## SERIES HISTORY

· Ole Miss is participating in its sixth NCAA College World Series and the second of the Mike Bianco era, last reaching Omaha in 2014.

• At 7-0, the Rebels are the only team remaining in the field that is undefeated during the NCAA Tournament.

. The two wins are tied for the most by Ole Miss ever at the College World Series. The Rebels have never reached the CWS Finals.

• The Rebel pitching staff leads the nation in hits allowed per nine innings, shutouts, strikeout-to-walk ratio, WHIP and hits allowed per nine inninas.

• Only four pitchers have pitched into the seventh inning during the College World Series and Ole Miss boasts two of them in Dylan DeLucia and Hunter Elliott.

· Kevin Graham's third-inning home run against Auburn was Ole Miss' 100th of the season. The Rebels have now hit a school record 102 big flies.

• During the NCAA Tournament, Ole Miss leads the nation in hits allowed per 9 innings (5.60), shutouts (2), strikeout-to-walk ratio (5.58), strikeouts per 9 innings (13.4) and WHIP (0.89) and ranks second in ERA (2.00).

• Ole Miss reached the College World Series with a two-game sweep on in-state foe No. 10 Southern Miss, recording the first two shutouts of the season for the Rebels.

• The Rebels are one of four programs all-time to make three-straight Super Regional performances, joining Arkansas, East Carolina and Stanford.

· Ole Miss advanced to the Super Regional round by winning all three of its games at the NCAA Coral Gables Regional, the first-ever road regional win for the Rebels.

• The Rebels are ranked Newspaper.

Garrett Wood has drawn the second most walks of any player during the NCAA Tournament with eight. In four starts since the start of the Coral Gables Regional, Wood has reached base in 11-of-18 plate appearances, good for a .611 OBP.

With 31, Dylan DeLucia has recorded more strikeouts than any other player in the postseason. The junior set a career-high in the category with 12 against Arizona and followed with 10 strikeouts Saturday against Auburn.

ATHLETICS COMMUNICATIONS: Ole Miss Associate Director of Athletic Communications Mitch Praxl handles all communications duties for the Ole Miss baseball program. For any questions or special requests, contact him on his cell at (662) 816-9914 or reach him by email at mipraxl@olemiss.edu.

**PRACTICES/INTERVIEWS:** The Rebels practice throughout the week at Oxford-University Stadium/Swayze Field, with practice typically occurring from 2-5 p.m. CT. All practices are open to the media. Media wishing ot arrange interviews with coaches or players either in person or remotely should contact Associate Director of Athletic Communications Mitch Praxl. All interview requests must be made at least 24 hours in advance. Media availability for players is subject to the team's time management plan.

**CREDENTIALS:** Due to social distancing guidelines, press box capacity is limited. Due to capacity restrictions, there will be no seasonlong credentials. Requests for credentials must be sent to Mitch Praxl (mjpraxl@olemiss.edu) at least 24 hours prior to each game. Please only submit credential requests for games you are sure to attend. Priority will be given to media outlets and members who regularly cover Ole Miss baseball.

**CREDENTIAL PICKUP/STADIUM ENTRANCE:** Credentials can be picked up on gameday at the Oxford-University Stadium will call window to the left of the main gate. Gates open one hour prior to first pitch for midweek games and two hours prior to weekend games, including Thursday games of weekend series. Outside of ADA considerations, media members are not permitted to utilize the elevator or enter the Diamond Club area. Media members can access the press box using the stairs between Section M and N.

PARKING: Media parking will once again be in Lot A, adjacent to the Main Athletics Building off of Gertrude Ford Blvd. When you are approved for single-game credentials, you will also be added to the pass list for Lot A.

**PHOTOGRAPHY/VIDEOGRAPHY:** Still photographers may shoot from the film deck behind home plate or inside the camera wells down both base lines. Photographers are not allowed to shoot from within the dugout area. Any photographer not following the guidelines may have his credentials revoked at any time. Credentials must be clearly and properly displayed at all times. To request a credential, please contact Mitch Praxl in the Ole Miss Athletics Communications office.

