LEADING OFF

- Ole Miss defeated 10th-seeded Florida in the second round of the SEC Tournament Wednesday night 3-1.
- Hunter Elliott continued his dominant stretch, working 5.1 innings and holding the Gators to just two hits while striking out eight.
- Wednesday night's win was the first time Ole Miss has won a game in the conference tournament since 2021 when they made it all the way to the semifinals.
- Judd Utermark is hitting .583 (14-for-24) with 14 RBI, nine runs scored, and three home runs over his last eight games played. He has collected two or more hits in four of his last five games.
- Ole Miss earned the seventh seed at the SEC Tournament, finishing with a 16-14 record in conference play. It was the first time since 2021 that the Rebels finished with a winning record in SEC games.
- The Rebels won five SEC series during the regular season surpassing their combined total from the previous two seasons. It is the first time they have won five series since 2021.
- The Rebels have won 30+ games for the first time since 2022 and for the 21st time under head coach Mike Bianco.
- Ole Miss is one of just two Division I teams with 17 or more Quad 1 wins in 2025.
- Ole Miss is ranked in three polls this week coming in at No. 16 in the Baseball America poll, No. 17 in the D1Baseball poll, and No. 20 in the USA Today/Coaches poll.
- The Rebels hit three home runs last Friday to reach the 100-home run mark for just the second time in program history. They are now six home runs shy of the program record for most home runs in a season (108, 2022).
- Luke Hill is currently riding a 40-game on base streak, reaching base in every game since the beginning of conference play.
- Hill is top 10 in the SEC in steals (18), walks (42), hits (72), on base percentage (.470), and runs scored (59).
- Hill's 18 stolen bases are the most by a Rebel since Anthony Servideo stole 24 in 2019.
- Austin Fawley has hit a home run in 10 of his last 21 games. He has hit more home runs than any other catcher in the Mike Bianco Era.
- Hudson Calhoun has struck out 18 of the last 36 batters he has faced for a 50% strikeout rate over his last eight appearances.
- The Rebels are ranked second in the SEC in total walks drawn as a team with 307 free passes so far this season.

ATHLETICS COMMUNICATIONS: Ole Miss Assistant Director of Athletic Communications Kyle Birnbrauer handles all communications duties for the Ole Miss baseball program. For any questions or special requests, contact him on his cell at (662) 816-3671 or reach him by email at kyleb@olemiss.edu.

PRACTICES/INTERVIEWS: The Rebels practice throughout the week at Oxford-University Stadium/Swayze Field, with practice typically occurring from 2-5 p.m. CT. All practices are open to the media. Media wishing to arrange interviews with coaches or players either in person or remotely should contact Assistant Director of Athletic Communications Kyle Birnbrauer. All interview requests must be made at least 24 hours in advance. Media availability for players is subject to the team's time management plan.

CREDENTIALS: Requests for credentials must be sent to Kyle Birnbrauer (kyleb@olemiss.edu) at least 24 hours prior to each game. Please only submit credential requests for games you are sure to attend. Priority will be given to media outlets and members who regularly cover Ole Miss baseball.

CREDENTIAL PICKUP/STADIUM ENTRANCE: Credentials can be picked up on gameday at the Oxford-University Stadium will call window to the left of the main gate. Gates open one hour prior to first pitch for midweek games and two hours prior to weekend games, including Thursday games of weekend series. Outside of ADA considerations, media members are not permitted to utilize the elevator or enter the Diamond Club area. Media members can access the press box using the stairs between Section M and N.

PARKING: Media parking will once again be in Lot A, adjacent to the Main Athletics Building off of Gertrude Ford Blvd. When you are approved for single-game credentials, you will also be added to the pass list for Lot A.

PHOTOGRAPHY/VIDEOGRAPHY: Still photographers may shoot from the film deck behind home plate or inside the camera wells down both base lines. Photographers are not allowed to shoot from within the dugout area. Any photographer not following the guidelines may have their credentials revoked at any time. Credentials must be clearly and properly displayed at all times. To request a credential, please contact Kyle Birnbrauer in the Ole Miss Athletics Communications office.

