LEADING OFF

• Ole Miss dropped their midweek matchup to South Alabama 14-5 on the road.

• The Rebels won 13 games in a row from February 16 to March 9,

their longest winning streak since they won 16 in a row during the 2020 season.

• Ryan Moerman has hit .457 (21-for-46) with 21 RBI, 17 runs scored, and six home runs during his 11-game hitting streak.

• Moerman hit two home runs in Sunday's win over Jacksonville State, including a walk-off grand slam, the first grand slam from an Ole Miss player since Calvin Harris in 2023.

• Mason Nichols, Will McCausland, and Landon Waters combined to two-hit Jacksonville State on Sunday, the first two-hitter since February of 2020.

· Ole Miss was ranked in all five polls this week with the highest being

No. 13 by D1Baseball. The Rebels were also slotted at No. 15 in both the Baseball America and USA Today coaches' poll and No. 23 in the Perfect Game and NCBWA polls.

· Riley Maddox has allowed just one run and struck out 14 batters over his last three starts.

· Ole Miss' offense comes into the week ranked fifth in the NCAA in home runs per game, averaging 2.07 long balls per game. They are also ranked ninth in total home runs with 31.

• The Rebels' ERA of 3.48 is the 25th best in the country and they are also ranked 10th in strikeouts per nine innings at 11.7.

• Ryan Moerman is now top 40 in the NCAA in doubles, doubles per game, total bases, slugging percentage, home runs, and home runs per

ATHLETICS COMMUNICATIONS: Ole Miss Assistant Director of Athletic Communications Kyle Birnbrauer handles all communications duties for the Ole Miss baseball program. For any questions or special requests, contact him on his cell at (662) 816-3671 or reach him by email at kyleb@olemiss.edu.

PRACTICES/INTERVIEWS: The Rebels practice throughout the week at Oxford-University Stadium/Swayze Field, with practice typically occurring from 2-5 p.m. CT. All practices are open to the media. Media wishing to arrange interviews with coaches or players either in person or remotely should contact Assistant Director of Athletic Communications Kyle Birnbrauer. All interview requests must be made at least 24 hours in advance. Media availability for players is subject to the team's time management plan.

CREDENTIALS: Requests for credentials must be sent to Kyle Birnbrauer (kyleb@olemiss.edu) at least 24 hours prior to each game. Please only submit credential requests for games you are sure to attend. Priority will be given to media outlets and members who regularly cover Ole Miss baseball.

CREDENTIAL PICKUP/STADIUM ENTRANCE: Credentials can be picked up on gameday at the Oxford-University Stadium will call window to the left of the main gate. Gates open one hour prior to first pitch for midweek games and two hours prior to weekend games, including Thursday games of weekend series. Outside of ADA considerations, media members are not permitted to utilize the elevator or enter the Diamond Club area. Media members can access the press box using the stairs between Section M and N.

PARKING: Media parking will once again be in Lot A, adjacent to the Main Athletics Building off of Gertrude Ford Blvd. When you are approved for single-game credentials, you will also be added to the pass list for Lot A.

PHOTOGRAPHY/VIDEOGRAPHY: Still photographers may shoot from the film deck behind home plate or inside the camera wells down both base lines. Photographers are not allowed to shoot from within the dugout area. Any photographer not following the guidelines may have their credentials revoked at any time. Credentials must be clearly and properly displayed at all times. To request a credential, please contact Kyle Birnbrauer in the Ole Miss Athletics Communications office.

VISITING RADIO: Please contact the Kyle Birnbrauer in the Ole Miss Athletics Communications Office for credentials. The visiting radio booth is behind home plate on the first base side of the plate. Space for a crew of four is allowed for each broadcasting medium. As required by the SEC, Ole Miss provides phone lines for visiting radio.

POSTGAME MEDIA: Both team locker rooms are <u>CLOSED</u> to the media following the game, by facility policy. Selected players will be brought to the media down the first base line following a 10-minute cooling off period. Ole Miss head coach Mike Bianco will address the media approximately 10 minutes after the game following player interviews. On some occasions, the selected players and coach may also be requested for radio interviews with the Ole Miss Radio Network or national television, and will meet those obligations for interviews first.

