@UGA\_WBB held South Carolina to 62 points, trying the Gamecocks' season low this year.

@UGA\_WBB's Caliya Robinson is averaging 17.5 ppg in Georgia's 10 wins and 9.1 in 11 losses.

@UGA\_WBB's three seniors combined to start just 29 games entering the 2016-17 season.

@UGA\_WBB's Pachis Roberts scored in double figures 12 times before this season. This year, she has scored in double figures 17 times.

@UGA\_WBB's Haley Clark has recorded 40 total assists in eight SEC games (5.7 per game).

#### OPENING TIP

» Georgia hits the road for the second consecutive game with a trip to Arkansas to take on the Razorbacks at 8 p.m. ET/7 p.m. CT inside Bud Walton Arena.

» **The Lady Bulldogs have won nine out of the last 10 meetings against Arkansas** and own a dominating 30-5 edge in the all-time series. Georgia has only lost three times in Fayetteville.

» Thursday's contest starts the second half of the league schedule for these two teams. Both squads enter the stretch run of conference action with identical 2-6 records.

» **Senior guard/forward Pachis Roberts is Georgia's leading scorer and rebounder, averaging 14.1 points and 7.2 rebounds per game.** Roberts, who averaged just 5.0 ppg during her first three collegiate seasons, has scored in double figures in nine-straight games.

» **Junior forward Mackenzie Engram has reached double figures in scoring in three-straight contests, averaging 15.6 points per game during that span.**

» Another bright spot for the Lady Bulldogs has been the play of freshman Stephanie Paul. **Paul averaged just 2.2 ppg in non-conference action, but has upped her contributions to 6.9 ppg during SEC play.**

#### Pachis' Production Up In Senior Season

» **Just one glance at the stat sheet and it is easy to see Pachis Roberts' improvement in her senior season. She is averaging 14.1 points per game (16.5 per game in conference play) and has started all 21 contests.** In the previous three years combined, Roberts averaged just 5.0 ppg and started a total of 13 games. Below is a closer look at Roberts' improvement:

#### Engram Showing Consistency

» **Junior guard/forward Mackenzie Engram, who missed the last 16 games last season due to an illness, is starting to show glimpses of 2015, when she placed on SEC All-Freshman Team.** The Powder Springs native has scored in double figures in three consecutive games, averaging 15.6 ppg during those contests. Engram scored 18 points against Florida, 10 vs. #5 South Carolina and 19 at Ole Miss.

#### Georgia Takes No. 5 South Carolina To The Wire

» **Georgia came within seconds of breaking South Carolina's then 26-game SEC win streak on Jan. 12.** In what was a back-and-forth game, the fifth-ranked Gamecocks never led by more than five points in the fourth quarter, with Georgia taking the lead at 55-53 with 4:51 remaining. **The Lady Bulldogs had a chance to tie the game with just five seconds remaining, but Haley Clark's second free-throw fell just short as USC held on for the win.**

#### Balanced Scoring Key In Two SEC Wins

» **Four Lady Bulldogs have scored in double figures in each of Georgia's two SEC wins.** A big reason for Georgia's success in those two victories was the play of newcomers Simone Costa and Stephanie Paul. Costa had perhaps her best game of the year with a 13-point effort against Texas A&M, while Paul set a new career-highs with 12 points and seven rebounds in the win against Vanderbilt.

#### Freshman Clutch At The Buzzer

» In a game that featured eight lead changes and four ties, **Georgia overcame a 13-point deficit in the first half to take down Vanderbilt. Freshman Stephanie Paul played a crucial role, not just in the final seconds, in the win against Vandy. She scored eight points in the third quarter, including the go-ahead shot at the beginning of the second half that gave Georgia its first lead since it was 2-0 in the early going.**

#### Defensive Numbers Carrying Over

» Georgia led the Southeastern Conference in most major defensive categories last season, pacing the league in field-goal percentage defense, 3-point field-goal percentage defense and scoring defense. Even though the team is mostly different from a season ago with the departure of four senior starters, some of those numbers have carried over. **Georgia has held 14 opponents at or below 40-percent shooting this season, including a season-low 35.9 percent shooting effort from Texas A&M. In the Joni Taylor Era, Georgia has held 43 of 52 opponents to the 40-percent clip.**

#### Robinson Puts Her Name Among Georgia Greats

» **With her 24-point, 11-rebound effort against Samford on Dec. 22, Caliya Robinson became just the fourth Lady Bulldog since 2000 to record three or more 20-point, 10 rebound games in their careers, joining an elite group of former Lady Dogs — Tasha Humphrey, Christi Thomas and Kara Braxton.** Robinson already has 14 double-figure scoring efforts (surpassing last year's total) and five double-doubles.