VISITING RADIO: Please contact the Kyle Birnbrauer in the Ole Miss Athletics Communications Office for credentials. The visiting radio booth is behind home plate on the first base side of the plate. Space for a crew of four is allowed for each broadcasting medium. As required by the SEC, Ole Miss provides phone lines for visiting radio.

POSTGAME MEDIA: Both team locker rooms are CLOSED to the media following the game, by facility policy. Selected players will be brought to the media down the first base line following a 10-minute cooling off period. Ole Miss head coach Mike Bianco will address the media approximately 10 minutes after the game following player interviews. On some occasions, the selected players and coach may also be requested for radio interviews with the Ole Miss Radio Network or national television, and will meet those obligations for interviews first.

TELEVISION INFORMATION: All Ole Miss home games not already scheduled for national television are broadcasted live on SEC Network+ via WatchESPN.com and the ESPN app. Links for these broadcasts are made available on the schedule page at OleMissSports.com, as well as in each week's preview. All other games scheduled on the ESPN family of networks can be found on the schedule page online.

LIVE STATS: Live stats are available for each Ole Miss baseball game. Links to follow will be made available online at OleMissSports.com, and can generally be found specifically in game previews or game notes. For all Rebel home games, live stats are available via StatBroadcast on the schedule page at OleMissSports.com or by visiting olemiss.statbroadcast.com.

FTP: Ole Miss offers free FTP downloads of game highlights and interviews with coaches and players for television stations to use during regularly scheduled news/sportscasts. KEEP IT 100

The Rebels hit three home runs last Friday against Auburn to reach the 100-home run mark for just the second time in program history. Will Furniss hit the 100th home run of the season in the eighth inning, a 414-foot, two-RBI shot to dead center field of Abe Chancellor.

With 102 total home runs on the season, the Rebels are now just six home runs shy of the single season record of 108 set by the 2022 team. That team reached the 100-home run mark in their 60th game of the season and averaged 1.66 home runs per game.

The current edition of the Rebel offense reached the 100-home run mark in their 54th game of the season and are currently averaging 1.82 home runs per game.

BASH BROS

For the first time in program history, three different Rebels have hit 15 or more home runs in a season. Judd Utermark and Austin Fawley lead the team, each with a career-high 16. For the second-consecutive season Mitchell Sanford has hit 15 home runs.

This is also just the second time in program history that five different Rebels have hit double digit home runs. In addition to Utermark, Fawley, and Sanford, Ryan Moerman has hit 11, and Isaac Humphrey has hit 10.

TOP OF THE HILL

Luke Hill is currently riding a 40-game on base streak, reaching base in every game since the beginning of conference play. He has reached base in all but two of his 55 games played this season. His 40-game streak is now tied for the seventh-longest by a Rebel since 1997.

Hill finished the regular season in the top 15 in multiple offensive categories in the SEC. He is ranked third in stolen bases (18), sixth in on base percentage (.473) and walks (42), eighth in runs scored (59), ninth in hits (71), and 14th in batting average (.345).

His 12 stolen bases during SEC play were the most in the conference.

BIG GAME HUNTER

Hunter Elliott has allowed just five earned runs and only 14 hits over his last five starts, working 29.2 innings and striking out 36 batters during that stretch.

The Ole Miss ace now owns the sixth-lowest ERA in the SEC and is one of five pitchers in the conference to have an opponent batting average below .200 (.188). His 1.12 WHIP is top seven in the SEC and he also ranks top nine in strikeouts (86) and innings pitched (73.1).

Over his career, Elliott now owns a 6-1 record and a 2.13 ERA with 51 strikeouts and just 10 earned runs given up over seven starts (42.1 innings) in the month of May.