TELEVISION INFORMATION: All Ole Miss home games not already scheduled for national television are broadcasted live on SEC Network+ via WatchESPN.com and the ESPN app. Links for these broadcasts are made available on the schedule page at OleMissSports.com, as well as in each week's preview. All other games scheduled on the ESPN family of networks can be found on the schedule page online.

LIVE STATS: Live stats are available for each Ole Miss baseball game. Links to follow will be made available online at OleMissSports. com, and can generally be found specifically in game previews or game notes. For all Rebel home games, live stats are available via StatBroadcast on the schedule page at OleMissSports.com or by visiting olemiss.statbroadcast.com.

FTP: Ole Miss offers free FTP downloads of game highlights and interviews with coaches and players for television stations to use during regularly scheduled news/sportscasts. IT JUST MEANS MORE, MAN

Ryan Moerman is currently riding an 11-game hitting streak and is hitting .457 (21-for-46) with 21 RBI, 17 runs scored, and six home runs during that stretch. He hit .529 (9-for-17) with 10 RBI and two home runs over four games last week.

The Illinois transfer has been personally responsible for 32.1 percent of the Rebels runs scored this season. Moerman has driven in 24 and scored 18 of the 131 runs Ole Miss has scored on the season.

RETURN TO FORM

Over his last three starts Riley Maddox has a 3-0 record, allowing just one run and striking out 14 batters while working five innings in all three outings. He has held opponents to three or fewer hits in each outing and has not allowed an extra-base hit during that time.

RETURN OF THE KING

Hunter Elliott was named the Dick Howser Trophy National Pitcher of the Month by the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association for the month of February.

Elliott made three starts in the opening month of the season, working at least five innings and picking up the win in each. He only allowed six total hits and did not allow a run, earned or otherwise, to score.

Elliott was one of 17 qualified pitchers in the NCAA to not allow an earned run this season and one of just four to not allow an earned run while working 16+ innings. He was also just one of 11 to not allow a run at all, earned or unearned.

On February 14, Elliott made his first start since April of 2023 shutting out No. 21 Arizona over five innings in Texas. He allowed just two hits and struck out three Wildcats on the way to his first win since February of 2023.

The following weekend Elliott had everything working against Eastern Kentucky in his first start at Swayze Field in almost 700 days. He tied his career-high with

10 strikeouts over six innings, allowed just three hits and not issuing a single free pass. He faced just one batter over the minimum as he picked off two of the three baserunners he allowed.

POWER SURGE

Judd Utermark hit two home runs in the Rebels' win over Murray State, giving him his first multi-home run game of his career. He hit four home runs in four-consecutive games from February 28 to March 5, hitting five total during that time. He joins Andrew Fischer, Logan Power, and Michael Rosamond as the only Rebels to hit a home run in four-straight games since 1997.

GET US STARTED

Ole Miss' starting rotation of Hunter Elliott, Riley Maddox, and Mason Nichols are sporting a combined ERA of 3.08 through the first four weeks of the season. They have allowed just 18 total runs and struck out 67 batters over 52.2 innings of work. Elliott and Nichols have each reached the 10 punchout mark in a start this season, tying or setting new career-highs.

WASTE NO TIME

The Rebels are outscoring opponents 23-6 in the first inning and 43-9 over the first two innings of games this season, jumping on opponents early. They are 9-0 when scoring in the first inning and 12-0 when they score the first run of a game.

NEVER SAFE

The Rebel pitching staff has picked off eight runners this season, surpassing its totals from each of the last two seasons already. Hunter Elliott leads the team with four pick offs, Riley Maddox has two, and Mason Nichols and Walker Hooks each have one.

HOOK 'EM

Walker Hooks picked up his first career win and first career save last week, making appearances against both Murray State and Jacksonville State. The freshman has made six appearances already in his young career allowing just seven baserunners, one of whom he picked off, over 10 innings of work. He made his debut on February 15 against No. 19 Texas, coming out of the bullpen with the bases loaded and just one out. He struck out the first two hitters he faced and would go on to retire all eight he saw. The freshman is up to 16 total strikeouts and is holding opponents to a .143 batting average against.

FEDERICO SUAVE

13 games into Hayden Federico's career, the freshman is currently top five on the team in multiple offensive categories including batting average and on base percentage. He is one of only three Rebels with a three-hit game this season.

