PREVIOUS GAME

- »Arkansas is 2-2 in the SEC/Big 12 Challenge.
- »Arkansas moves to 4-4 all-time against Kansas and Mike Neighbors is 0-1 against the Jayhawks.
- »Arkansas has had the same starters in every game this year: Malica Monk, Kiara Williams, Jailyn Mason, Devin Cosper and Bailey Zimmerman.
- »Devin Cosper and Malica Monk both reached double figures in the third guarter. It is their eighth consecutive game in double-figure scoring.
- »Kiara Williams grabbed her 10th rebound of the game in the third guarter. It is her third career game with double-digit boards and she finished with a career-best 16 boards in the game.
- »Jailyn Mason scored in double figures for the third time this season and for the second consecutive game.
- »Arkansas forced double figure turnovers for the eighth time this season.

ABOUT ARKANSAS

- »The Razorbacks are the only SEC team that does not return a double-figure scorer.
- »Arkansas ranks first in the SEC and eighth in th nation with just 81 total turnovers.
- »Arkansas is first in the SEC in 3-pointers attempts (234), second in 3-pointers per game (8.1) and third in 3-pointers made (65). The rank 10th, 50th and 34th in the country, respectively, in those categories.
- »The Razorbacks lead the SEC and rank second in the nation in turnovers per game with just 10.1 per contest.
- »Arkansas ranks third in the SEC and 23rd in the country in turnover margin.
- »The seven returning players have combined for 42 career-bests (12.5.17).
- »Players have set or tied 11 game or quarter records this year (12.5.17).
- »Arkansas has set or tied 16 quarter records.

PLAYER STORYLINES

- »Malica Monk and Devin Cosper have both scored in double figures in all eight games this year.
- »Devin Cosper has 31 career games in double digit scoring while Malica Monk has 24 games in double figures.

- »Devin Cosper ranks first in the SEC in 3-pointers attempted, 3-pointers made and 3-pointers per game. She is second, 16th and 26th. respectively, in those categories in the country.
- »Jailyn Mason had her second consecutive and third double-digit scoring game of the year with 10 points at Kansas.
- »Malica Monk has had five 20+ scoring performances in eight games this year. That is also her career number.
- »Devin Cosper leads the team with three career double-doubles - all set this season.
- »Malica Monk has had 10 career games with five or more assists including three this season.
- »Kiara Williams tallied a career-best 16 rebounds at Kansas on Sunday. She has had three career games with double-digit rebounds - all set this season.



GRAD STUDENT DEVIN COSPER

- »Only "senior" on the team
- »Missed the opening game last season after a death in the family
- »Averaged 6.4 ppg and 2.2 rpg last season and 7.7 ppg and 2.8 rpg for her career
- »Graduated in May 2017 with a degree in broadcast journalism
- »Interned at RSN, Arkansas' broadcast studio
- »Wears the SEC graduate patch on her jersey
- »Named "Comback Student-Athlete of the Year at annual HOGSPY awards after rebounding from an injury and a death in the family

FUNCTIONALLY FAST

You will hear Mike Neighbors say this a lot. He wants his teams to play as fast as possible and still function at a high level. That may look different from possession to possession depending on what Arkansas is running.

TRUST, TALENT AND TIME

My program will be built on three things. It's very simple.

TRUST - The highest form of loyalty that has to be earned, managed and sometimes re-earned. If we don't have this, nothing will work and the stool's legs will fall off and everything will collapse.

TALENT - It doesn't mean you can dribble, shoot, pass and rebound. It's a lot of other things like the ability to engage with the fan base and willingness to sign autographs for a 10-year-old child you might be inspiring.

TIME - It's just not being on time or making time. It's how you utilize your time and who you invest your time with and be around. Trust, talent and time. Those will be our pillars.


30 AND COUNTING

This year, Arkansas director of operations Amber Shirey enters her 30th season as a Razorback. The former Amber Nicholas was a two-time All-Southwest Conference selection during her four-year playing career from 1989-92. She spent one season (1992-93) as a student coach helping Arkansas transition to the Southeastern Conference. She moved on to a graduate assistant and assistant coach from 1993-94 through the 2006-07 season. In 2007-08 Shirey transitioned to the director of operations position holding that spot until she returned to the sidelines as an assistant coach for the 2013 and 2014 seasons. She moved into her current position as the Executive Director of Operations in 2014-15. She has been a part of seven different head coach's staffs during her tenure.

From Distance: Arkansas enters the game with 65 made 3-pointers while the 49ers have made just 26. They are efficient, shooting 31.7% from beyond the arc but average just 3.25 made 3-pointers per game.

Turn Them Over: The 49ers can be forced into turnovers. Charlotte enters the game with 135 miscues and a -2.2 turnover margin. Arkansas has just 81 turnovers and has a +6.6 turnover margin.

THE SCHEDULE

Arkansas' non-conference schedule features four teams who went to the post season a year ago. Arizona State played in the first round of the NCAA Tournament while Abilene Christian, UT-Arlington and Grambling were all WNIT teams a year ago. UTA was eliminated in the first round while Abilene Christian and Grambling both reached round two.

The always-tough SEC schedule features eight NCAA Tournament teams including the NCAA Champion South Carolina and the runner up, Mississippi State. Auburn and LSU were eliminated in the first round while Kentucky, Missouri, Tennessee and Texas A&M all bowed out in round two. In addition, Alabama and Ole Miss advanced to the WNIT Tournament. That means Arkansas faces 14 teams who played in the postseason a year ago.

FROM ROOKIE NOD TO NAISMITH NOMINEE

In four short years Mike Neighbors went from a Spalding Maggie Dixon Division I Rookie Coach of the Year nominee in 2014, to a Naismith Women's College Coach of the Year national semifinalist in 2017.

Neighbors guided UW to an historic campaign in 2016-17 leading the Huskies to 27 wins, it's second most in program history, and he was just one shy of the all-time a school record set in 1990 (28).

Picked to place third in the Pac-12 in the preseason poll, UW tied for second in the league with a 15-3 record, it's best conference finish since 2003. The Huskies' 15 conference wins tied for third most in program history. Washington, who entered conference play with the program-best 12 non-conference wins, clinched its first-ever bye in the first round of the Pac-12 Tournament. Washington put together an 11-game win streak and a six-game win streak in Pac-12 play in 2016-17.