FOR THE CAUSE

Will McCausland has posted a 1.50 ERA over his last 11 appearances dating back to April 4, allowing just three earned runs over 18 innings of work. He has 17 strikeouts and is holding opponents to a .180 batting average during that stretch.

BIG BAT BEHIND THE PLATE

Austin Fawley has hit 10 home runs over his last 21 games and is tied with Judd Utermark for the team lead with 16 home runs. The sophomore has now hit the most home runs by a catcher in the Mike Bianco Era, passing Calvin Harris (2023) and Justin Brashear (2006) who each hit 12.

He is third in the SEC and 18th in the NCAA in home runs per game (0.38).

Fawley's .613 slugging percentage is the highest on the team among qualified hitters and he is second on the team in OPS (.989). He was ranked at the No. 10 catcher in the country by D1Baseball in their Week 12 update.

SWIPE!

Ole Miss has stolen 69 bases so far in 2025, already reaching their highest season total since 2019 when they stole 93 bases. The Rebels have only reached the 50 steals mark once in the previous five seasons (2024, 50).

The Rebels stole eight bases in their win over Tennessee, three shy of the single-game record of 11 set in 1966. Hayden Federico stole four bases in the game, one shy of the individual single-game record. Luke Hill leads the team with 18 swipes and Mitchell Sanford has 12 and Federico has 11.

Federico is one steal shy of tying the Ole Miss single-season freshman record of 12 set by Jordan Henry in 2007.

WE'LL TAKE IT

The Rebels are ranked second in the SEC in walks drawn with 307 total walks on the season. That number is the 23rd highest in the NCAA.

Luke Hill leads the team with 42 walks, Will Furniss has 38, and Isaac Humphrey and Mitchell Sanford each have 32. Hill is the only Rebel with more walks than strikeouts.

Ole Miss drew 18 walks on April 1 against Jackson State, one shy of the program record set last season against High Point. Furniss set a new single-game record for walks in the Saturday finale of the Mississippi State series, drawing five walks in the game.

WASTING NO TIME

The Rebels are outscoring opponents 67-27 in the first inning and 107-56 over the first two innings of games this season, jumping on opponents early. They are 22-5 when scoring in the first inning and 30-4 when they score the first run of a game.

NEVER SAFE

The Rebels have picked off 23 runners this season, their highest total since 2002. They lead the SEC in total pickoffs by a wide margin with the next highest total being 11. Hunter Elliott leads the team with 12 pickoffs, the most by a Rebel pitcher in the Bianco Era.

ALL-SEC HONORS



Three Ole Miss baseball players have been selected to the 2025 All-SEC Baseball Team as announced by the conference office Monday afternoon.

Luke Hill and Mason Morris were each named to the Second Team at their respective positions while Hayden Federico was named to the All-Freshman Team.

Hill is the first third baseman to earn All-SEC honors since Justin Bench in 2021 and Morris is the first pitcher since Doug Nikhazy in 2021 and the first relief pitcher since Parker Caracci in 2018. Federico is the first Rebel freshman to earn conference honors since Hunter Elliott in 2022.

Hill finished the regular season in the top 14 of the SEC in batting average (.345), on base percentage (.473), runs scored (59), hits (71), walks (42), and stolen bases (18). His 12 stolen bases during conference play were the most in the SEC.

Morris has been Ole Miss' primary option out the bullpen all season long, working the most innings by any

Rebel outside of the starting rotation. He finished the regular season with a 5-1 record and a 3.60 ERA with one save and 65 strikeouts. His 65 punchouts and five wins are second-most on the team, trailing only Hunter Elliott, despite pitching almost 30 fewer innings. Morris made 11 appearances during SEC play, second-most on the team.

Morris struck out at least four batters in nine of his 11 appearances during SEC play and issued more than two walks only once. He allowed more than three hits in just two of his appearances all season long.

Federico has appeared in 46 games as a freshman for Ole Miss, starting in 39 of them, primarily as the designated hitter. He finished the regular season with a .247 batting average, 29 runs scored, and 11 stolen bases. His 29 walks are the sixth-most on the team and his 11 stolen bases are the third-most on the team. Federico is one stolen base shy of the Ole Miss freshman record set by Jordan Henry in 2007.