Federico hit a walk-off single last Wednesday night against Murray State and hit what would prove to be the game-winning home run Friday night against Jacksonville State.

PRESEASON ALL-SEC

Hunter Elliott was named to the 2025 Preseason All-SEC Team as one of five starting pitchers named to the Second Team.

Elliott is the first Rebel to be named to the Preseason All-SEC Team since Jacob Gonzalez in 2023 and the first Rebel pitcher to earn the honor since Parker Caracci in 2019.

Since being named a three-time Freshman All-American in 2022, Elliott has been sidelined for nearly two full seasons with an elbow injury. In 2022, Elliott set an Ole Miss freshman record for strikeouts in a season with 102. He finished second on the team with a 2.70 ERA over 20 appearances.

FRESHMEN READY TO MAKE AN IMPACT

The 2025 freshman class was named the No. 4 class in the country by three different publications: D1Baseball, Baseball America, and Perfect Game. They are one of five SEC classes in the top 10 and the third-highest ranked in the conference.

The class includes Hayden Federico, Owen Hancock, Walker Hooks, Cooper Johnson, Jackson Miller, Brett Moseley, Owen Paino, Jake Reigert, Tate Sirmans, Ethan Surowiec, and Cade Townsend.

Owen Paino is arguably the most heralded on the list as he was also named the No. 48 overall shortstop in the country by D1Baseball, No. 6 on Perfect Game's 2027 MLB Draft Board, No. 7 on Perfect Game's Fresh Arrivals On Campus, No. 8 on Perfect Game's Top 75 Collegiate Freshmen, and No. 12 on Baseball America's Top 25 College Baseball Freshmen.

TRANSFER TO THE SIP

Ole Miss' 2025 roster features 10 new transfers from Division I, Division II, and JUCO ranks.

Mitchell Sanford, a transfer from New Orleans, and Isaac Humphrey, a transfer from Louisville, were both ranked on D1Baseball's Top 50 Transfer Impact Hitters. D1Baseball also named them as two of the Top 35 outfielders in the country.

Sanford is the reigning Southland Hitter of the Year and was also named to the All-Southland First Team and All-Defensive Team in 2024 after hitting .381 with New Orleans last year. Humphrey played three seasons at Louisville where he hit .300 in 166 games in his career.

Will McCausland, a transfer from Saint Joseph's, was named to D1Baseball's Top 85 Transfer Impact Pitchers after playing two seasons for the Hawks. Ryan Moerman, an outfielder from Illinois, is a two-time All-Big Ten Second Team honoree who has played in 129 career games.

Alex Canney, a pitcher from Division II National Champions Tampa, is a three-time All-American and six-time

The combined newcomer class of both transfers and freshmen was ranked No. 10 in the country by Baseball America.

TOP OF THE HILL

Luke Hill was ranked as the No. 29 third baseman in the country according to D1Baseball's Preseason Top 50 Third Basemen List.

He was the ninth-highest ranked third baseman from the SEC and the eighth-highest ranked junior on the list.

Hill is coming off a sophomore campaign in which he hit .291 with 36 runs scored, 35 walks drawn, and 12 stolen bases. The Louisiana native really turned things up in SEC play, hitting .321 with an on-base percentage of .414 and 19 runs scored in 29 conference games.

BACK BEHIND THE DISH

Campbell Smithwick was ranked No. 22 on D1Baseball's Preseason Top 50 Catchers list ahead of the 2025 season. Smithwick was the third-highest ranked sophomore and the seventh-highest ranked catcher from the SEC on the list that looks at every backstop in the country.

He was also ranked No. 60 on Perfect Game's Top 100 Collegiate Sophomores List.

Smithwick is coming off a freshman season in which he played in 30 games and led the Rebels in on-base percentage at .449. His .266 batting average was also the fifth-highest on the team in 2024.

NEW FACE IN THE DUGOUT

Joel Mangrum was hired as the newest Ole Miss Baseball assistant coach on June 13 and will be heading into his first season as the team's pitching coach.

A native of Brandon, Mississippi, Mangrum came to Oxford after professional and college coaching stints

Mangrum worked with and helped develop former Rebels Doug Nikhazy and Dylan DeLucia as pitchers in the Guardians organization.

