• SERIES HISTORY

UCA and Arkansas will be meeting for the 10th time on Tuesday, but for the first time since 1948. Arkansas leads the overall series 4-3-2. All games in the series were played between 1921 and 1948. The Bears won twice in Fayetteville and once in Conway in 1947, with several other playing sites or date unknown.

UCA is 7-17 against Southeastern Conference opponents since moving to NCAA Division I in 2007, with wins over Mississippi State (4), Missouri (2) and Ole Miss (1).

• LAST WEEKEND

The Bear split their third Southland Conference series in as many weekends, winning twice and losing twice at UIW last weekend at Sullivan Field in San Antonio, Texas. The Bears won Game 1 12-7 on Friday, then lost both games of Saturday's doubleheader 12-11 and 10-2, before taking Sunday's series finale 4-3.

For the weekend, the Bears hit .300 and the Cardinals hit .305. UCA's earned-run average was 7.71 compared to 6.88 for UIW in the hitter-friendly park. Both teams hit five home runs, with Connor Emmet hitting a pair for the Bears. Emmet hit .500 (8 of 16) with 7 RBI for the weekend. Tyler Cleveland and Jack Haley picked up the victories on the mound for the Bears, both in relief.

UCA also split SLC series at home with Abilene Christian and on the road at Lamar.

• LAST TUESDAY

The Bears dropped a 5-2 decision to No. 4-ranked Ole Miss last Tuesday night in Oxford, Miss. The Rebels had three home runs among their eight hits against seven different UCA pitchers in a bullpen day. UCA had five hits from five different players, including Connor Emmet, AJ Mendolia, Beau Orlando, Benny Ayala and Connor Flagg. Ironically, those were the Nos. 1-5 in UCA's batting order. Flagg had a pair of RBIs.

UCA's seven pitchers combined to strike out 10 Rebels, including three by freshman right hander Trent Gregson in the eighth inning.

The game was played in front of the biggest crowd of the season (6,847) for a UCA game to this point of the season.

• NOTABLES

The Bears will play 9 games in 9 days, with the Arkansas game the middle game of that brutal stretch. UCA played four at UIW last weekend (including a 9-hour bus ride) and will host league favorite Sam Houston in a four-game SLC series beginning Thursday night at Bear Stadium... The Bears are without their top two pitchers from 2020. Gavin Stone was drafted in the 5th round by the LA Dodgers as a junior. Current junior lefty Noah Cameron, a Freshman All-American two years ago, had arm surgery in the offseason and will miss the 2021 year... UCA senior right hander Conner Williams made his 55th career appearance on March 21 at Lamar but his first career start in UCA's series finale. He went 4.2 innings, allowing 5 hits and 1 run while striking out 2 and walking 1. Williams was then UCA's Friday night starter last weekend at UIW and is scheduled to remain in the rotation... UCA has used five freshman (or redshirt freshman) pitchers this season among the 14 used... The Bears are second in the SLC in sacrifice bunts (22)... UCA leads the SLC in fielding percentage at .983, despite an uncharacteristic 4 errors in the weekend series at UIW... UCA entered last weekend with just 8 errors in 16 games... The Bears have 12 (of 20) games with zero errors this season... UCA is closing out a 10-game road swing, not returning to Bear Stadium until April 1 vs. Sam Houston State... The Bears have faced two Top 5 teams in the past week, at Ole Miss last Tuesday and at Arkansas this Tuesday... SR right hander Mark Moyer made his 63rd appearance last Sunday and 37th start, putting him tied for 5th all-time at UCA (tied with Ethan McKinzie (63, 2010-13) and Jeremy Brewer (63, 2007-10)... Conner Williams is 10th with 56 appearances... The

school record for appearances is 75 (Daniel Price, 2005-08)... UCA drew four bases-loaded walks in one inning in the ACU series... UCA has scored in every game this season, with a high of 19 runs vs. Tarleton on March 6.. UCA's opponents have also scored in every game... UCA's Alonso Bibiano has a pinch-hit grand slam vs. Tarleton State in his first at-bat of the season. and was hitting 1.000 and slugging 4.000... There were a combined four grand slams in four games at Bear Stadium on opening weekend (UCA/Tarleton State/Missouri State series), two from pinch hitters.

LAST SEASON:

The Bears finished the pandemic-shortened season with an 8-8 overall record against a tough non-conference schedule, but opened Southland Conference play with a 2-1 mark before play was halted in the middle of March. UCA beat SLU 2-0 and 2-1 to open their lone SLC series, then dropped the finale 5-3 on March 10.