» **Caliya Robinson became the first Lady Bulldog since Tasha Humphrey in 2008 to score 30 points in a single game.** Robinson had a career day against Minnesota on Nov. 24, scoring 30 points off a 14-for-27 shooting performance. Humphrey scored 32 points against Florida on Feb. 24, 2008.

#### Short Bench, Starting Five Shift for The Lady Bulldogs

» Georgia's roster features just eight scholarship players and one walk-on this season. The Lady Bulldogs lost four senior starters off last year's team and lost incoming freshman Kortney Eisenman due to a heart condition before the start of the season. **Georgia has used seven different starting lineup combinations so far with the most common being Haley Clark, Shanea Armbrister, Pachis Roberts, Mackenie Engram and Caliya Robinson.**

A total of 41 Lady Dogs have gone on to play professionally. Shacobia Barbee is now in Spain and Merritt Hempe is playing in Germany.

**Scouting Arkansas**

» The Razorbacks enter Thursday's game with a 2-6 SEC record and are 13-8 overall this season. Arkansas stormed out to an 11-2 start in non-conference action, but is averaging just 56.4 points per game and does not have a player scoring in double figures through eight league contests. Jimmy Dykes is in his third year as head coach in Fayetteville and owns a 43-40 record since taking over the job in 2014. Jessica Jackson is the star for the Razorbacks as she enters Thursday's contest ranked in the top-5 among SEC's active career leaders in scoring, field-goals made, 3-point field-goals made, rebounding and blocks.

» Head coach Joni Taylor and her husband Darius welcomed their first child, Jacie Elise Taylor, into the world Nov. 3. She weighed 6 pounds, 5 ounces and was 20 inches long. Taylor was on the bench for each of those games, except when the team played in the Bahamas on Nov. 24 and 26. Jacie has made several appearances at Georgia games this season and takes a seat beside her father, Darius, behind the Georgia bench.

**GEORGIA'S 2017 SIGNING CLASS RANKS NO. 10 NATIONALLY**

The Lady Bulldogs' 2017 signing class currently ranks among the top-10 in the nation according to ESPN.com's Hoopgurlz. Head coach Joni Taylor and her staff have signed some of the top players in the country, with all four of this year's signees ranking in the ESPN top-100.

**Que Morrison // Guard // Powder Springs, Georgia // ESPN.com Five Stars**

Quannecia 'Que' Morrison is one of the top high school players in the state of Georgia and a five-star prospect according to ESPN's HoopGurlz. Morrison, who helped Powder Springs, Georgia, powerhouse McEachern High School to a state championship this past year, is ranked as the No. 31 overall prospect and the No. 7 guard nationally in the 2017 class according to ESPN's Hoopgurlz.

**Gabby Connally // Point Guard // San Antonio, Texas // ESPN.com Five Stars**

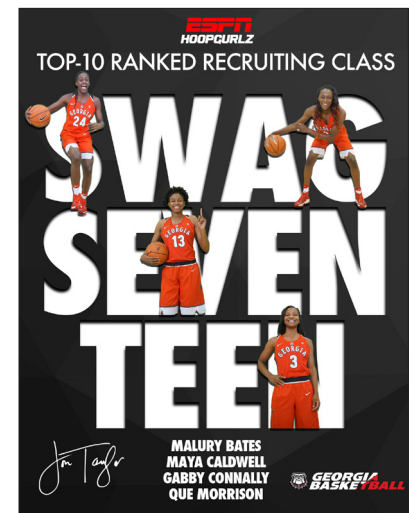

**Kelly and Coco Miller Join UGA's Circle Of Honor**

» Kelly and Coco Miller, twin sisters from Rochester, Minnesota who rank No. 4 and No. 5 respectively on the Lady Bulldogs' all-time career scoring list, were a dynamic duo that dazzled Georgia fans and helped the team to several remarkable accomplishments during their time in Athens. The duo will add to their impressive list of honors and will be enshrined into the University of Georgia's Circle of Honor at a ceremony on Feb. 11.

