DAWG BITES

- Mississippi State enters the weekend with a 16-10 overall record over the first 26 games of the season, including a 3-3 record in SEC play following a series win over Alabama at home last weekend. The Diamond Dawgs are 3-4 in road games this season.
- BOMBS AWAY: State is currently ranked 10th in the country and 3rd in the SEC with 43 home runs on the season. The Dawgs are led by sophomore Kellum Clark and freshman Hunter Hines with eight home runs each on the season.
- MSU's pitching staff enters the week ranked 3rd in the SEC and 5th nationally in strikeouts per 9 innings (11.9). MSU RHP Preston
 Johnson leads the team with 50 strikeouts in six appearances (5 GS), while he is ranked 3rd among SEC pitchers and 24th nationally in strikeouts. Parker Stinnett is 7th in the SEC with 46 strikeouts.
- MSU's Luke Hancock ranks 1st in the SEC and 11th nationally in toughest to strikeout. He has only struck out five times in 96 at bats.
- The Dawgs are hitting .274 as a team with 47 doubles and 43 home runs. MSU is out-scoring opponents 212-133.
- On the mound, MSU pitchers have combined for a 4.82 team ERA in 227.2 innings pitched. Opponents are hitting .243 against the Dawgs' pitching staff.
- In the last five games, Kamren James is hitting .400 for the Diamond Dawgs. James has gone 8-for-20 with two home runs, two doubles and five RBIs, while he is slugging .800 and drawn two walks with a .435 on base percentage and two stolen bases over that stretch.

- MSU's Logan Tanner and Hunter Hines also paced the Dawgs at the plate in the last five games after going a combined 12-for-34 with four home runs (2 HR each), four doubles and 10 RBIs.
- MSU OF Kellum Clark got off to a slow start in 2022, going 0-for-16 at the plate, but since recording an RBI single after getting the green light on a 3-0 count against Tulane (3/4), Clark is hitting .333 (21-for-63) with eight home runs, five doubles, 26 RBIs and 21 runs scored. Over the span of the last 17 games, Clark is slugging .794 and has posted a .455 on base percentage.

LAST TIME OUT:

- Mississippi State clinched a series victory over Alabama last weekend with back-to-back walk-off wins on Friday and Saturday.
 - In the opener, State rallied back from a 6-4 deficit when Hunter Hines tied the game with two outs in the bottom of the ninth with a two-run home run. Then in the 10th, RJ Yeager secured the walk-off win with a solo home run to right-center.
 - In Saturday's game, the Dawgs were down 7-4
 entering the bottom of the ninth before back-to-back
 doubles by Kamren James and Kellum Clark, followed
 by the game-tying two-run home run by Logan
 Tanner. Tanner Leggett then provided the heroics with
 an RBI walk-off single later in the ninth.

INSIDE THE SERIES

SCOUTING THE OPPONENTS

- Arkansas is led by head coach Dave Van Horn, who is in his 20th season with the Razorbacks. Arkansas enters the week with a 19-4 overall record on the season, including a 5-1 record in SEC games.
- Arkansas enters the weekend ranked as high as No. 2 in the national polls. The Razorbacks are ranked in the top five nationally in each poll.
- The Razorbacks opened SEC play with a sweep over Kentucky in Fayetteville, while the following week saw Arkansas travel to Missouri, where the Hogs took two of three from the Tigers in Columbia
- Arkansas has won 14 of their last 15 games entering the weekend.

SERIES NOTES

- Mississippi State leads the all-time series, 56-54, over Arkansas in a series that dates back to 1960.
- In 2019 and 2021, Arkansas swept both series over State in Fayetteville (2019) and Starkville (2021).
- The year prior, Mississippi State swept the No. 4-ranked Hogs in three close games at Dudy Noble Field in 2018.
- Mississippi State's last win in Fayetteville came on April 26, 2015, when the Diamond Dawgs secured a 2-1 win in the series finale at Baum-Walker Stadium.

