### **STARTING 9**

- The Missouri State Bears (18-24, 7-11 Missouri Valley Conference) wrap up a nine-game road swing with a midweek series at No. 2 Arkansas (37-7, 16-5 SEC). Game times in Fayetteville are 6:30 p.m. Tuesday and 4 p.m. Wednesday. The Bears have beaten the Razorbacks in each of the last two seasons, and Arkansas' No. 2 ranking makes them the highest-ranked team the Bears have played since No. 1 Rice in the 2003 CWS.
- The Bears have homered in 34 of 42 games this season and 96 of the last 116, including streaks of 29 and 21 games, and rank 13th nationally with 278 long balls since the beginning of the 2022 season. The Bears lead the MVC and rank 18th nationally with 79 homers this year, which ties the No. 10 season total in school history. Zack Stewart (18 1st), Caden Bogenpohl (14 3rd) and Dylan Leach (12 9th) all rank in the top 10 in the MVC.
- Sophomore outfielder Zack Stewart is a two-time MVC Player of the Week award winner this season and is hitting .331 while leading the MVC in home runs (18) and ranking 2nd in slugging (.710) and total bases (120). Stewart has 30 career homers in 95 games as a Bear, making him the 20th player in MSU history to reach 30.
- Senior Brandt Thompson leads the MVC with a 5.17 strikeout-to-walk ratio, 1.33 WHIP and 1.85 BB/9 ratio, ranks second with a 2.62 ERA, and sits 5th with 62 strikeouts. He sits 5th in MSU history (100 inning minimum) with a career 3.74 K/BB ratio and 16th with a 3.11 ERA, while his 5.17 K/BB this season trails only the 5.84 MSU record set by pitching coach Nick Petree in 2013. In MVC games, Thompson is 3-1 with a 2.41 ERA and .197 opponent average.
- Senior catcher Dylan Leach is hitting .339 and slugging .693 with 11 home runs and 31 RBI since March 1. For the year, Leach ranks 9th in the MVC with 12 homers and 11th with a .621 slugging percentage.
- 6 Freshman Caden Bogenpohl ranks second nationally among freshmen with 38 walks and fifth with 14 home runs. Georgia Tech's Drew Burress holds the home lead with 18, and Prairie View's Michael Smith is the walk lead at 43. Among MSU rookies all time, only Ryan Howard (19 in 1999) and Jason Hart (15 1996) have more home runs.
- The Bears have a 2.57 ERA in the first inning this season, allowing only 16 runs (12 earned) in 42 games.
- The Bears have 36 road games on the schedule in 2024, which would be a school record. Missouri State's highest total of true road games came in 2003 with 33, which included six in postseason play on the way to the CWS. MoState is currenty 14-16 on the road this year.
- Head coach Keith Guttin announced in November his plans to retire after the 2024 season, his 42nd in charge of the Bears. He ranks second among active coaches and 12th overall with 1,391 career wins. Among active skippers, Guttin trails only Danny Hall of Georgia Tech (1,405). Guttin also played for the Bears in 1976 and 1977 and served as an assistant coach from 1979-81, making this his 47th season with the program.

# **SERIES HISTORY**

MoState is 30-57 all-time against Arkansas with a 15-35 record in Fayetteville. The Bears won 6-4 in their last visit to Baum-Walker Stadium in 2022, and are 6-4 against the Hogs in Fayetteville since the beginning of the 2015 season.

### PRESEASON PREDICTIONS

Missouri State is picked to finish second in the Missouri Valley Conference this season by the league's coaches, with Garrett Ferguson, Taeg Gollert, Zack Stewart and Brandt Thompson earning preseason all-Valley honors. Indiana State is picked to repeat as league champs, with Evansville, the Bears and Murray State rounding out the top four.

D1Baseball tabbed Stewart as its preseason MVC Player of the Year, Thompson as the Pitcher of the Year and Caden Bogenpohl as the Freshman of the Year.

### **ROAD TO SUCCESS**

MSU has proven solid on the road over the past eight-plus seasons, logging a 129-113 (.533) record in such contests. Including their 32-19 record in neutral-field games over the same stretch, the Bears have gone 161-132 (.549) away from Hammons Field since the start of the 2015 season.

