First Pitch

- Louisiana Tech will ride a four-game winning streak into a weekend home series against No. 1 Arkansas starting on Friday night. The Bulldogs search for their first win versus a top-ranked team in program history during the three-game home series against the 10-0 Razorbacks.
- LA Tech is 0-14 in program history against top-ranked opponents, dropping five of those contests by two runs or less. The Bulldogs last played a No. 1 team in 2010, which is when the 'Dogs dropped a pair of games at No. 1 Texas.
- Tech's most recent victory over a top-five opponent came against the Razorbacks in 2007. The Diamond Dogs defeated No. 4 Arkansas 9-2 on Feb. 3, 2007, in the old Love Shack. Former LA Tech third baseman Courtney Jones went 3-for-4 with four RBI and two runs scored in the win.
- LA Tech earned its first true road victory of the season on Tuesday with a 10-3 come-from-behind triumph at ULM. The 'Dogs trailed 3-1 entering the seventh, but Tech's bats came alive as the Bulldogs tallied seven runs on five hits, three walks and an HBP. Right after Tech took a 4-3 lead, left fielder Philip Matulia cleared the bases with a three-run triple to push the lead to 7-3.
- Relievers Tanner Knight and Greg Martinez provided outstanding performances in relief on Tuesday, combining to tally 10 strikeouts while allowing just one earned run in 7.1 innings on the mound. Martinez nailed down the final 10 outs of the game to earn his second pitching victory of the season. The 10 combined strikeouts between the bullpen duo made it the first time since May 10, 2019, that Bulldog relievers combined to tally 10 punchouts of opposing batters.
- With a walk in Tuesday's win at ULM, senior slugger Steele Netteville extended his on-base streak to 22 games dating back to last season. Netteville's bases-loaded walk put the Bulldogs in the lead for good on Tuesday night.
- The last Conference USA team to defeat the Razorbacks has three more opportunities to update its claim this weekend. LA Tech defeated No. 10 Arkansas 12-7 at Baum-Walker Stadium on March 9, 2019. A pair of Masons – former Diamond Dogs Mason Mallard and Mason Robinson combined for two homers, seven RBI and three runs scored in the road victory.
- LA Tech has been dominate at its new ballpark in 2021, winning all six games at the new Love Shack while outscoring opponents 55-14. Tech has won by margins of 11, 10, eight and seven runs in home games this year.
- Bulldog Philip Matulia has had a breakout season so far for LA Tech, leading the team in batting average (.429), RBI (13), triples (two), slugging percentage (.743) and OPS (1.218).
- Senior centerfielder Parker Bates was one of just two non-Power Five players to be named a Preseason First-Team All-American by the NCBWA.

GUESS WHO'S BACK...BACK AGAIN

All six of Louisiana Tech's seniors from the 2020 season – Manny Garcia, Bryce Fagan, Hunter Wells, Kyle Griffen, Tyler Follis and Parker Bates – are returning for the Diamond Dogs in 2021. The Bulldogs turned down multiple offers to play professional baseball in order to return to Ruston for one last season. The returning seniors have combined for 124 wins in over four years in a Bulldog uniform, including a 39-win season in 2018.

BACK IN THE SHACK

In Tech's 9-2 win over Southern on Feb. 26, a run of 675 days without playing a home game on campus came to a welcomed end. It had been since April 23, 2019, that Louisiana Tech's baseball program had played a home game on campus. On April 25, 2019, an EF-3 tornado roared through Ruston, causing major damage to LA Tech's baseball, softball, soccer and tennis complexes. LA Tech's baseball, softball and tennis programs will all play in their new facilities this spring. Tech's 11-0 win over McNeese State on Friday, March 5, marked the first time in 682 days that the Bulldogs had played a home game on campus with fans in the stands. The 'Dogs welcomed fans back to the Love Shack with a sweep of the Cowboys this past weekend. The Bulldogs walked off their final game in the old J.C. Love Field at Pat Patterson Park 5-4 over Little Rock before the tornado struck Ruston in the early hours of April 25, 2019.

NEW HOME, SAME SPOT

The corner of Alabama Avenue and Tech Drive was the home of the former J.C. Love Field at Pat Patterson Park for 38 years. The Diamond Dogs posted an 843-460-1 record at the 48-year-old facility before the 2019 tornado caused its destruction. Lucky for longtime LA Tech Baseball fans, the new "Love Shack" will remain in the exact same location. All-time records from the old facility will carry over with the new J.C. Love Field. With six wins already this season, LA Tech can tally win No. 850 in a big way with the No. 1 Hogs in Ruston.