**VISITING RADIO:** Please contact the Athletics Communications Office for credentials. The visiting radio booth is behind home plate on the first base side of the plate. Space for a crew of four is allowed for each broadcasting medium. As required by the SEC, Ole Miss provides phone lines for visiting radio.

**POSTGAME MEDIA:** Both team locker rooms are <u>CLOSED</u> to the media following the game, by facility policy. Selected players will be brought to the media down the first base line following a 10-minute cooling off period. Ole Miss head coach Mike Bianco will address the media approximately 10 minutes after the game following player interviews. On some occasions, the selected players and coach may also be requested for radio interviews with the Ole Miss Radio Network or national television, and will meet those obligations for interviews first.



## POSTSEASON REBS

Ole Miss has qualified for the NCAA Division I Baseball Tournament for the 25th time in program history, including the last four tournaments and 18 of 21 full seasons in the Mike Bianco era. The Rebels have claimed 12 regional championships all-time, including three-straight. Ole Miss' NCAA Coral Gables Regional victory was the first time the Rebels have ever won a Regional on the road. Both Rebel Super Regional victories have come on the road.

## **REBS AT COLLEGE WORLD SERIES**

Ole Miss is making its sixth appearance in the College World Series and the second under head coach Mike Bianco. The Rebels' last trip to the CWS came in 2014, where Ole Miss battled out of the loser's bracket to win a pair of games over Texas Tech and TCU before falling to eventual national runner-up Virginia. Prior to the current format, the Rebels made four CWS appearances. In 1956, Ole Miss took its first two games over New Hampshire and Bradley before falling to Minnesota and Arizona to bow out. The Rebs lost its first two CWS games in 1964 to USC and Arizona State and were eliminated, but returned in 1969 falling in the opener to NYU, beating Southern Illinois and being eliminated by Texas. In 1972, Ole Miss was eliminated after losing its first two games, falling to USC and Texas. The Longhorns are the only member of this year's eight-team field to face off against the Rebels at the College World Series. Ole Miss' two wins are tied for the most in a College World Series appearances in school history. The Rebels have never advanced to the CWS Finals.

## THEY LET THE REBS GET HOT

Since the start of the postseason, Ole Miss has been on a tear. The Rebels are the only undefeated team in the NCAA Tournament, outscoring opponents 64-17. The Rebels racked up 22 runs against Arizona to claim the Coral Gables Regional, the most runs scored in a postseason game in program-history. The Rebs then swept No. 10 Southern Miss in Hattiesburg in the Super Regional round, securing Ole Miss' first two shutouts of the season. The Rebels have led wire-to-wire in Omaha, scoring in the first inning of both wins over Auburn and Arkansas.

## **ONE TWO PUNCH**

Starters Dylan DeLucia and Hunter Elliott have been nothing short of sensational during the Rebels' NCAA Tournament run. After a bit of a rocky start against Arizona, DeLucia has allowed just one run over his last 13.2 innings, leading the nation during the postseason with 31 strikeouts while surrendering just 3 walks. Meanwhile, Elliott has been just as steady, posting a 0.96 ERA in three starts striking out 22 to rank fourth in the nation.

### SOPHOMORE SURGE

Josh Mallitz has allowed 0 earned runs in 13-of-16 relief appearances this season, pitching at least one complete inning in 11 of those 13 instances. The Florida native has held Ole Miss' opponents scoreless in each of his last seven outings, totaling 15.2 innings. Mallitz retired all four batters he faced on Saturday, striking out the side in the ninth.

## **CAPTAIN CLUTCH**

Over the last two seasons, Rebel captain Tim Elko has stepped up on the biggest stage, claiming back-toback NCAA Regional MVP honors to lead Ole Miss to Regional Championships.

