- · TCU is set to make its second appearance in the College Baseball Showdown at Globe Life Field.
- · The Horned Frogs took part in the inaugural tournament back in 2021.
- TCU went 1-2 with a win over Mississippi State, while dropping contests to Ole Miss and Arkansas.

#### **TOURNAMENT NOTABLES**

- · TCU is playing in a season-opening tournament for the sixth time in program history.
- · Twice TCU has opened the season at Minute Maid Park in Houston (2002, 2006).
- · TCU also played in the inaugural MLB4 tournament (2019) and made a return trip in 2022.
- · The Frogs took part in the inaugural State Farm College Showdown (2021).
- · TCU is a combined 8-7 in those games.

#### **SERIES NOTABLES**

- · TCU and Vanderbilt will be meeting for the seventh
- · Vanderbilt holds a 4-2 series advantage.
- All previous six meetings have come at neutral sites.
- · Vanderbilt walked-off with a win in the last meeting, taking a 4-3 win at the MLB4 Tournament in 2020.
- TCU and Arkansas are meeting for the 71st time.
- Arkansas leads the series 47-23.
- The last time TCU and Arkansas met was in the 2019 Fayetteville Regional with the Razorbacks winning both meetings (3-1 and 6-0)
- · TCU and Missouri are meeting for the 12th time.
- · TCU leads the series 7-4.
- · TCU and Missouri last met in 2010 at the Houston College Classic. The Frogs were victorious by a 4-3 win in 10 innings.

#### TCU NOTABLES

- · TCU was picked to finish first in the Big 12 preseason poll, garnering five first place votes.
- TCU is ranked nationally in the preseason for the 14th consecutive season.
- TCU is opening the season in a tournament for the fourth time in the last five years (MLB4 in 2019, 2022, State Farm College Baseball Showdown in 2021).
- The Frogs are ranked in all six major polls. The Horned Frogs come in as high as No. 14 and as low as No. 17.
- TCU's recruiting class, which features 20 newcomers, was ranked sixth nationally.
- TCU welcomed five players via the transfer portal (Austin Davis, WVU; Hunter Hodges, UNC Wilmington; Tre Richardson, Baylor; Sam Stoutenborough, Cal; Ryan Vanderhei, Kansas).
- Brayden Taylor was voted the Big 12 Preseason Player of the Year and is a Preseason All-American.
- Anthony Silva was voted the Big 12 Preseason Freshman of the Year.
- Kurtis Byrne (13), Taylor (15) and Elijah Nunez (18) enter the season with significant reached base streaks.
- Taylor homered in the final three games of the 2022 campaign.

- Since Kirk Saarloos' arrival on campus, TCU is 59-33 (.641) in neutral site contests.



#### REPEAT OFFENDERS

In just his first season at the helm, Kirk Saarloos guided TCU to the Big 12 regular season championship and earned Big 12 Coach of the Year honors.

Saarloos is the first-ever first-year head coach in the Big 12 to take home Coach of the Year accolades. Additionally, TCU was the first team to defend its Big 12 regular season since the 2016-17 season.

#### TROPHY TOWN

With four regular season crowns and three tournament trophies, TCU's seven Big 12 championships are the most of any program in the league since the Horned Frogs joined in 2013.

Even more impressive, the Frogs, with four titles since 2015, now have the second-most regular season trophies of any Big 12 program.

#### **NEW MAN IN TOWN**

For the first time since the 2014 season, a new face will be calling the offensive action. The departure of Bill Mosiello to Ohio State as the head coach brought the arrival of T.J. Bruce. He comes to TCU after seven years as the head coach at Nevada.

DlBaseball ranked Bruce as the No. 3 top assistant coach hire this past offseason. As head coach, he put together a 171-168 record. The Wolfpack made one NCAA Tournament appearance. Bruce had assistant coach stops at Long Beach State, Cerritos College and UCLA. In 11 years as an assistant, his teams produced a 387-243-1 record. He made seven NCAA Tournament appearances and two College World Series appearances. In 2013, his UCLA squad won the National Championship.

