ABOUT ARKANSAS

- Alabama and Arkansas will meet for the 92nd time in series history when the two team meet at Baum-Walker Stadium on Friday evening. The Tide holds the overall series advantage, 48-34, but is 18-24 all-time in Fayetteville.
- The two teams met last met from March 22-24, 2019, in Tuscaloosa. The ninth-ranked Razorbacks claimed a 2-1 series win, notching victories in the bookend games of the weekend. Arkansas came away with a 12-3 win in the opener on Friday with Alabama returning on Saturday to blank the Hogs, 10-0. The Razorbacks came right back on Sunday with another double-digit scoring day, taking down the Tide by a 10-2 margin.
- Arkansas swept Alabama in the last meeting in Fayetteville from April 27-29, 2018. The Razorbacks won 7-3, 7-4 and 9-7 in three consecutive days. Alabama's last series win in Fayetteville came from May 13-15, 2016 - a sweep.
- The Razorbacks finished the pandemic-shortened 2020 campaign at 11-5 overall. Arkansas was set to travel to Mississippi State for the beginning of SEC play when the season was officially canceled.
- Dave Van Horn is in his 19th year leading the Arkansas baseball program and his 27th season overall as a Division I head coach. In total, Van Horn has accumulated 33 seasons as a collegiate head coach, including stints at the Division II and Junior College levels. Van Horn is assisted by Nate Thompson and Matt Hobbs along with volunteer assistant Bobby Wernes.
- The Razorbacks were selected to finish third in the West and fifth overall in the SEC in the league's preseason poll, as voted on by the conference's head coaches.

ABOUT ALABAMA

- Alabama wrapped up last week at 4-1 overall to push the 22nd-ranked Tide's win total to 14 on the season, matching LSU, Tennessee and Texas A&M for the most wins by a Division I baseball team as of Monday, March 15. The Crimson Tide first downed South Alabama last Tuesday followed by a win over Jacksonville State on Wednesday. Alabama then came away victorious, 2-1, in a three-game weekend series with Stetson last Friday through Sunday.
- Owen Diodati** recorded his third grand slam of the season, this one in walkoff fashion as the sophomore's roundtripper led Alabama to an 11-8 win over South Alabama last Tuesday night at Sewell-Thomas Stadium.
- The Crimson Tide and Jaguars traded runs all night with South carrying an 8-6 lead into the bottom of the ninth. Down to a final chance, Alabama used two hits and a pair of errors to score one and load them up for Diodati, with the sophomore sending a ball deep into the student section for the grand slam and walkoff win.
- Alabama used another solid start from **Connor Shamblyn** to earn a 7-2 win over Jacksonville State last Wednesday evening in Tuscaloosa to complete the 2021 home-and-home sweep of the Gamecocks.
- Shamblyn was reliable once again, posting a career-long 6.0 innings of work and allowing just one run on three hits to pick up his second win of the season. He did not issue a walk while striking out six to match his career-high total before handing the ball over to his bullpen.
- The Tide's comeback effort came up short last Friday evening as UA fell to Stetson, 4-2, in Tuscaloosa.
- Alabama was no-hit through eight innings and trailed 4-0 heading to the bottom of the ninth. **Drew Williamson** began that final frame with a single to left. He came home in the next at-bat when **Zane Denton** sent a home run deep over the visitor's bullpen in right-center to cut the lead in half. A single from Diodati and a two-out double from **Andrew Pinckney** brought the go-ahead run to the plate but a 6-3 groundout ended the Tide's comeback.
- Crimson Tide starter **Tyler Ras** was handed the hard-luck loss in the series opener as his defense failed him, committing a season-high four errors on the night. The four miscues played a part in his four runs allowed — only one of which was earned — across his 5.0-plus innings of work.
- Alabama walked it off in extras on Saturday against Stetson, downing the Hatters, 4-3, in 12 innings. The two teams were knotted up at three apiece through regulation. The Crimson Tide got runners on in the 10th and 11th but were unable to capitalize on the opportunities until the 12th.
- William Hamiter** began the 12th with a leadoff single. **Sam Praytor** followed with a walk to put two on with no outs, creating a sacrifice bunt situation for Williamson. The Tide cleanup hitter dropped down a perfect sac bunt that was fielded by the Stetson pitcher, but an errant throw sent the ball into right field and allowed Hamiter to come all the way in for the game-winning run.
- UA starter **Dylan Smith** was stellar, tossing a career-long 8.0 innings in the start. The junior allowed three runs on six hits and a walk with a career-high tying 10 Ks. He retired the final 10 batters faced before **Chase Lee** took over.
- The Tide closer picked up his fourth win of the year with a season-long 4.0 innings of scoreless, hitless baseball that included four strikeouts. Lee picked up right where Smith left off, retiring the first six batters he faced to help UA post a stretch of 16 straight retired from the sixth through the 10th inning to push it to extras for the eventual Alabama win.
- A seven-run third inning proved to be more than enough for the win as Alabama downed Stetson, 9-4, on Sunday afternoon for the series-clinching win.
- The Hatters got out front for a third straight game, crossing a run in the top of the first, but that would be the last time Stetson held a lead on Sunday. The Crimson Tide answered with a seven-run third inning to put the game out of reach. Stetson battled for two in the fourth and one in the seventh, but a two-run eighth by UA ensured the win.
- Eight of the Tide's nine starters recorded a hit on the day with five of those eight posting multi-hit efforts. Hamiter and Pinckney led the charge with three-hit efforts. Hamiter went 3-for-4, including a two-RBI double, and added one walk while Pinckney finished 3-for-4 with an RBI, one run and a stolen base. Pinckney's stolen base was one of the Tide's season-high six on the afternoon.
- Antoine Jean** claimed his second win of the season. The sophomore worked 6.0 innings, allowing three runs (one earned) on four hits and two walks with a career-high tying six strikeouts.
- Alabama returned 20 letterwinners while losing 12 from the 2020 squad. The 2021 Crimson Tide welcomed back six positional starters and 10 total pitchers while hosting 14 redshirts or newcomers.