UCA's last game of the season was a 5-3 victory over UT Martin on March 10 at Bear Stadium.

The Bears hosted the SLU Lions to open SLC play and got a no-hitter from junior Gavin Stone to take the opener 2-0. Stone struck out 13 and faced two batters over the minimum and walked just one. He threw 112 pitches (85 strikes) and struck out the final batter of the game.

UCA also won Game 2 by a 2-1 margin on the strength of Noah Cameron's 10-strikeout, 6-hit, 1-run performance that complemented Stone's opening day outing. RBI's by Beau Orlando and Josh Ragan in the third inning gave the Bears all the runs they would need. Orlando finished 3 for 4.

SLU took the finale with an 11-hit attack after UCA starter Mark Moyer battled through 5 2/3 innings, allowing just one run and leaving with the game tied at 1-1. The Lions got a pair of home runs, including a grand slam in the ninth.

In what turned out to be the season finale, UCA got a combined six-hitter from starter Logan Gilbertson and reliever Brad Verel. Gilbertson struck out six in 5 2/3 innings and Verel added seven more in the final 3 1/3 innings, including two of the three batters he faced in the ninth inning.

2020 NOTABLE NUMBERS:

UCA finished the shortened season with a 7-4 home record. The Bears were 5-0 in night games overall and 3-1 vs. lefthanded starting pitchers. UCA was 8-0 when leading after six innings and 0-6 when trailing. The Bears played one extra-inning game, losing 5-4 at Southern Miss in 10 innings.

Conner Emmet had a team-high eight multi-hit games and a team-high 3 multi-RBI games. He also had the team's best 13-game hitting streak, while Coby Potvin and Beau Orlando both reached base in all 16 games.

Potvin started all 16 games at first base while Josh Ragan had all the starts in centerfield. Orlando started 12 games at third base and the other four behind the plate. Emmet started 15 games (11 in RF, 4 in LF).

Emmett led the Bears with a .397 batting average, followed by Beau Orlando at .392. Emmett was also tops in slugging percentage at .571, while Orlando was tops in on-base percentage (.515), aided by a team-high 11 walks and 4 HBP.

RJ Peason led the Bears with 4 (of 4) stolen bases. Benny Ayala had a team-high 10 RBI and team-best 4 home runs.

UCA averaged 354 fans at home at Bear Stadium, with a high of 428 in Game 2 vs. SLU. Their season high attendance was 3,576 in the series finale at Southern Miss.

UCA won three of its final four games to get to .500 for the season.

• SOUTHLAND SCHEDULE/PROTOCOLS

The Southland Conference has expanded to a four-game series for this season's league weekends. The teams will play a single game Friday, a doubleheader Saturday and another single game on Sunday. The Saturday doubleheader will consist of a seven-inning game in the opener, followed by a nine-inning Game 2. If Game 1 should go to extra innings, Game 2 will become a seven-inning affair.

The league's presidents and ADs also voted on a participation minimum of 24 players, which must include 13 pitchers and 11 position players (two of which must be catchers). Should a team drop below that minimum, the coach has the discretion to play a four-game series or revert to a three-game series.

Member schools will play 40 conference games and are allowed 16 more non-conference matchups for a maximum total 56-game schedule.

The 2021 SLC Tournament was awarded on Feb. 18 to Southeastern Louisiana and will be played May 26-29 at Pat Kenelly Diamond at Alumni Field in Hammond, La. This will mark the first time the SLC baseball tourney has been held at a campus site since UCA hosted the tournament at Bear Stadium in 2014. Ironically, SLU beat defending champion UCA in the title game that season.

The double-elimination tournament will feature the top eight schools in the final standings, with a winner-take-all championship game on May 29 at 6 p.m. The tournament champion will receive the SLC's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament. All games from the tournament will be on ESPN+. This will be the 58th season of SLC baseball.

• RETURNEES

The Bears had nine of their 12 seniors return for another season after the pandemic cut short what would have been their senior season last spring. Those nine include: IF Cole Fiori, 1B Coby Potvin, OF Alonso Bibiano, 3B Beau Orlando, RHP Mark Moyer, SS Christian Brasher, LHP Brad Verel, RHP Conner Williams and C Nathaniel Sagdahl.