#### PRESEASON RESPECT

The last 19 seasons have seen the Horned Frogs gradually imprint themselves on the national scene. No stranger to the rankings, the Frogs find themselves in the preseason polls for the 14th consecutive season.

Brayden Taylor has been tabbed preseason All-American by Baseball America (1st-team), DlBaseball (1st-team), Perfect Game (2nd-team) and the NCBWA (3rd-team).

#### WINS UPON WINS UPON WINS

Since Saarloos arrived on campus, TCU has produced 384 wins and owns a .633 wining percentage. The 384 wins rank seventh nationally and are the most in the state of Texas.

TCU has been victorious in 86 of 125 series played and tallied 42 series sweeps. TCU's 2,372 program victories in 125 years of existence rank 41st all-time. The Frogs are 2,372-1,746 (.576) all-time.

#### **INSIDE THE ROSTER**

TCU returns nine players on offense and seven members of the pitching staff. Additionally, TCU's incoming class, which was ranked ninth nationally, features 12 newcomers on the mound and eight in the field.

Broken down, D1Baseball ranked the incoming transfer class No. 8 and the freshmen class No. 6.

The transfer class featured five Division I Power-5 transfers (Davis, Hodges, Richardson, Stoutenborough and Vanderhei). The two junior college transfers started their collegiate careers at Division I institutes. Calvin Marley started his career at Wichita State, while Cole Fontenelle spent his freshman season at Washington.

#### **SPEED FACTOR**

TCU continues to be one of the most prolific base-stealing teams in the nation. The Frogs ranked third in the Big 12 and 23rd nationally with 101 stolen bases in 2022. The 101 stolen bases are tied for the seventh-most all-time in program history. Four Horned Frogs reached double-digit steals

The Frogs are one of just 11 teams to have stolen at least 850 bases over the last 10 years. The 861 stolen bases rank 11th in the nation and third among Power 5 teams.

It's not just raw numbers that are impressive, the Horned Frogs have produced a high success rate, converting on 79% of their attempts over the last eight years (861-of-1091). No base is safe with the Frogs around. Over the last 10 seasons, TCU is 148-of-182 (81%) in stealing third.

#### STINGY STAFF

The Frogs' 3.40 ERA since 2013 is fifth nationally. TCU led the nation with a 2.22 ERA in 2014 and ranked second in 2015 with a 2.45 ERA. Additionally, the TCU pitching staff has pitched the ninth-most shutouts (55) nationally over the last eight years.

TCU has limited opponents to two or fewer runs 233 times in the 577 games played since Saarloos' arrival on campus. The staff has surrendered 5+ runs just 212 times in those contests.

#### THE K-ZONE

Since Kirk Saarloos' arrival on campus, the Horned Frogs have boasted one of the top pitching staffs year in and year out. In five of the last 10 years, TCU has ranked in the top 25 in strikeouts per nine inning and four times it has been in the top ten in K:BB ratio. Twice, the Horned Frogs have ranked second nationally in K:BB ratio (2014, 2015).

The Frogs set a school and Big 12 record in 2017 with 643 strikeouts. Over the last eight years, TCU has a 3.1 K:BB ratio and is averaging 9.0 strikeouts per nine.

Since the start of the 2013 season, TCU has registered 10 or more strikeouts in a game 234 times, including a school-record 30 times in 2017.

#### EXTRA, EXTRA

TCU has played 39 extra inning games since Kirk Saarloos arrived in 2013 and holds a 22-17 mark in those games.

TCU's five game losing streak in extra-inning games dating back to the 2019 campaign (0-3, 2021; 0-1, 2020 and 1-1, 2019) was snapped with a 6-5 win in 10 innings over Army on March 12.

The Frogs longest extra inning game was 22 innings in the 2014 NCAA Regional against Sam Houston State.