NEW ARMS IN RUSTON

Louisiana Tech added eight newcomers to its 2021 roster in the fall, all of which were pitchers. Four of the new Bulldogs are junior-college transfers and four are first-year students from high schools in Georgia, Maryland and Texas. Two of LA Tech's new pitchers are southpaws, giving the Bulldogs seven left-handed pitchers on this year's roster. Landon Tomkins, Tanner Knight, Nick Ellis, Cade Hodges and Wesley Kreger have all already made their debuts in a LA Tech uniform.

IT'S AN HONOR

After posting a breakout season in 2020, returning senior Parker Bates collected four Conference USA Preseason Player of the Year honors. Collegiate Baseball, D1Baseball, Baseball America and Conference USA named Bates their Preseason POTY. Other accolades for Bates include third-team Preseason All-American honors from Collegiate Baseball and Preseason All-Conference USA honors from Perfect Game Baseball. D1Baseball also listed Bates as its No. 18 prospect from the C-USA for the 2021 MLB Draft. The Tyler, Texas native recorded a .422/.531/.891 (AVG/OBP/SLG) triple-slash line during the shortened 2020 season.

WALK THIS WAY

Taylor Young has been a tough out since he arrived in Ruston for the 2018 season. After entering his junior season 11th in program history with 84 walks, he recorded 10 walks in the shortened 2020 season to move up to tie for seventh in the all-

before five walks in his first 11 games moved him into sixth place alone with 99 free passes. LA Tech's record holder in walks, Toronto Blue Jays' manager Charlie Montoyo (1985-87), has a strong grip on first place with 172 bases on balls.

MR. RELIABLE

In 2019's regular season finale, LA Tech reliever and swiss-army knife Kyle Griffen rewrote the Diamond Dog record books with his 33rd pitching appearance of the year. The crafty lefty broke the previous eight-year record held by Caleb Dudley (32 posts in 2011). Griffen notched eight pitching appearances in 2020 to tie for sixth in program history at 71. The left-hander would need just seven appearances to tie for second place at 78, but he still has a way to go to catch Dudley's LA Tech record of 110 appearances. The southpaw that "always posts," according to head coach Lane Burroughs, has recorded four appearances and one start already this season, moving up to 75 career pitching appearances.

NO PAIN, NO GAIN

One of head coach Lane Burroughs' favorite statistics every season is how his batters have a knack for getting on base via the HBP. LA Tech has led Conference USA in hit-by-pitches five of the past six seasons – (35 in 2020, 94 in 2019, 103 in 2018, 84 in 2016 and 89 in 2015). Tech's 2017 mark ranks first in program history. LA Tech tallied 35 HBPs in the COVID-19-shortened 2020 season, which was eight more than the second-place Southern Miss Golden Eagles had a year ago. Parker Bates moved into second place alone after wearing one in Tech's season opener against Air Force at Alex Box Stadium in Baton Rouge. Bates was then plunked on Feb. 27 against Southern, moving into a tie with Brent Diaz for first place. The centerfielder broke the record with an HBP against McNeese State this past Saturday in the bottom of the first, moving up to 34 career HBPs. Bates was hit again the next day to extend his new record total to 35 HBPs. Teammate and outfield partner Steele Netterville wore two pitches on Feb. 27 against Southern, moving into a tie for third place in school history.

UP TO THE CHALLENGE

Since 2016, the Bulldogs have played 41 games against opponents ranked inside the top 25, including three contests this past season. The Diamond Dogs are 23-18 in those games against ranked opponents, going 2-1 against top-25 foes in 2020. LA Tech has five victories over ranked SEC opponents – three against Arkansas, one against Texas A&M and one against LSU. Under head coach Lane Burroughs, the Bulldogs are 12-11 against ranked competition, sweeping No. 24 UL-Lafayette on the road before dropping a contest to No. 11 LSU in 2020. Earlier this year, the Diamond Dogs jumped ahead 6-2 at No. 11 LSU before the Tigers' bats heated up to pull away from Tech with a 16-7 victory. LA Tech will get five straight opportunities to earn a win over a top-five team with No. 1 Arkansas and No. 4 Ole Miss coming to town.

Philip Matulia has recorded a hit in eight straight games for the Bulldogs. He leads LA Tech with five multi-hit games and five multi-RBI games in 2021.

LADIES AND GENTLEMEN... THE WEEKEND

Louisiana Tech has been on fire during weekend games this season, holding a perfect 7-0 record while outscoring opponents 73-15. Tech has tallied hit totals of 18, 17, 14, 12 and 11 in five of those seven games, failing to crack the 10-hit mark just twice in weekend competition. LA Tech's pitching staff has also performed well over the weekend, combining to strikeout 73 opposing batters while allowing just 18 walks. Six of those walks came in just one contest against Southern on Feb. 28.