The Bears have several high road win totals in recent years, including 13 so far in 2024. MSU logged 19 road wins in 2017 and a program-record 21 wins in 27 road contests in 2015. Coupled with their 9-3 record in neutral field contests in 2015, the Bears' total of 30 wins away from home was second only to national champion Virginia in the Division I ranks. The Bears also posted the longest road win streak in Division I baseball in 2015, claiming 11-straight victories from March 15 to April 25.

#### **IN RARE COMPANY**

Bears head coach Keith Guttin sits in 12th place on the NCAA's Division I career coaching wins list.

With a career record of 1,391-919 (.602), Guttin ranks second among active coaches (full list on page 4). Guttin is the second-winningest coach in MVC history.

Of the top 20 in all-time victories, 10, including Guttin, have spent their entire coaching career at one institution.

### **NON-CON SUCCESS**

MSU has been solid against non-conference competition over the last eight seasons, compiling a 155-115 (.574) record in regular-season games versus non-league foes since the start of the 2015 season. The Bears have won 70 of their last 104 regular-season non-conference home games.

#### **CARDIAC CUBS**

Missouri State has seven come-from-behind victories this season, the largest a four-run comeback from a 5-1 deficit to 15-5 victory on March 3 versus Arkansas State. MSU has 126 comeback wins since the start of the 2015 season.

The Bears have rallied from at least a seven-run deficit twice in that span, erasing an 8-1 deficit to win 10-9 at Evansville on May 11, 2019, and wiping out an 8-0, seventh-inning deficit by scoring seven times in the seventh, three more in the eighth and one in the ninth to beat Oklahoma 11-8 on March 15, 2019.

Overall, the Bears have produced 156 players who have gone on to sign professional contracts over their 60 years as a varsity program, including 137 during Keith Guttin's 42-year tenure as head coach.

### **HALL OF FAMERS**

MSU head coach Keith Guttin was enshrined into the Missouri Sports Hall of Fame in 2015, while pitching coach and 2012 Louisville Slugger National Player of the Year Nick Petree joined the MSU Athletics Hall of Fame in February 2022.

# KEITH GUTTIN **Head Coach**

42nd Season Alma mater: UMSL (1978)

ne of the most successful baseball coaches in Missouri Valley Conference history, Keith Guttin began his MSU head coaching career in 1983, and has spent the past 41 seasons building the Bears into one of the top programs in the country. Under Guttin, the Bears have won more than 60 percent of their games, averaging 34 victories a year and racking up 12 different 40-win seasons.

Guttin enters the 2024 season, which will be his last as head coach, second among active Division I head coaches and 12th overall in career victories (1,391), and has been a part of the MSU baseball program as a player, assistant coach and head coach for 47 of the program's 61 years. He took the helm of Bears baseball at the start of the 1983 season, coinciding with the move of Missouri State athletics to Division I status. He inherited the reins of the program from its only previous head baseball coach, former Missouri State Director of Athletics Bill Rowe, Guttin ultimately helped stretch MSU's string of consecutive winning seasons to 32 in a row, easily the longest of any Missouri State athletics team. His 1,390 career wins are the most recorded by any head coach in the 114-year history of Missouri State athletics, and the Bears have finished in the top half of the conference race in all but seven of his 41 seasons.

During Guttin's tenure, 137 Bears have signed professional contracts, including six first-round draft picks and 21 players who have advanced to the Major Leagues. Additionally, MSU has won 21 combined conference regular-season and tournament championships and made 12 NCAA Division I Tournament appearances.

In 2003, Guttin led the Bears to the NCAA Division I College World Series for the first time in school history, marking the only trip to Omaha by a Division I team from the state of Missouri since 1965. He has been a conference coach of the year 13 times and was selected as the American Baseball Coaches Association Division I Midwest Region Coach of the Year in both 1997 and 2003.

