## LEADING OFF

The Texas A&M Aggies will have a chance to continue to climb in the SEC standings this weekend when they battle the Arkansas Razorbacks in a 3-game series at Baum-Walker Stadium.

The Aggies have won 4 SEC series in a row and will be in search of their first series win in Fayetteville since 2016 and to win a series in consecutive years over the Hogs for the first time since the Aggies joined the SEC.

## FOLLOW THE ACTION

**TV/STREAMING:** Thursday's series opener is set to be aired nationally on ESPNU with Tom Hart and Chris Burke on the call ... the pair will also have Saturday's series finale on the SEC Network ... Friday's middle game is set to be aired on SEC Network+ with Brett Dolan calling the action with Troy Eklund on analysis.

**RADIO:** The game can be heard locally on SportsRadio 1150 AM/93.7 FM The Zone.... Andrew Monaco will be in the booth bringing the action... the pregame show begins 15 minutes prior to first pitch.

## ON THE RUN

The Aggies have been at their near best when they've been on the bases this season, ranking second in the league with 60 successful stolen bases. But what is more impressive is they've done it in just 71 attempts, and the 84.5-percent successful steals is behind only Mississippi State (57 of 64) as SEC teams with at least 50 steals this year.

## CONSECUTIVE RANKED OPPONENTS ON THE ROAD

The Aggies made it over a difficult hurdle last week when they took the series from No. 13 Kentucky in Lexington, but now they have to hit the road to battle another ranked opponent at No. 7 Arkansas. Since it joined the SEC, Texas A&M has never won series in consecutive weeks on the road against ranked opponents.

## FOUR SEC SERIES IN A ROW

Texas A&M won 8 of its 10 league series a year ago, including each of its final 7 weekends. But such things are a difficult task in the SEC and the Aggies' series win at Kentucky was their fourth straight after dropping its first 2. It is the first time since the 2016 and 2017 seasons the Aggies have had consecutive seasons with a streak of at least 4 consecutive series wins in SEC play. The 9-9 record in the SEC is only 1 game off the pace of the 2022 squad who was 10-8 at the through 6 series.

# 12 TAKEAWAYS FOR THE AGGIES IN 2023

- 1 - The Aggies have drawn 265 bases on balls in 2023, ranking fourth in the nation. That mark is the most freebies in the SEC.
- 2 - The Aggies have 3 walk-off wins this year: 2/26 vs Portland (LaViolette double), 3/21 vs Rice (Bost HBP) and 4/2 vs Ole Miss (Targac HR)
- 3 - Jace LaViolette leads the Aggies in 3 categories as a true freshman: home runs (10), RBI (41) and stolen bases (12)
- 4 - Thanks in large part to losing Brett Minnich to injury on his first at-bat of the season, Texas A&M did not start its Opening Day 9 players again until April 1
- 5 - Nathan Dettmer is the first Aggie pitcher to get consecutive Opening Day starts on the mound since Khalid Balouli in 2001 and 2002
- 6 - A&M was the last team in Division I baseball to lay down a sac bunt in 2023
- 7 - The Aggies are 16-0 when leaving after the 7th inning
- 8 - The Aggies' 8-game win streak earlier in the year was the longest since A&M won 11 in a row early in 2011; the Aggies' longest win streak in the 2022 regular season was 4 games
- 9 - The Aggies scored a season-high 10 runs in the fourth inning vs Prairie View
- 10 - **BALL 5 COUNTER** - The season high counter for 2023 is currently held by HCU's Tim Ewald, who had Aggie fans at **BALL 10** on 2/28
- 11 - The attendance of 6,719 on Opening Night was highest since 2017 the third highest Opening Night crowd at Blue Bell Park since it was renovated in 2012
- 12 - The Aggies are 23 of 27 in attempts of swiping third base in 2023

## WANSING GIVES AGGIES SOLID START

The Aggies have been in search of quality starts since the beginning of SEC play and finally got one from left-hander Troy Wansing in Game 2 of the series at Kentucky. The Purdue transfer went 6.0 innings and left with the lead against the No. 13 Wildcats in what was his first weekend start since Week 2 at Tennessee. It was the longest outing by a starting pitcher since Nathan Dettmer logged 6.0 innings against LSU in the league opener on March 17.

