKANSAS

Arkansas leads 98-55
A&M streak: Lost 1

- Wednesday will be the seventh SEC contest between the Aggies & Razorbacks ... the two schools shared a spot in the Southwest Conference from 1915 until 1991 when the Razorbacks joined the SEC.
- The two schools have faced off 153 previous times on the hardwood during the series, which dates back to the 1923-24 season ... Arkansas stands out as the sixth-most common opponent in A&M men's basketball history.
- Texas A&M is winless during its last eight trips to Fayetteville, having last won at Arkansas on March 1, 1986.
- Last season the two schools split a pair of meetings with each team winning on its home court.
- A&M's Billy Kennedy is 3-4 all-time as a head coach against the Razorbacks ... his lone meeting against Arkansas prior to his tenure at A&M came during the 1997-98 season while the head coach at Centenary ... the Gents fell in Fayetteville 61-48.
- Kennedy's head coaching counterpart, Arkansas' Mike Anderson, is 3-9 all-time against the Aggies.

Williams Reviving Aggies' Block Party

Billed as one of the SEC's most athletic rookies, Robert Williams has wasted little time making his presence felt on the court for the Maroon & White and one of his biggest statistical impacts has come in the blocked shots column.

• As a team last season, the Aggies collected 133 blocks in 37 games for an average of 3.59 blocks per game ... This season in 16 games, A&M has 95 blocks for an average of 5.9 per game.

• Williams has 41 blocks in 16 games (2.6 per game) to rank seventh nationally in block percentage [13.0] on kenpom.com (through Jan. 14 games). The metric is the percentage of opponents' two-point shots that are blocked by the player while he is on the court.

• The rookie from Vivan, La., notched five swats against Northwestern St. during his first collegiate game to become the first Aggie to notch five blocks in a game since Keith Davis vs. Sam Houston St. on Dec. 7, 2011.

• Williams also collected a two swats last time out against Mississippi State to give him a blocked shot in 16 straight games, the longest streak by an Aggie since Bryan Davis had a 17-game block streak from Nov. 29, 2009 to Feb. 3, 2010.

A&M Takes Aim at Another 20-Win Sesaon; Would be 10th in 13 Years

A 79-77 overtime victory over Kentucky on Feb. 20 of last season stood out as the team's 20th win of the season. The Aggies would go on to win a school-record 28 victories on their run to the Sweet 16.

The 20-win season was the 15th in program history and the second in a row for Billy Kennedy's Aggies. Texas A&M has won 20 or more games in nine of the last 12 seasons.

Davis Named SEC Player of the Week (Dec. 12)

For the first time during his already impressive career Texas A&M center Tyler Davis was named SEC Player of the Week on Dec. 12

A 6-foot-10, 270-pound, Davis sophomore averaging 18 points and eight rebounds while shooting 73.1 percent from the field in wins over A&M-Corpus Christi, Denver and South Carolina State.

Davis scored a career-high 25 points during a victory over A&M-Corpus Christi, converting 9-of-12 field goal attempts and 7-of-9 chances at the free throw line. The Aggie big man hit the 20-point plateau for the second time during the week and his career with 22 points during the win over South Carolina State as he converted 8-of-9 shots from the field and notched his third consecutive game with eight boards.

Williams Named SEC Freshman of the Week (Nov. 28)

After making a splash on the national scene with an impressive three-game showing at the Wooden Legacy, Texas A&M's Robert Williams was named SEC Men's Basketball Freshman of the Week on Nov. 28.

The 6-foot-9, 237-pound forward from Vivan, La., averaged 12 points, 6.7 rebounds and 2.7 blocks while leading the Aggies to victories over CSUN and Virginia Tech before a near upset of No. 14 UCLA during the Wooden Legacy title game. Williams shot an impressive 56 percent from the field during the tournament as well as 88.9 percent from the free throw line while averaging 19.7 minutes on the court.

Additionally, Williams led the entire tournament field with eight blocked shots while adding five assists and four steals. He hit double-digit scoring during all three games in Southern California and collected his first career double-double by setting career highs in both points (13) and rebounds (10) in the Aggies' come-from-behind victory over the Hokies during the Wooden semifinals.

Come-From-Behind Victory Highlights Aggies' Run at Wooden Legacy

During their runner-up showing at the 2016 Wooden Legacy the Aggies received national praise for an impressive come-from-behind effort over a solid Virginia Tech squad.

