• Co-Players of the Week: Georgia's Ryland Zaborowski batted .438 (7-for-16) with one double, six home runs and 18 RBI in just four games in helping No. 5 Georgia extend its winning streak to 15 now at 18-1. He posted a 1.563 slugging percentage with 25 total bases in just four games in wins over Georgia State and Columbia. Zaborowski smashed two home runs with career-high 7 RBI in back-to-back games. Arkansas' Wehiwa Aloy recorded five multi-hit games and three multi RBI performances during the Razorbacks' perfect 5-0 week, slashing a team-leading .632/.667/1.136 with four doubles, three home runs and 11 RBI to power the offense. Aloy racked up an SEC-leading 12 hits and totaled 25 bases during the week, belting a pair of home runs, his first career multi-homer game

• Pitcher of the Week: Tennessee's Liam Doyle played a starring role in the ninth no-hitter in program history and first since 2002, tossing 5.2 shutout innings with 13 strikeouts vs. St. Bonaventure on Friday to earn the win and improve to 3-0 on the year. Doyle walked the leadoff man before retiring the next 17 batters he faced. The Derry, New Hampshire native's 13 punchouts were the second most in the conference during the week and brought his NCAA-leading total to 47 in just 20.1 innings pitched.

• Co-Freshmen of the Week: Tennessee's Levi Clark led all SEC freshmen with a .615 batting average for the week after going 8-for-13 with a double and a home run while driving in six runs to add to his team-leading RBI total (23). Clark posted back-to-back three hit performances in Tennessee's two midweek wins over Radford and Xavier and added three RBIs in Wednesday's win over the Musketeers. Vanderbilt's Brodie Johnston became the first Commodore since at least 2011 to hit two home runs in one inning on Friday against Xavier. The freshman hit

a two-run homer in the seventh inning before launching a walk-off grand slam later in the same frame to send the Dores home with a 15-3 run-rule win.

• Fourteen SEC teams begin conference play ranked in the national polls. Tennessee is ranked No. 1 in four polls, while LSU is No. 1 in another poll. Other teams ranked in the top-25 are: Arkansas (3), Georgia (3), Florida (6), Texas (6), Oklahoma (8), Ole Miss (13), Vanderbilt (13), Texas A&M (15), Alabama (16), Mississippi State (22), Auburn (23) and Kentucky (23). Six of the SEC weekend series feature a pair of ranked teams.

- SEC teams and individuals entering the week ranked No. 1 statistically in the NCAA include:
 - » Tennessee with a 1.83 ERA
 - » Alabama's Justin Lebron with 11 home runs and 43 RBI
 - » Georgia's Ryland Zaborowski with a 1.170 slugging percentage
 - » Tennessee's Liam Doyle with 47 strikeouts

• A total of 44 SEC baseball student-athletes are eligible to wear the SEC graduate patch on their uniforms this season, signifying that they have earned their college degrees.

• Five SEC coaches rank among the winningest active Division I coaches in the nation: Paul Mainieri (1st, 1,519 wins), Dave Van Horn (4th with 1,269 wins), Tim Corbin (8th with 1,040 wins), Mike Bianco (9th with 1,020 wins) and Jim Schlossnagle (11th with 959 wins).

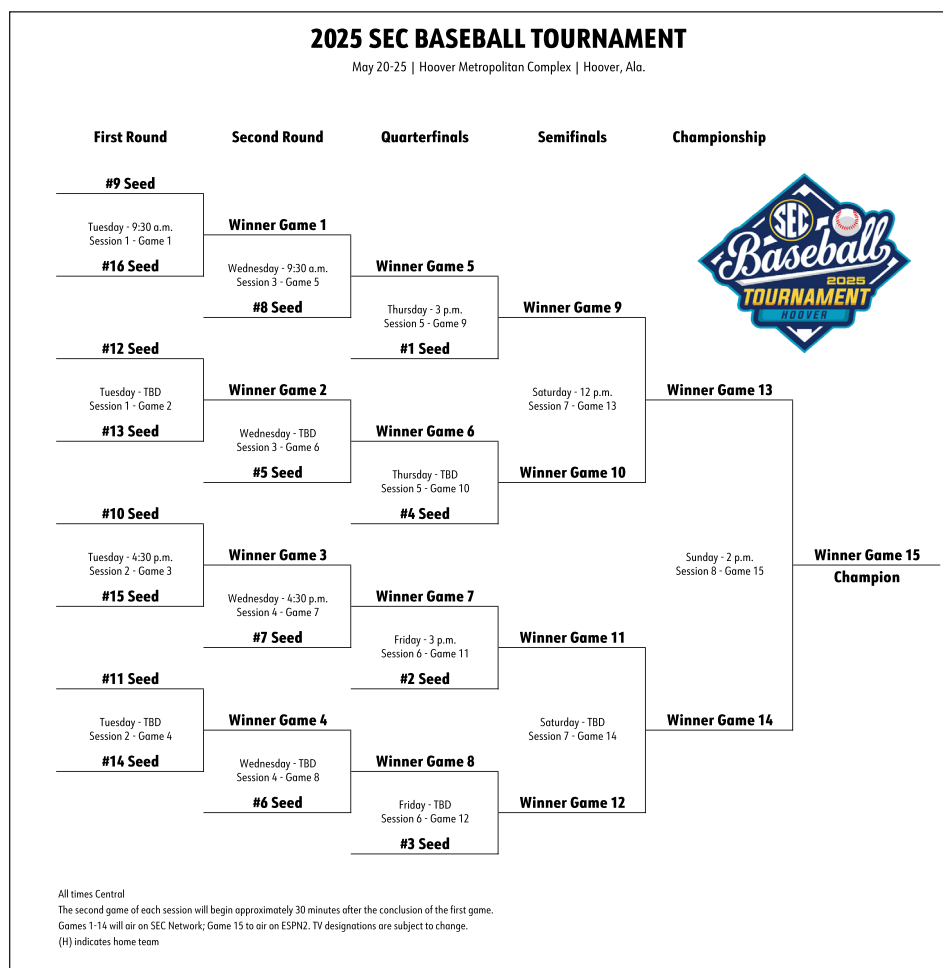
Teams shall be seeded based on winning percentage in regular season conference competition. Ties will be broken in the following manner:

1. Two-Team Tie. The following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken:

- A. Won-lost results of head-to-head competition between the two tied teams.
- B. Won-lost percentage of the two teams against all common opponents
- C. Won-lost percentage of the two teams versus the highest seed using common opponents only (and proceeding through the last seed, if necessary)
- D. Best cumulative winning percentage of all Conference opponents
- E. Coin flip by the Commissioner.

2. Three-Team Tie (or more). The following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken: (Note: If the three tied teams have three different records against each other, they shall be seeded in best-percentage order.) Otherwise, once the tie has been reduced to two teams, the two-team tiebreaker procedure will be used.

- A. If all tied teams are common opponents: Total won-lost percentage of games played among the tied teams.
- B. Won-lost percentage of the tied teams against all common opponents
- C. Won-lost percentage of the tied teams versus the highest seed using common opponents only, and proceeding through the lowest seed, if necessary. In the event of multiple ties, they shall be broken from first to last (e.g. a tie for first place will be broken before a tie for fourth place).
- D. Best cumulative winning percentage of all Conference opponents.
- E. If three or more teams still are tied, the Commissioner will conduct a draw.
