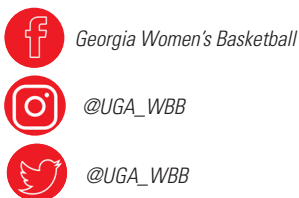

OPENING TIP: GEORGIA WELCOMES ARKANSAS FOR SEC BATTLE

» Georgia is back at home for the first time since New Year's Eve as the Lady Bulldogs host the Arkansas Razorbacks at 7 p.m. ET Thursday on SEC Network +.

» The Lady Bulldogs come home to Athens after winning back-to-back games on the road last week. Georgia held both Vanderbilt (52 points) and Kentucky (42 points) to season-low point totals to improve to 6-0 on the road for the first time since 1999.

» Georgia has won nine of the last 10 meetings against Arkansas and has only lost to the Razorbacks twice -- in 1990 and 2009 -- at Stegeman Coliseum in school history. The Lady Bulldogs own a 31-5 lead in the all-time series.

» Que Morrison was named the SEC Freshman of the Week on Monday after sealing Georgia's win at Kentucky. The Lady Bulldog rookie from Riverdale, Ga., led all scorers with 14 points for the game, including seven made free-throws in the fourth quarter. The win was Georgia's first at Kentucky since 2013.

» Caliya Robinson is Georgia's leading scorer (12.3 ppg) and rebounder (6.9 rpg) this season. Robinson has scored in double figures in five-straight games and currently leads the SEC in blocked shots with 51 total (3.2 per game) this season.

» Head coach Joni Taylor picked up the 50th win of her career last Thursday against Vanderbilt. Taylor owns a 51-27 record (.654) since being named head coach in 2015.

» Georgia is one of the most unselfish teams in the SEC. The Lady Bulldogs ranks fourth in both assists per game (17.3) and assist-to-turnover ratio (1.1). Taja Cole is fourth in the league with 76 dimes and has recorded three or more assists in 14 of 16 contests this season.

JONI TAYLOR

3RD SEASON // 2016 SPALDING MAGGIE DIXON NATIONAL COACH OF THE YEAR // RECORD: 51-27 (.654)

HIGHLIGHTS

- » NCAA Tournament appearance in first season as head coach
- » Only the 12th head coach in SEC history to win 20 games or more in his or her first season
- » Teams have totaled six wins over top-25 teams in two years
- » 2016 Maggie Dixon National Rookie Coach of the Year and Atlanta Tip-Off Club Georgia College Coach of the Year
- » 2017 signing class ranked in the top-10 nationally by several recruiting services

On Sunday, April 12, 2015, Joni (Crenshaw) Taylor, a member of the Georgia Basketball Staff for four seasons, including three as associate head coach, was appointed just the second full-time head coach in the program's illustrious history.

In her first season at the helm of the Georgia Lady Basketball program, Taylor led her team back to the NCAA Tournament for the 32nd time in school history, compiling five wins against ranked opponents (most for a Georgia team since 2006-07) on their way to a 21-10 record and 9-7 mark in SEC action. The Lady Bulldogs, who were picked ninth by league coaches in the preseason poll, finished strong in 2015-16, winning seven of their last nine regular season games to earn a No. 6 seed (just one game out of fourth place) in the SEC Tournament.

Georgia's 21-10 final record marked only the 12th time in league history that a first-year head coach won 20 or more games in his or her inaugural season at an SEC school, while her 12-1 start to the year was the third-best start for any SEC head coach in his or her first year with a program.

Taylor was honored for her successful first year as head coach, earning the prestigious WBCA Maggie Nixon NCAA National Rookie Coach of the Year Award, the Atlanta Tipoff Club's Whack Hyder College Coach of the Year Award and the Advocates for Athletic Equity Rookie Coach of the Year honor.

Her success in year one was followed by a 16-15 record in 2016-17 after Georgia replaced nearly half its scoring from the previous year. The Lady Bulldogs defeated Tennessee, Auburn and LSU in the same season for the first time since 1997.

Taylor entered her current position as Georgia's head coach with 13 seasons of coaching experience at the Division I level, including seven within the Southeastern Conference.

She herself was a highly sought after basketball prospect. She was the 1997 Gatorade Player of the Year for Mississippi after leading Meridian High to a 67-7 record during her junior and senior seasons. She also won three state titles in track and field and was selected as the school's Homecoming Queen.