Prior to professional baseball, Mangrum spent time at ULM, Austin Peay, New Mexico State, and Milligan College.

MIKE BIANCO

Ole Miss named Mike Bianco head coach of the Rebel baseball program on June 7, 2000. Since then, Bianco has become the winningest coach in program history, led the Rebels to the only national championship in program history and established Ole Miss as one of the premier programs in college baseball.

In 24 seasons leading the program, Bianco has delivered 18 postseason appearances, including eight Super Regional berths and a pair of trips to the College World Series. He has racked up 906 victories, holding a 906-543-1 (.625) record. Those wins are the most in Rebel baseball history and rank fourth all-time among active coaches in the SEC. He also stands as the winningest and longest-active coach in the SEC among the sports of baseball, men's basketball and football. The Rebels have reached the 30-win plateau in all but two of Bianco's 23 the Rebels don't rebuild under Bianco—they reload.

To become the all-time winningest coach in Ole Miss history, Bianco passed Rebel legend Jake Gibbs with his 486th win on March 9, 2013, against Lipscomb in non-conference action. A road SEC win at Texas A&M on May 8, 2021 gave Bianco 900 for his career, including 800 in a Rebel uniform to become one of 27 active head coaches with 900 career victories and one of five in the SEC alongside LSU's Paul Mainieri, Arkansas' Dave Van Horn, Vanderbilt's Tim Corbin, and Texas' Jim Schlossnagle. He joined Ron Polk and Skip Bertman as the only coaches in conference history with 800 wins.

Bianco earned the 1,000th win of his career in the second game of a doubleheader against Georgia on April 20, 2024. He is one of only 18 active NCAA baseball coaches with over 1,000 wins in their career.

The winning tradition has led to a wealth of success in the The winning tradition has led to a wealth of success in the nation's strongest baseball conference. Under Bianco, the Rebels have won four SEC Western Division titles, two SEC Tournament titles and one SEC regular-season championship, coming in 2009. Ole Miss captured the SEC Tournament title in 2006 and again in 2018. The Rebels also won the SEC West crown in 2018, becoming just the greated in program bittery to win both a divisional and second in program history to win both a divisional and tournament title in the same season.

National Champion Rebels

In a career that has been filled with memorable seasons, the pinnacle without a doubt came during the 2022 campaign. Once sitting at 7-14 in the SEC and left for dead by fans and media across the country, Bianco's Rebels responded with one of the most miraculous turnarounds in college baseball history to not only right the ship, but finish on top.

Ole Miss finished 7-2 over its last three SEC series, including its first-ever sweep over LSU in Baton Rouge, to bolster its resume and ultimately garner the very last bid into the NCAA Tournament.

Despite Rebel captain Tim Elko's warning of "don't let the Rebs get hot," the college baseball world did just that. Once in the postseason, the Rebels never looked back, cruising through three-straight wins to claim the Coral Gables Regional and topping Southern Miss in the Hattiesburg Super Regional to advance to Omaha for the corand time under Pierce second time under Bianco.

Even at the College World Series, the Rebels couldn't be cooled down as Ole Miss defeated Auburn and took down Arkansas twice to advance to the championship series against Oklahoma. After Bianco's bunch eased past the Sooners in game one, an eighth-inning rally sealed the deal, securing the program's first national championship.

Following the triumphant season, the longtime Rebel skipper was tabbed the National Coach of the Year by D1Baseball, USA Baseball, the ABCA, and Collegiate Baseball. It was the second season in which Bianco was named the national coach of the year, receiving the honor from Collegiate Baseball after leading Ole Miss to a 16-1 start to the 2020 season prior to the halting of play due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

MLB Rebs

The excellence on the field has not gone unnoticed over the past 24 seasons under Bianco. The Rebels have seen 137' Major League Baseball draft picks in that time, including a combined 38 in the past seven seasons

At least three Rebels have been selected in each of the past 20 full seasons of the Bianco Era. Prior to Bianco's arrival, Ole Miss eclipsed four draftees just three times.

