COUGARS FACE FAMILIAR FOE THIS WEEKEND

- The Cougars open the month of December when they play host to familiar rival Arkansas at 6:30 p.m., Saturday, inside H&PE Arena.
- Teams met at least twice every year from 1975-76 season through 1990-91 season as Southwest Conference members.
- Second straight year these two teams will meet after Razorbacks claimed an 84-72 win in Fayetteville, Ark., on Dec. 6, 2016... However, Saturday's game will be the first time Arkansas has visited Houston since Feb. 7, 1991.
- Both teams enter Saturday's game with 5-1 records... Cougars claimed a 75-66 victory over New Orleans on Wednesday in middle of season-long, four-game homestand... Arkansas comes into game well-rested after a 102-67 win over UConn in the PK80 Tournament in Honolulu on Nov. 26.
- Will be the third game in a season-long four-game homestand for the Cougars.

HEADLINES and STORYLINES

- Construction continues on former Hofheinz Pavilion as it undergoes a \$60 million renovation to become the Fertitta Center for the 2018-19 season... Houston is competing inside H&PE Arena on the campus of nearby Texas Southern for most of the 2017-18 season.
- Houston has outbounded its first six opponents to open the 2017-18 season... Cougars have not accomplished that feat at any point in a season since 2001-02 Cougars outbounded seven straight opponents Dec. 2-30, 2001.
- Senior guard **Rob Gray** has established himself as one of the American Athletic Conference's elite stars... Leads the league with and ranks 12th nationally with 23.6 points per game but also tops conference with a 5.8 assist-turnover ratio (23 asts, 4 TOS) and ranks fourth with 4.6 assists per contest.
- After posting 14 points with 12 rebounds against UIW on Nov. 25, freshman forward **Fabian White Jr.** was honored Monday as the American Athletic Conference Rookie of the Week, a first in his young career.

UP NEXT

- Following Saturday's game against Arkansas, the Cougars wrap up their season-long, four-game homestand when they play host to Fairfield at 11 a.m., Wednesday, inside H&PE Arena.
- Media and fans should note that the starting time for the Fairfield game was changed from earlier published schedules... That game will tip off at 11 a.m., Wednesday, as part of Education Day with elementary students from around Houston ISD attending the game.
- Houston returns to the road to face Saint Louis at 7 p.m., Dec. 9, in St. Louis, Mo., and at 8 p.m., Dec. 13, at LSU in Baton Rouge, La.

ABOUT ARKANSAS

• Arkansas brings a 5-1 record into Saturday's game after taking a 102-67 win at UConn in the Victory bracket at the PK80 Tournament in Portland, Ore.

• Razorbacks won their first four games before falling to North Carolina on Nov. 24 at the PK 80 Tournament.

• Against UConn, Arkansas raced out to a 45-31 lead at halftime and scored 57 second-half points... Razorbacks connected on 60.0 percent from the field, including 65.4 percent in the final 20 minutes.

• Senior guard Jaylen Barford led the Razorbacks with 24 points on 9-of-12 shooting, including 4-of-5

from behind the arc... Senior guard Daryl Macon added 14 points, while sophomore guard C.J. Jones came off the bench to post 19 points, including 6-of-6 from the free throw line... Freshman forward Darius Hall added a team-high six rebounds, while senior forward Trey Thompson finished with five assists.

• This season, Barford leads Arkansas with 20.8 points and ranks second with 3.3 assists per game... Macon averages 16.3 points per game to stand second among the Razorbacks, while freshman forward Daniel Gafford ranks third with 12.8 points per contest... Senior guard Anton Beard is fourth on the team with 12.2 points per game.

• Gafford and senior forward Dustin Thomas are tied for the team lead with 5.7 rebounds per game with Beard averaging a team-high 3.5 assists per contest.

Head Coach: Mike Anderson is in his seventh season at Arkansas and his 16th season as an NCAA collegiate head coach.

• Has compiled a 333-173 record during his career and is 133-75 at Arkansas.

• Cougars now have won their last nine and 13 of their last 14 season openers... Only a 65-63 loss to Georgia Southern on the first day of the 2K Sports Classic benefiting Coaches vs. Cancer in Durham, N.C., prevents a longer streak.

• Houston has won handily in recent history, winning their last nine season openers by an average of 22.6 points per game... That includes back-to-back 41-point wins against Prairie View A&M (110-69, Nov. 18, 2015) and Morgan State (93-52, Nov. 11, 2016).

A SPECIAL EXHIBITION

• The Cougars defeated No. 24/24 Baylor, 81-78, on Oct. 21 inside the Ferrell Center in Waco, Texas, in a special exhibition game for Hurricane Harvey Relief.