At Alabama, Taylor was a significant contributor to four teams that reached post-season play -- the 1998 and 1999 NCAA Tournaments and the 2000 and 2001 WNITs. She was a two-year starter and scored 716 points, grabbed 555 rebounds and blocked 103 shots, which is No. 4 among the Tide's career leaders.

Taylor also was a standout off the basketball court. She was recognized as one of the most influential African Americans on the Alabama campus in 2001, was named to the SEC's Community Service team for women's basketball in 1999, 2000 and 2001 and was awarded a post-graduate scholarship from the SEC for her community service record. She received her bachelor's degree in Education from Alabama in 2002.

Taylor married her husband, Darius, on August 1, 2015. The couple welcomed their first child, Jacie Elise, on Nov. 3, 2016.

NEWCOMERS MAKING A DIFFERENCE

» Three of Georgia’s top six scorers this season are in their first years in Athens. Que Morrison (8.9), Taja Cole (7.8) and Gabby Connally (6.8) rank third, fourth and sixth, respectively, among the Lady Bulldogs’ scoring leaders. The ninth-ranked recruiting class in the nation, according to ESPN.com, has been a welcome addition to this year’s roster after Georgia played with just eight scholarship players a season ago.

QUALITY WINS FOR LADY BULLDOGS

» Georgia has six wins against teams that won 20 or more games and made postseason play a year ago, with the Lady Bulldogs’ only two losses coming to top-10 squads Texas and Mississippi State. Georgia, which is ranked 34th in the RPI, has quality wins against Virginia, Mercer, BYU, Georgia Tech, Wright State and Kentucky -- all teams that won 20 or more games in 2016-17. During Joni Taylor’s tenure, the Lady Bulldogs have recorded six wins against top-25 teams in three seasons.

STRONG NON-CONFERENCE PERFORMANCE

» Georgia finished with a 12-1 non-conference record for the second time in three years. In all, the Lady Bulldogs own a 33-8 non-conference record under Coach Taylor, a near 80-percent win percentage. This season, Georgia won its non-conference contests by an average margin of 17 points per contest.

GEORGIA’S OFFENSIVE OUTBURST

» The Lady Bulldogs pride themselves on defense, but Georgia has also been able to put up a lot of points this season. In fact, this year’s team has scored 1,155 points through 16 games, an average of 72.2 points per game, which is the most scored by a Georgia squad since 2007-08, when the team scored 1,201 points through the first 16 contests.

CALDWELL JOINS CONNALLY AND MORRISON AS FRESHMAN STARS

» Freshman guards Gabby Connally and Que Morrison got off to strong starts this season, but they are not the only Lady Bulldog rookies who have been impressive. As of late, it has been the play of guard Maya Caldwell, who has scored in double figures in two of the last six games with 20 against Howard (most for a Georgia freshman since 2014) and 15 against North Florida. Caldwell, who scored all 15 of her points in the second half against UNF, is the team’s most efficient 3-point shooter, hitting 15-of-28 (53.6 percent) from behind the arc for the year.

BALANCED BULLDOGS

» Georgia’s balanced scoring has helped the team to a fast start this season. Through 16 games, eight or more players have scored in 14 contests. The Lady Bulldogs, which played with just eight scholarship players last season, have been aided by newcomers who make up three of Georgia’s top six scorers. Que Morrison leads the 2017 freshman class with 8.9 ppg.

LADY BULLDOGS’ BENCH SHINES

» Georgia’s bench play has been impressive this season. The Lady Bulldogs’ bench players have outscored their opponents, 436-239, in the first 16 games, an average of 12.3 points per contest. During Georgia’s outing against Howard on Dec. 19, the Lady Bulldogs outscored the Bison 54-14 and outmatched North Florida’s bench 40-5 on Dec. 28. In the game against Vanderbilt on Jan. 4, Georgia’s bench held a 41-15 edge.

FRESHMEN COMBINE FOR POINTS BARRAGE

» During Georgia's outing against Howard on Dec. 19, Lady Bulldog freshmen combined for 47 total points, led by a new career-high of 20 points from Maya Caldwell and 11 from Malury Bates. You have to go back to 2009 to find the last time a Georgia freshman class combined for that many points in a single game. That year it was Jasmine James (24), Anne-Marie Armstrong (14), Ebony Jones (6) and Jasmine Hassell (5) who combined to score 49 points in a December matchup against Southern Miss.

GEORGIA BEATS TECH FOR 35TH TIME

» The Lady Bulldogs won their sixth game in the last seven contests against Georgia Tech with a 60-53 win on Dec. 17. The victory, which improved Georgia's record to 16-0 against Tech in Athens and 35-5 overall, also gave the Lady Bulldogs a crucial win against a team with a top-40 RPI. Georgia now has five victories -- Virginia, Mercer, BYU, Georgia Tech and Wright State -- against teams that won 20 or more games last season.