## SAVING THE BEST FOR THE BLUEGRASS

Texas A&M had to dig deep to pick up the doubleheader sweep on Saturday at Kentucky and closer Will Johnston played a big role in that. The lefty picked up the save in each game of the twinbill, throwing just 25 total pitches for the day. He struck out three of the four hitters he faced on just 14 pitches in a 1.1-inning save in Game 1 and followed that by working around a leadoff single in the ninth of Game 2 and punching out two of the final three hitters to end an 8-7 Aggie win. They were Johnston's third and fourth saves of the season and marked the first time the Aggies have converted saves on each end of a doubleheader since Andrew Vinson and Mark Ecker had saves in a twinbill sweep of the Wildcats in 2015.

## GOLDEN BOY

Aggie shortstop Hunter Haas got a nod of approval from USA Baseball when he was named as one of 45 players in the country to the Golden Spikes Award Midseason Watch List. He earned another honor earlier last week when he was one of 101 players named to the initial Brooks Wallace Award watch list, honoring the top shortstop in the country. Haas enters the week ranked second to teammate Jack Moss for the team lead in batting average (.354) and on-base percentage (.454) and has been error free in 38 of 40 games played in the field.

## LAVIOLETTE NOT LOOKING LIKE A FRESHMAN

Aggie outfielder Jace LaViolette earned SEC Freshman of the Week honors after his big series at Auburn, and has continued his strong play within the SEC since. He hit his ninth and tenth home runs of the season against the Tigers and ran his RBI total to the year to 38. He leads the Aggies with 10 home runs and 41 RBI, along with 11 stolen bases. Each total is the most by an Aggie freshman since Braden Shewmake led the team in each category in his 2017 breakout campaign. John Byington holds the Aggie freshman record for home runs (17) and RBI (78), set during the 1987 season.

## RPI WATCH

With the season approximately two-thirds of the way through, the postseason picture is slowly coming into focus, and that means RPI will be coming into play for many teams in search of a bid to an NCAA regional. That includes the Aggies who used 2 wins at Kentucky (No. 1 RPI) to move up 14 spots to be ranked at 30 in the RPI through games played on April 26. Here's a look at where each of the remaining Aggie opponents are in the RPI:

## WERNER HEATING UP

A big piece of Texas A&M winning its last 4 league series has been third baseman Trevor Werner who goes into the weekend already with a career high of 8 home runs after his first career multi-home run game in the series finale against Missouri. He has hit safely in 10 of his last 14 outings overall, including 5 multi-hit games. In the Aggies' series wins over Ole Miss, Auburn, Missouri and Kentucky, Werner is hitting .313 and slugging at an .708 clip with 15 RBI, 5 home runs, 3 doubles and 12 runs scored.

## P.S., THIS IS AUSTIN

If you didn't know better, it would be easy to look past Austin Bost in the Aggie lineup if you base it on 2023 numbers only. But SEC teams know better and the senior was on his game last weekend at Kentucky, reaching base in 7 of his 14 plate appearances. That included a key 3-for-5 outing in Game 2 highlighted by a go-ahead, 2-run double with two outs in the top of the ninth. It was his first multi-hit game since April 1 vs Ole Miss and marked the third time this season the Aggies have erased a ninth-inning deficit to walk away as victors.

## HALFWAY HOME

When Ryan Targac walked off Ole Miss in the finale at Blue Bell Park to clinch the series for the Aggies, it also got Texas A&M to the halfway point of the 2023 regular season. The second half of the season was very good for the Aggies in 2022, going 18-10 in the final 28 games of the regular season. They would reach the finish line in Omaha, winning 27 of their final 40 games overall.