Federico hit four home runs and three of them were leadoff blasts, including one on the first pitch he saw in SEC play.

POWER SURGE

Judd Utermark and Austin Fawley have each hit home runs in four consecutive games this season. Utermark accomplished the feat first, hitting five home runs in four games from February 28 to March 5. Fawley later matched with four home runs in four games from April 11 to April 17. They join Andrew Fischer, Logan Power, and Michael Rosamond as the only Rebels to hit a home run in four-straight games since 1997.

OFFENSIVE EXPLOSION

The Rebels set new program records for runs scored and RBI in a single game in their 29-1 win over Alcorn State on April 9. Their 29 runs scored took down a program record that had stood since 1989 when Ole Miss defeated Illinois College 28-0.

The previous single-game RBI record was 25 which

had been accomplished three times and as recently as last season against High Point. The Rebels collected 27 RBI in the win over Alcorn to set a new record.

The Ole Miss offense also had 44 total bases which was just two shy of the single-game program record and 23 hits which was four short of the program record.

NOT JUST YOUR SUNDAY STARTER

Mason Nichols has been recognized by the NCAA, the SEC, and the University of Mississippi recently for his achievements in the classroom. He was one of 90 Ole Miss students to be awarded the 2025 Taylor Medal, the highest academic honor awarded by the university.

The senior was also named one of the two recipients of the NCAA's Walter Byers Graduate Scholarship, one of the highest academic honors awarded by the NCAA, and was named the H. Boyd McWhorter SEC Scholar-Athlete of the Year by the conference.

Nichols has been a mainstay in the Rebels' starting rotation this season, making a start in every weekend series so far. In 12 starts, he has posted a record of 3-1 while striking out 45 batters over 43.1 innings of work. On March 2, in a start against Wright State Nichols struck out a career-high 10 hitters and is one of only two Rebel pitchers to reach double-digit strikeouts in a game this season.

Nichols will graduate with a degree in biological sciences in May. A three-year team representative on Ole Miss's Student-Athlete Advisory Committee, Nichols' community involvement has included volunteering at events for individuals with special needs, church activities for the elderly and team projects to give back to low-income families.

HUMP WEEK

Isaac Humphrey was named the SEC Player of the Week and the NCBWA Dick Howser Trophy Player of the Week after his huge weekend in Missouri.

Humphrey hit .389 (7-for-18) with four home runs, 13 RBI, and 21 total bases in four total games, including the Rebels' midweek matchup with Southern Miss.

The senior went 1-for-3 with a double in Pearl before really heating up in Columbia. Humphrey hit .400 (6-for-15) with four home runs, 13 RBI, and 19 total bases as Ole Miss swept Missouri for their first conference sweep since 2022.

He came into the series with three total home runs on the season and more than doubled his total with four long balls in three games. He launched two home runs in the series-clinching win on Saturday for the first multi-home run game of his career.

Humphrey drove in 13 of the Rebels' 40 runs scored in the series, a whopping 32.5 percent of the scoring.

MIKE BIANCO

RUN DOWN

Ole Miss named Mike Bianco head coach of the Rebel baseball program on June 7, 2000. Since then, Bianco has become the winningest coach in program history, led the Rebels to the only national championship in program history and established Ole Miss as one of the premier programs in college baseball.

In 24 seasons leading the program, Bianco has delivered 18 postseason appearances, including eight Super Regional berths and a pair of trips to the College World Series. He has racked up 906 victories, holding a 906-543-1 (.625) record. Those wins are the most in Rebel baseball history and rank fourth all-time among active coaches in the SEC. He also stands as the winningest and longest-active coach in the SEC among the sports of baseball, men's basketball and football. The Rebels have reached the 30-win plateau in all but two of Bianco's 23 full seasons, including 10 40-win campaigns, proving that the Rebels don't rebuild under Bianco—they reload.