7-0 START BEST IN JONI TAYLOR ERA

» The Lady Bulldogs, which currently sit at 14-2 this season, jumped out to a 7-0 record to begin the year, marking the best start in the Joni Taylor era. In Taylor's first season, her team started 12-1 in non-conference play en route to a NCAA Tournament appearance and 21-10 final record.

IT STARTS WITH DEFENSE UNDER TAYLOR

» Georgia prides itself on defense, and that has paid off this season. The Lady Bulldogs have held four opponents (BYU, Furman, Vanderbilt and Kentucky) to their season lows in scoring and. ***In all, the Lady Bulldogs are 19-0 under Coach Taylor when holding an opponent to 50 points or less and are 12-0 when an opponent shoots less than 40 percent this season.***

MORRISON'S DEBUT AMONG BEST FOR UGA FRESHMEN

» Que Morrison's 19-point effort in the season-opener against Wofford puts her name among a prestigious group of Lady Bulldog freshmen. Morrison's total is the most for a Georgia rookie in a season-opening game since Tasha Humphrey scored 25 versus Furman at the beginning of the 2004-05 season. A closer look at the record book shows just how impressive her performance was compared to former Georgia greats.

ROBINSON NAMED TO NAISMITH, KATRINA MCCLAIN AWARD WATCH LISTS

» Lady Bulldog junior forward Caliya Robinson has received national attention for her efforts on the court. Among the SEC’s returning leaders in scoring, rebounding and blocked shots, Robinson was named to the Citizen Naismith Trophy National Player of the Year Watch List, joining 50 of the top players from around the country. Before the season started, she was tabbed a Katrina McClain Award Watch List candidate, placing Robinson’s name among the top 20 power forwards from across the country.

A TOP-10 SHOT BLOCKER

» Robinson has moved into the top-10 of the Lady Bulldogs’ career blocked shots leaders. In just 73 games, Robinson has 168 blocks (2.3 per game), which ranks seventh-best in Lady Bulldog history. Perhaps even more impressive is that Robinson has done this in just 73 career games. It took Tasha Humphrey (who is currently in 10th place with 119) 126 games, while Anne-Marie Armstrong (in ninth place) recorded 122 blocks in 133 contests.

FRESHMEN STEP UP AT CRUCIAL TIME

» In the final 10 seconds of the game at Virginia it was two freshmen guards that stepped to the line and sealed the game for the Lady Bulldogs. Gabby Connally was fouled with just nine seconds remaining and sunk two-straight to put her team up 62-58. After the Cavaliers hit a long 3-pointer on the next possession, Que Morrison knocked in two-straight free-throws to give her team a 64-61 lead with five seconds remaining.

GEORGIA BOASTS TOP WOMEN’S HOOPS PROGRAM

» The Lady Bulldogs have boasted one of the top women’s basketball programs in the nation over the last three decades. During head coach Andy Landers’ 36-year tenure, Georgia ranked No. 2 nationally in both NCAA Tournament appearances (31) and weeks ranked by the Associated Press (522). Georgia is also one of three DI basketball programs to post a winning record every season since women’s athletics became under the auspices of the NCAA with the 1981-82 season. The Lady Bulldogs’ 32 NCAA Tournament appearances rank second only behind Tennessee for most in the nation.

GEORGIA INKS THREE IN EARLY SIGNING PERIOD

A year after boasting one of the top classes in the country, Georgia filled most of its needs with the signing of Caitlin Hose, Kaila Hubbard and Donnetta Johnson in the early portion of the 2018 signing period. Below is more information on each of Georgia’s signees.

CAITLIN HOSE // 5-9 // GUARD // HAZEL GREEN, ALA.

- The 5-foot-10 guard averaged 16.2 points, 6.5 rebounds and 5.6 assists to lead Hazel Green High School to the Alabama Class 6A state championship game this past year.

“Caitlin is a very bright young woman who has tremendous ability on the court,” Taylor said. “Our staff enjoyed getting to know her and her family throughout the recruiting process, and I am glad she chose to be a Lady Bulldog. Caitlin knows what it takes to win. Her high school team has played for the state title as she became one of the top players in Alabama. She is also a high-character individual who has been a tremendous student throughout her high school career — something that is very important to us here at the University of Georgia.”

