LEADING OFF

Texas A&M faces the top-ranked team in the nation for a three-game series when they battle the Arkansas Razorbacks at Baum Stadium... Texas A&M ranks high on the NCAA pitching charts, including No. 3 in Shutouts (5), No. 8 in Strikeouts Per Nine Innings (11.5), No. 11 in K-to-BB Ratio (3.50) and No. 28 in Walks Allowed Per Nine Innings (3.28)... **Dustin Saenz** (No. 5 - 69) and **Chandler Jozwiak** (No. 29 - 60) rank in the top 50 in the nation in strikeouts. Jozwiak also ranks 18th in Strikeouts Per Nine Innings (14.21) and 32nd in K-to-BB Ratio (7.50). Saenz checks in at No. 42 in Strikeouts Per Nine Innings (12.94) and No. 73 in K-to-BB Ratio (5.75)... **Will Frizzell** is enjoying an All-American start to the 2021 campaign. He currently ranks in the top 20 in the nation in Total Bases (5th - 87) and Home Runs (9th - 11) and Hits (13th - 46), as well as the top 100 in Slugging Percentage (65th - .674), Walks (66th - 22) and Runs (93rd - 29).

SUSTAINED EXCELLENCE

The Texas A&M Aggies are one of only three schools to appear in each of the last 13 NCAA Division I Baseball Championships. The Maroon & White's 13-season NCAA postseason string is the second-longest in the SEC trailing only Vanderbilt (14 years). It is also the longest active string among Texas schools.

TEXAS A&M/ARKANSAS SERIES NOTABLES

The Aggies and Razorbacks have met on the diamond 90 times with Texas A&M holding the series lead 46-43-1. The Maroon & White first took the field against Arkansas in 1908 with the Aggies winning, 4-1. The teams didn't meet again until 1926, followed by a 48-year hiatus to 1974. Since joining the SEC in 2013, the Maroon & White have competed in a yearly three-game series. The Aggies currently hold a two-game winning streak.

In their last meeting, the 2019 Aggies took the rubber match, 6-1, claiming the series win. Texas A&M got lights out pitching from starter Christain Roa, who earned the win. Roa yielded just one run via a home run on five hits and one walk, while tying a career-high seven strikeouts in six frames. **Joseph Menefee** and **Kasey Kalich** were perfect in the final three innings of relief. Offensively, **Jonathan Ducoff**, **Logan Foster** and **Mikey Hoehner** paced the Aggies' bats. Ducoff was 2-for-3 with two runs, one double and one RBI, while Foster and Hoehner added two hits and one run apiece.

CLEAN SHEETS

The Aggies enter the week ranked third in the nation with five Shutouts. Louisiana Tech leads the nation with seven shutouts.

WINNING TRADITION

Heading into the 2021 campaign, the Aggies have 14 consecutive winning seasons. Texas A&M has posted a winning record in 58 of the last 60 years.

FAST STARTS

Texas A&M is outscoring opponents 63-14 in the first two innings, including 28-6 in the first frame. The Maroon & White have scored first in 25 of the 35 games this season.

The Aggie pitchers have yielded just six first-inning runs, five earned, in 34 games, for a 1.29 earned run average. The Maroon & White are holding opponents to a .138 batting average in the opening frame, striking out 53 of 132 batters. **Jonathan Childress** has surrendered four of the six first-inning runs. Taking him out of the equation, Aggie pitchers own a 0.67 ERA and .115 batting average.

Dustin Saenz has retired 24 of 28 batters he has faced in the first inning, including 16 strikeouts. **Chris Weber** has faced the minimum in just 17 batters in his five first innings, allowing one hit, one walk and hitting two batters, but he also turned a double play and caught a runner stealing.

FRIDAY'S PROBABLE STARTER: #37 DUSTIN SAENZ

Enters weekend ranked fifth in the nation and fourth in the SEC with 69 strikeouts... also ranks 42nd in the nation in Strikeouts Per Nine Innings (12.94) and 73rd in K-to-BB Ratio (5.75)... making his 42nd career appearance and 18th career start... owns a career record of 9-4 with one save, a 3.63 ERA and 123 strikeouts in 114.0 innings... owns wins against Baylor, New Mexico State, Samford, Georgia and Missouri this season... pitched 7.0 blank frames at Missouri, scattering three hits and three walks while striking out 10... struck out a career-high 14 in 8.0 shutout innings against Samford... pitched in seven games in 2020, including two starts, logging a 2-0 record with a 3.12 ERA and 22 strikeouts in 17.1 innings... logged a 2-1 mark with one save, a 4.85 ERA and 17 strikeouts in 29.2 innings as a sophomore... pitched in 11 games as a freshman, posting a 0-0 record with a 3.32 ERA and 15 strikeouts in 19.0 innings.

Ranks 11th among active pitchers in Career Strikeouts Per Nine Innings (12.37)... missed two weekend starts in COVID protocol... SEC Pitcher of the Week, Collegiate Baseball National Player of the Week and USA Baseball/Golden Spikes Award Performer of the Week five weeks ago... fanned a career-high 15 in win against New Mexico State without issuing a walk, marking the most strikeouts by an Aggie pitcher since Casey Fossum punched out 15 against Baylor in 1998... making his sixth consecutive start after making his first 41 appearances out of the bullpen... owns a 7-4 career record of with four saves, a 3.36 ERA and 98 strikeouts in 62.2 innings... made 33 appearances out of the bullpen as a sophomore in 2019, posting a 4-2 record with one save, a 3.77 ERA and 57 strikeouts in 43.0 innings... registered a 1-2 record with three saves, a 3.27 ERA and 14 strikeouts in 11.0 innings as a junior... pitched one season at Blinn College, earning NJCAA All-Texas with a 7-1 record, five saves and 34 strikeouts in 28.2 innings.

