LSU IN THE SEC TOURNAMENT

• **LSU has a league-best 90-47 (.657) all-time record in the SEC Tournament**, and the Tigers own a conference-high 12 tournament titles ... Alabama and Mississippi State are second behind LSU with seven tournament titles ... LSU has won six of the past 14 SEC Tournament crowns, claiming the title in 2008, 2009, 2010, 2013, 2014 and 2017 ... the Tigers were 38-11 under former coach Paul Mainieri (2007-21) in SEC Tournament games ... LSU had reached the semifinal round in seven straight SEC Tournaments (2013-19) before dropping a first-round, single-elimination game to Georgia in 2021 by a score of 4-1.

SERIES RECORD VS. ARKANSAS

• LSU leads the all-time series with Arkansas, 77-40, and the Tigers have won 14 of the past 18 and eight of the past 11 SEC regular-season series versus the Razorbacks, including a 2-1 series victory earlier this season (March 24-25) in Baton Rouge ... Arkansas had won three straight SEC series versus LSU before the Tigers captured the series this year ... the Tigers are 41-22 against Arkansas over the past 19 seasons (2005-23), including two wins over the Razorbacks in the 2009 College World Series ... LSU has a 11-3 all-time mark versus the Razorbacks in the SEC Tournament; the most recent meeting came in the 2018 tournament semifinal round, a 2-1 LSU victory.

ABOUT THE TIGERS

• LSU right-hander Thatcher Hurd recorded his second-longest outing of the season Wednesday, and leftfielder Brayden Jobert homered to highlight a 12-hit LSU output, as the third-ranked Tigers defeated No. 19 South Carolina, 10-3, in the SEC Tournament at Hoover Metropolitan Stadium ... the win was the 400th career coaching victory for LSU coach Jay Johnson, who is in his 11th season and his second at LSU ... his record is 400-207 in 11 seasons at Point Loma Nazarene, Nevada, Arizona and LSU.

• The Tigers completed the 2023 regular season 42-13 overall and 19-10 in conference play. LSU recorded its most SEC regular-season wins since the 2017 club won 21 SEC games, and the Tigers posted their most overall regular-season wins since the 2015 squad ended the regular season with 46 victories.

• The Tigers, the SEC's No. 4 seed last season, have finished in the Top 4 in the overall SEC standings in back-to-back seasons for the first time since 2014 and 2015. LSU's second-place finish in the SEC Western Division is its best since the Tigers won the Western Division in 2017.

• LSU has reached the 40-win mark in back-to-back years for the first time since the 2016 and 2017 seasons ... LSU finished 40-22 in 2022.

• LSU entered the SEC Tournament at or near the top of several NCAA statistical categories ... the Tigers were No. 1 in the nation in shutouts pitched (9); No. 2 in on-base percentage (.440); No. 3 in hit-by-pitch (119); No. 3 in strikeouts pitched per nine innings (11.6); No. 4 in runs scored (522);

No. 4 in slugging percentage (.568); No. 6 in scoring average (9.5 runs per game); and No. 9 in hits allowed per nine innings (7.70).

- LSU centerfielder **Dylan Crews** entered the SEC Tournament No. 3 in the nation in on-base percentage (.573); No. 2 in runs scored (79); No. 3 in walks (56); and No. 7 in batting average (.423); ... third baseman **Tommy White** was No. 2 in the nation in RBI per game (1.75), and he was No. 2 nationally in total RBI (89).

- Right-hander **Paul Skenes** entered the SEC Tournament No. 1 in the nation in strikeouts (164), strikeouts per nine innings (17.03), WHIP (0.75) and strikeout-to-walk ratio (10.93) ... Skenes was No. 3 in hits allowed per nine innings (5.19) and No. 4 in ERA (1.77) ... second baseman **Gavin Dugas** was No. 3 in the nation in hit-by-pitch (26).

- Entering the SEC Tournament, LSU was **No. 1 in the SEC** in 10 offensive categories – batting average (.310), slugging percentage (.568), on-base percentage (.440), runs (522), hits (569), RBI (478), home runs (115), total bases (1,042), hit-by-pitch (119) and sacrifice flies (32) and plate appearances (2,332).