**The Miller twins were each four-year starters for the Lady Bulldogs from 1997-2001 and helped Georgia advance to the 1999 Final Four, capture the 2000 SEC Championship and win the 2001 SEC Tournament title. Kelly (2,177 points) and Coco (2,131 points) are two of only five Lady Bulldogs to score more than 2,000 points. They also rank among Georgia's top-10 career leaders in field goals made and attempted as well as steals.**

**Georgia Replacing Production**

» Entering 2016-17, the Lady Bulldogs had to replace four senior starters off of last year's team. Shacobia Barbee, Tiaria Griffin, Merritt Hempt and Marjorie Butler accounted for 65 percent of Georgia's scoring and over 50 percent of the team's rebounding a season ago. Barbee and Griffin were two All-SEC performers, while Butler played in all 31 games at the point guard spot. The group combined for 479 games played and made three NCAA Tournaments (Elite Eight in 2013).

**Lady Bulldogs Go International**

» Georgia's roster has an international feel to it this season with the addition of Romania native and Washington State transfer Bianca Blanaru as well as Portugal native Simone Costa. Shanea Armbrister, who is in her second season with the Lady Bulldogs, grew up in the Bahamas and will make a return trip home when Georgia travels to the Junkanoo Jam on Nov. 24-26.

**Robinson Rises Among SEC's Top Up-and-Comers**

» Georgia's Caliya Robinson completed a banner year in 2015-16. Robinson etched her name into the history books, moving ahead of UGA great Katrina McClain for the fifth-most blocked shots for a Georgia freshman with 48 -- a total that ranked third overall in the SEC last season.

She was an x-factor all season long and finished strong, recording four consecutive double-figure scoring games down the stretch. The 2016 SEC All-Freshman Team selection and three-time SEC Freshman of the Week honoree finished the year averaging 8.0 points per game to go along with 5.7 rebounds per contest.

TAYLOR TAKES LADY DOGS TO TOURNEY IN FIRST YEAR  
Strong Start ... Even Better Finish

» Georgia stormed out to an impressive start last season under head coach Joni Taylor, rolling to a 12-1 record before conference play began on Jan. 3. The Lady Bulldogs finished the year with a 21-10 record and 9-7 mark in SEC play, putting Taylor's name in elite company for first-year head coaches. **In fact, Taylor became one of just 12 coaches in SEC history to record 20 or more wins in his or her first year with their respective programs.**

Dominant Defense A Trademark Of 2015-16 Season

» Georgia paced the Southeastern Conference in nearly every defensive category last season. The Lady Bulldogs ranked first in scoring defense (54.1 points per game), field-goal percentage defense (35 percent) and 3-point field-goal percentage defense (24.3%). The 54.1 points allowed per game marks the second-best defensive points per game effort for a single season in school history.

20-Win Season The Usual For Georgia

» Georgia recorded 20 or more wins for the 30th time in the past 37 years with its 21-10 record in 2015-16, building on the great tradition and history of Lady Bulldog basketball. With their appearance in the 2016 NCAA Tournament, the Lady Dogs rank second all-time in NCAA history with 32 appearances -- a total that only trails Tennessee.

Five Top-25 Wins In 2015-16

» Georgia won five games over ranked opponents during the 2015-16 season for the first time since 2006-07. Four of those victories came against SEC foes, while one win came against then-No. 21 Seton Hall, who finished third in the Big East. UGA also had a victory against BYU, who won the West Coast Conference regular season title.

Taylor Gets Most Prestigious Honor For First Year Coach

» Georgia head coach Joni Taylor won several honors for her team's success in her first year as head coach. Among them was the 2016 Spalding Maggie Dixon National Rookie Coach of the Year award, which goes to the top first-year head coach in the country. Taylor also earned the Atlanta Tip-Off Club Georgia College Coach of the Year honor.

Feb. 25, 2016 - LADY BULLDOGS DOWN ARKANSAS, 72-57

ATHENS, Ga. -- Behind a deep scoring effort in which eight Lady Bulldogs appeared on the score sheet, the Georgia Lady Bulldog basketball team (21-7, 9-6) defeated Arkansas (11-17, 6-9) by a 72-57 tally in the home finale at Stegeman Coliseum.

Four Lady Dogs reached double-digit scoring, led by seniors Merritt Hempe (18 points) and Tiaria Griffin (15 points). Caliya Robinson and Pachis Roberts also crossed the 10-point plateau, posting 14 and 12 points, respectively. After trailing by two points at the break, Georgia shot 61.5-percent from the field in the second half, scoring 48 points in the final 20 minutes of play. With the win, Georgia finishes the 2015-16 regular season slate with a 14-3 record at home.

"We felt like we could take advantage of some size inside," said Georgia head coach Joni Taylor. "Arkansas is a really good team. Credit them for their effort. We knew it would be all hands on deck, and to have four players in double-figures (scoring), we really settled in in the third and fourth quarter and got comfortable and made plays."