In the Bianco Era, Rebel pitchers have accounted for 76 selections in the MLB Draft, including three first-rounders. Drew Pomeranz was selected fifth overall in 2010, becoming the highest-selected Rebel ever, part of a class that featured five Ole Miss pitchers taken in the top 100 picks. Ryan Rolison joined Pomeranz as a first-round selection in 2018 when he was taken 22nd overall by the Colorado Rockies. Gunnar Hoglund became the third Rebel pitcher coached by Bianco selected in the first round, earning the No. 19 pick from the Toronto Blue Jays.

Bianco has also tutored 20 catchers who have gone on to Bianco has also tutored 20 catchers who have gone on to sign professional contracts. In 2018 and 2019, three Rebels were drafted as catchers in the top six rounds. Nick Fortes signed with the Miami Marlins after they chose him in the fourth round in 2018, while Thomas Dillard (5th Round - Milwaukee Brewers) and Cooper Johnson (6th Round - Detroit Tigers) were quickly taken off the board in 2019. Hayden Dunhurst and Calvin Harris have added to the recent run of Rebel backstops drafted highly with to the recent run of Rebel backstops drafted highly, with Dunhurst being selected in the sixth round by the Kansas City Royals in 2022 and Harris going to the Chicago White Sox in the fourth round in 2023.

In his 29 years as either an assistant or head coach at Northwestern State, LSU, McNeese State and Ole Miss, Bianco has coached 171 players who have gone on to sign professional contracts. Among those 171 players, 34 have made Major League rosters, including 23 Rebels in the past 23 seasons.

T.J. Beam (New York Yankees) was the first player from the Bianco Era to be called up in 2006, followed by Seth Smith (Colorado) in 2007 and Matt Tolbert (Minnesota) in 2008. Chris Coghlan (Florida) was named the 2009 National League Rookie of the Year, while Matt Maloney (Cincinnati) made his MLB debut that same season. Alex Presley (Pittsburgh) became the sixth Bianco-coached Rebel to get the call to the majors in 2010.

Right-hander Lance Lynn (St. Louis), shortstop Zack Cozart (Cincinnati) and left-hander Drew Pomeranz (Colorado) became the next crop of player to make their Major League debuts, getting the call to the big leagues in 2011. Those call ups gave the Rebels eight players active in the Majors in the 2011 season, the second most of any Southeastern Conference team that season. Seven players appeared on Major League rosters in the 2013 season, including the call up of right-hander Phillip Irwin (Pittsburgh) that year. Right-hander Aaron Barrett (Washington) made his Major League debut on March 31, 2014. 2014.

Matt Tracy was called up to the big leagues by the New York Yankees, April 11, 2015, and made his debut later that day. Just over one month later, another former Rebel pitcher made his Major League debut as David Goforth began pitching out of the bullpen for the Milwaukee Brewers. In 2016, Mike Mayers (St. Louis) became the 14th Bianco-coached Rebel to see his big league dream come true, earning a start for the Cardinals against the



Los Angeles Dodgers on Sunday Night Baseball.

Johnny Bench Award winner Stuart Turner saw his dream come true when he made the Cincinnati Reds roster to start the 2017 season. Less than a month into the season, the Oakland Athletics called up Bobby Wahl as the next Rebel to make his MLB debut. Braxton Lee earned MLB Reb when he earned a spot on the 2018 Opening Day roster for the Miami Marlins. Two more Rebels added Day roster for the Miami Marins. Iwo more keepels added their names to the MLB ranks in 2019 as pitchers Chris Ellis (Kansas City) and Jacob Waguespack (Toronto) toed the rubber in the bigs and former backstop Nick Fortes reached the majors in 2021, clobbering a home run in his debut with the Marlins. Chad Smith became the latest Rebel to make it to the "big leagues" in 2022, debuting the the Calenda Pacific for the Colorado Rockies.

OLE MISS RECORD

Award-Winning Rebels On the field, Bianco has established a tradition of developing some of the nation's top players, as the Rebels have seen a combined 94 selections to All-America and Freshman All-America teams over the past 24 seasons.

Three Rebels received All-American nods during Ole Miss' national championship campaign in 2022. College World Series Most Outstanding Player Dylan DeLucia was named a Third Team All-American by Baseball America, while three-time Rebel captain Tim Elko landed on the NCBWA's Third Team All-America squad. Rookie hurler Hunter Elliott received three different Freshman All-American designations, receiving plaudits from Collegiate Baseball,



Perfect Game and D1Baseball.