## **BIG PLAY PEY**

Peyton Chatagnier was in top form during the Coral Gables Regional, pacing the Rebels with 10 runs driven in, while posting a .538 average, five extra base hits and three runs scored. The Texas native's biggest swings came in game one against Arizona, tying the game with a towering two-run blast and notching the winning hit with a bases clearing double.

## THE PEN IS MIGHTIER

The Rebel bullpen has been in top form all tournament long, posting a 0.09 ERA with just two earned runs allowed over 21.1 innings. Arkansas's two-run home run in the ninth on Monday snapped a streak of 24.2 innings without an earned run allowed by the Rebel relievers, dating back to May 21.

## **TEAM USA REBS**

Ole Miss' Jacob Gonzalez and Hunter Elliott have been invited to the 2022 USA Baseball Collegiate National Team, which will be managed by Rebel head coach Mike Bianco. It is the second-straight season that Gonzalez has made the Team USA Roster. The team will compete this summer in North Carolina and The Netherlands.

## **ROOKIE RECOGNITION**

Left hander Hunter Elliott was tabbed to the Collegiate Baseball Newspaper Freshman All-American list. Elliott ranks third in the SEC with a 2.70 ERA, third lowest in the nation among freshmen. The Tupelo, Mississippi, native Also ranks fifth in the SEC in opponent batting average at .206. Elliott has struck out 96 batters on the year, the eighth most in the conference. In league play, the rookie excelled as well, ranking ninth in the SEC in strikeouts (53) and 10th in ERA (3.43).

## ALL-SEC REBS

Ole Miss landed three players on the 2022 All-SEC teams, with Jacob Gonzalez, Tim Elko and Hunter Elliott all honored. Gonzalez was named to the first team as a shortstop, ranking in the top-10 in the SEC in walks, runs and home runs. Elko received his first All-SEC nod with Second Team recognition after recording the third most RBIs in the league during the regular season. Elliott rounded out the honorees with a spot on the Freshman All-SEC team, posting a 3.29 ERA with 74 strikeouts, ranking seventh in the league in both.

## SUPER BASH BROS.

Ole Miss has not one but two of the greatest home run hitters in the history of the program on its roster in seniors Tim Elko and Kevin Graham. With 232 home runs this season, a single-season record at Ole Miss, Elko has racked up 45 in his career, second most in program history and three shy of Kyle Gordon's career record. Not far behind is Graham. who with 11 this season sits at 38 in his career, the fifth most in a Rebel career.

## **REBS DIG THE LONG BALL**

Ole Miss is tied for 16th in the nation and has set a single-season program record with 102 home runs on the year. The Rebels have five double-digit home run hitters in Tim Elko (23), Jacob Gonzalez (17), Peyton Chatagnier (11), Kevin Graham (11) and Kemp Alderman (10) and have had 13 different players go yard. The Rebels have hit back-to-back home runs five times this season, including launching three in a row twice.

## **ANSWERING THE CALL**

Ole Miss had a historic weekend in Baton Rouge, taking all three games at Alex Box Stadium. It was the first-ever sweep in Baton Rouge for the Rebels. Also winning two-of-three games in 2019, Ole Miss has won back-to-back series at LSU for the first time since 1964-65. The Rebels have won five-straight games at Alex Box Stadium.

## ELLO GOV'NA

Ole Miss earned a 5-2 win over Mississippi State at Trustmark Park, regaining control of the Governor's Cup for the first time since 2015.

## FERRISS FINALIST

Senior Tim Elko was one of five finalists for the 2022 Boo Ferriss Trophy, recognizing the best collegiate baseball player in the state of Mississippi, joining Delta State's Harrison Haley, Belhaven's Brett Sanchez, Mississippi State's R.J. Yeager and winner Tanner Hall from Southern Miss.

### GREAT IN A PINCH

After filtering in and out of the starting lineup at the beginning of the year, senior Ben Van Cleve has settled into a role as the Rebels' best option off the bench in a pinch-hitting situation. Van Cleve is batting .300 this season as a pinch hitter, including three doubles.