To become the all-time winningest coach in Ole Miss history, Bianco passed Rebel legend Jake Gibbs with his 486th win on March 9, 2013, against Lipscomb in non-conference action. A road SEC win at Texas A&M on May 8, 2021 gave Bianco 900 for his career, including 800 in a Rebel uniform to become one of 27 active head coaches with 900 career victories and one of five in the SEC alongside LSU's Paul Mainieri, Arkansas' Dave Van Horn, Vanderbilt's Tim Corbin, and Texas' Jim Schlossnagle. He joined Ron Polk and Skip Bertman as the only coaches in conference history with 800 wins.

Bianco earned the 1,000th win of his career in the second game of a doubleheader against Georgia on April 20, 2024. He is one of only 18 active NCAA baseball coaches with over 1,000 wins in their career.

The winning tradition has led to a wealth of success in the nation's strongest baseball conference. Under Bianco, the Rebels have won four SEC Western Division titles, two SEC Tournament titles and one SEC regular-season championship, coming in 2009. Ole Miss captured the SEC Tournament title in 2006 and again in 2018. The Rebels also won the SEC West crown in 2018, becoming just the second in program history to win both a divisional and tournament title in the same season.

National Champion Rebels

In a career that has been filled with memorable seasons, the pinnacle without a doubt came during the 2022 campaign. Once sitting at 7-14 in the SEC and left for dead by fans and media across the country, Bianco's Rebels responded with one of the most miraculous turnarounds in college baseball history to not only right the ship, but finish on top.

Ole Miss finished 7-2 over its last three SEC series, including its first-ever sweep over LSU in Baton Rouge, to bolster its resume and ultimately garner the very last bid into the NCAA Tournament.

Despite Rebel captain Tim Elko's warning of "don't let the Rebs get hot," the college baseball world did just that. Once in the postseason, the Rebels never looked back, cruising through three-straight wins to claim the Coral Gables Regional and topping Southern Miss in the Hattiesburg Super Regional to advance to Omaha for the second time under Bianco.

Even at the College World Series, the Rebels couldn't be cooled down as Ole Miss defeated Auburn and took down Arkansas twice to advance to the championship series against Oklahoma. After Bianco's bunch eased past the Sooners in game one, an eighth-inning rally sealed the deal, securing the program's first national championship.

Following the triumphant season, the longtime Rebel skipper was tabbed the National Coach of the Year by

D1Baseball, USA Baseball, the ABCA, and Collegiate Baseball. It was the second season in which Bianco was named the national coach of the year, receiving the honor from Collegiate Baseball after leading Ole Miss to a 16-1 start to the 2020 season prior to the halting of play due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

MLB Rebs

The excellence on the field has not gone unnoticed over the past 24 seasons under Bianco. The Rebels have seen 137 Major League Baseball draft picks in that time, including a combined 38 in the past seven seasons.

At least three Rebels have been selected in each of the past 20 full seasons of the Bianco Era. Prior to Bianco's arrival, Ole Miss eclipsed four draftees just three times.

In the Bianco Era, Rebel pitchers have accounted for 76 selections in the MLB Draft, including three first-rounders. Drew Pomeranz was selected fifth overall in 2010, becoming the highest-selected Rebel ever, part of a class that featured five Ole Miss pitchers taken in the top 100 picks. Ryan Rolison joined Pomeranz as a first-round selection in 2018 when he was taken 22nd overall by the Colorado Rockies. Gunnar Hoglund became the third Rebel pitcher coached by Bianco selected in the first round, earning the No. 19 pick from the Toronto Blue Jays.