- LSU junior centerfielder **Dylan Crews** was named **2023 SEC Player of the Year** Monday in a vote of the league's 14 head coaches ... Crews, also voted the 2022 SEC Player of the Year, is only the second player to win the award on two occasions, joining Florida's Matt LaPorta, who was named SEC Player of the Year in 2005 and 2007 ... Crews is the only player to receive the honor in back-to-back seasons.

- **Crews**, a junior from Longwood, Fla., has increased his reached base streak to 60 straight games, which includes all 56 games this season and the final four games of last season.

- Junior right-hander **Paul Skenes** was named **2023 SEC Pitcher of the Year** in a vote of the league's 14 head coaches ... Skenes is LSU's first SEC Pitcher of the Year since Aaron Nola won the award in both 2013 and 2014.

- **Skenes**, a junior from Lake Forest, Calif., leads the SEC in wins (10), strikeouts (164), earned run average (1.77), innings pitched (86.2) and opponent batting average (.161) ... he is ranked No. 2 on LSU's all-time single-season strikeouts list, trailing only Ben McDonald, who recorded 202 strikeouts in 1989.

- **Skenes**, who has allowed two or fewer runs in 11 of his 14 starts this season, was named the SEC Pitcher of the Week three times in 2023 ... he has also received Collegiate Baseball National Player of the Week recognition on seven occasions this season.

- LSU is now the only school with both a two-time SEC Player of the Year (Dylan Crews, 202-23) and a two-time SEC Pitcher of the Year (Aaron Nola, 2013-14).

- Sophomore third baseman **Tommy White** was voted **First-Team All-SEC** Monday in a vote of the league's 14 head coaches ... White has 91 RBI this season, already the fifth-highest single-season total in LSU history ... entering the SEC Tournament, he was No. 2 in the nation in RBI per game (1.75), No. 2 in total RBI and No. 11 in slugging percentage (.793).

- **White** is hitting .391 on the year, and he leads LSU in doubles (22) and home runs (20) ... he entered the SEC Tournament No. 1 in the SEC in RBI, No. 2 in doubles, No. 3 in total bases (161), No. 4 in batting average, No. 4 in slugging percentage, No. 5 in hits (79) and No. 7 in homers.

- First baseman/DH **Jared Jones** was voted to the 2023 Freshman All-SEC Team by the league's 14 head coaches ... he is hitting .307 this season with 11 doubles, 14 home runs and 45 RBI ... Jones is second on the LSU squad in homers, third in RBI and fourth in doubles as a true freshman.

- Junior right-hander **Ty Floyd** posted a career-high 10 strikeouts in the May 13 game versus Mississippi State ... Floyd worked 6.0 innings and limited the Bulldogs to just one run on five hits with one walk and 10 Ks.

- Junior right-hander **Paul Skenes** was named SEC Pitcher of the Week on May 8 after he defeated Auburn on May 5, working a season-high 7.1 innings and allowing no runs on six hits with one walk and a career-high 15 strikeouts ... he became the first LSU pitcher to record 15 strikeouts in a game since Tyler Jones fanned 15 at the University of New Orleans on May 17, 2011 ... Skenes' outing marked the most strikeouts by an LSU pitcher in an SEC game since April 24, 2009, when Anthony Ranaudo fanned 15 against Auburn in Baton Rouge.

- Junior centerfielder **Dylan Crews** saw his 26-game hitting streak end on April 4 in the Tigers' 12-2 win over Nicholls; however, his reached base streak is currently at 60 games (all 56 games of this season plus the last four games of the 2022 season) ... graduate second baseman **Gavin Dugas** enters Thursday's game versus Arkansas riding a 52-game reached base streak.

- The Tigers have recorded **21 come-from-behind wins this season**, including overcoming a five-run deficit on April 29 vs. Alabama ... LSU trailed Alabama, 6-1, entering the bottom of the third inning, and the Tigers rebounded for a 12-8 victory ... LSU has staged comebacks from four-run deficits on four occasions this season – LSU trailed Southern, 4-0, in the bottom of the third inning on Feb. 21 (W, 18-4); the Tigers trailed Texas A&M, 4-0, in the top of the fourth inning on March 18 (W, 12-7); LSU trailed South Carolina, 7-3, in the top of the eighth inning on April 7 (W, 8-7); and LSU trailed Alabama 7-3 in the bottom of the fifth inning on April 30 (W, 13-11).