• Senior guard **Rob Gray** led the Cougars with 25 points and 11 assists, connected on 7-of-14 shots from the field and 10-of-13 tries from the free throw line.

• Both teams received waivers from the NCAA to play the game with all ticket sales going to Hurricane Harvey relief... Texas Farm Bureau Insurance matched the ticket sales total with more than \$20,000 raised.

• Cougars jumped out to an 11-2 lead in the first four minutes before Baylor stormed back... With Baylor holding a 62-61 lead with under seven minutes left, Cougars used a 9-4 run to take the lead for good... Senior forward **Devin Davis** scored four points, while Gray sank a layup and assisted on two buckets during that stretch.

• Gray drained four free throws in the final 18 seconds to ice the win.

• Making his Houston debut, junior point guard **Corey Davis Jr.** added 11 points -- thanks to three 3-pointers on four attempts -- with three assists. Freshman forward **Fabian White Jr.** led the Cougars with six rebounds, including three offensive boards.

• Jo Lual-Acuil Jr. led Baylor with 18 points and added a game-high eight rebounds, while Manu Lecomte and Terry Maston totaled 17 points apiece with Lecomte's 10

assists pacing the Bears. McCure finished with 11 points in the losing effort.

• In season openers, Sampson is now 4-0 during his Houston tenure and posted a 2-0 record at Indiana, an 11-1 mark at Oklahoma and was 6-1 at Washington State.

• Sampson's teams have now won their last 10 season openers and 23 of his last 24... Only a 68-62 loss to Alabama at the AT&T Wireless Classic in New York on Nov. 14, 2002, prevents a longer streak.

• During his career, Sampson's teams have won by an average of 23.1 points per game (532 points in 23 games).

• In his teams' 32 season-opening wins, only two teams have won by fewer than double digits... His first team at Houston in 2014-15 claimed a 77-74 win at Murray State on Nov. 14, 2014, in his most recent single-digit, season-opening win.

- In most recent action, went 3-of-7 from the arc in Cougars' loss to host UConn in American Championship Quarterfinals on March 10 in Hartford, Conn.
- Ranks among nation's top-15 leaders with a 43.7 3-point field goal percentage (12th nationally, 2nd The American) and 3.4 treys per game (8th nationally, 2nd The American).
- It took 39 minutes and 48 seconds of game time, but Dotson finally buried a trey in the Cougars' Senior Day win during the Final Game inside Hofheinz Pavilion on March 5 to extend his streak... Was his biggest scare of the season.
- Dotson set the Houston record with his first trey of the night with 4:01 left in the game at Cincinnati on March 2.
- Broke out of a tie with **Robert McKiver** (2006-08), who started his streak with a trey against Coastal Carolina on Nov. 26, 2007, and added 27 more games through the end of his senior season.
- In 30 games to date, Dotson has made 2+ treys in all but three games.

SCORING AND REBOUNDING

- Thanks to a team-leading seven double-doubles in 2016-17, senior guard **Damyean Dotson** has emerged as one of the American Athletic Conference's top-10 leaders in both scoring and rebounding.
- Currently fourth in the league with 17.3 points per game and 10th with 7.0 rebounds per game... Also tied for sixth in the conference with seven double-doubles in 2016-17.
- Dotson is one of only two players to rank among the Amer-

- Became first Cougar to reach that milestone since junior guard and current teammate **Rob Gray** tied his own career high with 31 points in win against Rhode Island on Dec. 10, 2016, inside Hofheinz Pavilion.

