- ▶ Mizzou is coming off its first home win over Texas A&M since
- ▶ Mizzou now has three consecutive wins at home over ranked opponents (No. 25 Texas A&M this season and No. 6 Mississippi State and No. 22 Florida last season).
- ▶ Mizzou is 10-1 this season at home. The Tigers finished the nonconference slate 8-0 at home and have won 32 consecutive nonconference home games.
- ▶ Mizzou is searching for its first win at Arkansas since Dec. 21, 2008 and the second total victory against the Razorbacks in Fayetteville in program history.
- ▶ Mizzou and Arkansas have split its season series each of the last two seasons, with both teams winning at home in 2015-16 and 2014-15
- ▶ Mizzou has been dominant in first quarters this season, outscoring opponents 352-267 in the frame, including 98-63 in SEC play.

- ▶ Mizzou is coming off a historic 2015-16 season, having racked up 22 wins for the first time since 2000-01
- ▶ The Tigers earned an NCAA Tournament berth for the first time since 2006 and won an NCAA Tournament game for the first time since 2001 after upsetting 7-seeded BYU in the opening round as a No. 10 seed.
- ▶ The Tigers cracked the Associated Press Top 25 poll and were ranked for eight weeks during the 2015-16 season. It was just the second time Mizzou entered the poll since 1985. It was the longest run for the program in the poll in more than 30 years.
- Mizzou won eight conference games, clinched three victories over top-50 RPI opponents and four more over top-100 RPI foes.
- Mizzou has now completed four consecutive winning seasons for the first time since 1986-90.
- ▶ Coach Pingeton's squad also excelled in the classroom, posting a spring 2016 Team GPA of 3.31, the highest ever in program history.

NOTABLES

SENSATIONAL SOPHIE

- Since returning from a back injury that sidelined her for two games, Sophie Cunningham has averaged 20 points per contest over the last nine outings. She is averaging 20.7 points per game during SEC play, which ranks second in the conference.
- ▶ Cunningham has played her best basketball of the season of late. The sophomore paced Mizzou with 24 points on 10-of-16 shooting (62.5 percent) vs. Alabama, followed with 32 points on 12-of-17 shooting at LSU and most recently poured in a season-high 36 points against Texas A&M. The 36 point-outburst is the best performance in the SEC during conference play thus far and she's the only player in the league to record multiple 30-point games since the conference slate began.
- ▶ Cunningham went 10-for-19 from the field and 14-of-15 from the free throw line vs. Texas A&M. She is the first Tiger in 15 seasons to make 10 field goals and 10 free throws in the same game and she's now done it twice in her career (Wake Forest last season). The 14 free throws are the most by an SEC player in a game during league play and she's one of two SEC players to make at least 10 field goals in game three times during conference play, alongside Kentucky's Evelyn Ahkator.
- Last Thursday marked the fifth time since her return that Cunningham has notched at least 20 points in a game. She's now reached 20 points in a game six times this season and 16 times in her young career (which includes just 50 total games played).
- ▶ After averaging 14.0 points per game a season ago on her way to capturing SEC Freshman of the Year honors, Cunningham has pushed her average to 17.6 points per game in 2016-17. That ranks third in the SEC thus far and she's one one averaging 17 points or more. She's also dishing out 3.8 assists per contest, which ranks seventh in the league.
- ▶ Cunningham is the only player in the SEC shooting above 45 percent from the field (48.8 percent) and above 80 percent from the free throw line (84.8 percent) this season.
- ▶ Cunningham was one of 50 players nationally to be named to the 2017 Preseason Naismith Player of the Year Watch List.

OT MADNESS

- ▶ In Thursday's contest between Mizzou and Texas A&M, the Tigers and Aggies combined to score 42 points in the overtime period. That set a new NCAA record for combined points in a single overtime period.
- ▶ Mizzou notched 22 points in OT, which was one shy of matching the NCAA record for points by a single team in one overtime period. The 22 points are a new program record and tied the SEC record.
- ▶ Mizzou and Texas A&M have now played back-to-back overtimes against each other with the two teams each winning one. Mizzou is 3-2 in its last five overtime games.
- ▶ The Tigers made 17 free throws in overtime alone. Sophie Cunningham, Cierra Porter and Lindsey Cunningham combined to make 14-of-14 free throws in OT.