TIED FOR SECOND NATIONALLY IN WINS

- Alabama baseball owns a 14-3 record heading to the weekend in Fayetteville.
- The Crimson Tide's 14 wins are tied with Mississippi State, Southern Illinois and Texas Tech for the second-most wins by a Division I program so far this season.
- Alabama joins the Bulldogs and Red Raiders with an .824 winning percentage, which is tied for sixth-best in the nation among teams with at least 15 games played. Only the Salukis (14-1, .933); Vanderbilt and East Carolina (13-2, .867); and LSU and Tennessee (15-3, .833) have a better winning percentage to date.
- UA owns a 30-4 (.882) mark across its last 34 games dating back to the start of the 2020 pandemic-shortened season.

ALABAMA vs. NO. 1

- Alabama has faced off with college baseball's top-ranked team on 37 occasions prior to Friday's opener with No. 1 Arkansas. The Tide holds a 17-20 (.459) record in those matchups.
- Despite the 17-20 record, the Crimson Tide is 7-3 in three-game weekend series against the top-ranked team. Alabama has also taken part in two-game series and single games against the nation's No. 1 team in the NCAA postseason.
- The Crimson Tide's last meeting with the nation's No. 1 team came when UA traveled to Nashville to take on Vanderbilt from May 16-18, 2013. The Commodores opened with a 7-6 win before the Tide evened things up with a 5-4 victory in game two. Vandy came out on top in the finale, 14-11, to claim the series win.
- Alabama has never faced Arkansas when the Razorbacks are ranked No. 1.

SEC PLAY - A FIRST TIME FOR MANY ON UA

- Alabama enters Southeastern Conference play with very limited experience against league opponents.
- The Crimson Tide has eight total pitchers and only three active position players that have seen time in an SEC matchup.
- On the pitching side, the 2021 roster features just one SEC win which came from Hunter Ruth while at Florida. Ruth came out with the win against the Crimson Tide on March 31, 2019.
- Positionally, Alabama is without one of its most experienced players in T.J. Reeves, who suffered an injury that will keep him off the field to begin conference play. Additionally, veteran catcher Sam Praytor has not seen SEC action since his freshman season in 2018 due to a season-ending injury in 2019 and the cancelation of league play a season ago.
- A young roster, the 2021 Tide group is made up of 10 true freshmen and eight COVID freshmen. In addition to the 18, Davis Heller, Will Patota and Jackson Tate (JUCO) along with Landon Green (injury) have never played in an SEC game.