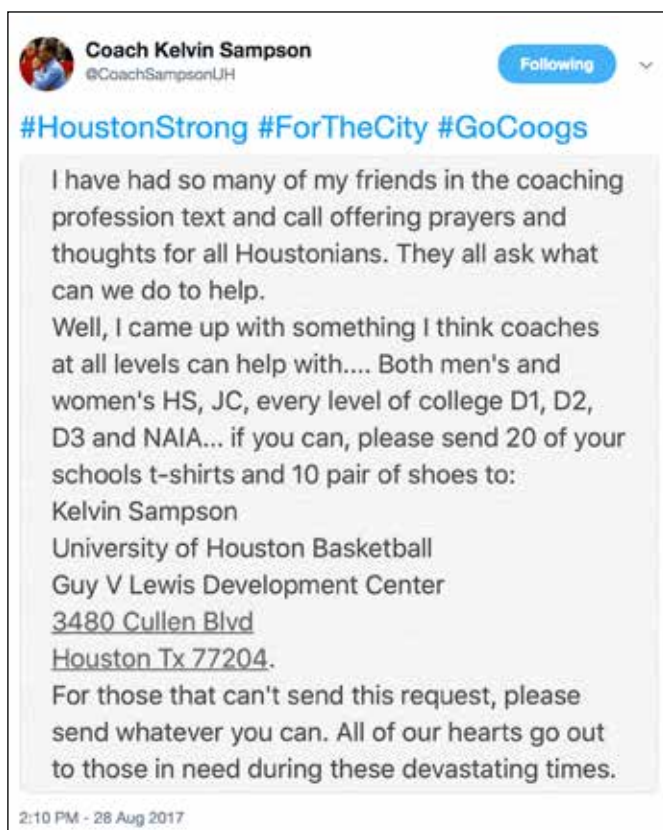

On Aug. 28, 2017, as Hurricane Harvey ravaged the Texas Gulf Coast and the greater Houston area, Houston Head Coach Kelvin Sampson sent out a tweet asking for basketball coaches at all levels to donate 20 t-shirts and 10 pairs of shoes and send to his attention at the Guy V. Lewis Development Facility on the University of Houston campus to distribute to relief efforts.

Basketball coaches responded... as the did the entire nation.

Eventually, more than 2.7 million people saw his tweet Sampson and the Men's Basketball program received nearly 1,500 donation commitments to his Twitter account from 49 states and Canada as well as many more donations from people who did not use social media. Sampson and his team received thousands of boxes during the next several weeks and distributed to local missions and charity groups to assist in hurricane relief efforts.

By the end of the drive, Houston Men's Basketball estimated that it received more than 20,000 pairs of shoes and more than 200,000 t-shirts for those in need.

- Founded in 1927, the University of Houston is the leading public research university in the vibrant international city of Houston. Each year, we educate more than 40,900 students in more than 300 undergraduate and graduate academic programs, on campus and online. UH awards more than 8,000 degrees annually, with more than 200,000 alumni.

- UH is located in Houston, Texas, the nation's fourth-largest city and the energy capital of the world. Our students regularly test their skills through internships with national and international companies based here, and our faculty routinely partner with businesses and government agencies through research.

- Our undergraduates choose from 120 majors and minors. At the graduate level, we offer 139 master's, 54 doctoral, and three professional degree programs. The University of Houston Men's and Women's Basketball programs will compete in a new game arena during the 2018-19 season when the Fertitta Center officially opens.

With the completion of the 2016-17 season, Hofheinz Pavilion – the Cougars' current home arena – will undergo a \$60 million renovation. The renovation was made possible through a generous \$20 million donation from University of System Board of Regents Chairman Tilman J. Fertitta and his family in late August 2016.

The facility will feature a premium club area and a court-side club. The reconfigured bowl will move mid-court seating locations closer to game action with floor-level seating opposite the team benches for UH students. Renovations include a new audio system, sports lighting and video boards as well as new concession stands and expanded restrooms. The facility's exterior also will be refreshed.

Prominent to the center's exterior, the renovation will preserve the legacy of the Hofheinz family and its contributions to both UH and the city of Houston. UH will transform an

area adjacent to the new facility into Hofheinz Plaza, where fans will be greeted by a bronze statue of former Harris County Judge Roy Hofheinz.

The University of Houston will request that city officials rename a portion of Holman Street in front of the arena after the Hofheinz family. In addition, Roy Hofheinz's records will be permanently archived and publicly accessible as a special collection in the UH library and the Alumni Center will house an area describing the lives and public service of Roy and Irene Hofheinz.

"This gift is personal. It represents a commitment from my family and me to support the University of Houston in its quest to strengthen our nationally competitive institution both in academics and athletics," Fertitta said. "Upgrading our athletics facilities shows we are serious about competing at the highest levels of collegiate sports for many years to come. I'm proud of where the University of Houston is today and I'm proud to make this investment in my university's future."

The University of Houston Men's Basketball program moved into its new home during the 2015-16 season following completion of construction of the Guy V. Lewis Development Facility.

The near-53,000-square-foot facility provides the environment that University of Houston Men's and Women's Basketball student-athletes need to excel throughout the season in all areas.

Named after 592-game winner and Hall of Fame Head Coach Guy V. Lewis, the Development Facility is located adjacent to Hofheinz Pavilion at the corner of Cullen Boulevard and Holman Street on the UH campus.

Construction on the \$25-million facility became in September 2014. Austin Commercial served as the construction manager for the project, which was designed by DLR Group and Page.

The first level houses a dedicated practice court for each team as well as sports performance and sports medicine areas, which are shared by both programs.

The second level features the teams' areas, which include locker room and academic/film theaters. The team rooms contain spacious, modern lockers, multiple video screens for television and video games and comfortable furniture.

The third level holds office space for both Men's and Women's Basketball coaching and support staffs.
