Opening Statement

"First of all, I'd like to commend the University of Arkansas with hosting and their professionalism and quality. Certainly, I knew that was going to be the case coming in but hats off to many, many folks who made this successful for our programs, student-athletes and fans. Those things sometimes go unnoticed but they do need to be recognized and I appreciate it.

"Today was a tough day. Certainly didn't want to end it like we did. It's always tough when that last one ends your season but we didn't come out and do the things we needed to do at this time of year to play, especially in a do-or-die game. Hats off to Dallas Baptist who was faced with the same situation but they responded to it pretty well. We talk all the time about momentum and it's a game of momentum. Certainly, DBU got the momentum, they kept it and we didn't do anything to take it back. What I don't want to be overshadowed in all this for our program and our season is all the great things this group accomplished. And that's what talked about there after the game...the regular-season conference title, the (conference) tournament title, which is hard to do in winning both of those.

Most importantly, the way these young men grew and represented and learned about teamwork...not only for this year but for years to come whether they're in athletics or in family life and in society. I'm very, very proud. Disappointed that it's over but very proud of these young men. We never had one off-the-field problem the whole year and that, certainly, equates to success on the field, and that's what we've seen over the past few years. Those are some sacrifices and commitments that those young men make that aren't easy for 18 to 21 year olds in today's world but these guys did and I'm very proud of that."

On Walker Powell's performance ...

"He's had a tremendous season, and I think you alluded to it earlier about his injury, trying to come back from a second Tommy John (surgery)...there's a lot of rehab that goes into one. You're pitching really good as a true freshman and then all of a sudden, in the last game of a conference tournament something goes and now it's pretty devastating. It's an emotional thing that 'man, I have to go through this whole thing again.' For him to be able to do that and rehab and keep that mental approach that you have to have every day to go in there, along with our trainer Josh Walker who we can't leave it out because that was really his angel that guarded him and made him do it. Today probably wasn't his best outing, didn't seem like he could get the ball down in the zone. Dallas Baptist made him pay for it with some good swings on it—all solo home runs, I think. We just couldn't get anything back. Their guy (Luke Eldred) did an outstanding job of tilting it and keeping it down in the zone. Like (Matthew) Guidry said, he was mixing it with a good changeup that was speeding up his fastball, and it kept us down. We didn't compete like we needed to do but given Walker's situation, I know it was special for him to come back to Fayetteville in front of family and friends. Like he said, wish the outcome was different but I'm grateful that the young man had two Tommy John (surgeries) and he was back out there."

On gaining experience from this season ...

"Hopefully, (they learn) the commitment that it takes to do the things we did. Like I said, it's tough to win a regular-season (title). It's tough to win a (conference) tournament title. But to do that, you have to

sacrifice. You have to be willing to give up some things that everybody else gets to do. You have to understand accountability, not only for your team but for everyone else involved. Like I told them, the normal student out there, if they do something wrong, they disappoint their parents. These guys, if they do something wrong, not only do they disappoint their parents but they disappoint their coaches, they disappoint their teammates. They disappoint a lot of people. With that being said, there's a lot of accountability out there, and I hope they learn from this year.

Opening Statement
