- ◆ Georgia (27-16, 10-11 SEC) begins its toughest stretch of the year with seven straight road games before finishing the regular season in Athens. First up, the Bulldogs will face No. 1 Arkansas (34-8, 15-6 SEC).
- ◆ For the second time this season, Georgia will go on the road and face the nation's top-ranked team. Back in April, Georgia captured an SEC series over top-ranked Vanderbilt in Nashville, outscoring them 25-8. Since then, Georgia won a home series over Kentucky, claimed a road series over Mizzou and dropped a home series to Auburn that featured a 14-inning loss.
- ◆ The Georgia-Arkansas series goes back to 1987 when the teams first met at the College World Series. The Razorbacks won an elimination game 5-4. UA leads the all-time series 34-24. Since joining the SEC in 1992, the teams have played 19 series, and UA leads 11-8. The last three-game series came

in Athens in 2018, and Georgia won it two games to one. The last trip to Fayetteville came in 2017, and the home team swept the series. Georgia is 2-0 against UA at the SEC Tournament, the latest meeting coming in 2019 when then No. 7 Georgia beat No. 5 Arkansas 3-1.

- ◆ Georgia's SEC rotation for the Arkansas series will feature freshman LHP Liam Sullivan (1-0 4.74 ERA) making his first career start, sophomore RHP Jonathan Cannon (2-2, 4.19 ERA) and senior LHP Ryan Webb (3-3, 3.04 ERA). Webb and Cannon were instrumental in leading the Bulldogs to a series win over then top-ranked Vanderbilt and then were not as sharp in subsequent starts against UK and Missouri. However, they returned to form against Auburn last weekend. Webb was nearly perfect, facing the minimum over six shutout innings in a 4-0 win but left after only 62 pitches due to back spasms. Cannon provided seven innings in a no decision. When Cannon left, the game was 3-all, and Auburn outlasted the Bulldogs in 14 innings. Sullivan provided a career-high 4 scoreless innings with five strikeouts against Auburn last Saturday. Georgia was hoping to get senior LHP C.J. Smith (0-2, 3.00 ERA) back, but he's now out for the year.
- ◆ The Bulldogs are 7-3 in one-run contests and 3-1 in extra innings. Georgia has posted seven walk-offs, the most since 2001 when the SEC Champions registered 10 under Ron Polk en route to the CWS.
- ◆ Redshirt junior RF Connor Tate (.351-10-30) is one of the leading hitters in the SEC. He has hit eight of his 10 home runs in league play where he is batting .337 with perfect fielding in 40 total chances. Tate has reached base safely in 23 straight games. Tate's 59 hits this year is tied for second in the SEC.
- ◆ Redshirt sophomore LHP Ben Harris (4-0, 1.55 ERA, 2 SV) has been a pivotal member of the bullpen this season. In SEC action, he is 3-0 with a 1.86 ERA and 2 Saves in eight relief outings. He has limited opponents to a .065 batting average. He pitched the final three innings of a 4-0 shutout of Auburn.
- ◆ Redshirt junior INF Josh McAllister (.354-8-21), one of the top hitters in SEC action at .351, returned to the lineup last Saturday after missing a pair of games due to a nagging hamstring injury. It marked the third time this year that it has sidelined him. He has provided superb defense at second base and has made starts at shortstop and third base, posting a .989 fielding percentage with just one error in 91 total chances.
- ◆ Freshman C Fernando Gonzalez (.292-2-12) batted .385 with a pair of doubles, a grand slam and five RBI in four games last week. His grand slam, the first by a Bulldog this year, provided a 4-0 win over Auburn last Thursday as Ryan Webb and Ben Harris combined on a two-hitter.

- ◆ While the teams don't play every year, the last time Georgia won a series in Fayetteville came in 2008 (2-1) when the Bulldogs eventually won the SEC and advanced to the CWS Finals.

# **COLUMN NOTES: DID YOU KNOW?**

- ◆ On Apr. 15, it was announced that lke Cousins head baseball coach **Scott Stricklin** had agreed to a contract extension through 2026. He came to Georgia from Kent State in June of 2013. Earlier this year, Stricklin missed eight games due to COVID-19 including the first two SEC series (UT, @ A&M). Georgia went 4-4 without their skipper.
- ◆ Twice this season Georgia has hit Back-to-Back-to-Back Home Runs and before this year, the last time they did it just once was 1987!

This year, Georgia did it against Lipscomb on March 12 (Connor Tate, Riley King and Josh McAllister) as part of a 10-0 victory. Then on Apr. 8 at #1 Vanderbilt, the Bulldogs did it again, this time it was Tate, King and Garrett Blaylock as part of a 14-2 rout.