Bianco has also tutored 20 catchers who have gone on to sign professional contracts. In 2018 and 2019, three Rebels were drafted as catchers in the top six rounds. Nick Fortes signed with the Miami Marlins after they chose him in the fourth round in 2018, while Thomas Dillard (5th Round - Milwaukee Brewers) and Cooper Johnson (6th Round - Detroit Tigers) were quickly taken off the board in 2019. Hayden Dunhurst and Calvin Harris have added to the recent run of Rebel backstops drafted highly, with Dunhurst being selected in the sixth round by the Kansas City Royals in 2022 and Harris going to the Chicago White Sox in the fourth round in 2023.

In his 29 years as either an assistant or head coach at Northwestern State, LSU, McNeese State and Ole Miss, Bianco has coached 171 players who have gone on to sign professional contracts. Among those 171 players, 34 have made Major League rosters, including 23 Rebels in the past 23 seasons.

T.J. Beam (New York Yankees) was the first player from the Bianco Era to be called up in 2006, followed by Seth Smith (Colorado) in 2007 and Matt Tolbert (Minnesota) in 2008. Chris Coghlan (Florida) was named the 2009 National League Rookie of the Year, while Matt Maloney (Cincinnati) made his MLB debut that same season. Alex Presley (Pittsburgh) became the sixth Bianco-coached Rebel to get the call to the majors in 2010.

Right-hander Lance Lynn (St. Louis), shortstop Zack Cozart (Cincinnati) and left-hander Drew Pomeranz (Colorado) became the next crop of player to make their Major League debuts, getting the call to the big leagues in 2011. Those call ups gave the Rebels eight players active in the Majors in the 2011 season, the second most of any Southeastern Conference team that season. Seven players appeared on Major League rosters in the 2013 season, including the call up of right-hander Phillip Irwin (Pittsburgh) that year. Right-hander Aaron Barrett (Washington) made his Major League debut on March 31, 2014.

Matt Tracy was called up to the big leagues by the New York Yankees, April 11, 2015, and made his debut later that day. Just over one month later, another former Rebel pitcher made his Major League debut as David Goforth began pitching out of the bullpen for the Milwaukee Brewers. In 2016, Mike Mayers (St. Louis) became the 14th Bianco-coached Rebel to see his big league dream come true, earning a start for the Cardinals against the

Los Angeles Dodgers on Sunday Night Baseball.

Johnny Bench Award winner Stuart Turner saw his dream come true when he made the Cincinnati Reds roster to start the 2017 season. Less than a month into the season, the Oakland Athletics called up Bobby Wahl as the next Rebel to make his MLB debut. Braxton Lee earned MLB Reb when he earned a spot on the 2018 Opening Day roster for the Miami Marlins. Two more Rebels added their names to the MLB ranks in 2019 as pitchers Chris Ellis (Kansas City) and Jacob Waguespack (Toronto) toed the rubber in the bigs and former backstop Nick Fortes reached the majors in 2021, clobbering a home run in his debut with the Marlins. Chad Smith became the latest Rebel to make it to the "big leagues" in 2022, debuting for the Colorado Rockies.

Award-Winning Rebels

On the field, Bianco has established a tradition of developing some of the nation's top players, as the Rebels have seen a combined 94 selections to All-America and Freshman All-America teams over the past 24 seasons.

Three Rebels received All-American nods during Ole Miss' national championship campaign in 2022. College World Series Most Outstanding Player Dylan DeLucia was named a Third Team All-American by Baseball America, while three-time Rebel captain Tim Elko landed on the NCBWA's Third Team All-America squad. Rookie hurler Hunter Elliott received three different Freshman All-American designations, receiving plaudits from Collegiate Baseball,

Perfect Game and D1Baseball.

During the 2021 campaign, Doug Nikhazy became the program's fourth two-time All-American and its third unanimous All-American. Taylor Broadway and Jacob Gonzalez joined Nikhazy on the All-American teams, Gonzalez being just the second true freshman in program history, alongside Stephen Head, to be named an All-American. Gonzalez was also tabbed as a freshman All-American along with TJ McCants, giving Ole Miss two or more Freshman All-Americans for six consecutive seasons, a total of 14 in that span.