• 500 CLUB

UCA head coach Allen Gum joined the 300 Club in 2013, the 400 Club in 2016, and the 500-win mark last season with a win over ACU on May 12. He now stands at 522-319 as a collegiate head coach. He ranks fourth in the Southland Conference in overall career victories behind Jim Gilligan at Lamar (1,111), Butch McBroom at UT-Arlington (756) and Pat Patterson at Louisiana Tech (538).

Gum was 226-68 in five seasons at his alma mater Division II Southern Arkansas (Magnolia, Ark.), and is now 296-251 in his 11th season at UCA. He is the winningest coach in UCA history, ahead of second-place Doug Clark (209 wins, 2003-10).

• VICTORIES

The 19 conference victories for the Bears 2019 was the most since moving to the Southland Conference in 2007. The previous best was 17 (2014, 2017, 2018). UCA's overall wins mark was 42 in 2013. UCA has won at least 29 games for the past seven years. UCA has won at least 10 league games in all nine seasons under Head Coach Allen Gum.

• FRIENDLY CONFINES

The Bears went 18-11 at home at Bear Stadium in 2019 and 7-4 last season. They were 22-13 in 2018, 20-8 in 2017 and 21-6 in 2016. They were 12-7 in 2015, making them 100-49 over the past six seasons at The Bear heading into the 2021 season.

• ACADEMIC HONORS

UCA led the way with five Southland Conference All-Academic selection following the 2020 season. Christian Brasher had a 4.0 while working on his MBA. Brad Verel had a 3.9 in exercise science. Beau Orlando had a 3.12 in Health Education, Gavin Stone had a 3.05 in Health Education. Conner Williams had a 3.0 in Health Education.

• NO-NO HONORS

Gavin Stone became UCA's 11th MLB draftee in the past eight years last June when he got the call from the Los Angeles Dodgers in the fifth round. He was the 159th overall pick in the condensed 2020 MLB Draft after going 3-1 with a miniscule 1.30 earned-run average. Stone, a 6-1, 175-pounder righthanded pitcher from Lake City, Ark., played at Riverside High School. He is UCA's third-highest draftee and highest since 1992. He is the 23rd Bear overall to be selected in the MLB Draft since the first in 1967. Stone is the first UCA player taken by the Dodgers.

Stone tossed just the third no-hitter in school history on March 6 against Southeastern Louisiana at Bear Stadium. In that game, he struck out a career-high 13 batters, including the final out in the ninth inning. He faced one batter over the minimum and retired the final 14 he faced after his only walk in the fifth inning. Following the walk, he struck out the next two batters. In all, Stone struck out eight of the nine SLU starters, including one player three times. He struck out the side in the third on 11 pitches and had a strikeout in every inning except the first.

For the season, he recorded 31 strikeouts and walked just six batters in 27.2 innings and ranked in the Top 6 in the Southland Conference in every starting pitching category.

Stone was named the Southland Conference Pitcher of the Week and also earned three national awards. He was named the D1Baseball AstroTurfUSA National Player of the Week, the NCBWA National Player of the Week and the USA Golden Spikes Performance of the Week.

The last no-hitter for the Bears was by Bryce Biggerstaff against Jackson State on 2/24/13. He struck out 9 and walked none but UCA committed one error. He also faced one over the minimum.

The first no-hitter in UCA history was by Mike Moore at Little Rock on 4/12/69. The Bears won 4-0 in 7 innings.

• SOUTHLAND TOURNAMENT HISTORY

The Bears reached the Southland Conference championship game in 2019 for the fourth time since 2013, losing to McNeese 4-2 in the title game after playing a 10-inning game earlier in the day (6-3 win over Southeastern Louisiana).

UCA won the 2013 SLC Tournament as the seventh seed after losing its opener to Texas A&M-Corpus Christi, then winning five consecutive elimination games, shutting out third-seeded Southeastern Louisiana 4-0 in the title game. The Bears were runnerup in 2014 as the tournament host at Bear Stadium, and again in 2017 and 2019.

In 2014, UCA beat Texas A&M-Corpus Christi 3-1 in the opener, knocked off McNeese State 11-3 the next day, beat McNeese again 8-6 in the semifinals, then lost to Southeastern Louisiana 9-4 in a rematch of the previous year's championship game.

UCA made its eighth consecutive tournament appearance last season, one of only three schools to reach the tournament every year since 2012 (McNeese, Sam Houston).

After the 2013 championship, the Bears advanced to their first NCAA Regional at Starkville, Miss. UCA went 3-3 in the regional, beating every team there (Mercer, South Alabama, MSU) before losing to the Bulldogs in the final.