## PACK SWAYZE

Ole Miss ranked fourth in the nation in both total and average attendance this season. In 31 home games this season, 309,949 total fans packed the stands at Swayze Field, good for an average of 9,998 per game.

### **MISSISSIPPI MADE**

Of the 41 players on the Ole Miss roster, 11 hail from the state of Mississippi. The 11 local products are tied for the most for the Rebels since 2017.

## **TRIPLE THREAT**

Jacob Gonzalez lashed his third triple of the season in the Rebels' Governor's Cup win over Mississippi State at Trustmark Park, becoming the first Rebel with at least three triples in a season since Tate Blackmon legged out four in 2017.

## #MLBREBS

Ole Miss has four former players currently on MLB rosters in Chris Ellis (Baltimore Orioles, injured list), Nick Fortes (Miami Marlins), Lance Lynn (Chicago White Sox) and Drew Pomeranz (San Diego Padres, injured list).

## THE BOYS ARE BACK!

Ole Miss returns nearly the entirety of its potent offense from the 2021 season with eight of nine positional starters returning to the Rebel lineup, Ole Miss is poised once again to put up gawdy numbers on the scoreboard.

It will be the second time donning a Team USA uniform for Bianco, who served as the pitching coach for the Collegiate National Team in 2013. Under Bianco's guidance, the USA posted a 1.87 ERA, a 20-3 record and 222 strikeouts. The remaining 2022 Collegiate National Team staff, as well as more information about the 2022 Collegiate National Team schedule, will be announced at a later date.

# WIKE BANCO Run down

Ole Miss named Mike Bianco head coach of the Rebel baseball program on June 7, 2000. Since then, Bianco has become the winningest coach in program history and one of the top coaches in Southeastern Conference history while establishing Ole Miss as one of the premier programs in college baseball.

In 21 seasons leading the program, Bianco has delivered 17 postseason appearances, including seven Super Regional berths and a trip to the College World Series in 2014. He has racked up 812 victories, holding a 812-462-1 (.637) record. Those wins are the most in Rebel baseball history and rank third all-time among coaches in the SEC. He also stands as the winningest and longestactive coach in the SEC among the sports of baseball, men's basketball and football. The Rebels have reached the 30-win plateau in each of Bianco's 20 full seasons, including nine 40-win campaigns, proving that the Rebels don't rebuild under Bianco—they reload.

The Rebels posted three straight 40-win seasons from 2005-07 for the first time in school history and have hit the program record of 48 wins three times, most recently a 48-17 (.738) season in 2018, which came as the best win percentage by a Rebel team in the past 48 seasons. That 48-win campaign set in motion another trio of 40-win seasons in 2018, 2019 and 2021.

Ole Miss was poised for another 40-win season in 2020, racing out to a 16-1 start before the campaign was cut short due to the spread of COVID-19. The Rebels ended the season on a 16-game win streak—the longest in the nation in 2020 and one short of the program record for consecutive wins. At the conclusion of the shortened season, Bianco became the first Rebel head coach to be named National Coach of the Year, earning the honor from Collegiate Baseball.

To become the all-time winningest coach in Ole Miss history, Bianco passed Rebel legend Jake Gibbs with his 486th win on March 9, 2013, against Lipscomb in nonconference action. On March 6, 2016, he won his 600th game at Ole Miss to become just the ninth coach in SEC history to record at least 600 wins. On May 11, 2018, Bianco became just the fifth coach in history to record 700 wins with an SEC school, as well as earning his 800th career win with a victory over Auburn.

The Rebel skipper added multiple milestones in 2019, including notching his 300th win in SEC play as Ole Miss turned in a dominant 12-4 victory over Florida on April 5. When his Rebels defeated Texas A&M 13-3 on Friday, April 26, Bianco won his 739th game as the head coach in Oxford, moving him to third all-time in SEC history ahead of South Carolina's Ray Tanner.