Texas A&M trailed by 17 during the second half (53-36) before it outscored the Hokies 32-12 during the game's final 14:04 to complete the comeback, which stands out as the biggest come-from-behind win of the Billy Kennedy era at A&M.

Against the Hokies, the Aggies dominated the paint during, owning a 44-18 edge for points in the paint and a 49-30 advantage in the rebounding column.



Kennedy Hits 100 Wins at A&M

Aggie head coach Billy Kennedy has enjoyed successful coaching stops at Centenary (1997-99), Southeastern Louisiana (1999-05), Murray State (2006-11) and now Texas A&M (2011-).

The sixth-year Aggie coach eclipsed another coaching milestone as the season-opening win over Northwestern State gave him 100 victories for his tenure at Texas A&M. Only Shelby Metcalf, who guided the Aggies to 438 wins from 1963 to 1990, has claimed more victories while guiding the Texas A&M men's basketball program than Kennedy.

On Jan. 30 of last season, when the Aggies earned a 72-62 victory over No. 14 Iowa State, Kennedy hit another career milestone as he captured his 300th victory as a collegiate head coach.

After playing a prominent role in the Aggies' success as a freshman a year ago and standing out as one of the SEC's top big men, sophomore center Tyler Davis was honored as a First Team Preseason All-SEC selection as well as garnering a spot on the watch list for the 2017 Kareem Abdul-Jabbar Center of the Year Award.

The Plano, Texas, native averaged 11.3 points and 6.2 rebounds per contest while shooting 65.5 percent from the floor and pacing the team with 41 blocked shots. Along with teammate DJ Hogg, Davis garnered SEC All-Freshman honors at the conclusion of the season.

By mid-February, the watch list of 20 players for the 2017 Kareem Abdul-Jabbar Center of the Year Award will be narrowed down to just 10. In March, five finalists will be presented to Mr. Abdul-Jabbar and the Hall of Fame's selection committee. The winner of the 2017 Kareem Abdul-Jabbar Award will be presented at the ESPN College Basketball Awards Show presented by Wendy's in Los Angeles, Calif., on Friday, April 7, 2017.

Billy Kennedy: Program Builder

Even before taking over the helm of the Texas A&M men's basketball program prior to the 2011-12 campaign, Billy Kennedy had the reputation of a program builder. Following his first head coaching job at Centenary, Kennedy assumed the job at his alma mater Southeastern Louisiana and in years four and five of his tenure helped the Lions capture back-to-back Southland Conference Championships and make an appearance in the 2005 NCAA Tournament.

At Murray State, Kennedy and the Racers also won back-to-back league titles in seasons four and five of his tenure. His team made a trip to the 2010 NCAA Tournament where they downed fourth-seeded Vanderbilt.

Kennedy's impressive career has left him with a spot on an elite list of just 26 active NCAA Division-I coaches to lead three different programs to the NCAA Tournament.

The Departed: Replacing Four Senior Starters

Last season was one for the Aggie basketball record books and much of the firepower and leadership that powered the team came from four outstanding senior starters who no longer don the Maroon & White.

Three of the departed senior starters -- Jalen Jones, Alex Caruso and Danuel House -- garnered All-SEC accolades, with Jones earning first team distinction and House being selected an honorable mention All-American by the *Associated Press*. Caruso, meanwhile, stands out as A&M's all-time leader in assists (649) and steals (276) and ended his career as the only player in SEC history to score 1,000 points with at least 500 rebounds, 600 assists and 250 steals.

For his part, Anthony Collins made an impression during his lone season in Aggieland after transferring from South Florida as he made all 37 starts at the point guard spot while dishing out 155 assists and collecting 38 steals. He ranked 24th nationally with a 2.92 assist-to-turnover ratio.

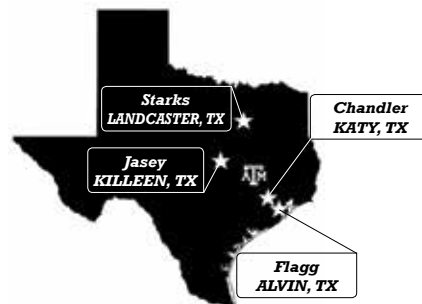