UCA's No. 2 seed in the 2019 SLC Tournament was the highest for the Bears since becoming eligible for the tournament. UCA was the No. 2 seed despite losing 12 seniors from the 2018 team.

There was no 2020 SLC Tournament due to the covid-19 shutdown.

• 2021 SCHEDULE

UCA will play another formidable schedule this season, including series with Missouri State and Oklahoma State, a single game in Fayetteville, Ark., against the Top 10 Arkansas Razorbacks, a single game at Top 10 Ole Miss, along with five other in-state matchups against Little Rock (2), Arkansas State (2) and Arkansas-Pine Bluff.

The game with the Razorbacks is historic because until last season, Arkansas did not play in-state schools in any sport.

• MLB BEARS

Senior righthander Tyler Gray (7th round, 2017), junior left fielder Hunter Strong (25th, 2018) and junior catcher William Hancock (31st, 2018) were all drafted by the Kansas City Royals in the MLB Draft. Gray was the SLC Pitcher of the Year, while Strong and Hancock were first-team All-SLC selections. Gray and Hancock are still in the Royals' organization, along with 2019's draftee, righthander Cody Davenport (20th round, Royals, 2019).

They are joined by former Bears' outfielder Jonathan Davis and RHP Ty Tice, who are both with the Toronto Blue Jays. Davis (15th round, 2013) was up with the Blue Jays for 37 games a year ago and was featured on ESPN SportsCenter Top Plays several times for his outfield catches. Tice (16th round, 2017, Twins) pitched mostly at the AA/AAA level last year (3-4 record, 2.34 ERA, 8 saves combined) but got a non-roster invite to spring training this month.

Gray played all of the 2019 season at Lexington (Class A full) after spending 2018 at Idaho Falls (Rookie). Hancock spent the 2019 season at Burlington (Rookie).

UCA has had 12 MLB draft selections since moving to NCAA Division I for the 2007 season. Prior to that, the Bears had only had 10 in school history. The Bears have had multiple players drafted three times in the past six years, including three each in 2013 and 2018.

• GOVERNOR'S I-40 SHOWDOWN

The Bears and Little Rock Trojans will compete in the third year of the "Governor's I-40 Showdown" in a year-long battle between the schools who are just 25 miles apart. The teams will compete for points in each sport that both schools sponsor, amounting to 17 contests and a total of 43 points available. The Trojans beat the Bears 5-3 on March 3 at Gary Hogan Field in Little Rock. UCA will host Little Rock on April 13 at Bear Stadium.

UCA easily won last the first trophy in 2019, which wrapped up with the third of three meetings with the Trojans at Dickey-Stephens Park in North Little Rock, home of the Seattle Mariners' AA club, the Arkansas Travelers. Arkansas Governor Asa Hutchinson threw out the first pitch for the finale. There was no winner in 2020 after the covid-19 shutdown. The series is normally one game each at UCA, at Little Rock and at the neutral site on the banks of the Arkansas River. However, in 2021, the teams will only meet twice on the UCA and LR home fields due to scheduling difficulties.

HEAD COACH ALLEN GUM

Allen Gum brought a successful track record to the Central Arkansas baseball program in June 2010, and in the 10 years since, has brought that same winning tradition to the Bears' program, putting it on the regional and national map. Along the way, Gum became the winning coach in UCA history and also surpassed the 500-victory mark for his career.

Under Gum's leadership, UCA has won 287 games over the past 10 seasons and is the winningest coach in UCA history. The highlight was a record-setting 2013 season that saw the Bears accomplish things that had never been done before at UCA. The 2013 edition of the Bears won a school-record 42 games and reached the NCAA Regionals for the first time since moving to Division I in 2007. The real story is the route they took to get there.

The Bears entered the Southland Conference Tournament as the seventh seed, a team that finished just 12-15 in conference play during the regular season. After losing their opening game, Gum's Bears reeled off five straight elimination-game victories, eventually taking the SLC Tournament championship with a 4-0 win over Southeastern Louisiana.

That title earned the Bears a trip back to Starkville, Miss., for the NCAA Regional. Once there, the Bears defeated two conference champions in Mercer (Atlantic Sun) and South Alabama (Sun Belt) and knocked off host Mississippi State to become the only team at the Starkville Regional to defeat every opponent. UCA, which had taken a series 2-1 from the Bulldogs during the regular season, ultimately lost in a winner-take-all championship game at historic Dudy Noble Field. The Bulldogs would eventually finish as national runnerup to UCLA at the College World Series.

