


- The University of Michigan baseball team (2-2) sets its sights on Globe Life Field in Arlington, Texas, for three games in the Kubota College Baseball Series, from Friday through Sunday (Feb. 23-25). U-M will open the weekend with Oklahoma State on Friday (Feb. 23) at 3 p.m. CST, followed by No. 7 Oregon State on Saturday (Feb. 24) and No. 2 Arkansas on Sunday (Feb. 25) at 1 p.m. CST.
- Michigan returns 12 players from last year's team led by Freshman All-American and two-way player Mitch Voit and the team's leader in average Jonathan Kim. Jacob Denner leads the pitching staff and is one of three pitchers in college baseball with a complete game this season. Joining the 12 returners are 26 newcomers (19 freshman, seven transfers).
- Two transfers earned All-League status with outfielder Stephen Hrustich earned Third Team All-Big Ten and Mack Timbrook earned Second Team All-MAC.
- Michigan leads the nation in double plays turned with eight with Friday opponent Oklahoma State tied for third. U-M also had a strong offensive weekend, ranking in the top 10 nationally in three offensive categories, ranking sixth in hit-by-pitches (11), eighth in sacrifice bunts (fourth) and tenth in hits (43).





PLAYER & TEAM NOTES

Wolverines Earn Split Against Western To Open Season U-M split the opening weekend against Western Michigan losing two offensive slug fests to open the weekend before some strong pitching helped the Wolverines earn the series split. The series' first two games saw a combined 47 runs and 21 innings of baseball as U-M fell 14-13 and 11-9. Jacob Denner took the ball on Saturday for game two and pitched a 7-inning complete game with five strikeouts for a 9-4 win. On Sunday, Chase Allen held the Broncos scoreless for five innings and Ricky Kidd closed the door with four strong innings as well as Michigan won 6-2.

Strong Defense and Offense to Start the Season

Michigan leads the nation in double plays with eight with Gonzaga in second with seven and five teams tied for third with 6 including Friday's opponent Oklahoma State. U-M also had a strong offensive weekend. The Wolverines rank first in the conference in hits, on-base percentage and hit by pitches and second in five categories including runs scoring 37. The Wolverines are in the top ten nationally in three offensive categories ranking sixth in hit-by-pitches (11), eighth in sacrifice bunts (4) and tenth in hits (43).

Ten Freshman Make Collegiate Debuts

Ten freshmen made their collegiate debuts with Collin Priest and Brock Leitgeb leading the way. Priest leads the team in average at .667 with one home run and five RBI. In addition to his four hits, he also had two walks and two hit-by-pitches for an .800 on-base percentage. Leitgeb started the final two games of the series at catcher and is 2-for-8 with three RBIs. On the mound, Dylan Vigue earned the opening-day start and gave up just two earned runs in 4.1 innings and struck out two. The other freshman to make debuts were AJ Garcia, Jack Counsell, Noah Miller, Bradley Navarro, and Wyatt Novara and Alfredo Velazquez.

Priest Leads Team To Open Season

Priest made appearances in just three of the four games this week, but started the last two. He leads the Big Ten in batting average (.667), on-base percentage (.800) and slugging percentage (1.333) and is top-25 nationally in all three categories, including sixth in onbase percentage. Priest also ranks seventh in the conference tied with Kim in RBI (five).

Kim Off To Strong Start in Sophomore Season

After a very successful first season with the Wolverines, Jonathan Kim has picked up where he left off in his sophomore season. He is currently second on the team with a .529 batting average. Dating back to last season, Kim is on a 6 game hitting streak and 11 game on-base streak. Kim is first in the conference and seventh nationally in hits with 9 and fourth in the Big Ten in onbase percentage. He also has 13 total bases, putting him fourth in the conference and top 50 nationally. Last season, he led the team in batting average at .322, contributing three home runs, 28 RBIs, and 11 multi-hit games as well. He played in 44 games throughout the season, starting in 39 of them. Kim was also an All-Big Ten Freshman Team Selection and an All-Big Ten Third Team Member.