- Skenes is also **No. 1 in the SEC** in strikeouts (164), opponent batting average (.161), ERA (1.77) and innings pitched (86.2)
- Defeated Mississippi State (May 12), working 7.0 innings and allowing one run three six hits with one walk and 13 strikeouts ... earned Collegiate Baseball **National Player of the Week** recognition for the seventh time this season after the win over Mississippi State
- Named **SEC Pitcher of the Week** and a Collegiate Baseball **National Player of the Week** after posting win at Auburn on May 5, working a season-high 7.1 innings and allowing no runs on six hits with one walk and a career-high 15 strikeouts ... he became the first LSU pitcher to record 15 strikeouts in a game since Tyler Jones fanned 15 at the University of New Orleans on May 17, 2011
- Defeated Alabama on April 28, limiting the Crimson Tide to one run on five hits in 6.0 innings with no walks and nine strikeouts
- Posted win over Ole Miss (April 21), allowing three runs on four hits in 6.0 innings with three walks and 11 strikeouts
- Defeated Kentucky (April 13), allowing four earned runs on seven hits in six innings with one walk and a career-high 13 strikeouts
- Earned Collegiate Baseball **National Player of the Week** recognition on April 3 after he helped lead LSU to a series-opening win over No. 9 Tennessee on March 30 by firing 7.0 innings and allowing just one run on five hits with one walk and 12 strikeouts
- Pitched seven innings in Game 1 of the Arkansas series on March 24, allowing just one run on two hits with three walks and 12 strikeouts ... Skenes received Collegiate Baseball **National Player of the Week** recognition for the fourth time this season on March 27
- Received Collegiate Baseball **National Player of the Week** recognition on March 20 after he defeated No. 11 Texas A&M on March 17, working 6.1 scoreless innings while allowing four hits and recording no walks and 11 strikeouts ... Skenes fired a season-high 106 pitches in the outing to lead LSU to the series-opening victory over the Aggies
- Posted win over Samford on March 10, working six innings and limiting the Bulldogs to one run on two hits with one walk and 12 strikeouts
- Voted **SEC Pitcher of the Week** and a Collegiate Baseball **National Player of the Week** on March 6 after defeating Butler on March 3 in a dominating six-inning outing ... he limited Butler to no runs on one hit with no walks and 13 strikeouts ... his 13 Ks represented the most by an LSU pitcher since March 2, 2018, when Zack Hess recorded 13 strikeouts against Toledo
- Defeated Kansas State on Feb. 24 in the opening game of the Round Rock Classic ... Skenes worked six innings, limiting the Wildcats to one run on two hits with two walks and 11 strikeouts, firing 101 pitches in the outing ... he retired 17 of the final 18 Kansas State hitters that he faced, and he was voted to the Round Rock Classic All-Tournament team
- Named **SEC Pitcher of the Week** and a Collegiate Baseball **National Player of the Week** on Feb. 20 as he worked six shutout frames on Feb. 17 to defeat Western Michigan, allowing just three hits with one walk and 12 strikeouts ... the 12 Ks represented the most by an LSU pitcher since April 15, 2021, when Landon Marceaux recorded 12 strikeouts versus South Carolina ... Skenes' effort also marked the most strikeouts by an LSU pitcher in a season opener since Scott Schultz fanned 12 Lamar batters in 1995 in the Winn-Dixie Showdown at the Louisiana Superdome

At Air Force

Played the 2021 and 2022 seasons at Air Force before transferring to LSU ... earned first-team 2022 and 2021 All-America recognition for the Falcons ... recipient of the 2022 John Olerud Award as the best two-way player in college baseball ... recorded a 2.96 ERA and 96 strikeouts in 85.2 innings (15 starts) in 2022, limiting opponents to a .224 batting average; also batted .314 in 2022 with 10 doubles, 13 homers and 38 RBI ... in 2021, he was voted National Co-Freshman of the Year by Collegiate Baseball, sharing the honor with LSU's Dylan Crews ... Skenes was voted the Mountain West Conference Freshman of the Year in 2021; made 18 relief appearances on the mound and saw action at DH, catcher and first base ... batted .410 in 2021 and finished second in the Mountain West Conference in hits with 77 ... recorded 11 saves on the mound in 2021 and limited opponents to a .208 batting average ... pitched against LSU in Alex Box Stadium during the opening weekend of the 2021 season and posted a save in Air Force's 6-5 win over the Tigers on February 21; he pitched one inning to earn the save, allowing one run on one hit with no walks and two strikeouts.