MAKING A "STATE"MENT

Since Burroughs' first season in Ruston in 2017, the 'Dogs are 32-13 (.711) against in-state opponents. LA Tech's stellar performances against Louisiana schools continued in 2020, posting a 5-1 record in the shortened campaign. Tech won eight games in 2018 and 2019 against in-state opponents with its best winning percentage (.727) coming in 2018 after an 8-3 record versus in-state foes. Despite some early season schedule changes, the Bulldogs are still scheduled to play five more games against Louisiana schools in 2021 - Tulane (three), LSU (one) and ULM (two). LA Tech swept Southern University and McNeese State at home and dropped two games on the road to UL-Lafayette and one away from the Love Shack at No. 11 LSU. Tech's recent victory at ULM gave the 'Dogs their first road win of the season.

WELLS TWO AWAY FROM TRIPLES' RECORD

Hunter Wells is not only one of the six Bulldog seniors who returned for the 2021 season, but he's also one on the verge of rewriting the LA Tech record books. Wells batted .324 during the 2020 season and smacked the seventh triple of his career, moving him into a tie for sixth place in program history. In his first game back at the Love Shack on Feb. 26, Wells laced a triple to right center for the eighth triple of his career, moving into a tie for third place with former Bulldogs Jac Adcock, Bobby Brasher and Dale Holman. The Katy, Texas native now needs just one three-bagger to move into a tie for first with John Cassibry (1969-72) and Bill Laird (1963-65).

BOMB SQUAD

The Bulldogs ranked No. 4 in the nation in 2020 with 26 home runs as a team. LA Tech tallied eight more homers than the next closest Conference USA opponent (Florida Atlantic - 18). The Diamond Dogs swept the top-three spots in the C-USA for individual home run leaders. Bates (eight), Netterville (six) and Young (five) rounded out the top three for the conference. Bates' eight dingers ranked tied for third in the nation this past season. Through 11 games in 2021, the 'Dogs have tallied 17 round-trippers as a team. Bulldogs Taylor Young (four), Steele Netterville (three), Hunter Wells (three), Parker Bates (two), Manny Garcia (two) and Philip Matulia (two) have all recorded multiple home runs this season.

KINGS OF THE HILL

Bulldog pitchers led the way in multiple Conference USA pitching categories in 2020, including team ERA (3.03), opposing batting average (.205), fewest hits allowed (112), fewest runs allowed (64), fewest earned runs allowed (50) and fewest hit batters (seven). Starting pitcher Jarret Whorff tied for a league-best three wins while recording 13 strikeouts and allowing just four extra-base hits over 23.1 innings pitched. Both Whorff and Tech's Jonathan Fincher ranked inside the top 10 in the C-USA in opposing batting average. Fincher finished sixth with a .174 average against him, while Whorff placed just a place behind in seventh with a .172 opposing average.

PUTTING UP O'S

LA Tech's pitching staff posted four shutouts in the shortened 2020 season, which tied for fifth in the NCAA. The Bulldogs shut out four different opponents a year ago, blanking Southeastern Louisiana (2-0), No. 24 UL-Lafayette (10-0), Troy (9-0) and Maine (19-0). Whorff recorded the win in two of Tech's shutouts, including spinning the Bulldogs' only complete-game shutout of the 2020 season against the Troy Trojans. The Bulldogs recorded their first shutout of 2021 against McNeese State on Friday, March 5.

A CLEAN SLATE

After announcing a schedule with a record-setting 37 home games in November, the Diamond Dogs announced changes to their 2021 schedule in January. Due to Big Ten Conference COVID-19 protocols, the Bulldogs replaced their opening weekend series at home against Illinois with an opening weekend trip to Baton Rouge. LA Tech also added eight Conference USA contests to its schedule, boosting the number of conference games from 24 to 32. The Diamond Dogs will play three-day, four-game conference weekends with one day including a doubleheader. The doubleheaders will consist of two seven-inning matchups. Other key changes include moving both I-20 showdowns against ULM to March. LA Tech will also close the season by hosting Old Dominion instead of Rice in a pair of games that will not count toward conference standings.

Head Coach Lane Burroughs



Louisiana Tech head baseball coach Lane Burroughs enters his fifth season coaching the Bulldogs in 2021 after two of the most tumultuous years in Louisiana Tech history.

Burroughs led the 'Dogs to an 11-6 record in 2020 before the public health threat of COVID-19 resulted in the cancellation of the remainder of the season. The Bulldogs were getting ready to face off with Middle Tennessee in Jackson, Mississippi, when they got the news of the cancellation. Tech went 5-1 against other Louisiana schools in 2020.