Denner Puts Wolverines Back on Track in Opening Weekend

Using his COVID year, Jacob Denner calmed down the staff after a shaky start to the weekend. Denner pitched a seven-inning complete game on Saturday and is one of just three collegiate pitchers with a complete game. In the game, Denner struck out five batters and allowed four runs. With his first strikeout of the game Denner managed 200 career strikeouts and became the 14th Wolverine to reach that threshold. Last season Denner was a reliable pitcher and struck out 75 batters in 71 innings pitched. He currently leads the team in 4+ strikeout games with 20 throughout his career. Near the end of the 2023 season, Denner earned Big Ten Pitcher of

the Week honors after a win against Minnesota where he allowed just one run, only seven base runners, while striking out seven others. Denner also earned Academic All-Big Ten Honors in 2021 and 2023.

Two Way Voit Returns After Strong First Season

This season, Mitch Voit is hitting .263 with five hits and three doubles. The doubles rank third in the conference and 12th nationally. He also has three runs, two RBI and a .421 slugging percentage this season. He returns after an outstanding freshman year performance behind the plate and on the mound. He hit .267 with seven home runs while leading the in ERA at 3.25, had a WHIP of 1.19, struck out 25 batters over 36 innings. Voit also earned many awards in his first year, such as two Big Ten Freshman of the Week, All-Big Ten Tournament Team at Utility, All-Big Ten Freshman Team at 3B and RP, Second Team Baseball America Freshman Team, Second Team D1 Baseball Freshman Team, and Collegiate Baseball Freshman Team. He also participated in the 2023 USA Baseball Training Camp.

Pace Jr. Showed Flashes in Freshman Season

Greg Pace Jr. is currently third on the team in batting average at .308 with four hits and four runs. He also made his debut on the mound in opening weekend and pitched 1.2 innings. Last season, he appeared in 49 games, starting in 22 of them. Pace's best week came a couple games into the season when he earned Big Ten Freshman of the Week honors after recording two hits with three runs, three RBIs and a stolen base in two wins over Cal State Fullerton.

Allen Returns to Mound After Injury Ended Third Season

After an injury ended Chase Allen's junior season he appeared twice in opening weekend. His first start was rocky, but was able to dust off the cobwebs and pitched five scoreless innings on Sunday for the win. In the past two seasons, Allen recorded 106 strikeouts, pitched 128.1 innings, and has thrown many scoreless innings over the course of his career. He is second on the team in 4+ strikeout games, with 11 from the past two seasons. Last year, Allen received Academic All-Big Ten Honors and a Big Ten Distinguished Scholar award for his academic success.

Junior Caruso Strong First Weekend For Wolverines

Cole Caruso is third on the batting average hitting .400 on the season with a .500 on-base percentage. He also leads the team in runs with six and which is good for third in the conference and 40th nationally. Caruso is a junior who transferred from University of South Carolina Upstate. He had an incredible sophomore season with the Spartans where he started in all 60 games, hit .319 on the season, had .424 on-base percentage, and had 23 multiple hit games. He was named to the Big South Conference honorable mention team at the end of the season.

Timbrook Shows Talent on Opening Day

Mack Timbrook joined the program from Kent State and showed his potential on opening day going 3-for-6 with two runs and a walk. Timbrook added two more runs through the weekend and drew four more walks while playing at second base in all four games. He saw lots of action in his junior and senior year, playing in every game and starting in all but two games each season for the Golden Flashes. In the 2023 season, Timbrook recorded 15 multi-hit games, had a .301 batting average, hit six home runs, and was Second Team All-MAC. In 2022, he recorded 16 multi-hit games and a batting average of .317.