FREE PASSES - THE EASY WAY AND THE HARD WAY

- The Crimson Tide offense has been patient at the plate this season, drawing 88 walks in 17 contests. In addition, Tide batters have been hit by a pitch on 25 occasions.
- Alabama's 88 walks are seventh in the SEC and rank 16th nationally. The trio of Owen Diodati, Jim Jarvis and Peyton Wilson pace the UA hitters with 12 each to tie for 16th in the conference.
- The 25 hit-by-pitch is tops on the SEC charts while ranking 18th in Division I. Diodati leads the Tide in that category as well, being beamed five times so far to tie for fourth in the conference.

HIT PARADE

- Alabama's bats have accumulated 165 hits through 17 games this season. That total includes seven games with double-digit hits and a season-high total of 20 at the College of Charleston on March 7.
- The Crimson Tide's 165 hits rank as the 12th-most nationally and are sixth-best in the SEC.
- Alabama's hit totals have trended upward as of late with UA recording 10-plus hits in six of the last nine games after recording just one game with double-digit hits across the first eight contests.
- Zane Denton and William Hamiter lead the Crimson Tide in hits with 24 apiece, a number that is tied for 26th nationally and ranks seventh in the conference. The duo is followed by Peyton Wilson, who has 21 to rank 13th in the SEC.

IT'S BOMB TIME

- Alabama's offense has shown early power during the 2021 season, producing two-or-more home runs in seven of 17 games and at least one home run in 11 games overall. That power surge has pushed UA's home run total to 21 heading into the weekend with top-ranked Arkansas.
- The Crimson Tide has totaled two home runs in a game on four occasions while posting three-homer efforts in three contests. UA also hit one home run at the College of Charleston on March 7, against South Alabama on March 9 and in back-to-back games against Stetson from March 12-13. The Tide is 10-1 in games in which it has homered, including a perfect 7-0 mark in the games with two-plus homers. For contrast, UA is 4-2 in matchups without a roundtripper.
- Alabama's home run total is currently eighth in SEC and 20th nationally while UA's 1.24 home runs per game rank 10th in the league and 43rd in the country.
- The Tide bats started off the 2021 season by combining for seven home runs across Opening Weekend, the most in a season-opening series since 2007. That impressive start paired with two bombs at Jacksonville State saw the Tide record multiple homers across the first four games. The stretch marked the first time a Crimson Tide offense has posted two-plus homers in four straight games since 2013.
- Alabama's early-season power surge comes one year removed from Tide hitters producing at least one home run in 13 of 17 games with multiple homers in five of those contests. The Crimson Tide's home run total in 2020 finished ninth nationally and third in the Southeastern Conference.
- Heading into SEC play last season, Alabama was averaging 1.29 home runs per game. That total was 14th nationally and fifth in the SEC. It put the Tide on-pace for 73 homers by season's end. That total would have been the most by any UA roster in the BBCOR era and would have been close to eclipsing the program's top-10 ranks for homers in a season.

DIO'S GRAND SLAMS

- Sophomore Owen Diodati has recorded three grand slams through 17 games this season.
- Diodati's grand slam total ties for the second-most in a single season in program history since grand slams were recorded at UA (since 1983). He has already matched Doug Duke (1986), Roberto Vaz (1997) and Beau Heard (2003), who all totaled three over a full season. Duke's squad played in 63 games while Vaz and the 1997 team made it to the College World Series, playing in 70 total contests. Heard and the 2003 group took part in 62 games.
- Mike Pitisci's six grand slams is the NCAA and Alabama single-season mark, which he accomplished in 1984. The six grand slams also serve as the Crimson Tide's all-time career mark.
- Diodati's three grand slams are the most by any Crimson Tide player in the BBCOR era (since 2011) for a single season or a career. Only Austen Smith has recorded multiple grand slams in the same season with two in 2011, while Smith (2011), Kenny Roberts (2012-13), Casey Hughston (2014-15), Chandler Avant (2017-18) and Hunter Alexander (2017-18) have posted two for their careers during the new era of bats.
- Two of Diodati's grand slams came in back-to-back contests, first at College of Charleston on March 7 followed by a second in the Tide's next game against South Alabama on March 9. Diodati is the only player in program history to record a grand slam in back-to-back games.
- Entering this weekend's series in Fayetteville, Diodati is 3-for-3 with the bases loaded - all three opportunities have finished with a grand slam.