With a road SEC win at Texas A&M on May 8, 2021, gave Bianco 900 for his career, including 800 in a Rebel uniform to become one of 16 active head coaches with 900 career victories and one of just two in the SEC alongside LSU's Paul Mainieri and Arkansas' Dave Van Horn. The SEC's winningest active coach joined Ron Polk and Skip Bertman as the only coaches in conference history with 800 wins.

The winning tradition has led to a wealth of success in

the nation's strongest baseball conference. Under Bianco, the Rebels have won four SEC Western Division titles, two SEC Tournament titles and one SEC regular-season championship, coming in 2009. Ole Miss captured the SEC Tournament title in 2006 and again in 2018. The Rebels also won the SEC West crown in 2018, becoming just the second in program history to win both a divisional and tournament title in the same season. The Rebels have finished .500 or above in 17 of Bianco's 20 seasons.

## MLB Rebs

The excellence on the field has not gone unnoticed over the past 21 seasons under Bianco. The Rebels have seen 119 Major League Baseball draft picks in that time, including a combined 20 in the past four seasons.

At least three Rebels have been selected in each of the past 17 full seasons of the Bianco Era. Prior to Bianco's arrival, Ole Miss eclipsed four draftees just three times.

In the Bianco Era, Rebel pitchers have accounted for 68 selections in the MLB Draft, including three firstrounders. Drew Pomeranz was selected fifth overall in 2010, becoming the highest-selected Rebel ever, part of a class that featured five Ole Miss pitchers taken in the top 100 picks. Ryan Rolison joined Pomeranz as a first-round selection in 2018 when he was taken 22nd overall by the Colorado Rockies. Gunnar Hoglund became the third Rebel pitcher coached by Bianco selected in the first round, earning the No. 19 pick from the Toronto Blue Jays.

Bianco has also tutored 18 catchers who have gone on to sign professional contracts. In 2018 and 2019, three Rebels were drafted as catchers in the top six rounds. Nick Fortes signed with the Miami Marlins after they chose him in the fourth round in 2018, while Thomas Dillard (5th Round - Milwaukee Brewers) and Cooper Johnson (6th Round - Detroit Tigers) were quickly taken off the board in 2019.

In his 28 years as either an assistant or head coach at Northwestern State, LSU, McNeese State and Ole Miss, Bianco has coached 159 players who have gone on to sign professional contracts. Among those 159 players, 31 have made Major League rosters, including 20 Rebels in the past 21 seasons.

### National Treasure

Bianco's on-field accomplishments have been recognized nationally, as the Rebel skipper was selected to serve as an assistant coach with the USA Baseball Collegiate National Team in the summer of 2013.

Ole Miss has a strong history with Team USA. Ten Rebels have competed internationally for USA Baseball in the Bianco Era. Seth Smith and Stephen Head both competed for the 2003 edition of the Collegiate National Team. Zack Cozart made the national squad in 2006, and Cody Satterwhite and Lance Lynn kept that going in 2007.

Drew Pomeranz became the sixth Rebel to sport the American flag uniform in 2009, followed by Bobby Wahl in 2012 and Dallas Woolfolk in 2017. Parker Caracci carried on the tradition in 2018, earning a spot on the Team USA roster, where he posted a perfect 0.00 ERA with two saves

and opposing batting average of .094 in 9.2 innings of work. Doug Nikhazy made it three straight seasons with a Rebel arm wearing the Stars and Stripes, earning a spot on the 24-man roster for the 2019 summer.

Three Rebels were selected for the 2021 Collegiate National Team: Jacob Gonzalez, Hayden Dunhurst and Derek Diamond. Gonzalez and Dunhurst both represented the Rebels in red, white and blue, though Diamond elected not to join the team in competition.

Bianco will once again don the stars and stripes this coming summer, being selected as the manager for the 2022 USA Collegiate National Team.

### Title Time in Oxford

Not to be content with the success of previous years, Bianco's Rebels used the achievements of 2005 to springboard into the 2006 season.