Guttin's pupils have produced results off the diamond as well. Missouri State baseball players have been recognized on the Valley's all-academic team 73 times since the inception of the honor in 1992. Additionally, eight Bears have garnered academic All-America honors on 12 different occasions under Guttin, including three-time selection Brian Mahaffey.

Missouri State is coming off a successful stretch that has seen the Bears claim three MVC regular-season titles and play in four NCAA Tournaments in the last eight seasons. In 2018, Guttin picked up his second consecutive MVC Coach of the Year honor after leading the Bears to their 12th 40-win campaign, as MSU swept the MVC regular-season and postseason tournament crowns for just the second time in school history. The previous spring, the Bears won their first 18 Valley games en route to the title, then captured their third overall NCAA Regional crown by knocking off Arkansas in the deciding game of the Fayetteville Regional. MSU saw its storybook season come to an end at the Fort Worth Super Regional, as TCU secured a fourth straight trip to Omaha with a two-game sweep of Guttin's Bears. Consensus All-America picks Jake

Burger and Jeremy Eierman led a potent Bears lineup that paved the way to a 43-20 campaign, while Valley pitcher of the year Jake Fromson led a star-studded pitching staff and garnered All-America recognition of his own

The 2015 season will go down as one of the more memorable campaigns for Guttin, who was inducted into both the Missouri Sports Hall of Fame and Springfield Area Sports Hall of Fame during the year. He also surpassed the 1,100 career victory mark early in MSU's record-setting season en route to earning his fifth MVC Coach of the Year nod. Under Guttin's guidance, the 2015 Bears set a program record with 49 victories and were ranked as high as No. 6 (Baseball America) in the nation while capturing the Valley's regular-season and postseason tournament titles. MSU went on to earn its ninth NCAA Division I postseason berth, sweeping the Springfield Regional at Hammons Field to advance to its second Super Regional appearance, where the Bears came up just one win shy of punching their ticket to the College World Series.

In 2001. Guttin led the Bears to their first-ever MVC regular-season championship and, in the process, dethroned perennial league powerhouse Wichita State. The Shockers had previously won outright or shared the Valley regular season crown in the previous 14 years, but the Bears posted a 22-10 record in 2001 and bested WSU by one game for the MVC crown.

While the accomplishments of Guttin's teams on the field speak volumes about the success of his program, another dream came true in April 2004 when the Bears opened a sparkling 8,000-seat stadium just four blocks north of the Missouri State campus. It was merely a coincidence that the crown jewel of the Missouri State baseball program came one year after the Bears exploded onto the national college baseball radar in the College World Series. But both events show the growth of college baseball in the Ozarks and the amount of community and administrative support the program had received in the last several years. With the continued support of the MSU community, Guttin has led the Bears' efforts in numerous charitable endeavors, including the program's annual Price Cutter Celebrity Golf Classic, proceeds from which have been committed to Champion Athletes of the Ozarks in each of the last 20 years. MSU's popular First Pitch and Reunion Night has also been a positive force for both the Bears and a variety of local charitable organizations. The preseason kickoff event has benefitted entities such as the Miracle League Ball Field, Care to Learn, Boys and Girls Clubs and the Wounded Warrior Proiect.

The Bears have finished lower than third in the league standings just 10 times since Guttin took over. Guttin directed Missouri State to six straight league titles in Mid-Continent play from 1984 through 1989. He has given MSU its first five Valley postseason tournament championships in 1996, 1997, 2015, 2018 and 2022. He was voted the MVC Coach of the Year in 1993, 2001, 2003, 2008, 2015, 2017 and 2018 and was selected the American Baseball Coaches Association Division I Midwest Region Coach of the Year in 1997 and 2003.

Guttin had two notable seasons as the Missouri State second baseman, coming from Mineral Area College. He earned MIAA all-conference honorable mention in 1977 as the Bears made their first NCAA Division II tournament appearance in seven years.

A University City native, Guttin finished his undergraduate degree at the University of Missouri-St. Louis in 1978, and earned his master's degree in 1984 at Truman State. He and his wife, Marianne, have three daughters, Lauren, Lindsey and Samantha; and two grandsons, Bradley and Brody.