Making his second career weekend and SEC start... has been strong as a starter - he has yielded just 10 runs, eight earned, in 37.2 innings, scattering 28 hits and 16 walks while striking out 34 for a 3-1 record, 1.91 ERA and .211 opponent batting average in eight starts... earned win against No. 5 Texas, pitching 7.0 scoreless innings... tough-luck loser against Rice, yielding just one unearned run in 6.0 innings... notched win against A&M-Corpus Christi, scattering three hits and three walks while striking out one in 5.1 innings... earned a win against Houston Baptist, scattering three hits and one walk while striking out seven in 6.0 scoreless innings... did not allow a hit or run in his 18.0 innings of prep baseball in 2020... earned 6A Texas High School First Half Pitcher of the Year in 2020 and earned Academic All-State... named 6A All-State Third Team and first-team all-district as a junior... also earned Academic All-State honorable mention in 2019.

K SQUAD

This season, the Maroon & White have recorded double digits in the strikeout column in 24 of the 35 games and they rank No. 7 in Strikeouts Per Nine Innings (11.5), No. 14 in K-to-BB Ratio (3.38). **Dustin Saenz** (No. 5 - 69) and **Chandler Jozwiak** (No. 29 - 60) rank in the top 50 in the nation in strikeouts. Jozwiak also ranks 18th in Strikeouts Per Nine Innings (14.21) and 32nd in K-to-BB Ratio (7.50). Saenz checks in at No. 42 in Strikeouts Per Nine Innings (12.94) and No. 73 in K-to-BB Ratio (5.75).

Among active players with over 75.0 innings pitched, **Bryce Miller** ranks 11th in the nation with 12.23 Strikeouts Per Nine Innings. Jozwiak ranks 28th in the nation with 11.37 Strikeouts Per Nine Innings and **Chris Weber** ranks 46th in the nation with 10.83 Strikeouts Per Nine Innings.

In 2020, the Aggies ranked second in the nation in Strikeouts Per Nine Innings (12.5). They also checked in at No. 16 for K-to-BB ratio (3.68).

In 2019, the Aggies led the nation in K-to-BB Ratio (3.33) and ranked second in Strikeouts Per Nine Innings (10.9), third in ERA (3.21), eighth in WHIP (1.21), 11th in Hits Allowed Per Nine Innings (7.58), 10th in Shutouts (6) and 25th in Walks Allowed Per Nine Innings (3.27).

POST SEASON STREAK CONTINUES HEADING INTO 2020

Prior to the arrival of Coach **Rob Childress**, Texas A&M had never appeared in the NCAA Tournament more than four consecutive years. The 2019 tournament appearance extended the Aggies' current string to 13, something that had never happened before in the program's 118-year history.

Childress has led the Aggies to the postseason each of the last 13 seasons, topping the previous-high water mark of four-straight trips, a feat that had happened only twice before at Texas A&M. Former head coach Tom Chandler led his squad to the NCAA Regionals each season from 1975 to 1978 and 11 years later the Aggies enjoyed a similar four-year run from 1986-89 under the direction of head coach Mark Johnson.

MORE PITCHING NUMBERS

Texas A&M ranks high on the NCAA pitching charts, climbing up to No. 8 in Strikeouts Per Nine Innings (11.5), No. 11 in K-to-BB Ratio (3.50) and No. 28 in Walks Allowed Per Nine Innings (3.28)

GOOD EYE

The Aggies enter the week ranked fourth in the nation and third in the SEC with 180 walks. Tennessee leads both with 195 bases on balls. **Bryce Blaum** ranks 19th in the nation with 25 walks while **Will Frizzell** checks at 80th with 21 walks.

SEC ALL-TIME LEADER IN WINS

The Aggies own the most wins of any SEC program with 2,769 victories, which ranks 11th nationally. Texas A&M is currently one of just 13 NCAA Division I programs to reach the 2,700-win plateau, entering play with a 2,769-1,546-43 mark. On February 20, 2019, the Aggies became the first SEC team to reach the 2,700-win mark with a 19-1 victory against Prairie View A&M. Texas A&M's all-time winning percentage of .641 also leads the SEC and ranks 15th among NCAA Division I schools.

Ray Alejo enters the weekend with 11 stolen bases on the season. His career steals tally of 68 leads the NCAA and ranks 10th among all active NCAA Division I players. Alejo's best stolen base tally came as a sophomore in 2018 when he swiped 34 bags with UCF. The following season he logged 17 steals with the Knights and he tacked on six in the COVID-shortened 2020 campaign with Texas A&M.

CALL ON ME

Sophomore (COVID Freshman) **Alex Magers** and senior **Chandler Jozwiak** lead the SEC and rank third in the nation with 17 pitching appearances. Magers is 2-1 on the season with a 2.70 ERA. He has yielded six runs on 18 hits and eight walks while striking out 14 in 20.0 innings. Jozwiak is 1-2 with four saves, a 3.32 ERA and 60 strikeouts in 38.0 innings.

ANOTHER DAY, ANOTHER STARTING LINEUP

The Aggies have trotted out 1 different starting lineups, replicate a prior line up on just four occasions. **Kalae Harrison** and **Will Frizzell** are the only players to start all 35 games. Harrison has been the most consistent part of the lineup starting all 35 games at shortstop and batting in the ninth spot of the order. The Aggies have already had 12 different players bat in the No. 5 spot and 11 players bat in the No. 6 spot. The Maroon & White have started seven different players as designated hitters and six in leftfield.