Burroughs has amassed 109 victories through his first three years, more than any Tech baseball coach in their first three seasons.

In 2019, Burroughs led LA Tech to a 34-24 overall record, including a 17-13 mark in Conference USA. Though a mid-April tornado forced the Bulldogs out of J.C. Love Field at Pat Patterson Park, Louisiana Tech still finished the regular season strongly with a victory over then-no. 15 LSU and series wins over FIU and Western Kentucky. LA Tech picked up four wins over ranked teams in 2019, defeating Arkansas, LSU, and Florida Atlantic.

The 2019 campaign also saw two Bulldogs make their way into Major League Baseball. The Oakland Athletics drafted pitcher David Leal in the 38th round, and the Tampa Bay Rays signed Mason Mallard as a free agent after the draft.

In 2018, Burroughs led the Bulldogs to a 39-20 record - including a program record 21 victories in conference play - en route to the second seed in the Conference USA Tournament after the team was picked to finish seventh in the preseason poll. Under his leadership, the Bulldogs won 18 true road games (sixth-most in NCAA, and most in C-USA) for the first time since 1982. Tech also finished a perfect 5-0 in league series on the road.

Tech also claimed several signature victories in 2018, including wins over Power 5 foes in then No. 9 Texas A&M and Cal, as Tech claimed The Frisco Classic Championship Title. Burroughs also led the Bulldogs to a road series win over then No. 9 Southern Miss, finishing as the only team to beat the Golden Eagles in a regular-season series in 2018.

Burroughs continued his home success, leading the Bulldogs to 18 home victories, marking the first time that a Tech team posted 18 wins at home and on the road in the same season since 1982.

With a new-look roster, featuring eight brand new starting position players, Burroughs paced the Tech offense, finishing the regular season second in OBP, runs scored, hits, RBI, doubles, triples and total bases.

In his first year in Ruston, Burroughs registered a 36-20 inaugural season in 2017, leading the 'Dogs to their first back-to-back 35+ win seasons in more than 25 years for the program.

In 2017, Tech drew a record number of season ticket holders that saw a 22-7 record in Ruston. The Bulldogs also held the nation's longest home winning streak after knocking off nationally-ranked Arkansas on February 28.

Burroughs saw three players selected in the 2017 MLB Draft, as pitcher Nate Harris (Conference USA Pitcher of the Year), catcher Brent Diaz (Johnny Bench Award Finalist) and outfielder Raphael Gladu (First Team All-Conference USA) all heard their names called to compete at the next level.

Burroughs joined the LA Tech family after spending the past four years as the head baseball coach at Northwestern State, where he compiled 113 wins and led the Demons to three straight 30-win seasons from 2014-16.

In his final three seasons in Natchitoches, Burroughs guided Northwestern State to a 97-73 record and qualified for the Southland Conference Tournament each year, while the Demons averaged 19.7 conference wins in that span.

Burroughs replaced Greg Goff, who led LA Tech to a 67-47 record in two seasons and the program's first NCAA Regional appearance in 29 years before accepting the position of head coach at the University of Alabama last week.

In 2016, the Meridian, Mississippi, native led Northwestern State to a 33-24 record, while the Demons recorded back-to-back seasons of 20 Southland Conference victories and ended the season No. 47 in the NCAA Ratings Percentage Index (RPI).

After being named head coach at Northwestern State in 2013, Burroughs was tasked with the job of rebuilding the historic baseball program and delivered soon after taking over the helm. Burroughs guided the Demons to the largest turnaround in Southland Conference history after NSU increased its league win total from 2013 to 2014 by 14 to finish third in the

Southland, while NSU also tied the school record for the largest increase in total wins from a previous season with 17 more victories than the previous season.

Prior to being named the Demons skipper in 2013, Burroughs spent a total of 17 years as an assistant coach at Mississippi College (1996), East Mississippi Community College (1997), Northwestern State (1998), Southern Miss (1999-2007), Kansas State (2008) and Mississippi State (2009-12). In all, the 21-year veteran has coached in the SEC, Big 12, Conference USA and Southland Conference.

Burroughs coached eight NCAA Regional tournament teams as an assistant.

During his playing career, Burroughs spent two years at Meridian Community College where he helped lead the Eagles to back-to-back Region 23 championships and the NJCAA College World Series in 1993. From 1994-95, Burroughs was an outfielder and catcher for Mississippi College and earned first team All-Gulf South Conference honors.

Burroughs studied pre-law at Mississippi College, where he earned his bachelor's degree in 1995, before earning his master's in social sciences in 1996.