<u>Dernedde Brings NCAA Postseason Experience to Lineup</u>

Kyle Dernedde transferred from Oregon State and will face off against his old team this weekend. Derneddehad a strong debut going 5-for-17 over the weekend with four runs. Dernedde was also part of five double

Will Rogers Reunites with Tracy Smith

Recruited out of high school, Will Rogers was a Top 15 catcher and chose ASU and Coach Smith. Rogers now reunites with Smith after he played his first two seasons with Arizona State. He started out strong in his freshman year as he recorded a .299 batting average, nine home runs, and 16 multi-hit games. As a sophomore, he made contributions to the team as a hitter and pitcher. Rogers made seven relief appearances and recorded five strikeouts along with three multi-hit games and three home runs. This season Rogers has a .357 on-base percentage with two runs and made an appearance on the mound.

Denner Closing On Top 10 in Two Career Categories With his start on Saturday, Jacob Denner is tied with Will Tribucher for tenth all-time with 67 career appearances. Changes in Coaches for 2024 Season

After a whole new staff last season, some more changes came in the offseason this year. Associate Head Coach Ben Greenspan left his role and took the head coaching job at Northwestern. Replacing Greenspan is Jake Valentine. Valentine comes from Washington State where he helped the Cougars to their best record since 2015 and first ranking since 2010. Before WSU, he spent time at Portland, Santa Clara, UC Riverside and started his career at Stephen F. Austin. He played at Hawai'i Pacific and Tacoma Community College.

Josh Phegley served as the team's Director of Player Development in 2023 after time in the Majors and playing for Coach Smith at Indiana. Phegley now joins the coaching staff as an assistant coach as Tyler Graham moves to the support staff as the team's director of hitting development.

Two student assistant coaches join the coaching staff this season. Zach Putnam played seven seasons in the MLB and was drafted in the 5th round of the 2008 Draft. Putnam is back to Ann Arbor to finish his degree after he played here for three seasons and earned All-American honors all three seasons. He earned Freshman-All American honors his first season in the Maize and Blue and then Second Team All-American honors in his sophomore and junior seasons. Joining Putnam is Jack Van Remortel who is earning a certificate in real state after four seasons in Ann Arbor and one at Umpqua Community College. Van Remortel played in 106 games for the Wolverines with his career highlight coming against Central Michigan with a walk-off home run.

First Season Under Tracy Smith Recap

In the first season under new Head Coach Tracy Smith, U-M finished 28-28 (13-11 Big Ten) and reached the Big Ten Tournament Semifinal. Connor O'Halloran won the Big Ten Pitcher of the Year with a 4.11 ERA with 110 strikeouts in 103 innings. Three other Wolverines earned All-Big Ten Honors with Ted Burton and Jonathan Kim named to the third team while Mitch Voit earned two spots on the Freshman Team.

Kim led the team in batting average with his season highlighted by a 5-for-5 performance against Illinois. Jacob Denner earned a Big Ten Pitcher of the Week performance after a complete game victory against Minnesota. Denner pitched nine innings of one run ball with seven strikeouts. Voit led the team in ERA and was second in home runs.

Voit Named To Bobby Bragan Slugger Shortlist

Sophomore first baseman Mitch Voit was one of 52 players named to the Bobby Bragan National Collegiate Slugger Award List. The award honors the most outstanding offensive baseball player in the country based on athletic performance, personal integrity and academic excellence. Voit earned three Freshman All-America honors and was named th to Big Ten All-Freshman Team last season after hitting seven home runs. He is the first Wolverine to be chosen for the honor since the award expanded nationally in 2020. Voit is one of 16 sophomores on the list and joins Jack Frank (Michigan State), Devin Taylor (Indiana) and Brock Tibbitts (Indiana) as representatives from the Big Ten.

Perfect Game Preseason All-Conference Honors

Three Wolverines earned Perfect Game Preseason All-Conference team. Mitch Voit and Collin Priest earned spots on the Preseason Team with Voit earning the nod at First Base and Priest earned the Utility position spot. Freshman Dylan Vigue was named Preseason Big Ten Freshman of the Year.