The Rebels posted a 44-22 record, marking the first time in history that Ole Miss had turned in back-to-back 40-win seasons. Ole Miss also claimed the 2006 SEC Tournament Championship on the way to hosting its thirdconsecutive NCAA Regional as well as a second-straight Super Regional against the Miami Hurricanes.



The Rebels again had two players gain national recognition as Zack Cozart and Cody Satterwhite were named All-Americans and three Rebels gained All-SEC honors. With the conclusion of the 2006 season, Ole Miss found itself holding a spot as one of the top teams in the nation and atop the Southeastern Conference. The Rebels were the only team in the SEC to post a winning record in conference play each of the previous four seasons. Ole Miss also posted more wins in the SEC than any other program over the same time frame.

Ole Miss extended that streak in 2007 as the Rebels posted a fifth-straight winning season in SEC action, remaining the league's winningest program in a five-year span. The Rebels also set a new standard with a third consecutive 40-win season as Ole Miss advanced to the Tempe Super Regional and posted a 40-25 mark on the year. The Rebels became one of only two schools to have hosted an NCAA Regional each of the previous four years and one of only four schools to have advanced to Super Regional play three-straight years.

Several players pulled in honors in 2007 as Ole Miss added a third SEC Freshman of the Year in Jordan Henry and seven Rebels took slots on All-SEC teams. Cozart was named an All-SEC First Team selection, while Henry, Lance Lynn and Cody Satterwhite were named to the second team. Henry also joined Nathan Baker and Zach Miller on the SEC All-Freshman team. The trio also pulled in Freshman All-America honors, marking the first time the Rebels earned the honor for three players in the same season.

The honors continued to come in for the Rebels in 2008 as Ole Miss advanced to a sixth-straight NCAA Regional, playing in Coral Gables at No. 1 Miami. The Rebels advanced to the championship game before falling to the top-ranked Hurricanes. Scott Bittle brought home the program's third Ferriss Award as the state of Mississippi's top collegiate player and also earned First Team All-America honors.

Ole Miss continued to pull in the accolades in 2009 as the Rebels claimed the SEC Regular-Season Championship for the first time since 1977 with a 20-10 record in conference play. The 20 wins set the school record for wins in SEC play and helped Ole Miss secure a seventh straight berth in the NCAA Tournament, hosting for the fifth time in Bianco's nine years. The Rebels advanced to an NCAA Super Regional for the fourth time in five seasons, becoming one of only six schools to advance to at least four Super Regionals in that time.

In 2010, the Rebels made an appearance in the postseason with an eighth consecutive berth, competing in an NCAA Regional at the University of Virginia. With the appearance, Ole Miss became one of only 12 schools nationally to advance to eight straight NCAA Tournaments. Lefthander Drew Pomeranz claimed SEC Pitcher of the Year honors, becoming the first Rebel to claim the award since its inception, and also garnered All-SEC and All-America honors. Right-hander Brett Huber also claimed postseason accolades as he was also named an All-SEC selection and earned Freshman All-America honors. Pomeranz became the highest draft pick in school history when he was taken fifth overall by the Cleveland Indians and led a group of five Rebels drafted in 2010. The left-hander also became the fourth Rebel to claim the Ferriss Trophy, giving Ole Miss more winners of the award than any other program in the state.

In 2011, the Rebels continued to bring in postseason accolades as Alex Yarbrough was named an All-SEC selection. Ole Miss also continued the trend of sending Rebels to the pros with six players selected in the 2011 MLB Draft.

The 2012 season saw the Rebels advance to the NCAA Tournament for the 10th time in the Bianco era as Ole Miss advanced to the championship at the College Station Regional hosted by Texas A&M. The Rebels defeated the eighth-ranked Aggies on the way to the program's sixth regional championship game in an eight-year span, a feat accomplished by only 15 teams nationally at the time. Yarbrough was tabbed as an All-SEC and All-America selection at the conclusion of the season and was one of six Rebels drafted in the 2012 MLB Draft.