UCA's three victories (3-3 overall for the year) over the Bulldogs were MSU's only non-SEC losses of the season until the College World Series championship series against UCLA. In all, the Bears won eight consecutive elimination games between the SLC Tournament and Starkville Regional.

For the first time in history, UCA had three players selected in the 2014 Major League Baseball Draft. Forrestt Allday, Jonathan Davis and Jeffery Enloe were all drafted and played in their respective minor league systems last summer. Allday, the Most Valuable Player of the SLC Tournament, was named a first-team All-American by Rawlings/American Baseball Coaches Association, making him the first NCAA Division I All-American for the program.

Despite losing 10 seniors and three MLB draftees, the Bears returned to the SLC championship game again in 2014, losing to Southeastern Louisiana in the final before a packed house at Bear Stadium. UCA entered the SLC Tournament as the No. 6 seed but won three straight games to reach the title game. UCA added another draftee in senior center fielder Doug Votolato, who went in the ninth round to the Rangers.

UCA reached the SLC championship game again in 2017, making it three trips in five seasons, and again in 2019, losing to McNeese State after playing an elimination game earlier in the day.

Over the course of his career, Gum has won more than 500 games as a head coach.

Gum came to UCA from a highly successful five-year stint at his alma mater Southern Arkansas University in Magnolia. Gum compiled a 226-68 record in five seasons at the SAU helm and recorded five consecutive 40-plus win seasons. His .769 winning percentage is the second best in the Gulf South Conference. The Muleriders spent 24 weeks at number one in the nation over his last three seasons.

Gum led SAU to a 47-10 record in 2010, winning the Gulf South Conference-West Division, as well as being the top seed of the NCAA II South Regional. He had four players taken in the Major League Baseball Draft, including the No. 16 overall pick, and had two more sign professional contracts.

Gum's 2009 squad was ranked No. 1 for much of the season and at 52-11, finished with the most wins in school history and advanced to the semi-finals of the NCAA Division II South Region tournament, which the Muleriders hosted by virtue of being the top seed in the region. Advancing to the Gulf South Conference tournament for the 11th consecutive year, the club captured SAU's second league championship with a 5-0 sweep in the tourney, and also claimed its first-ever share of a GSC West Division title. Despite not being one of the final eight teams to advance to the College World Series, Southern Arkansas still finished the season ranked fourth.

Gum's first year (2006) at the helm of the Muleriders proved to be quite a successful one as he led the team to a 40-18 overall record and the program's first-ever GSC championship. SAU advanced to the South Central Region tournament, making it to the semi-finals before their season ended as the 18th-ranked team in the country.

In 2007, Gum's squad concluded their first-ever back-to-back 40-win seasons as members of the NCAA when the team finished 41-17 and again made the conference tournament field. The following year, Southern Arkansas finished 46-12 and reached a No. 1 national ranking for the first time in the history of the program. They made their 10th straight league tournament and moved on to the semi-finals of the South Central regional, ending the season ranked 12th.

A native of Bentonville, Gum played collegiate baseball at Crowder Community College (now Crowder College) in Neosho, Mo., before playing two years at Southern Arkansas for Coach Steve Goodheart, who retired in 2003 after coaching the Muleriders for 23 years. Gum is a member of the Crowder College Baseball Hall of Fame.

In 1990, Gum led SAU in hitting as a junior outfielder with a .338 average and fielded .975 as Southern Arkansas won the Arkansas Intercollegiate Conference (AIC) championship with a 20-4 record and finished the season 27-23 overall. As a senior, Gum hit .328 and fielded .961 while helping the Muleriders win their sixth consecutive AIC championship with a 20-4 record and an overall record of 44-15-1. The 1991 team also won the National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics (NAIA) Area 5 Tournament by defeating the nation's number-one ranked team, North Florida, in the championship game, to advance to the NAIA World Series in Lewiston, Idaho. Gum was honored with the Charles Berry Hustle Award at the World Series.

Prior to returning to SAU, Gum served as assistant baseball coach at Sheridan High School for six years, before moving to Batesville as the head baseball coach in 2000. Batesville had a 75-25 record in his three years with the Pioneers, and was the Class AAAA runner-up in 2002 and 2003. Gum served two seasons (2004-2005) as an assistant coach for Southern Arkansas before assuming the head coaching duties.

Gum is married to the former Shenna Calloway of Strong, and they have two sons, Tyler and Calloway. Tyler, a two-time UCA graduate, is currently the Director of Gameday Operations at Southern Arkansas.