D1 Baseball Preseason Conference Preview

Michigan was picked to finish sixth in the conference. Will Rogers was our lone representative on the 2024 Draft Conference Prospects list and ranks 23rd. Three players were named to the 2025 Draft Conference Prospects List with Mitch Voit ranking second behind Indiana's Devin Taylor. Jonathan Kim cracked the top ten and ranks eighth on the list. Greg Pace is just outside the Top ten and is 12th on the list. Three freshman were also named in D1 Baseball's list. Dylan Vigue ranks the highest at three while Collin Priest is just outside the top five at 6. Keegan O'Hearn made the list as well and ranks 23rd.

D1 Baseball Preseason Player Rankings

Two U-M players are ranked in the Preseason player rankings for D1 Baseball. Freshman Dylan Vigue was named as the 121st top starting pitcher and was just one of five freshman to make the list. Junior transfer Cole Caruso also a list of the top 50 third baseman and was ranked 37th on the list.

Four Two-Way Players To Make Impact This Season

Mitch Voit, Greg Pace Jr., Will Rogers and Alfredo Velazquez all made appearances on both sides this weekend. Voit was a Freshman All-American last season and made the Big Ten Freshman Team last year as a third baseman and relief pitcher. Voit started three out of four games at first base with the other start coming on the mound. Pace Jr. appeared in all four games with three starts in right field, a relief appearance on the mound and a defensive substitution in left field. Rogers started one game at catcher, one in right field and made an relief appearance on the mound. Velazquez appeared in two games with two at-bats and 1.1 innings so far.

Two-Sport Mann Back to Mound after National Championship

Brandon Mann rejoins the Baseball team after he spent the fall with the National Championship winning Football team. He did not see game action in his sophomore season but traveled with the team throughout the season and played in 2022 completing one pass to letter in football. Mann pitched 17 innings last season and made his first career start in the Big Ten Tournament against lowa.

Jack Counsell, Son of Craig Counsell, Joins Wolverines

Joining the Wolverines this season as a freshman is Jack Counsell. He is the son of current Chicago Cubs manager Craig Counsell who was the manager of the Brewers from 2015-2023 after a 16 year MLB career. Jack Counsell made his collegiate debut as a pinch hitter on opening day. He also has a brother who plays on Minnesota.

Michigan Returns 13 for 2024 Season

After a 28-28 season and a Big Ten Tournament semifinal appearance, 13 players return under Tracy Smith's second season. On the pitching staff Jacob Denner and Chase Allen highlight the returners. After a strong summer in the Northwoods League, Eamon Horwedel looks to make an impact from the pen. Sophomore's Kurt Barr and Brandon Mann also are back. Three senior batters return for their final season highlighted by Dylan Stanton who went 4-for-5 in a Big Ten Tournament win over Indiana. Seniors Trevor Kilinski and Ian Kennedy also are back. Junior Joe Longo is the Ione junior who started at U-M and played in 42 games last season with five home runs. The Wolverines also return three strong Sophomore bats with Mitch Voit, Jonathan Kim and Greg Pace Jr.

Smith Adds Seven Transfers To 2024 Roster

Joining the 12 returners are seven transfers from the MAC, Big Ten, Pac-12 A-SUN, and MCCAA. From the MAC, Mack Timbrook joins from Kent State as a All-MAC Second Team member. Two players join from fellow Big Ten Schools with All-Big Ten Third-Team member Stephen Hrustich and Hungarian International and former Indiana player Alex Ogg. Ogg was recruited by Coach Smith to Arizona State along with Will Rogers. Rogers joins the team after two years with the Sun Devils and is joined by fellow Pac-12 member Kyle Dernedde. Cole Caruso also joins the team from USC Upstate in the A-Sun and looks to be a strong third baseman this season. Our last transfer comes from Henry Ford Community College in Ricky Kidd who had 90 strikeouts last season with a 3.19 ERA.

