RAZORBACKS AT THE NCAA REGIONALS

- Arkansas has seen its share of success of late at the NCAA Regional.
- Since NCAA Regionals began in 1988-89, Arkansas is making its 31st appearance as a team to go along with four times just an individual represented the Hogs at a Regional.
 - Arkansas won the 1995 NCAA Regional and has finished runner-up seven times.
 - Arkansas has advanced from a Regional to the NCAA Championship 21 times as a team
 - Four other times, just an individual advanced from a Regional to the NCAA Championship including 2017 national runner-up Mason Overstreet.
 - Since the cut line was shorted to five times in 2009, Arkansas has advanced to the NCAA Championship nine times.
 - Arkansas has advanced to the NAAs in four of the last six championships held. The two times Arkansas did not advance, the Razorbacks came up short in Regionals held in Austin, Texas, in 2019 and 2024.
 - Arkansas has never had an individual win an NCAA Regional but has had five runners-up and a total of 14 top-five finishes.

REGIONAL STREAK

- Arkansas has earned an NCAA Regional bid in each of the last 17 times there was a postseason played (there was no postseason in 2020 due to COVID).
 - That ties LSU for the fourth-longest, current consecutive streak for a team berth at an NCAA Regional behind Texas (35), Georgia (27) and Alabama (19).
 - Arkansas has six runner-up finishes at NCAA Regionals
 - Arkansas has advanced to the NCAA Championship nine times
 - Twice, a Razorback individual advanced to the NCAA Championship.

RAZORBACKS GETTING FIRST POSTSEASON EXPERIENCE

- Arkansas may be bringing the youngest, most inexperienced team to the NCAA postseason.
 - 2 Freshmen
 - 2 Sophomores
 - 1 Junior
- None of the Razorbacks have played in an NCAA Regional.**

FAMILIAR GROUND

- Arkansas has never played the Popular Grove Golf Club but the Razorbacks are familiar with the region.
- In each of the last three years, Arkansas has played about 56 miles away in Charlottesville at Virginia's Lewis Chitengwa Memorial. It is the final event prior to the conference championships.
- Arkansas placed: 3rd of 14 in 2023 T3rd of 13 in 2024 6th of 12 in 2025

TOUGH COMPETITION

- Granted Arkansas has not had its best season of late, due to its youth. However, The Hogs had once again played one of the toughest schedules in the nation.
 - Arkansas has faced Florida State in 7 of its 10 events
 - The Hamptons Intercollegiate had Ole Miss, Florida State, Virginia and Wake Forest
 - The other 5 teams in the Jackson T. Stephens Cup includes Oklahoma State, SMU, San Diego State, Oklahoma and Florida State.

* The CABO Collegiate 14-team field featured 10 of the top 51 ... Arkansas finished fourth and beat now #26 Tennessee, #32 Texas Tech, #40 Stanford, #22 Arizona, #18 Vanderbilt, #1 Ole Miss and #41 Houston.

^ Arkansas was "just" 10th of 17 at the also tough Valspar Collegiate. The field included 14 of the nation's top 42, including 4 of the top 7. Arkansas beat #10 North Carolina, #26 Tennessee, #33 Texas Tech #41 Houston and #46 Wake Forest.

SPRING FORWARD

- Having one of the youngest teams made for a tough fall.
 - Posted a 17-22-0 fall record