Hose has already picked up several accolades over the past three seasons. This past year, she was named to the AL.com Super All-State second team and the Alabama Sports Writers Association 6A All-State second team. In addition, Hose garnered Al.com All-Huntsville Region first team honors.

KAILA HUBBARD // 5-10 // GUARD // JONESBORO, GA.

- Hubbard, who plays at Holy Innocents’ Episcopal School, is rated as a top-50 player nationally and a four-star prospect according to ProspectsNation.com. ESPN’s HoopGurlz ranks Hubbard as the No. 14 wing player in the country.

“What I love about Kaila is her toughness,” Taylor said. “She is a versatile player who is strong and physical to the rim. She also thrives in transition, which makes her a perfect fit for our program. More than anything, Kaila is a winner and has been a part of a state championship team as well as two Nike National Championships. She is someone who has taken honors classes all throughout high school and has what it takes to be successful in anything she sets her mind to. We cannot wait to welcome Kaila to Athens and the University of Georgia.”

DONNETTA JOHNSON // 5-11 // GUARD // QUEENS, NY

- Considered one of the top players in the 2018 class according to ProspectsNation.com and one of the top guard prospects nationally according to ESPN’s HoopGurlz, Johnson is entering her senior season at Baldwin High School

“We are excited to welcome Donnetta to the Lady Bulldog family,” Taylor said. “She is an athletic playmaker who can create off the dribble and finish in transition. For Donnetta, I also know that life beyond basketball is very important, and I look forward to our staff helping her grow throughout her college career. We are pleased to have Donnetta joining our program, and I think Lady Bulldog fans will enjoy watching her play over the next few years.”



GEORGIA'S CLARK ALREADY A COLLEGE GRADUATE

» A three-time selection to the SEC Academic Honor Roll, Haley Clark graduated in just three years and received her diploma from UGA during graduation ceremonies this past May. Clark received her bachelor's degree in business and finance and is pursuing a master's in financial planning. One of her career goals is to work in corporate finance and help other athletes with financial planning.

A native of Orlando, Florida, Clark was Georgia's starting point guard in each of the team's 31 games last season. She ranked in the top-5 in the Southeastern Conference in assists per game during league play, averaging 4.7 per contest, with 122 total for the season. On a roster that featured just eight scholarship players, Clark played close to 33 minutes per game after starting just four contests in her previous two seasons combined.

CLARK, ENGRAM EARN LEADERSHIP AWARDS

» Haley Clark and Mackenzie Engram enter their senior seasons as the leaders for the Lady Bulldogs. That leadership ability did not go unnoticed by the UGA Athletic Association this past spring, as both Clark and Engram received awards recognizing their efforts in leadership and sportsmanship. The announcement was made at the annual student-athlete awards banquet in April.

Clark received the UGA Athletics Sportsmanship-Ethics Award, which is given annually to one female and male student-athlete who are selected based upon their displays of trustworthiness, respect, responsibility, friendship, caring and citizenship. Engram was chosen for the Clifford Lewis Leadership Award — an honor presented to one female student-athlete who demonstrates a commitment to a group of individuals above personal gain.

WBB: GEORGIA FENDS OFF ARKANSAS, 69-66

FAYETTEVILLE, Ark. ---- Sophomore forward Caliya Robinson's 20-point effort spearheaded the Lady Bulldogs' (11-11, 3-6) 69-66 victory over the Arkansas Razorbacks Thursday night inside the Bud Walton Arena.

Georgia led by 13 points in the fourth quarter but the Razorbacks (13-9, 2-7) clawed back into the game in the last two minutes. Arkansas got as close as two points but the Lady Bulldogs held on to secure the win.

"She needed to see the ball go through the hole," Georgia head coach Joni Taylor said on Robinson's effort. "I'm happy for Caliya, she has struggled in the last couple games in SEC play but she really practiced well this week and we sat down to have a conversation about how to get her back going and I thought she did that tonight. She really carried us tonight. She put us on her back and made plays on both ends of the court."

Robinson's 20-point performance marked the sixth of her career, all this season. Redshirt senior Pachis Roberts notched her fourth double-double of the season with 13 points and 11 rebounds while senior guard Shanea Armbrister chipped in 14 points and eight boards.



2017-18 SEC STANDINGS

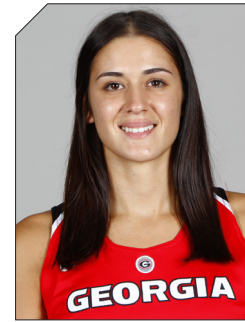