MICHA3LIS

- ▶ After scoring 20 points in a win over Georgia and pouring in 22 points at Kentucky, senior guard Sierra Michaelis has racked up at least 20 points 10 times in her career, including four times in 2016-17 (which matches a career high in a season). The performances against Kentucky and Georgia marked the first time she recorded back-to-back 20-point outbursts.
- ▶ Michaelis racked up 19 points, six rebounds, four assists, three steals and three blocked shots against Vanderbilt. The last time a Tiger reached those plateaus in all five categories in a single game was Amanda Lassiter in 2001.
- ▶ After making four 3s each vs. Georgia and Kentucky, Michaelis has now sunk at least four threes in a game 18 times in her career. She's just the third Tiger in program history to do so. Only Morgan Eye (43 times) and Alyssa Hollins (20 times) accomplished that feat more times than Michaelis.
- ▶ Michaelis has scored in double figures 12 times this season. Mizzou is 9-3 in those contests. She received her first career SEC weekly honor when she captured SEC Co-Player of the Week in mid-December.
- ▶ She recorded a career-high nine steals against Wichita State. Michaelis is the first Mizzou player to do so since Tracy Franklin in 2001.
- ▶ Michaelis ranks 5th among active SEC players in career 3s and 9th among active SEC players in career points with 986. She needs just 14 more points to become Mizzou's 34th member of the 1,000-point club, joining teammate Jordan Frericks. Among active players, she is the only player in the SEC to rank in the top ten in career points, top ten in career assists and top five in career three-pointers.

PORTER CONTROLLING THE PAINT

- ▶ Sophomore Cierra Porter has been Mizzou's most consistent offensive weapon this season. Her streak of consecutive games scoring in double digits to open the season was snapped at 15 games. The last time a Tiger reached double digits in the team's first 15 games was when RaeShara Brown (current assistant coach) did so during the 2011-12 campaign. Porter has scored at least 10 points in 18 of 20 contests.
- After a 14-point, 13-rebound outing vs. Texas A&M, Porter has a team-high nine double-doubles this season and 10 in her career. When Porter has recorded a double-double, Mizzou is 8-1.
- ▶ She ranks third in the SEC in total blocked shots with 36 swats (which is 14 more than her total output from last season) and third in the league in total offensive rebounds with 67. Porter matched her career high with five blocked shots against Alabama. She is one of three players in the SEC to rack up at least five swats in multiple games this season. Porter has recorded at least 10 points, 10 rebounds and four blocked shots in a game four times this season.
- ▶ Earlier this season, she racked up 13 points, a career-high 15 rebounds and a career-high five blocked shots vs. Western Illinois. She is the only player in the SEC to post a 15-rebound, 5-block performance in a game this season.
- ▶ Porter was named to the All-Tournament teams following both the Preseason WNIT and the Junkanoo Jam.

DOMINANT AT THE FREE THROW LINE

- Mizzou ranks eighth in the nation in free throw percentage as a team so far this season as the Tigers are shooting 79.0 percent from the line. That percentage currently tops the Southeastern Conference.
- Mizzou ranks 10th in Division I in total free throws made with 297. Mizzou has taken at least 35 less attempts at the line than all nine teams ahead of them on the list.

- After averaging 13.7 made free throws per game last season, Mizzou is up to 14.9 made free throws per game through 20 games in 2016-17.
- Mizzou is one of 12 teams in the nation that have made at least 290 free throws this season.
- ▶ When Mizzou takes more free throw attempts than an opponent, the Tigers are 11-1 and when Mizzou makes more free throws than an opponent, the Tigers are 13-1.
- ▶ Mizzou has put together the three best single-game performances from the free throw line as a team in the Southeastern Conference.

- Mizzou's 27-of-28 (96.4 percent) performance from the free throw line against Indiana State matches the thirdbest FT percentage in school history (min. 10 attempts) — the only two performances that were better are a 21-for-21 mark against Oklahoma in 2004 (a 77-65 win) and a 10-for-10 performance against North Florida in 2011 (a 67-46 win). Mizzou is the only team in the nation to shoot above 96 percent in a game while taking more than 25 attempts.
- Two of the top three team single-game FT performances have now come in the Robin Pingeton era.
- Alongside South Carolina and Mississippi State, Mizzou is one of three teams in the SEC that have made at least 27 free throws in a single game twice (27 vs. Indiana State, 27 vs. Texas A&M).
- Mizzou made all of its free throw attempts at LSU. Mizzou has shot above 70 percent from the charity stripe in 18 of 20 games this season.