Ole Miss made the NCAA Tournament in 2013 with a berth in the Raleigh Regional hosted by N.C. State after a 38win season and advancing to the third day of play at the SEC Tournament. Stuart Turner and Bobby Wahl became All-SEC and All-America honorees, while Turner was named the winner of the Johnny Bench Award as the top collegiate catcher in the nation. Ole Miss also continued the trend of sending players to the professional ranks with five players drafted, marking the 10th consecutive season with at least five players taken in the MLB Draft.

#### Rebels Return to Omaha

The 2014 season will go down as one of the best in Ole Miss history. The Rebels advanced to the College World Series for the fifth time in program history and the first time since the 1972 season.

Ole Miss claimed the SEC Western Division title for the third time under Bianco's leadership, posting a 19-11 record before hosting an NCAA Regional for the sixth time during the head coach's watch. The Rebels blew through the Regional with a win over Jacksonville State and a pair of wins over Washington on the way to a fifth NCAA Super Regional in 10 seasons.

In the NCAA Super Regional, the Rebels traveled to face top-ranked Louisiana-Lafayette and rallied after losing the first game to claim the NCAA Super Regional with wins in game two and three to secure the program's berth in the College World Series.

In Omaha, the Rebels faced No. 1 seed Virginia, falling to the Cavaliers 2-1 in the opening-round game before picking up win a dramatic walk-off win over Texas Tech and a 6-4 victory over TCU in elimination contests to set up another showdown against Virginia with a berth in the CWS Championship Series on the line. Ole Miss fell to the Cavaliers to end the season with a third-place finish, tying the best finish in the CWS by an Ole Miss team with the 1956 Rebels.

#### **Top Recruiter**

Not only have fans and the media covering college baseball noticed Ole Miss' resurgence under Bianco, some of the top talent in the country is also taking a close look at the Rebels.

Sixteen of Bianco's 21 recruiting classes at Ole Miss have garnered top-20 national rankings, including nine that have placed in the top-10. His first recruiting class was rated as one of the nation's 10 best by both Collegiate Baseball and Baseball America, including a No. 6 ranking by Collegiate Baseball.

The 2003 recruiting class was ranked No. 10 by Collegiate Baseball, while the 2011 class was ranked third nationally by Collegiate Baseball and fifth by Baseball America. It marked the first top-5 recruiting class for Bianco at Ole Miss. In the fall of 2016, Rebel Baseball earned the No. 1 ranking in national recruiting rankings by both Baseball America and D1Baseball.com. The top ranking was the first No. 1 recruiting class in the history of not only the baseball program but all of Ole Miss athletics.

Just when that 2016 class cycled through, the Rebels reloaded with another elite class. The 2019 Ole Miss class ranked No. 2 in the nation, highlighted by four prospects who were taken in the MLB Draft but chose instead to play in Oxford. The 2019 group included four of Perfect Game's top 50 prospects—the only class in the country of its kind—and the top-rated incoming freshman, two-sport star Jerrion Ealy.


#### Foundation of Success

Bianco's winning ways can be traced back to his playing days. After spending two seasons at Indian River (Fla.) Community College, he played two seasons for Skip Bertman at perennial national-power LSU in 1988 and 1989. He was the starting catcher and team captain for the Tigers' 1989 team that finished third at the College World Series in Omaha, Nebraska. He homered in LSU's 6-3 win over Miami (Fla.) in the 1989 CWS to help advance the Tigers to the semifinals.

While working behind the plate for LSU, Bianco caught major league pitchers Ben McDonald, Russ Springer, Curtis Leskanic, John O'Donoghue, Chad Ogea and Paul Byrd.

His time behind the plate as a player would later benefit him as he served as LSU's pitching coach during three World Series championship teams in the 1990s. Bianco also worked with the pitchers during his three years as head coach at McNeese State, and continues to serve in that same capacity with the Rebels.