During the 2021 campaign, Doug Nikhazy became the program's fourth two-time All-American and its third unanimous All-American. Taylor Broadway and Jacob Gonzalez joined Nikhazy on the All-American teams, Gonzalez being just the second true freshman in program history, alongside Stephen Head, to be named an All-American Conzolae was also tabled as a fractman All American. Gonzalez was also tabbed as a freshman All-American along with TJ McCants, giving Ole Miss two or more Freshman All-Americans for six consecutive seasons, a total of 14 in that span.

Ole Miss also became the first school to produce two different finalists for the Johnny Bench Award in consecutive seasons when Stuart Turner and Will Allen were named as finalists in 2013 and 2014, respectively. Turner claimed the award in 2013, becoming the first catcher in program history to be tabbed as the national catcher of the year. Nick Fortes and Hayden Dunhurst carried on the tradition in 2018 and 2021, earning Johnny Bench Award semifinalist nods.

Grae Kessinger added to the award-winning tradition in 2019. The Rebel legacy was named the Brooks Wallace Award Winner, given annually to the nation's top shortstop, becoming the first player in program history to win the award.

Another Rebel shortstop made history in 2021 when Jacob Gonzalez became the program's first National Freshman of the Year, bestowed by D1Baseball.

The Rebels have totaled 73 All-SEC nods under Bianco. Most recently, Gonzalez was the shortstop selection on the All-SEC First Team, while Elko's final collegiate season landed him on the All-SEC Second Team. Giving opposing hitters problems from the left side all season long, Hunter Elliott earned a Freshman All-SEC nod.

Bianco's Rebels have brought home a number of awards from the league office as well, including Stephen Head's SEC Player of the Year laurel in 2004, Drew Pomeranz earning SEC Pitcher of the Year honors in 2010 and the Rebels' trio of SEC Freshman of the Year winners: Seth Smith in 2002, Head in 2003 and Jordan Henry in 2007. In 2021, Tim Elko became the program's first SEC Scholar-Athlete of the Year.

Bianco has also coached five C Spire Ferriss Trophy winners, given annually to the best college baseball player in Mississippi. Head won it in 2004, followed by Brian Pettway in 2005, Scott Bittle in 2008, Pomeranz in 2010 and Auston Bousfield in 2014.

The Rebels have also celebrated great academic success under Bianco. Five of his Rebels have been named CoSIDA Academic All-District. The SEC's First-Year Academic Honor Roll has included 93 Bianco-coached Rebels, while 251 student-athletes have been selected to the SEC Academic Honor Roll.

National Treasure

Bianco's on-field accomplishments have been recognized nationally, as the Rebel skipper was tapped as the manager of the USA Collegiate National Team before the start of the 2022 season. Under Bianco, the boys in Red, White and Blue earned the Bronze Medal at Honkbalweek in Haarlem, Netherlands.

Three Rebel players joined Bianco on the Collegiate National Team, with Jacob Gonzalez and Hunter Elliott making the travel squad that competed in The Netherlands and Mason Nichols earning a spot on the initial Collegiate National Team training camp roster that competed in the Stars vs. Stripes intrasquad series in North Carolina.

Ole Miss has a strong history with Team USA. 12 Rebels have competed internationally for USA Baseball in the Bianco Era. Seth Smith and Stephen Head both competed for the 2003 edition of the Collegiate National Team. Zack Cozart made the national squad in 2006, and Cody Satterwhite and Lance Lynn kept that going in 2007.

Drew Pomeranz became the sixth Rebel to sport the American flag uniform in 2009, followed by Bobby Wahl in 2012 and Dallas Woolfolk in 2017. Parker Caracci carried on the tradition in 2018, earning a spot on the Team USA

roster, where he posted a perfect 0.00 ERA with two saves and opposing batting average of .094 in 9.2 innings of work. Doug Nikhazy made it three straight seasons with a Rebel arm wearing the Stars and Stripes, earning a spot on the 24-man roster for the 2019 summer.

Top Recruiter

Not only have fans and the media covering college baseball noticed Ole Miss' resurgence under Bianco, some of the top talent in the country is also taking a close look at the Rebels.