STOUT DEFENSE

- Against Mizzou, Alabama shot 33.8 percent from the field. Mizzou has now held opponents under 35-percent shooting seven times this season. The Tigers are 6-1 in those contests. Alabama's 16 percent effort from the beyond the arc was the lowest 3-point field goal percentage allowed by the Tigers this season.
- ▶ After holding Alabama to six points in the opening frame, Mizzou has now limited its opponents to single digit scoring in 14 total quarters this season and six points or fewer six different times. (2nd Quarter vs. Wichita State 4, 2nd Quarter vs. Abilene Christian − 5, 4th Quarter vs. Nebraska − 5, 1st Quarter vs. Alabama − 6, 2nd Quarter vs. SLU − 6, 3rd Quarter vs. Georgia − 6).



STRONG SEMESTER IN THE CLASROOM

- As a team, Mizzou collectively finished the fall semester with a 3.29 grade point average. That is the highest fall semester GPA on record in program history.
- ▶ Five Tigers were named to their respective academic program's Dean's List.
- ▶ Two Tigers finished the semester with a 4.0 GPA.

FRESHMEN STEPPING UP

- ▶ In last Sunday's road win over Vanderbilt, freshmen Jordan Chavis and Amber Smith were instrumental in the victory, combining for 24 points and 7-of-8 shooting from beyond the arc. Smith's three 3-pointers were a careerhigh and her dagger with 1:15 remaining proved to be the game-defining shot.
- ▶ Sunday marked the sixth time this season Chavis and Smith have combined to score 15 points or more. When one of them reaches double digits, Mizzou is 5-1.
- ▶ Chavis is the only player in the SEC to make all of her 3-point attempts in a game (when taking at least four attempts) after going 4-of-4 from beyond the arc vs. Vanderbilt. She is one of two freshmen in the SEC with at least four threes in conference play this season and the only freshman in the league to make four in one game.

2017 CLASS TAKES SHAPE

- ▶ On National Signing Day (Nov. 9), Mizzou inked three National Letters of Intent with a trio of explosive guards. Elle Brown (Columbia, Mo.), Nadia Green (Homewood, III.) and Kelsey Winfrey (Lebanon, Mo.) all signed to play for Mizzou in 2017-18.
- ▶ All three signees averaged at least 11 points per game as juniors.
- ▶ All three signees were named McDonald's All-American game nomineees on Jan. 10.
- ▶ Winfrey already holds 21 school records at Lebanon High School, including career points, career rebounds, career assists and career steals. Winfrey is a three-time First-Team All-Ozark Conference selection, three-time First-Team All-District honoree and was a 2016 Gatorade Player of the Year finalist.
- ▶ Green averaged 15.0 points and 6.0 rebounds during her junior campaign. She earned 2016 IBCA Class 3A/4A Second-Team All-State honors and All-Conference recognition. Green guided Homewood-Flossmoor High School to a 22-3 record and a sectional title last season.
- ▶ Brown is the daughter of former Mizzou Track & Field All-American and U.S. Olympian, Natasha Brown, and Assistant Athletic Director for the Mizzou Made program, Brian Brown. Elle transferred to Rock Bridge High School for her senior season after three years as a standout at Johnston High School in Iowa. At Johnston, Brown captained the Dragons to 52 wins over three seasons. As a junior, she averaged 11.9 points per game and steered her squad to a school-record 22 wins





QUICK NOTES

400 ASSISTS

- ▶ Through 20 games, redshirt senior point guard Lianna Doty is averaging 3.5 assists per game, which ranks 11th in the SEC. She has dished at least four assists in a game nine times this season.
- ▶ Doty recently played her first full career game against Georgia, racking up five assists and chipping in five crucial points.
- ▶ With 443 career assists, Doty tops active SEC players in career dimes. She has 62 more assists than any other active SEC player. She ranks 23rd among active Division I players in career assists.
- ▶ In a game against Missouri State, Doty lofted a beautiful full-court pass to a streaking Sophie Cunningham, who finished a layup in transition. That pass gave Doty her 400th career assist. Doty is just the third Tiger to ever reach that mark and the first player to do so since Kerensa Barr in 2003.
- ▶ Doty is also excelling defensively. She ranks fourth in career steals among active SEC players with 176 swipes, which is one shy of cracking the program's all-time top ten list. She recorded a career-high seven steals in the season-opener vs. Abilene Christian.