Ole Miss also became the first school to produce two different finalists for the Johnny Bench Award in consecutive seasons when Stuart Turner and Will Allen were named as finalists in 2013 and 2014, respectively. Turner claimed the award in 2013, becoming the first catcher in program history to be tabbed as the national catcher of the year. Nick Fortes and Hayden Dunhurst carried on the tradition in 2018 and 2021, earning Johnny Bench Award semifinalist nods.

Grae Kessinger added to the award-winning tradition in 2019. The Rebel legacy was named the Brooks Wallace Award Winner, given annually to the nation's top shortstop, becoming the first player in program history to win the award.

Another Rebel shortstop made history in 2021 when Jacob Gonzalez became the program's first National Freshman of the Year, bested by D1Baseball.

The Rebels have totaled 73 All-SEC nods under Bianco. Most recently, Gonzalez was the shortstop selection on the All-SEC First Team, while Elko's final collegiate season landed him on the All-SEC Second Team. Giving opposing hitters problems from the left side all season long, Hunter Elliott earned a Freshman All-SEC nod.

Bianco's Rebels have brought home a number of awards from the league office as well, including Stephen Head's SEC Player of the Year laurel in 2004, Drew Pomeranz earning SEC Pitcher of the Year honors in 2010 and the Rebels' trio of SEC Freshman of the Year winners: Seth Smith in 2002, Head in 2003 and Jordan Henry in 2007. In 2021, Tim Elko became the program's first SEC Scholar-Athlete of the Year.

Bianco has also coached five C Spire Ferriss Trophy winners, given annually to the best college baseball player in Mississippi. Head won it in 2004, followed by Brian Pettway in 2005, Scott Bittle in 2008, Pomeranz in 2010 and Auston Bousfield in 2014.

The Rebels have also celebrated great academic success under Bianco. Five of his Rebels have been named CoSIDA Academic All-District. The SEC's First-Year Academic Honor Roll has included 93 Bianco-coached Rebels, while 251 student-athletes have been selected to the SEC Academic Honor Roll.

National Treasure

Bianco's on-field accomplishments have been recognized nationally, as the Rebel skipper was tapped as the manager of the USA Collegiate National Team before the start of the 2022 season. Under Bianco, the boys in Red, White and Blue earned the Bronze Medal at Honkbalweek in Haarlem, Netherlands.

Three Rebel players joined Bianco on the Collegiate National Team, with Jacob Gonzalez and Hunter Elliott making the travel squad that competed in The Netherlands and Mason Nichols earning a spot on the initial Collegiate National Team training camp roster that competed in the Stars vs. Stripes intrasquad series in North Carolina.

Ole Miss has a strong history with Team USA. 12 Rebels have competed internationally for USA Baseball in the Bianco Era. Seth Smith and Stephen Head both competed for the 2003 edition of the Collegiate National Team. Zack Cozart made the national squad in 2006, and Cody Satterwhite and Lance Lynn kept that going in 2007.

Drew Pomeranz became the sixth Rebel to sport the American flag uniform in 2009, followed by Bobby Wahl in 2012 and Dallas Woolfolk in 2017. Parker Caracci carried on the tradition in 2018, earning a spot on the Team USA

roster, where he posted a perfect 0.00 ERA with two saves and opposing batting average of .094 in 9.2 innings of work. Doug Nikhazy made it three straight seasons with a Rebel arm wearing the Stars and Stripes, earning a spot on the 24-man roster for the 2019 summer.

Top Recruiter

Not only have fans and the media covering college baseball noticed Ole Miss' resurgence under Bianco, some of the top talent in the country is also taking a close look at the Rebels.

Seventeen of Bianco's 22 recruiting classes at Ole Miss have garnered top-20 national rankings, including 10 that have placed in the top-10. His first recruiting class was rated as one of the nation's 10 best by both Collegiate Baseball and Baseball America, including a No. 6 ranking by Collegiate Baseball.

