• **Player of the Week:** Florida's Brody Donay tallied 18 total bases, three homers, two doubles, six runs, five RBI, two walks and one stolen base in Florida's three-game sweep of Air Force. Donay homered in all three games, with all three blasts traveling over 400 feet. He batted 7-for-10 (.700/.750/1.800) across Florida's three games and was intentionally walked in his final at bat of the weekend in game three. Donay finished a triple shy of the cycle in Florida's season opener.

• **Pitcher of the Week:** Texas' Luke Harrison blanked SEC foe Ole Miss to help the Longhorns earn the Shriners Children's College Showdown title. Harrison retired 16 of the first 19 batters he faced on Saturday, recording a career-long 6.1 innings and a career-best six strikeouts. The left-hander surrendered only two hits and one walk to earn the win just his third career start.

• **Co-Freshman of the Week:** Texas' Adrian Rodriguez helped guide the Longhorns to the Shriners Children's College Showdown in his debut weekend, highlighted by a 10-0 run-rule win over SEC foe Ole Miss and a 14-8 victory over No. 17 Oklahoma State. Rodriguez slashed .429/.467/1.071 with a pair of home runs and three RBI. He closed out the weekend with his best performance, posting a four-hit effort, highlighted by a pair of doubles and a home run vs. Oklahoma State.

• **Co-Freshman of the Week:** Texas A&M's Terrence Kiel II led the team with a .500 batting average and helped lead the Aggies to a season-opening sweep over Elon. After reaching base twice on Friday, Kiel had a pair of hits and two RBI on Saturday. Kiel then added two more hits, two runs scored and a walk in the series finale on Sunday. He also topped the squad with two multi-hit contests on the weekend.

• Week 2 of the 2025 season features the first slate of midweek games followed by weekend series. SEC teams combined to go 39-7 during opening weekend.

• Twelve different SEC programs are ranked in the top-25 of the major polls entering the season's second week. Texas A&M is ranked No. 1 in all five polls, while LSU and Tennessee are ranked as high as No. 2. Arkansas and Georgia are ranked as high as No. 4. High rankings for other SEC squads are Florida at No. 6, Texas at No. 12, Vanderbilt at No. 13, Mississippi State at No. 16, Oklahoma at No. 20, Kentucky at No. 23 and Auburn at No. 25.

• The SEC is coming off a year in which a record 11 of its teams earned NCAA Tournament bids and four teams advanced to the College World Series.

• At least one SEC team has reached the College World Series finals 15 times in the last 16 tournaments.

• A total of 44 SEC baseball student-athletes are eligible to wear the SEC graduate patch on their uniforms this season, signifying that they have earned their college degrees.

• Five SEC coaches rank among the winningest active Division I coaches in the nation: Paul Mainieri (1st, 1,508 wins), Dave Van Horn (4th with 1,258 wins), Tim Corbin (8th with 1,030 wins), Mike Bianco (9th with 1,008 wins) and Jim Schlossnagle (11th with 948 wins).

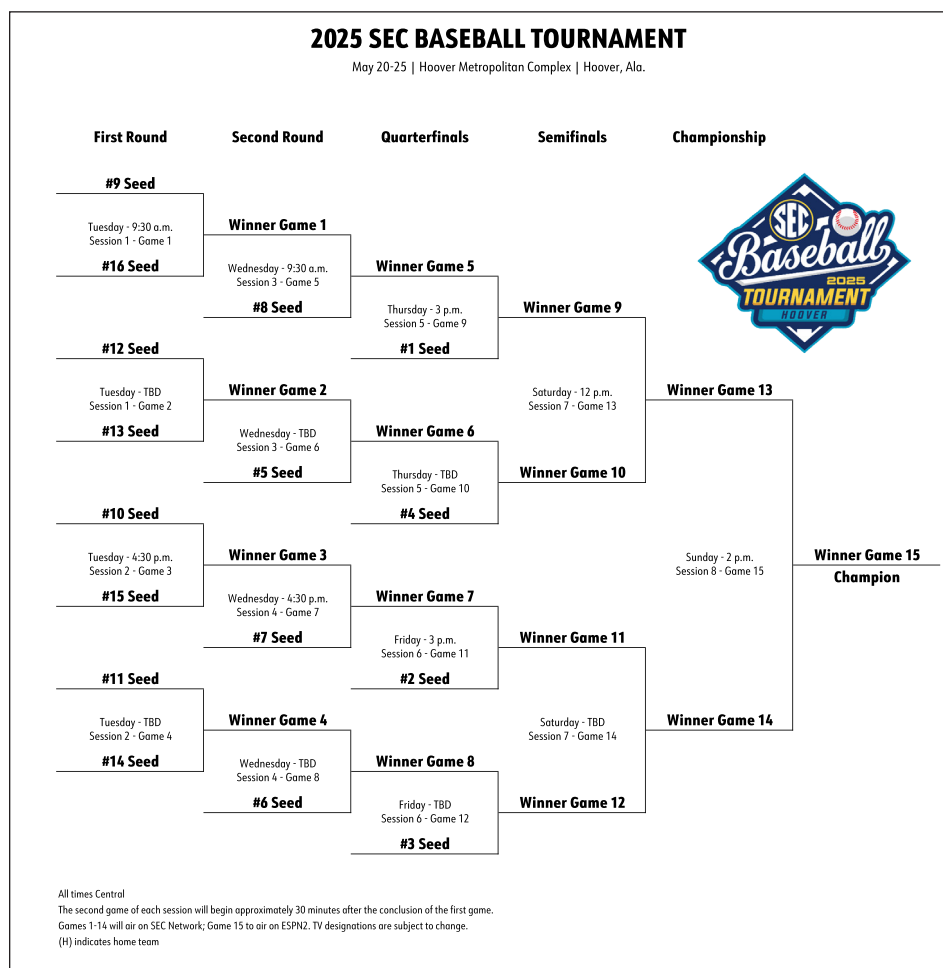

### Seeding

Teams shall be seeded based on winning percentage in regular season conference competition. Ties will be broken in the following manner:

1. Two-Team Tie. The following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken:
  - A. Won-lost results of head-to-head competition between the two tied teams.
  - B. Won-lost percentage of the two teams against all common opponents
  - C. Won-lost percentage of the two teams versus the highest seed using common opponents only (and proceeding through the last seed, if necessary)
  - D. Best cumulative winning percentage of all Conference opponents
  - E. Coin flip by the Commissioner.
2. Three-Team Tie (or more). The following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken: (Note: If the three tied teams have three different records against each other, they shall be seeded in best-percentage order.) Otherwise, once the tie has been reduced to two teams, the two-team tiebreaker procedure will be used.
  - A. If all tied teams are common opponents: Total won-lost percentage of games played among the tied teams.
  - B. Won-lost percentage of the tied teams against all common opponents
  - C. Won-lost percentage of the tied teams versus the highest seed using common opponents only, and proceeding through the lowest seed, if necessary. In the event of multiple ties, they shall be broken from first to last (e.g. a tie for first place will be broken before a tie for fourth place).
  - D. Best cumulative winning percentage of all Conference opponents.
  - E. If three or more teams still are tied, the Commissioner will conduct a draw.