WELL TRAVELED

- ▶ Mizzou is 9-5 after traveling to the Junkanoo Jam tournament in Bimini Islands, Bahamas.
- ▶ With trips to Lincoln, Neb., Seattle, Indianapolis, St. Louis, Lexington, Ky., Baton Rouge and Nashville also under their belts, the Tigers have traveled more than 10,000 total miles through 20 games this season.
- ▶ Mizzou has played in three different time zones and seen two oceans.

LAST TIME OUT

- ▶ Mizzou knocked off No. 25 Texas A&M, 78-76, in an overtime thriller at Mizzou Arena on Thursday night. The victory marked Mizzou's first home win over Texas A&M since 2005. The Tigers have now won three consecutive games over ranked opponents at Mizzou Arena.
- ▶ The Tigers were bolstered by an incredible performance from sophomore guard Sophie Cunningham (Columbia, Mo.). Cunningham poured in a season-high 36 points (10-of-19 FG, 14-of-15 FTs), including a game-tying reverse layup with three seconds left in regulation to send the game to overtime. Cunningham made 14-of-15 free throws, 10 of which came after the 1:04 mark in the fourth quarter. The 14 free throws were a career-high and just three shy of tying the program record in a single game.

EDGE ON THE GLASS

- ▶ Despite having just one true forward playing 15 minutes or more per game, Mizzou has outrebounded opponents 14 times in 20 games this season, going 11-3 in those contests.
- Mizzou ranks sixth in the SEC in defensive rebound percentage (69.8 percent) and second in total defensive rebounds (551).
- Mizzou got its first win over an opponent when being outrebounded when the Tigers downed Vanderbilt last Sunday.

RANKED IN THE PRESEASON

- ▶ Mizzou was tabbed No. 24 in the 2016-17 Associated Press preseason poll.
- It's the first time Mizzou cracked the preseason rankings since 1984.

HEAD COACH ROBIN PINGETON

Since stepping foot on Mizzou's campus in 2010, head coach Robin Pingeton has led the Mizzou Women's Basketball program to greater heights each and every season. Pingeton is entering her seventh season at the helm after the Tigers completed the best campaign during her tenure in 2015-16, winning 22 games.

Under Pingeton's guidance, the program's success on and off the court helped produce the nation's largest attendance increase as Mizzou fans came out in droves to support the team last season. Mizzou Arena welcomed an average of 3,990 fans per game, including a facility-record 7,989 fans for a showdown with Tennessee.

Mizzou faithful were rewarded for their support as the Tigers posted their fourth consecutive winning season for the first time since 1986-90. Mizzou spent eight weeks in the AP Top 25 poll and finished with eight conference victories for the first time in more than a decade, highlighted by victories over No. 6 Mississippi State and No. 22 Florida.

Pingeton's squad capped the season with the program's 10th NCAA Tournament appearance. Mizzou entered the Big Dance as a No. 10 seed and knocked off seventh-seeded BYU, 78-69, in the opening round to seal its first NCAA Tournament victory since 2001.

At season's end, both Sophie Cunningham and Jordan Frericks received recognitions for outstanding campaigns. Cunningham became the first SEC Freshman of the Year in program history and was one of eight finalists for the USBWA National Freshman of the Year award. Frericks took home Second-Team All-SEC honors after surpassing the 1,000-career point mark during her junior season.

Pingeton's system, defined by relentless hard work, also excelled in the classroom. The Tigers finished with a 2016 Spring Team GPA of 3.31, which is the highest ever recorded in program history. Additionally, redshirt senior Lindsey Cunningham was inducted into the Mizzou 39 Class of 2016, the most prestigious honor a student can receive at the University of Missouri.

Pingeton has restored a proud Missouri women's basketball tradition and has recorded a 101-89 (.532) record over her six seasons with her teams averaging 19 wins per year over the last three seasons. In 21 years overall as a head coach, Pingeton's teams have gone 436-246 (.639). She has led her squads to postseason play 14 times and has mentored 34 all-conference honorees, seven Academic All-Americans, six All-Americans and five conference Players of the Year. She has won three regular season conference titles, two postseason conference tournaments and has twice been named the conference Coach of the Year.

In 2014-15, the Tigers finished 19-14, the highest win total for the program since 2005-06. Mizzou earned victories in each of the first two rounds of the WNIT. The squad featured a stifling defense, which ranked 12th in the country in opponent field goal percentage (35.1) and 17th in the nation with 29.0 defensive rebounds per game. It was also a banner year for the offense as the Tigers drained 49 more 3-pointers than any other school in the SEC and finished 31st nationally with 249 triples throughout the season.