START ME UP

- The Crimson Tide has been able to lean on its starting pitchers early this season, helping UA to a 14-3 mark.
- Alabama has had six different pitchers make a start through 17 games. That group has combined for 89.1 innings, or 5.1 innings per start, and owns a lowly 1.61 ERA (16 ER).
- The six starters have given up just 58 total hits (3.4 hits per game) and limited opposing batters to a .183 average.
- Alabama's starting group has also struck out 94 compared to just 19 walks and holds an impressive 0.86 WHIP.
- The group of six is made up of William Freeman, Antoine Jean, Connor Prielipp, Tyler Ras, Connor Shamblin and Dylan Smith. Together, the six starters have combined for a 7-2 record and two shutouts.

PRIELIPP'S EARNS MULTIPLE PRESEASON ALL-AMERICA HONORS

- Alabama sophomore pitcher Connor Prielipp picked up multiple preseason All-America honors heading into his second season with the Crimson Tide. He was tabbed as a preseason first team All-American by Collegiate Baseball News, the NCBWA, Perfect Game USA and D1Baseball.com.
- The honors come one-year removed from an impressive first season of collegiate baseball. Prielipp finished the pandemic-shortened 2020 campaign at a perfect 3-0 across four starts and 21.0 IP. He recorded 35 strikeouts compared to six walks and led the SEC with a 0.52 WHIP. Prielipp allowed the fewest hits (five) and earned runs (zero) in the league and gave up just 2.14 hits per nine innings to lead the conference and rank third nationally.
- His freshman efforts earned him First Team All-America honors from CBN along with Freshman All-America recognition while being named as one of CBN's 'National Freshman Players of the Year'. Prielipp was also selected as Perfect Game's 'Impact Freshman of the Year' and named D1Baseball's 'Top Freshman Pitcher'.

GOLDEN SPIKES AWARD PRESEASON WATCH LIST - CONNOR PRIELIPP

- Connor Prielipp was selected to the Gold Spikes Award Preseason Watch List, USA Baseball announced on Thursday, Feb. 18. Prielipp was one of 55 student-athletes featured on the preseason list.
- He became the sixth UA player named to the award's preseason watch list, the first since Mikey White back in 2015.

PRAYTOR PICKS UP PRESEASON ALL-AMERICA ACCOLADES

- Alabama catcher Sam Praytor was selected as a preseason third team All-American by Collegiate Baseball News. He joined Connor Prielipp on CBN's preseason All-America list.
- Praytor made a name for himself as a freshman in 2018 but saw his sophomore season cut short after only six games. He returned for the 2020 campaign and got off to a hot start before the season was canceled just 17 games in.
- The Tide backstop saw time in 16 games a season ago, leading UA in home runs (six) while ranking third in average at .350 (21-60). He added 18 RBI and 14 runs while walking seven times. Praytor's red-hot start saw him set new single-season career-highs in home runs and RBI in just those 16 games.

DIODATI NAMED PRESEASON ALL-AMERICAN BY NCBWA

- Crimson Tide outfielder Owen Diodati was selected as an NCBWA Preseason Third Team All-American, the writers announced on Wednesday, Feb. 17. Diodati joined Connor Prielipp on the preseason list.
- Diodati batted .309 as a freshman with nine extra-base hits, including three doubles, a triple and five home runs.
- He added 22 RBI and maintained a .673 slugging percentage to lead all SEC freshmen hitters.
- The Canadian tied for third in RBI and seventh in home runs across all league hitters in 2020 and finished as the Crimson Tide's leader in RBI while ranking second in roundtrippers.

PRIELIPP, DIODATI SELECTED TO PRESEASON ALL-SEC LISTS

- Rising sophomores Connor Prielipp and Owen Diodati were selected to the 2021 Preseason All-SEC Baseball teams, as voted on by the conference head coaches.
- Prielipp was selected as a first-teamer at starting pitcher while Diodati was tabbed as a second-teamer in the outfield.
- Tabbed as a preseason All-American by three separate outlets, Prielipp joined Kumar Rocker (Vanderbilt) in the league's two starting pitcher slots.
- Diodati built a name for himself a season ago despite a shortened 2020 schedule. He wrapped up his freshman campaign with 22 RBI and a .673 slugging percentage to lead all SEC freshmen hitters while adding five home runs and 13 walks to tie for the league lead among first-year players. The Tide outfielder tied for third in RBI and seventh in home runs across all league hitters while finishing as Alabama's overall leader in RBI and ranking second in home runs.
- In addition to the all-conference honors, the Crimson Tide was selected to finish 12th overall in the SEC.