- AWARD SZN: Mississippi State RHP Parker Stinnett was named the SEC Co-Pitcher of the Week on March 14 and the National Pitcher of the Week by the NCBWA after a pair of dominant starts on the mound for the Dawgs.
 - Stinnett led all SEC pitchers that week with 24 strikeouts in 11.0 innings pitched after starting twice in a span of six days. The junior went 2-0 and registered a career-high 12 strikeouts twice, including in just his second career start, as MSU defeated #11 Texas Tech, 11-5, in Biloxi.
- MSU first baseman Luke Hancock recently enjoyed a 17game reached base streak, the longest of his career. Hancock did not reach base in the season-opener vs. Long Beach State (2/18), but followed up by reaching in the next 17 games.
- BAD NEWS IN THE BIG EASY: During Mississippi State's three-game road series at Tulane(3/4-6), the Diamond Dawgs were dealt a pair of blows to the pitching staff on back-to-back days. In the series opener, starter Landon Sims was tossing a perfect game before having to leave the game due to an injury. The following day, MSU reliever **Stone Simmons** pitched a 1-2-3 inning before also leaving with an apparent arm injury.
 - On Monday, March 14, both Sims and Simmons announced they would both undergo season-ending Tommy John surgery this week.

• NOW PITCHING...LANE FORSYTHE

- Mississippi State SS Lane Forsythe toed the rubber for the first time since high school in a 13-5 victory over Binghamton (3/14). Forsythe entered the game in the fifth inning and allowed one run on a solo home run, but quickly bounced back by retiring the next three batters he faced in one inning of relief work. In high school, Forsythe was 11-1 on the mound with one save and a 0.78 ERA.
- HITTER HINES: MSU's Hunter Hines enters the week with eight home runs on the young season, which ranks as the second-most in the nation among freshmen this season.







BIOGRAPHY

The largest on-campus facility in college baseball, Dudy Noble Field hosted its 55th season of Mississippi State baseball at the current site in 2021. With over 1,600 games played at the venue, the Diamond Dawgs own a .730 winning percentage at the facility, which recently received a \$68-million upgrade.

The field is named in honor of longtime MSU baseball coach, athletics director and ABCA Hall of Famer Clarke Randolph "Dudy" Noble. On April 27, 1998 the facility was renamed Dudy Noble Field, Polk-DeMent Stadium, honoring another ABCA Hall of Famer, former Bulldog skipper Ron Polk, and the late Gordon DeMent, a successful businessman and longtime fan of the Diamond Dawgs from Indianola, Mississispipi.

The Origin

From 1929 until 1964, Mississippi State hosted its baseball games at the original on-campus venue, Hardy Field, which was located several hundred yards to the south of the Bulldogs' home football venue, Davis Wade Stadium at Scott Field. The baseball field was closed following the 1964 season to make way for the construction of Dorman Hall and for the next two seasons the Diamond Dawgs played their home games at Redbird Park in Columbus, Mississippi, capturing SEC titles both seasons at their temporary home.

The tin-roofed grandstand and 2,000-seat bleachers from the original Dudy Noble Field were transported to the stadium's present site, which became playable for the 1967 campaign. Since that time, facility enhancements have followed at a steady pace to make the "Carnegie Hall of College Baseball" one of the finat all-around facilities on the road to Omaha. Among with numerous upgrades, the current site has seen two complete demolitions and reconstructions, the latest occurring during a three-year span (2017-19) and opening prior to the start of the 2019 campaign.

Leading the Attendance Boom

With a laundry list of legendary names on its all-time roster, it comes as no surprise that Mississippi State ranks among the nation's attendance leaders year in and year out. The Dudy Noble Field faithful have sold out the reserved seating allotment every season since 1987.

Along with routinely hosting some of the largest crowds in the SEC, ten of the last 12 three-day Super Bulldog Weekend series have drawn more than 25,000 fans.

MSU eclipsed the 200,000 mark in paid attendance at Dudy Noble Field for six-straight seasons between 2012-17, marking the first such occurrence in the program's history. In 2013, the Diamond Dawgs' five-millionth fan walked through the turnstiles at Dudy Noble Field. Since home attendance figures were charted starting in 1976, the "Carnegie Hall of College Baseball" has seen 6,720,459 fans rush through the gates.

In 20 of the last 21 seasons, Mississippi State has averaged 6,000 fans per game, including a record average of 8,899 during the 2019 campaign. Overall, State has eclipsed the 200,000-fan mark 12 times since 2002, with a school-record 373,784 viewing the 2019 home schedule.