On Feb. 26, 2015, Mizzou upset No. 12 Texas A&M, 70-69, and ended a 17-game home winning streak for the Aggies in College Station when Maddie Stock drained a gamewinning 3-pointer with less than a second remaining.

The Tigers earned WNIT victories at Northern Iowa and at Kansas State to advance to the quarterfinals for the first time in 12 years. In a record-setting performance against K-State in the second round, Mizzou earned a 67-48 win, with the 19-point margin of victory serving as the largest in postseason annals for the Tigers. In that contest, the Tigers dominated the glass with a 50-31 rebounding margin which also established a new postseason program record. Morgan Eye tied a WNIT record with nine 3-pointers to lead the offense on a landmark afternoon.

Jordan Frericks earned second-team All-SEC honors and honorable mention All-SEC recognition from the Associated Press after leading the conference with 9.9 rebounds per game, which is the highest average by a Tiger since the 1997-98 campaign. Her 327 total

rebounds rank third in Mizzou single-season history and are the most since Renee Kelly's record of 395 set in 1985-86. Frericks tied a program record with 33 starts, equaling Lorraine Ferret's mark that had stood since 1980-81.

Eye closed her illustrious career with 367 baskets from beyond the arc, which is 141 more than any other player to ever wear a Tiger uniform. Following the season, she was invited to the State Farm College Women's 3-Point Championship at the Final Four in Indianapolis.

With one season of SEC play under their belt, Pingeton's Tigers came into the 2013-14 season with a vengeance, recording wins over two ranked foes in No. 25 Georgia and No. 16 Vanderbilt. The Tigers closed the season with a 17-14 record and advanced to the WNIT for the second year in a row. Mizzou broke its own 3-point shooting records with 292 made 3-pointers. The number stands not only as the most in Missouri history but also established an SEC record. In addition, Pingeton's squad topped Bradley early in the season, 126-55, to set the school's single-game and single-half scoring records.

Pingeton's recruiting talents were once again on display in 2013-14 as Mizzou's three true freshmen proved to be the most productive incoming class since the 1996-97 season. The trio of newcomers, Frericks, Kayla McDowell and Sierra Michaelis averaged 17.9 points per game on 44.4 percent shooting while pulling down 13.5 rebounds and dishing out 2.6 assists per game. Pingeton's Tigers were successful from top-to-bottom as first-team All-SEC selection Bri Kulas ranked among the conference scoring leaders by averaging 18.3 points per game. Kulas became Mizzou's seventh WNBA draft pick as she was selected by the San Antonio Stars in the third round (28th overall) of the 2014 WNBA Draft.

Pingeton's Tigers have also successfully proven themselves as standouts off the court as several Tigers were again given academic honors from the SEC. Lianna Doty was named SEC Scholar Athlete of the Year in 2013-14. Under Pingeton's tutelage, Missouri has seen a consistent increase in academic recognition each season as Lindsey Cunningham, Doty, Eye, Bree Fowler, Frericks, McDowell, Juanita Robinson, Maddie and Morgan Stock were all named to the SEC Winter Academic Honor Roll in 2014-15. Missouri has also consistently worked to better the Columbia area by volunteering in the community. The Tigers put in more than 350 hours of community service during the 2013-14 season, 333 hours in 2012-13 and 325 hours in 2014-15.

During Mizzou's inaugural season in the SEC, the Tigers showed that they would be a force to be reckoned with under Pingeton's guidance. In addition to setting numerous school and SEC records, the Tigers posted a 17-15 record, made the postseason for the first time since 2007 and knocked off three top 25 teams on the way to a respectable finish in the conference. Eye lit up the nets on her way to finishing the year as one of, if not the best, 3-point shooters in the NCAA. Eye led the country in 3-point shooting, set the Mizzou single-game record for triples (11) and set the SEC record for treys in a season (112).

The 2012-13 season under Pingeton showed that a solid foundation had been laid for Mizzou Women's Basketball. Not only did the Tigers knock off 12th-ranked South Carolina and NCAA Tournament-bound Florida, but the Tigers took down perennial power Tennessee in a victory that many of her peers say was a "program-changer." Through the recruiting efforts of Pingeton and her staff, three Tigers earned SEC recognition for their efforts and contributions on the court. Kulas was named second-team All-SEC, Doty made the SEC All-Freshman Team and Eye was recognized as the SEC Co-6th Woman of the Year. Following the season, four Tigers were named to the SEC Winter Academic Honor Roll and five freshmen were named to the 2012-13 SEC First-Year Academic Honor Roll.