• Brad Bohannon was hired as Alabama's 32nd head baseball coach on June 1, 2017, and formally introduced at The University of Alabama on Monday, June 5.

• Known for his recruiting prowess, Bohannon has started to stock the Crimson Tide with top recruits and welcomed a second consecutive top-10 class to campus in the Fall of 2019. The crop of Crimson Tide players (now sophomores) were rated as a top-19 or better class by all major recruiting outlets, peaking as the nation's No. 7 class (Collegiate Baseball News).

• Since 2008, all but one of Bohannon's recruiting classes have been ranked in the top-25 by Perfect Game USA among other outlets. His first recruiting class at Alabama, the Crimson Tide's current juniors, was ranked No. 23 by Perfect Game USA, No. 15 by Baseball America and as high as No. 10 by Collegiate Baseball News. Last season's group, the 2019 class, earned a No. 19 rating by D1Baseball.com and PG USA while also being tabbed as the No. 15 class by BA and No. 7 group from CBN.

• UA's 2019 class, highlighted by Owen Diodati, Antoine Jean and Connor Prielipp, all made significant contributions to the 2020 team going 16-1 before a global pandemic ended the season early. The trio helped Alabama enter SEC play ranked for the first time since 2010 and finish the year at No. 18 by CBN along with a No. 21 ranking in both the NCBWA and the USA Today Coaches polls.

• The 2018 class played a key role in helping Alabama finish 30-26 overall in 2019. The Crimson Tide's record was highlighted by a 23-3 mark in non-conference pairings and included a 13-1 record in midweek matchups along with a 14-3 record against schools from the state of Alabama. The 23 wins against non-conference opponents were the most by a Crimson Tide team since 2010 and the .885 winning percentage was UA's highest since 2002 when the team finished at 24-2 (.923) during the regular season.

• Bohannon immediately made his mark on the Alabama program in 2018. His first season saw the Crimson Tide get off to a perfect 9-0 start, with Bohannon matching Wallace Wade (1924) for the second-best start to an Alabama head coaching career.

• Under his direction in 2018, Alabama improved its win total by eight from the previous season, including three more victories in SEC play, to finish 27-29 overall and 8-22 in SEC action. The 27 wins were highlighted by six victories over top-25 teams, including a series win over then-No. 7 Kentucky.

• Bohannon came to Tuscaloosa with 14 years of Southeastern Conference coaching experience after having served as an assistant at Kentucky from 2004-15 and Auburn from 2016-17. He played a pivotal role in turnivcxfsdgdth Kentucky and Auburn within three years on the job. The Wildcats became the first team in SEC history to go from worst to first in only one season, winning 44 games and the program's first SEC title in 2006, while the Tigers won 12 more games in 2017 than in 2016 and advanced to the NCAA Tournament.

• While at Kentucky, Bohannon served under two SEC Coach of the Year winners in John Cohen and Gary Henderson. Along with winning the school's only league title, Bohannon was a part of a trio of record-breaking win seasons, capped off by the 2012 team that won 45 games to set the UK program mark.

• A combined 69 Wildcat student-athletes were chosen in the Major League Baseball Draft or signed as a free agent during Bohannon's tenure as recruiting coordinator. He was responsible for signing 13 Kentucky Wildcat student-athletes that went on to play in the Major Leagues, including 2014 Golden Spikes Award winner A.J. Reed.

• Prior to his time at UK, Bohannon worked for two seasons as Wake Forest where the Demon Deacons advanced to the NCAA Tournament twice and captured the ACC title in 2001.

• Bohannon earned an undergraduate degree from Berry College in 1998 and then graduated with a master's from Wake Forest in 2002. He began his collegiate career playing at Vanderbilt and Georgia Tech before ending up at Berry.

• A native of Rome, Ga., Bohannon is married to the former Kim Traylor.