Burroughs and his wife, Susan, have three children: Parker Grace, Camryn Laine and Thomas Jackson. Burroughs spent four seasons as the recruiting coordinator and assistant under John Cohen at Mississippi State from 2009-12, while the new LA Tech skipper also brings nine years of Conference USA experience with him to Ruston after he spent time on Corky Palmer's staff at Southern Miss from 1999-2007. Burroughs served as the hitting coach, recruiting coordinator and infield coach for the Golden Eagles and helped lead Southern Miss to six NCAA Regional appearances in nine seasons before spending one year coaching in the Big 12 as an assistant at Kansas State.

Early in his coaching career, Burroughs also spent the 1998 season as an assistant under Cohen, who was the head coach at Northwestern State, as the two helped lead the Demons to 40 wins and a Southland Conference title.

Burroughs began his coaching career in 1996 as a graduate assistant at Mississippi College before spending the 1997 season as an assistant at East Mississippi Community College.

As an assistant, Burroughs has coached eight NCAA Regional tournament teams.

During his playing career, Burroughs spent two years at Meridian Community College where he helped lead the Eagles to back-to-back Region 23 championships and the NJCAA College World Series in 1993. From 1994-95, Burroughs was an outfielder and catcher for Mississippi College and earned first team All-Gulf South Conference honors.

Burroughs studied pre-law at Mississippi College, where he earned his bachelor's degree in 1995, before earning his master's in social sciences in 1996.

The New Home of the Bulldogs



A NEW HOME IN 2021

On Nov. 21, 2019, Louisiana Tech officials presented their vision for the future of Bulldog and Lady Techster baseball, softball and soccer.

The new home for baseball will remain at its traditional location -- the corner of Tech Drive and West Alabama -- and will include an indoor practice facility. The estimated capacity is 2,500 with all chairback seats, as well as right-field berm seating that students recommended.

"The entire landscape of our athletic facilities is being taken to an entirely new level. The same can be said for our recruitment and development of our current and future student athletes. We are so thankful to everyone that worked so diligently and tirelessly to make this a possibility," head coach Lane Burroughs said. "It has been a long process since that awful night in April, but our people have stood firm and patiently worked every day to see us come out better than before. Our loyalty, patience and persistence will allow us to reap benefits in the future. It's a great day to be a Bulldog and Lady Techster."

Construction on the new facilities for baseball, softball, and soccer began after January 1, 2020. The Bulldogs practiced for the first time in their new facility on Feb. 9. The facility will include four luxury suites, a spacious press box, the Origin Bank Baseball Complex and hitting facility, and coaches' offices as well as other enhancements to Tech's new facility. LA Tech played its first home game in the facility on Feb. 26, 2021, in a 9-2 win over Southern. While fans were not allowed into the stadium due to the fire marshall's orders, many members of the Louisiana Tech Baseball fan base watched the game beyond the wall in left field. Tech welcomed fans into the stadium for the first time on March 5, 2021, against McNeese State. The Bulldogs rewarded LA Tech fans with an 11-0 win in the first of three weekend victories at the Love Shack.





APRIL 25, 2019

In the early morning hours of Thursday, April 25, 2019, an EF3 tornado ravaged the city of Ruston, Louisiana, and the campus of Louisiana Tech. Two residents of Ruston lost their lives, while Louisiana Tech's baseball facility (J.C. Love Field at Pat Patterson Park), affectionately named the "Love Shack" was destroyed, along with Tech's softball, soccer and tennis complexes.

Tech's players and coaches were forced to clean out their locker rooms and offices, relocating to nearby Ruston High School's facilities for the remainder of the 2019 season. Tech junior outfielder Seth White's father, Toby, is the head coach for the Ruston High Bearkats, who allowed Tech to play its final home series of the year vs. WKU at Ruston High School, as well as practice at the field for the duration of the 2020 season.

Fundraising efforts after the storm collected incredible amounts for not only the Tech athletic programs, but also for the university and surrounding community. When the Bulldogs played at Mississippi State in 2019, the host Bulldogs waived admission and accepted donations throughout the game - totalling just over \$14,000. Similar fundraising efforts were conducted by neighboring programs in Northwestern State, Rice and LSU.

With the new complex set to be built over the next year, Bulldogs were without a true home facility for the 2020 season. Despite not allowing fans on opening day, the new Love Shack will be ready for game use in Tech's opening series against Southern beginning on Feb. 26.

Though he didn't know it at the time, Hunter Wells hit a walk-off home run in the 'Dogs final at-bat inside the Love Shack. The now-redshirt senior sent a solo shot over the center field wall to defeat Little Rock 5-4.
