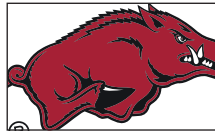

On The Aggies

- The Aggies have notched their 13th straight 20+ win season, which is the ninth-longest active streak in the nation
- Chennedy Carter was named SEC Freshman of the Week for the third time this season after averaging 29.5 points over the past two games
- Anriel Howard has posted four straight double-doubles, and is looking to be the first Aggie with five straight since Kelsey Bone in 2012-13
- Danni Williams ranks fifth at Texas A&M in career 3-pointers made and tied for seventh in single-season 3-pointers made
- Khaalila Hillsman ranks 11th at Texas A&M with over 1,000 career points, and ranks in the top 10 in career rebounds, blocks and double-doubles
- Chennedy Carter, the nation's leading scorer among freshmen, has posted two of the top four single-game scoring totals in Texas A&M history (School-record 46 at USC, 36 at South Carolina)
- Carter has scored 20+ points in nine of her last 11 games, and 16 times overall this season
- Carter ranks in the top 10 among freshmen nationally in assists, steals, field goal percentage, free throw percentage and free throws made
- Anriel Howard is on pace to average a double-double for a second straight year, and holds the Texas A&M career double-double record.
- The Aggies are ranked No. 17 in the Associated Press Top 25 and 18th in the USA Today/Coaches' Poll.
- Texas A&M is 68-13 in Reed Arena since the start of the 2013-14 season, and is 159-6 against unranked teams at Reed Arena since February 2005
- Texas A&M is 51-5 when leading after three quarters, since the rule changed for the 2015-16 season
- Texas A&M head coach & Women's Basketball Hall of Famer Gary Blair is 351-149 in 15 seasons at Texas A&M. He is 759-312 in his Hall of Fame career, which ranks 8th among active coaches in wins.

Carter Named SEC Freshman of the Week (Feb. 20)

- Chennedy Carter was named SEC Freshman of the week for the third time on Feb. 20, after averaging 29.5 points and 5.5 rebounds
- She scored 31 points at No. 2 Mississippi State, which ties for the third-most by an Aggie freshman
- She had 28 points, including back-to-back buckets to ice the game, against Florida
- She is the first Aggie since Adaora Elonu in 2008-09 to earn three conference freshman of the week honors

Chennedy Carter's Single-Game Scoring

- Chennedy Carter has posted two of the top four single-game scoring totals in Texas A&M history, and all four of the top freshman scoring totals in Texas A&M history.
- Carter has the top two scoring outputs of any D1 Freshman this year, with 36 points at South Carolina and 46 at USC
- Her 46 points at USC are the most by any D1 freshman since Elena Delle Donne had 54 in 2009-10.

AGGIE TRADITIONS

Home of the 12th Man

- Texas A&M is known by sports fans everywhere as the home of the 12th Man
- The tradition was born out of the willingness to serve. This willing spirit has endured, and today the Aggie student body is known as the 12th Man: united in loyalty, united in support and ready to serve when they are called to do so.

Yell Leaders

- Yell Leaders are a team of upperclassmen, three seniors and two juniors, elected each year by the student body. Aggie Yell Leaders still wear white during games and attend all home women's basketball games, plus postseason. The tradition dates back to 1907.

Reveille

- Reveille, the first lady of Aggieland, is a purebred collie and the official mascot of Texas A&M. As a five-star general, she is the highest ranking member of the Corps of Cadets.

Aggie Ring

- The distinctive Aggie Ring serves as the symbolic link to the Aggie network of former students. The ring is not given, it must be earned academically. It was E.C. Jonas, class of 1894, who designed the ring Aggies wear today. Nothing on the ring has changed, except when the university's name changed to Texas A&M University in 1963.

Gig 'Em

- At a yell practice before the 1930 TCU game, a dedicated fan and member of the Texas A&M Board of Regents named Pinky Downs '06 shouted, 'What are we going to do to those Horned Frogs?' Improvising, he borrowed the name of a sharp-pronged frog hunting tool, called a gig. 'Gig 'em, Aggies!' he said as he made a fist with his thumb extended straight up. With that, the first hand sign in the old Southwest Conference was born.

15th Season at Texas A&M

Women's Basketball Hall of Fame member, Gary Blair, led Texas A&M to the 2011 NCAA Championship and has transformed the women's basketball program into a national power since his appointment as head coach in 2003.

Blair, a two-time national finalist for the Naismith Coach of the Year Award, has guided Texas A&M to 12 straight NCAA Tournament appearances, and to four conference championships, including the 2013 SEC Tournament Championship.

Blair led the Aggies to their first national title in their first-ever trip to the NCAA Women's Final Four and closed out the 2010-11 season with a 33-5 record, the most victories in program history.

The Aggies have made five appearances in the Sweet Sixteen in the past nine years, and reached the Elite Eight in 2008, 2011 and 2014.

Over the course of his 33-year collegiate coaching career (this includes 2017-18), which includes stops at Stephen F. Austin from 1985-93 and Arkansas from 1993-03, Blair has led his teams to 32 winning seasons (including 2017-18), 27 20-win seasons (including 2017-18), 23 NCAA Tournament appearances and 35 NCAA postseason victories.

Blair has won a championship at every level of his coaching career, including three state championships at Dallas South Oak Cliff High School, two national championships as an assistant coach at Louisiana Tech, a WNIT Championship at Arkansas and an NCAA championship at Texas A&M.

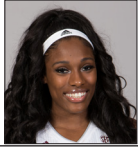