The 2003 recruiting class was ranked No. 10 by Collegiate Baseball, while the 2011 class was ranked third nationally by Collegiate Baseball and fifth by Baseball America. It marked the first top-5 recruiting class for Bianco at Ole Miss. In the fall of 2016, Rebel Baseball earned the No. 1 ranking in national recruiting rankings by both Baseball America and D1Baseball.com. The top ranking was the first No. 1 recruiting class in the history of not only the baseball program but all of Ole Miss athletics.

Just when that 2016 class cycled through, the Rebels reloaded with another elite class. The 2019 Ole Miss class ranked No. 2 in the nation, highlighted by four prospects who were taken in the MLB Draft but chose instead to play in Oxford. The 2019 group included four of Perfect Game's top 50 prospects—the only class in the country of its kind. Bianco brought in another top-five class in 2022 with Perfect Game's No. 4 ranked recruiting class.

Foundation of Success

Bianco's winning ways can be traced back to his playing days. After spending two seasons at Indian River (Fla.) Community College, he played two seasons for Skip Bertman at perennial national-power LSU in 1988 and 1989. He was the starting catcher and team captain for the Tigers' 1989 team that finished third at the College World Series in Omaha, Nebraska. He homered in LSU's 6-3 win over Miami (Fla.) in the 1989 CWS to help advance the Tigers to the semifinals.

While working behind the plate for LSU, Bianco caught major league pitchers Ben McDonald, Russ Springer, Curtis Leskanic, John O'Donoghue, Chad Ogea and Paul Byrd.

His time behind the plate as a player would later benefit him as he served as LSU's pitching coach during three World Series championship teams in the 1990s. Bianco also worked with the pitchers during his three years as head coach at McNeese State, and continues to serve in that same capacity with the Rebels.

Omaha Experience

Following his playing career, he joined Jim Wells' (former head coach at Alabama) coaching staff at Northwestern State, where he served two seasons from 1991-1992 as a graduate assistant. He helped coach Northwestern State to a 1991 Southland Conference (SLC) championship and an appearance in the 1991 NCAA South I Regional.

He then returned to Baton Rouge where he joined Bertman's staff at LSU. In five seasons at LSU (1993-1997), the Tigers advanced to the College World Series four times and claimed three national championships. LSU also won three Southeastern Conference crowns and two SEC Tournament titles in that five-year span.

After the Tigers' 1997 College World Series title run, Bianco was named the head coach at McNeese State in July of that year.

Bianco Earns Head Coaching Experience

After seven seasons as an assistant at Northwestern (La.) State and LSU, Bianco received his first head coaching opportunity, taking over the reins of McNeese State.

He quickly displayed his abilities to develop a competitive

program. In his first season with the Cowboys in 1998, he engineered an 11-game improvement from 1997, posting a 30-26 record - the first of three 30-win seasons. The 1998 season also saw the Cowboys rise to third in the conference standings and qualify for the SLC Tournament.

Following a 31-25 campaign in 1999, Bianco's 2000 team produced one of the most successful seasons in McNeese State history. The Cowboys finished 39-20, including winning a school-record 20 SLC games en route to claiming their first conference title since 1988, and making their third-ever appearance in the NCAA Regionals. In recognition, Bianco was named the SLC's Coach of the Year.

Bianco's 2000 McNeese State team raked in the individual postseason awards. Four Cowboys were named to the SLC's first team, including the conference's Hitter and Newcomer of the Year in Chris Williamson, and the SLC's Pitcher of the Year in Chris Howay.

Power hitting was the Cowboys' trademark under Bianco, as they hit 212 home runs in his three seasons, including a school-record 81 in 1999. His 2000 team batted .305 and set a new school standard for hits in a season with 600.

Personal Background

Bianco, 55, was born May 3, 1967, and is a native of Seminole, Florida. He is married to the former Camille Marquette, and the couple has five children: sons, Michael, Benjamin, Andrew and Samuel, and one daughter, Catherine.

Bianco was inducted into the Indian River Community College Hall of Fame in 2003. He was also named to the
