- · TCU and Arkansas, longtime SWC foes, will be meeting for the 70th time on Sunday.
- Arkansas owns a 46-23 series lead, including a 3-0 lead since Jim Schlossnagle took over as head coach.
- . TCU and Arkansas last faced off in 2019 in the NCAA Fayetteville Regional.



FROG TIDBITS

Conner Shepherd hit the four of the last six home runs for the Horned Frogs in 2020

Eight of Zach Humphreys' 13 hits in 2020 went for doubles.

Five of Austin Henry's six hitsin 2020 drove in runs.

TCU has stolen a base in all but three games this season.

TCU had tallied five outfield assists in 2020. They had only 12 in 2019.

PRESEASON RESPECT

The last 17 seasons have seen the Horned Frogs gradually imprint themselves on the national scene. No stranger to the rankings, the Frogs find themselves in the preseason polls for the 12th consecutive season.

TCU was ranked No. 10 in the D1Baseball. com preseason poll. Additionally, the Frogs were ranked No. 11 (NCBWA, USA Today), No. 13 (Baseball America) and No. 19 (Collegiate Baseball)

THE BEST IN TEXAS

Since taking over the program in 2004, head coach Jim Schlossnagle has done nothing but win. In 17 years under his guidance, the Horned Frogs are 693-327. TCU has posted 11 seasons with at least 40 wins and three of 50+ wins. The Horned Frogs have appeared in 14 NCAA Regionals.

The 693 victories are tops among Division I programs in the state of Texas as is the .679 winnings percentage.

BONUS YEAR

A shortened 2020 campaign afforded a rare opportunity for a group of eight seniors. The NCAA granted eligibility relief to members of the 2020 squads.

TCU had eight seniors on its 2020 roster and all eight elected to return for the 2021 season. The group of eight have a combined 34 years of collegiate baseball experience.

Five Frogs (Dalton Brown, Austin Henry, Conner Shepherd, Hunter Wolfe and Gene Wood) will be in their sixth year of eligibility.

NATIONWIDE

The United States is well-represented on the Horned Frogs rosters. The 43 athletes hail from 14 states spanning the continental USA.

There are 28 players from the state of Texas. Utah has two representatives (Hill and Taylor), while 13 other have one representative - Arizona (Sacco), California (Shepherd), Colorado (Cornelio), Illinois (Ray), Iowa (Krob), Michigan (Henry), Mississippi (Wood), Missouri (Byrne), Oklahoma (Thompson), Tennessee (Wolfe), Virginia (Williams) and Wisconsin (Mihlbauer).

SCORING IN BUNCHES

In three of the last five years, TCU has ranked in top 50 in scoring and near the bottom nationally in sac bunts. TCU has averaged 6.5 runs the last five seasons, while tallying just 24 sacrifices

Over the last five years, TCU has scored multiple runs in 607 innings. In 174 innings, TCU has

produced four or more runs.

TCU has scored 10 or more runs 81 times over the last seven seasons and tallied 121 wins of 5+ runs. Conversely, the Frogs have lost just 36 games by five or more runs since 2014.

SPEED FACTOR

TCU continues to be one of the most prolific base-stealing teams in the nation. The Frogs ranked fourth in the Big 12 and 53rd nationally with 26 stolen bases in a shortened 2020 season.

The Frogs are one of just nine teams to have stolen at least 600 bases over the last seven years. The 601 stolen bases rank eighth in the nation and second among Power 5 teams.

It's not just raw numbers that are impressive, the Horned Frogs have produced a high success rate, converting on 77% of their attempts over the last six years (601-of-785).

STINGY STAFF

The Frogs' 3.19 ERA since 2014 is fourth nationally. TCU led the nation with a 2.22 ERA in 2014 and ranked second in 2015 with a 2.45 ERA. Additionally, the TCU pitching staff has pitched the fourth-most shutouts (45) nationally over the last seven years.

TCU has limited opponents to two or fewer runs 173 times over the last 400 games played. The staff has surrendered 5+ runs just 139 times.

LEADER OF THE PACK

There are 297 NCAA Division 1 programs across the country. Of those 297 programs, only 44 have employed its head coaches for at least 17 years.

Of those 44 head coaches, Jim Schlossnagle is one of just 11 to have recorded a .600+ winning percentage. Just five head coaches: Brian O'Connor - Virginia (.709); Jim Schlossnagle - TCU (.679); Tim Corbin - Vanderbilt (.677); Danny Hall - Georgia Tech (.659); Gary Gilmore - Coastal Carolina (.657) boast a winning percentage over .650.

THE K-ZONE

The Frogs set a school and Big 12 record in 2017 with 643 strikeouts. Over the last seven years, TCU has a 3.1 K:BB ratio and is averaging 8.8 strikeouts per nine.

Since the start of the 2013 season, TCU has registered 10 or more strikeouts in a game 181 times, including a school-record 30 times in 2017.

EXTRA, EXTRA

TCU has played 65 extra inning games since 2004 and holds a 41-24 mark in those games.

TCU went to extra innings for the first time in 2020 on March 3 against UT Arlington, dropping a 6-4 decision in 12 innings.

TCU owns a 9-4 record in extra innings dating back to the 2015 campaign.

The Frogs longest extra inning game was 22 innings in the 2014 NCAA Regional against Sam Houston State.

TCU's longest regular-season extra inning game was 15 innings against Texas A&M on March 4, 2017.
