## #FASTEST40 STORYLINES »

- Arkansas returns home on Tuesday for the first time in 18 days, welcoming Colorado State to town as the two teams meet for the first time in program history.
- In three home games this year, the Razorbacks are 3-0 with a +75 scoring margin, including a +64 scoring margin in the first half.
- Arkansas is 58-1 against unranked non-conference opponents inside Bud Walton Arena during the Mike Anderson era.
- According to ESPN, the Razorbacks have the No. 10 RPI in the nation and the 14th toughest strength of schedule in the country.
- Arkansas' opponents this year have combined for a 36-17 (.679) record with five of the seven schools posting 5+ wins.
- During the last three games, C.J. Jones is averaging 14.0 points per game, going 10-of-22 from behind the arc and 6-of-6 from the charity stripe.
- For the first time in 23 years, Arkansas scored 90+ points in four of its first six games. The Razorbacks last accomplished the feat in 1994-95.
- The Razorbacks have a +57 scoring margin in the first half through seven games, leading by double-digits at the break in four of their five wins.
- Arkansas' 35-point win against UConn handed the Huskies their worst defeat in the last 40 years.
- The Razorbacks last win of at least 35 points against a high-major school came on Feb. 10, 2010 against LSU. The last 35-point win against a high-major nonconference opponent came on Dec. 2, 1993 against Missouri.

# > NEWS AND NOTES »

- Arkansas has recorded eight victories over AP Top 25 teams during the Mike Anderson era, including at least one in five of his first six years. Last season, the Razorbacks went on the road and defeated No. 21 and eventual Final Four participant South Carolina.
- For just the second time since joining the SEC, Arkansas had three players with six-plus assists in the season opener against Samford.
- The last time Arkansas led by 20+ points at halftime in the first two games of the season was during the 1993-94 National Championship season.
- For the first time in the last 70 years, Arkansas opened the season with back-to-back wins of at least 28 points.
- The Razorbacks are the only high-major program in country with seven seniors on its roster. TCU and Minnesota both have six.
- Adrio Bailey swatted five shots against North Carolina in 18 minutes of play, becoming the first Razorback since Moses Kingsley (02/21/15 - Mississippi State) with 5+ blocks in fewer than 20 minutes of playing time.
- Against Fresno State (Nov. 17), Daniel Gafford became the first Razorback in 22 years to record 25+ points, 8+ rebounds and 3+ blocks coming off the bench (via @HogStats).
- Arkansas recorded 28 assists in the season opener, marking the third time in the 21st century and the second time in the Anderson era the Razorbacks had 28-plus assists in a
- During the last seven years, Arkansas is 40-3 when dishing out 20 assists, including a 28-1 mark in non-conference play.
- Daryl Macon and Jaylen Barford are looking to become the sixth and seventh players in program history to score 1,000 points as a Razorback in just two seasons. They could follow in the footsteps of Martin Terry, Scotty Thurman, Todd Day, Dusty Hannahs and Bobby Portis.



# **HEAD COACH** 7TH SEASON AT ARKANSAS **16TH SEASON OVERALL**



Razorback Nation welcomed home one of its own on March 23, 2011, when Mike Anderson was named the 12th head men's basketball coach in Arkansas history. Charged with bringing back the winning tradition that was synonymous with the Razorback program throughout the '80s and '90s, Anderson enters his seventh season at Arkansas and 16th year as a head coach in 2017-18.

Anderson continued to bring Razorback basketball back to national relevance in 2016-17, leading Arkansas to a 26-10 record, a spot in the SEC Tournament Championship game and on the brink of knocking off the eventual National Champion North Carolina Tar Heels with the Sweet 16 on the line.

The Razorbacks posted the seventh-most wins in program history last season, as Anderson led his squad to 12 SEC victories for the fifth time in school history and captured six conference road victories, tying the 1994 championship team and the 2015 NCAA Tournament squad for the most in the SEC era. The Razorbacks ended the season 8-3 in their last 11 SEC road contests, the best stretch since the end of the 1993-94 and beginning of the 1994-95 seasons. Arkansas used its secondbest free throw percentage in school history (.761) to post a 4-0 record in games decided by one possession and a perfect 24-0 mark when leading with two minutes left in the contest.

The outlook on Razorback basketball has never been brighter, as Anderson welcomes a top-25 recruiting class to Fayetteville for the upcoming season that features four of the top five players in the state of Arkansas. Three of the four players are listed as four-star prospects by ESPN as Anderson's staff continues to land the best talent in the state.

During the last four years, 17 current or former players have received their degree from the University of Arkansas, including five individuals during the 2016-17 season. Seniors Dusty Hannahs, Moses Kingsley and Manuale Watkins walked across the stage, while junior Trey Thompson participated in commencment and is scheduled to complete his degree in December and wear the coveted "SEC Graduate" patch on his uniform during the 2017-18 campaign. Former Razorback great and all-time assist leader Kareem Reid walked across the stage 18 years after his final game as a Hog, and former graduate transfer Willy Kouassi graduated in the summer of 2017 with his master's degree.

During his first six seasons at Arkansas, Anderson produced a 128-74 record and was the first head coach in program history to win 18 or more games in each of his first four years. Anderson has also re-established Bud Walton Arena as one of the toughest places to play and brought excitement back to the tradition-rich program. Since his return to Fayetteville, the Razorbacks are tied for the fourth-most home victories in the country with 95 and are one of four teams in the country with 95-plus wins and 15 or fewer losses at home over the last six seasons. The 2012-13 squad posted just the third unbeaten SEC home record (9-0) in program history and the first since 1998. The success on-and-off the court has translated into fan support as Arkansas returned to the top 25 in national attendance the first six years, including No. 12 in 2016-17.