- ◆ Three Bulldogs have already earned a UGA degree. Riley King (Exercise & Sports Science), Mason Meadows (Business Management) and Logan Moody (Communication Studies). King and senior Chaney Rogers have started at four different spots in their career. King has made starts at 2B-3B-LF-RF while Rogers has started at 1B-LF-RF-DH.
- ♦ On March 15, **Corey Collins** earned SEC Freshman of the Week honors. He batted .444 (8-for-18) with two doubles, two home runs, five runs scored and nine RBI in a 4-0 week for the Bulldogs. He posted an .889 slugging percentage and .500 on-base percentage. He tied his career high with a pair of three-hit games. He launched a pair of three-run home runs.
- ♦ On Sunday, Apr. 18, Georgia held its annual Vs. Cancer Game. Along with honoring the memory of their STAR, Nicholas Chaclan (CHECK-lin), the team wore gold shoelaces to bring awareness to #VsCancer. Some Bulldogs have kept them in their cleats.
- ◆ Redshirt junior OF **Connor Tate** led the Bulldog attack against the top-ranked Commodores, batting .583 (7-for-12) with two doubles, three home runs and six RBI. He was named a National Player of the Week by *Collegiate Baseball*, and he was the SEC Player of the Week.
- ◆ Sophomore RHP **Jonathan Cannon** was named the NCBWA National Pitcher of the Week and the SEC Pitcher of the Week after he tossed a careerhigh seven shutout innings with 9 strikeouts and no walks in clinching an SEC road series over No. 1 Vanderbilt in April.
- ♦ Against #1 Vanderbilt's vaunted pitching staff that led the nation with a 2.31 ERA, Georgia slugged .585 with eight doubles and nine home runs in winning that road series. Georgia's pitching staff posted a 2.77 ERA and registered 42 Ks against the league's best offense that ranked second nationally in slugging percentage at .544.
- ♦ Senior **Cole Tate** tied a school record with a pair of triples in a game, helping Georgia to a 7-5 road win in 10 innings over Missouri on Apr. 24. Tate provided a go-ahead two-run triple in the 10th against the Tigers. He became the first Bulldog with two triples in a game since 2010 when Zach Cone did it versus Ga. Tech. Tate is just the seventh Bulldog to accomplish this feat.

# UGA'S IKE COUSINS HEAD BASEBALL COACH 8TH SEASON AT UGA; 17TH OVERALL

Now in his eighth year at the helm, lke Cousins Head Baseball Coach Scott Stricklin has returned the Bulldogs to one of the top programs in the country. In April of this year, it was announced he had agreed to a contract extension to lead Georgia through 2026.

Georgia was one of just two schools to have earned a top eight National Seed for the NCAA Championships in both 2018 and 2019. Georgia was a No. 8 seed in 2018 and a No. 4 seed in 2019, which marked the best in school history. Then in 2020, the Bulldogs were poised to have a



special year, selling out its season tickets, when the global COVID-19 pandemic hit. Georgia finished 2020 ranked as high as No. 2 nationally (USA Today Sports Top 25). The Bulldogs had jumped out to a 7-0 start, swept rival Georgia Tech for the third time in the past four years and tallied a 14-4 mark when the season was canceled. Four Bulldogs signed professional contracts including first round pick Emerson Hancock (sixth overall) and a school record 26 Bulldogs earned a spot on the SEC Academic Honor Roll. Georgia was the only SEC program to receive NCAA APR recognition, 10 Bulldogs earned a degree, and the program posted a record 3.14 GPA for the spring. Hancock was just the fourth student-athlete in school history to be both a first round draft pick and first team Academic All-American.

Stricklin, who led his alma mater Kent State to five NCAA Regionals and the 2012 College World Series (CWS), was named head baseball coach at the University of Georgia on June 3, 2013. During a nine-year stint with the Golden Flashes, he posted a 350-188 record, winning five Mid-American Conference regular season crowns and five MAC Tournament titles. Also, the Golden Flashes were honored in Omaha in 2012 for having the highest team Grade Point Average of all the eight participants at the CWS, owning a 3.09 GPA.

Stricklin, a two-time All-Mid-American Conference catcher, handled pitching staffs that were ranked No. 1 and No. 2 in the nation in ERA during his final two playing seasons at KSU. A 23rd round draft pick of the Minnesota Twins in 1993, he played five seasons and reached the Triple-A level with the Twins.

Stricklin graduated magna cum laude with a bachelor's degree in marketing from Kent State in 1995. He and his wife Cheri have three children: daughters Sydney (18) and Keaton (13), and a son, Cale (16).