Seventeen of Bianco's 22 recruiting classes at Ole Miss have garnered top-20 national rankings, including 10 that have placed in the top-10. His first recruiting class was rated as one of the nation's 10 best by both Collegiate Baseball and Baseball America, including a No. 6 ranking by Collegiate Baseball.

The 2003 recruiting class was ranked No. 10 by Collegiate Baseball, while the 2011 class was ranked third nationally by Collegiate Baseball and fifth by Baseball America. It marked the first top-5 recruiting class for Bianco at Ole Miss. In the fall of 2016, Rebel Baseball earned the No. 1 ranking in national recruiting rankings by both Baseball America and D1Baseball.com. The top ranking was the first No. 1 recruiting class in the history of not only the baseball program but all of Ole Miss athletics.

Just when that 2016 class cycled through, the Rebels reloaded with another elite class. The 2019 Ole Miss class ranked No. 2 in the nation, highlighted by four prospects who were taken in the MLB Draft but chose instead to play in Overat. The 2019 group included in Oxford. The 2019 group included four of Perfect Game's top 50 prospects—the only class in the country of its kind. Bianco brought in another top-five class in 2022 with Perfect Game's No. 4 ranked recruiting class.

Foundation of Success

Bianco's winning ways can be traced back to his playing days. After spending two seasons at Indian River (Fla.) Community College, he played two seasons for Skip Bertman at perennial national-power LSU in 1988 and 1989. He was the starting catcher and team captain for the Tigers' 1989 team that finished third at the College World Series in Omaha, Nebraska. He homered in LSU's 6-3 win over Miami (Fla.) in the 1989 CWS to help advance the Tigers to the semifinals.

While working behind the plate for LSU, Bianco caught major league pitchers Ben McDonald, Russ Springer, Curtis Leskanic, John O'Donoghue, Chad Ogea and Paul Byrd.

His time behind the plate as a player would later benefit him as he served as LSU's pitching coach during three World Series championship teams in the 1990s. Bianco also worked with the pitchers during his three years as head coach at McNeese State, and continues to serve in that same capacity with the Rebels.

Omaha Experience Following his playing career, he joined Jim Wells' (former head coach at Alabama) coaching staff at Northwestern State, where he served two seasons from 1991-1992 as a graduate assistant. He helped coach Northwestern State to a 1991 Southland Conference (SLC) championship and an appearance in the 1991 NCAA South I Regional.

He then returned to Baton Rouge where he joined Bertman's staff at LSU. In five seasons at LSU (1993-1997), the Tigers advanced to the College World Series four times and claimed three national championships. LSU also won three Southeastern Conference crowns and two SEC Tournament titles in that five-year span.

After the Tigers' 1997 College World Series title run, Bianco was named the head coach at McNeese State in July of that year.

Bianco Earns Head Coaching Experience

After seven seasons as an assistant at Northwestern (La.) State and LSU, Bianco received his first head coaching opportunity, taking over the reins of McNeese State.

He quickly displayed his abilities to develop a competitive

program. In his first season with the Cowboys in 1998, he engineered an 11-game improvement from 1997, posting a 30-26 record - the first of three 30-win seasons. The 1998 season also saw the Cowboys rise to third in the conference standings and qualify for the SLC Tournament.

Following a 31-25 campaign in 1999, Bianco's 2000 team produced one of the most successful seasons in McNeese State history. The Cowboys finished 39-20, including winning a school-record 20 SLC games en route to claiming their first conference title since 1988, and making their third-ever appearance in the NCAA Regionals. In recognition, Bianco was named the SLC's Coach of the Year.

Bianco's 2000 McNeese State team raked in the individual postseason awards. Four Cowboys were named to the SLC's first team, including the conference's Hitter and Newcomer of the Year in Chris Williamson, and the SLC's Pitcher of the Year in Chris Howay.


Power hitting was the Cowboys' trademark under Bianco, as they hit 212 home runs in his three seasons, including a school-record 81 in 1999. His 2000 team batted .305 and set a new school standard for hits in a season with 600

Bianco, 55, was born May 3, 1967, and is a native of Seminole, Florida. He is married to the former Camille Marquette, and the couple has five children: sons, Michael, Benjamin, Andrew and Samuel, and one daughter, Catherine.