Pingeton reinvigorated the Tigers program from the moment she stepped on-campus in Columbia. During her initial season, Missouri posted a 13-18 record and 5-11 mark in Big 12 Conference play, the best for the team since 2006-07. The Tigers accomplished those feats despite playing the seventh-toughest schedule in the nation, a slate that featured 16 games against teams who qualified for the NCAA Tournament and 10 games against ranked opponents.

Mizzou recorded three wins against ranked foes, defeating No. 12 Georgetown, No. 22 Texas and No. 23 Iowa State. The three wins over ranked opponents were the most for the Tigers since the 2000-01 season. Additionally, Mizzou's win over Texas ended a 12-game losing streak to the Longhorns dating back to 2001, and was only the second time the Tigers had ever defeated the Longhorns.

Success for the Tigers continued in the 2011-12 season as Mizzou started out with a 10-1 record, the program's best start since the 2006-07 season when Mizzou began the year 12-1. Under Pingeton's direction, the Tigers went undefeated through the first five games for the first time since 1997. With Pingeton's leadership, Christine Flores became the first Tiger to record a triple-double since 1995. Flores set several records at Mizzou, including the most blocks in her career (209) and in a single season (93) before being drafted by the Phoenix Mercury in the third round (30th overall) of the WNBA Draft.

Before taking the reins at Mizzou on April 8, 2010, Pingeton spent seven years leading the Illinois State Redbirds, where she amassed a 144-81 (.640) record and brought the Redbird program back to national prominence. During her tenure, she led the school to three straight Missouri Valley Conference Regular Season titles, two State Farm Missouri Valley Conference Tournament championships, a school-best four straight 20-win seasons, two NCAA Tournament berths and three WNIT appearances en route to Missouri Valley Coach of the Year honors in 2004 and 2010. During her last three seasons in Normal, Pingeton compiled an 81-23 (.779) mark to put together the best three-year span in Illinois State history.

In 2009-10, Pingeton led the Redbirds to a third consecutive Missouri Valley Conference regular season title, the semifinals of the WNIT and a 28-8 record. During Illinois State's WNIT run, the team earned wins over Butler, Purdue, Illinois and Kansas. The 28 wins tied the 1980-81 Illinois State team for the most in program history and marked the fourth straight year the team won at least 22 games. Pingeton's efforts garnered Russell Athletic/Women's Basketball Coaches Association Region 6 Coach of the Year and Missouri Valley Conference Coach of the Year accolades.

In 2008-09, Pingeton's squad went 27-8 and had a 16-5 mark in The Valley as the team earned its first ever outright Missouri Valley regular season title and advanced to the WNIT semifinals. One year earlier, the Redbirds went 26-7, posted the second-best winning percentage (.788) in school history, earned a trip to the NCAA Tournament and claimed the State Farm Missouri Valley Conference Tournament title and a share of the regular season crown.

In her first year on the Illinois State sideline, Pingeton earned Missouri Valley Conference Coach of the Year honors after going 16-13, the first winning season for the Redbirds in seven years. The following year, Illinois State earned its first NCAA Tournament berth since 1989 after claiming the Missouri Valley Conference Tournament championship. Pingeton then led the team to a 22-11 record in 2006-07, Illinois State's first 20-win season since 1989-90.

Before taking over at Illinois State, Pingeton spent three seasons as an assistant coach on Bill Fennelly's staff at lowa State, including the 2002-03 season as the associate head coach. During her time in Ames, the Cyclones went 66-33, made two NCAA Tournament appearances and won the 2001 Big 12 Tournament title.

Pingeton started her head coaching career in 1992 at St. Ambrose, her alma mater. In eight seasons, the Bees qualified for five NAIA National Tournaments, including Elite Eight berths in 1996 and 2000. Pingeton was named the conference coach of the year three times and the NAIA Kodak District Coach of the Year in 2000.

A 1990 graduate of St. Ambrose, Pingeton stands as the school's all-time scoring leader with 2,502 points and earned All-American honors in basketball and softball. She also played three seasons of professional basketball in the Women's Basketball Association.

Pingeton and her husband, Rich, are the proud parents of two sons, Blake, born June 9, 2006, and Zach, born July 5, 2011. In her limited spare time, Pingeton enjoys spending time with her family on their boat and playing golf.