Momentum Shifts Throughout Second Game of Season as Broncos win in Ten

Western Michigan got out to a 7-0 lead after two innings before U-M got on the board with a Jonathan Kim single that scored Mack Timbrook. A big fifth inning put U-M down just one with two bases loaded walks, a sacrifice fly from Mitch Voit and a Joe Longo single gave the Wolverines a five run inning. The Broncos scored again in the top of the fifth, but U-M tied it in the bottom of the inning with a Will Rogers double which scored Kyle Dernedde and Greg Pace Jr. scored as Stephen Hrustich reached on an error. Head Coach Tracy Smith 2nd Year Miami (Ohio) '89 Career W-L: 835-644-1 Michigan W-L: 30-32



Tracy Smith enters his second year as head coach for the Wolverines. Smith led the Wolverines to a 28-28 record in his first season and finished 4th in the Big Ten Tournament. Four Wolverines earned selections to All-Big Ten teams, including Pitcher of the Year Connor O'Halloran. Smith also worked with Mitch Voit who collected multiple Freshman All-American honors.

Smith comes to Ann Arbor with 25 years of head coaching experience and 805 victories while producing 90 MLB Draft picks, including seven first-rounders and seven USA Baseball Collegiate National Team selections. One of just eight coaches all-time to bring three different Division I schools to the NCAA Tournament, Smith most recently led the Arizona State University baseball program between 2015-21 and advanced the Sun Devils to four NCAA Regional appearances in six seasons.

Smith earned National Coach of the Year and Big Ten Coach of the Year honors in 2013 after leading Indiana to the school's only Men's College World Series appearance in a 49-win campaign. The Hoosiers followed that performance with 44 victories in 2014 before Smith moved west to ASU. Before his time at Indiana, Smith led his alma mater, Miami University (Ohio), for nine seasons.

At Arizona State, Smith signed the nation's top recruiting class in 2016, including eight players drafted by the Major League out of high school. His 2017 class was also rated in the Top-5 nationally and was the No. 1 class in the West region.

Among the 90 MLB Draft selections developed under Smith, a staggering 58 of them have come over his past eight seasons, including the No.1 overall pick of the 2020 MLB Draft, Spencer Torkelson, two first-rounders in 2019 and 2020 (Hunter Bishop and Alika Williams, respectively), and the fourth overall pick in 2014 in Kyle Schwarber. In addition, three other first-round selections played under Smith's tutelage in 2009 in Eric Arnett, Josh Phegley, and Matt Bashore.

Torkelson, already playing with the Tigers, was a two-time Golden Spikes Award semifinalist, given annually to the top player in college baseball. He was a unanimous All-America selection as both a freshman and sophomore and became the first Pac-12 player in history to be crowned the league home run champion in three consecutive seasons.

Despite the 2020 MLB Draft being shortened to five rounds from 40 due to the fallout from COVID-19, the Sun Devils made history as ASU's five draft selections through the first four rounds marked a program record. The five selections in the 2020 MLB Draft were the most of any program. In addition, it was ASU's third consecutive season with five draft picks and the fourth season in the last five years with the total.

In guiding Indiana to consecutive 40-win seasons in his final two campaigns in Bloomington, Smith secured back-to-back Big Ten championships for the first time in school history. The Hoosier's title in 2013 was the school's first since 1949 and its first outright title since 1932 en route to the No. 4 national seed, the first national seed in Big Ten history.

Smith mentored two Big Ten Players of the Year, three Big Ten Pitchers of the Year, and a pair of Big Ten Freshman of the Year in his time at Indiana.

In nine years at Miami (Ohio), Smith compiled eight consecutive 30-win seasons, two NCAA Regional appearances, and advanced to the Mid-American Conference Tournament finals six times.

He began his coaching career as head coach at Miami University-Middletown in 1990, served as an assistant coach at Miami (Ohio) from 1993-94, and was the pitching coach at Indiana from 1995-96.

Smith was a four-year letterwinner as a pitcher and infielder at Miami (Ohio) before playing three seasons in the Chicago Cubs organization.

Smith graduated from Miami (Ohio) in 1989 with a bachelor's degree in education before completing a master's degree in sport organization from the school in 1992.

A native of Kentland, Indiana, Smith and his wife, Jaime, have three sons, Casey, Ty, and Jack.