Of the top 25 all-time college baseball on-campus attendances, Dudy Noble Field finds itself on the list 19 times, most notably owning the all-time on-campus attendance record of 15,586 on April 12, 2014. The Bulldogs own 15 of the top 16 marks in NCAA on-campus history and are the only NCAA baseball program to boast on-campus attendances of 14,000 or more. The five largest NCAA Super Regional crowds have all assembled in Starkville, Mississippi, as well.

From April 11-13, 2014, the Bulldog faithful flooded the gates at Dudy Noble Field to the tune or 39,181 fans for a three-game series versus Ole Miss. The nearly 40,000 fans on the weekend set an NCAA on-campus attendance record for a three-game series.

Dudy Noble Field has ushered in crowds of 10,000 or better 61 times, including 2007 NCAA Super Regional-record draws of 13,715 and 12,620 for nationally-televised, late-morning games against Clemson. In 2019, the first season of the "New Dude," the Diamond Dawgs garnered crowds of 10,000-plus a school-record 10 times.

Mississippi State has hosted 26 postseason events at the facility, including three NCAA District III Tournaments (1973-75), five SEC tournaments (1979, 81, 83, 88 & 95), 16 NCAA Regionals (1979, 84-85, 87-89, 90, 92, 97, 2000, 03, 13, 16, 19 & 21) and four NCAA Super Regionals (2007, 16, 19 & 21).

The Left Field Lounge

The aura of Mississippi State baseball at Dudy Noble Field is certainly not confined to the loyal legions in the impressive grandstand, pro-style luxury sky suites or luxurious Left Field Lofts.

In fact, some of the more highly-prized seats at Bulldog baseball games are found beyond the outfield fence in the Left Field Lounge™. Waiting lists greet those seeking to purchase one of the 96 outfield lounges in the iconic two-level outfield tailgate.

Once a colorful assortment of pickup trucks, motor homes, and trailers — most equipped with grills — lined the outfield fence, completing a circle of humanity at Dudy Noble Field. Now, the permanent lounge spaces are connected to the concourse, allowing everyone to stroll through and experience the iconic lounge culture.

What began in the late 1960s as a popular gathering spot for baseball-loving MSU supporters now forms college baseball's largest tailgate party.

The "New Dude"

The second demolition at the current site occurred following the 2017 season and the \$68 million facility opened its gates for the 2019 campaign. Architect Wier Boerner Allin, along with consultants Populous and farned stadium architect/State alum Janet Marie Smith designed the project, while construction manager ICM and general contractor JESCO Construction, Inc. oversaw the construction.

Covering 12 acres of land on the Mississippi State University campus, the 230,000 square foot facility carries on Dudy Noble Field's legacy as the "Carnegie Hall of College Baseball." Installation of the second largest scoreboard in college baseball, measuring 43 feet wide by 60 feet high, started the project in 2017. The board, which was the largest in college baseball upon instillation, is larger than boards owned by three Major League Baseball teams. The addition of 96 permanent Left Field Lounge rigs encircling the outfield followed during the fall of 2018.

The concourse and lower-level grandstands were in place for the 2018 season, with the Diamond Suites, upper-deck reserved seating area and three unique club areas – Farm Bureau Triple Crown Club, Charlie and Dana Stephenson Omaha Club and The Rooftop Club —were completed prior to the 2019 campaign. The newest version of Dudy Noble Field also features increased restroom facilities and concession points of sale.

The player spaces also received an upgrade, expanding to cover 18,000 square feet underneath the facility. The fully-equipped Bruce and Julie Martin Locker Room includes an embedded equipment room, houses 40 wooden lockers and features an oversized, dimensional halo-lit '85 Script Mississippi State sign suspended overhead in the middle of the room.

The more spacious locker room includes an attached training room with whirlpool and fully-functional fueling station. The Mitch Moreland Hitting Tunnel, which is equipped with HitTrax, and Turner & Gloria Wingo Team Lounge are easily accessed from the home dugout, with the eye-popping player entrance and Hassell H. Franklin Omaha Room greeting players as they enter the facility. The Pat McMahon Pitching Lab is also housed under the stadium, featuring arm care and conditioning equipment, one oversized turfed mound with three pitching rubbers and state of the art video equipment.
