QUICK HITS

• ORU and Arkansas have met 11 times leading into Tuesday's contest, with the Razorbacks holding a 9-2 advantage in the series. Both of ORU's wins came at home, in 1996 and 2002.

• After passing the 1,000 point mark for his career, **Albert Owens** is now trying to become the next member of the 1,000-point, 500-rebound club. Owens currently has 462 career rebounds. 15 other players have reached both benchmarks during their ORU careers. Korey Billbury (2012-15) was the most recent to do so.

• Sophomore **Emmanuel Nzekwesi** earned his first career Summit League Player of the Week honor on December 18, after scoring 24 points and pulling down 11 rebounds in ORU's win over Florida Gulf Coast. This year, Nzekwesi was also named to the All-Tournament team for the Malibu Subregional of the 2017 Legends Classic.

• Entering the 2017-18 season, senior center **Albert Owens** was picked as a preseason first team All-Summit League selection while sophomore forward **Emmanuel Nzekwesi** earned preseason second team honors. Additionally, Blue Ribbon Sports tabbed sophomore guard **Sam Kearns** as The Summit League's Preseason Newcomer of the Year.

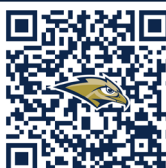

The Basics

Score: Oral Roberts 83 - Florida Gulf Coast 64

FORT MYERS, Fla. - The Oral Roberts men's basketball team made a statement on the road Saturday night as the Golden Eagles top pulled away from No. 12 (MM) Florida Gulf Coast to with 83-64 and earn its second straight victory over a ranked mid-major program.

ORU held FGCU to less than 70 points for the first time this season, snapping a streak of 11-straight games to start the year, the second longest streak in school history. The Golden Eagles dominated the boards 40-20 against a team that is 25th in the nation in rebounding and 34th in rebounding margin.

The Golden Eagles got career scoring performances from Javan White (25) and Emmanuel Nzekwesi (24), with the duo each notching a double-double with 11 rebounds apiece. The duo combined for 22 rebounds, out-rebounding the entire FGCU team (20).

Brandon Goodwin led the FGCU offense with 20 points to lead a trio of double figure scorers. In his first game with the Eagles, Michael Gilmore added 10 points and a team high four rebounds.

Turning Point

ORU's lead was trimmed to four (55-51) with 13:02 to play before ORU mounted an 8-0 run. The Golden Eagles withstood a couple more FGCU spurts before pulling away for good at the five minute mark with a 7-0 run to push it from an eight point game to a 15 point advantage.

Individual Leaders

Oral Roberts: White led ORU in scoring with 25 points, while matching Nzekwesi with 11 rebounds each. Kearns had seven assists and Nzekwesi and Miller each recorded three steals.

Florida Gulf Coast: Goodwin hit three 3-pointers and scored 20 points to lead FGCU. Zach Johnson had eight assists and three steals. Gilmore was the leading rebounder with four.

Inside the Box Score

- ORU out-rebounded FGCU 40-20, including 17 offensive rebounds. The dominance around the basket extended to the scoring column as ORU out-scored FGCU 58-22 in the paint and 19-9 in second chance points.

- ORU also held a decisive advantage in points off turnovers, 24-12.

- The Golden Eagles shot 54 percent (34-63) from the field, despite going 4-14 (29 percent) from 3-point range. ORU shot 85 percent (11-13) from the free throw line.

- FGCU shot 44 percent (24-54) from the field and 44 percent (11-25) from 3-point range. The Eagles were 5-8 (62 percent) from the free throw line.

News and Notes

- With his block in the first half, Owens moved into a tie with Rocky Walls (1994-98) for sixth all-time at ORU with 127 career blocks.

- ORU's +20 on the boards was the largest rebounding margin of the season and the largest since out-rebounding John Brown by 22 (60-38) on December 9, 2015.

- ORU matched its season high with 18 assists in the game.

- In addition to Nzekwesi and White's career scoring efforts, Chris Miller recorded a career best three steals.

HOME SWEET HOME

Since the start of the 2004-05 season, ORU is 134-37 (.801) at home and an amazing 90-21 (.810) in conference play in that time. During that stretch, the Golden Eagles have at least 10 wins in eight of the 12 years, including a 15-0 regular season mark in 2011-12.

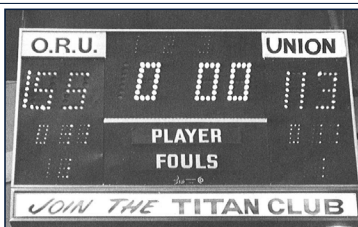

Previously known as the Mid-Continent Conference, The Summit League rebranded in 2007 and has since produced eight NCAA Champions, and over 75 Academic All-Americans, 65 All-America selections and numerous former student-athletes competing at the highest professional level.

Since its inception in 1982, The Summit League recorded several transcendent moments that resonate on the national stage. While known as the Mid-Continent Conference, the league's first two decades produced a pair of appearances in the NCAA Men's Basketball Tournament's "Sweet 16" and the Women's College World Series as well as three individual NCAA Track and Field Champions.

To coincide with The Summit League's 30th Anniversary Season in 2011-12, the league released a list of its Top 30 Distinguished Contributors from the Division I era as selected by a panel of voters from member schools and the media. Four individual NCAA champions and three Olympic medalists, along with four NBA players and two World Series Champions headlined The Summit League's list of top student-athletes, coaches and administrators that was the jewel of the anniversary celebration. Included on the list where ORU alumni Andretti Bain, Dennis Bigley, Caleb Green, Prince Mumba, Krista Ragan, Jack Whitt and Ori Zuzic.
