Washington State Baseball opens the 2025 season with a four-game series at fourth-ranked Arkansas. Due to rain in the Fayetteville forecast, Friday will be a doubleheader at 10 a.m. (PT), Saturday will be a single game at Noon (PT), Sunday will be off and Monday will start at 10 a.m. (PT).

ABOUT WASHINGTON STATE

Washington State finished the 2024 season 21-32 overall including a 9-21 mark in the Pac-12 Conference play. The Cougars beat No. 24 Kentucky and Kansas to win the Round Rock Classic in Texas in February and later swept Arizona State in Pullman in March. The Cougars finished second in the Pac-12 with 50 double plays turned and third with a .976 fielding percentage. Washington State has added 24 newcomers to its 34-player roster and was picked to finish third in the Mountain West Conference. Head coach Nathan Choate begins in his second season at WSU after five seasons at Loyola Marymount.

ABOUT ARKANSAS

Arkansas enters the season ranked among the Top-5 in most of the major College Baseball Top-25 Preseason Polls and as high as fourth by Baseball America. Last season, the Razorbacks went 44-16 overall including a 20-10 mark in SEC play, and went 1-2 in the NCAA Regional round. Arkansas leads the all-time series 7-3 against Washington State. The teams are meeting for the first time since facing off three times during the 2010 NCAA Regional in Fayetteville with the Razorbacks taking two of the games including 7-2 in the winner-take-all regional final.

HARTMAN NAMED PRESEASON ALL-MOUNTAIN WEST

Junior outfielder Max Hartman was named to the Preseason All-Mountain West Conference Team and the Cougars were picked to finish third. Last season, Hartman hit .286 with 55 hits, 11 doubles, three home runs and 41 RBI to go along with 32 runs scored and 10 stolen bases as the Cougars leadoff hitter. The junior from St. Albert, Alberta tallied 17 multiple-hit games and tied for the team lead with 10 multiple-RBI games. Hartman was also a CSC Academic All-District and conference honor roll selection after posting a 3.56 GPA while majoring in civil engineering.

Five Washington State Baseball student-athletes were named CSC Academic All-District by the College Sports Communicators. Senior pitchers Andrew Baughn, Chase Grillo and Grant Taylor along with sophomore outfielder Max Hartman and senior infielder Crew Parke each earned the recognition while Taylor will be up for Academic All-America honors. The five selections after the most Academic All-District selections in program history.

TOMMY RICHARDS BACK HOME AS ASSISTANT COACH

WSU added former Cougar infielder Tommy Richards as an assistant coach. Richards served as the head coach at Bushnell University (NAIA) the previous three seasons after the school started the baseball program in 2022. The Beacons increased their win total each season under Richards, capped by 29-win 2024 campaign that saw Bushnell win the Cascade Collegiate Conference Tournament Championship and earn the program's first NAIA National Tournament appearance. The former Cougar infielder played for Washington State (2009-12), appeared in 155 career games, played on WSU's last two NCAA Tournament teams in 2009 and 2010 and was later drafted by the Baltimore Orioles in the 24th round of the 2012 MLB Draft.

PLAYER RANKINGS

JOHN OLERUD NAMED PAC-12 PLAYER OF THE CENTURY

The Pac-12 Conference inducted Coug legend John Olerud into the Pac-12 Hall of Honor in 2019. Olerud was named the Pac-12 Conference's Baseball Player of the Century in 2016. During his three seasons in a Cougar uniform, Olerud (1987-89) had one of the finest careers of any Cougar studentathlete, in any sport, in Washington State history, rewriting the WSU record books and becoming the only Cougar baseball athlete ever to be named College Athlete of the Year. In 1988, Olerud became the only player in NCAA history to win 15 games on the mound and hit 20 home runs in the same season, going 15-0 with 23 home runs that year. Olerud went 26-4 overall with a 3.17 ERA over 241.1 innings during his three seasons, hitting .434. He set two Pac-10 records and 10 Pac-10 North marks, highlighted by his sophomore season when he was named Athlete of the Year by Baseball America. In January prior to his junior year at WSU, Olerud suffered a subarachnoid hemorrhage, a type of brain seizure. He missed the first 28 games of the spring season, but returned to hit .359 for WSU over the final 27 games. Prior to his senior season, Olerud signed a contract with Toronto and went directly to the Major Leagues. In 1993, he became the first Blue Jay to win a batting title, hitting .363. Olerud played for Toronto, the New York Mets and Yankees, Seattle and Boston during his 17-year career, winning back-to-back World Series titles with Toronto in 1992 and 1993. In 2001 he joined his father, John Sr., in the WSU Athletics Hall of Fame, and is a member of the College Baseball, State of Washington and Inland Northwest Sports Halls of Fame. The John Olerud Two-Way Player of the Year Award, given annually by the College Baseball Hall of Fame, was named in his honor and in 2016, he was named the Pac-12 Conference Player of the Century.

INTERIM TAG REMOVED, ANNE MCCOY TO LEAD WASHINGTON STATE ATHLETICS

The interim tag was removed and Anne McCoy was named the WSU Director of Athletics, it was announced June 25. McCoy, who spent the previous three months as Interim Director of Athletics, officially becomes the 15th person to lead Cougar Athletics and the first woman to hold the position. McCoy is no stranger to WSU, serving a variety of roles on the senior administrative team since arriving in 2001 as associate director of athletics for internal operations. McCoy, who was hired by former Cougar Athletic Director Jim Sterk, has risen within the athletic department. Most recently, she served as senior deputy director of athletics and senior woman administrator (SWA) before assuming the interim director of athletics title in March of this year. Throughout her time on WSU's senior leadership team, McCoy has been actively involved with all facets of the department, having a role in all head coaching hires since her arrival, including all current head coaches. McCoy has played a role in each area of Cougar Athletics during her tenure and served in a supervisory capacity for every WSU sport. Most recently, McCoy served as WSU's interim director of athletics since late March of 2024. In the span of three months in the interim role, McCoy secured the hiring of WSU Men's Basketball Head Coach David Riley, Head Swimming Coach Russ Whitaker and Head Women's Golf Coach Kevin Tucker, extending the contract of Women's Head Basketball Coach Kamie Ethridge, secured a home for baseball and women's swimming through affiliate membership with the Mountain West Conference for the 2024-25 and 2025-26 seasons, and was involved with the Pac-12 Conference' securing a media rights agreement with the CW Network and FOX for the 2024 football season.

WASHINGTON STATE ALUM CHRIS KING NAMED VOICE OF THE COUGS


WSU Athletics and Learfield's Washington State Sports Properties named Washington State alumnus Chris King as the new "Voice of the Cougs" in August. King, from Marysville, Wash., takes over play-by-play duties for Cougar Football, Men's Basketball and Baseball. King returns to Pullman – where he graduated from the Edward R. Murrow College of Communication in 2009 – after gaining 13 years of Division I broadcasting experience in neighboring Idaho. After two years announcing women's basketball at Boise State, King became the men's basketball broadcaster for the Idaho Vandals in 2013 before adding football broadcasting duties in 2021. In addition to his time calling college football and basketball, King also has extensive baseball experience, broadcasting Minor League Baseball for the Tri-City Dust Devils from 2012-2021. Away from the radio booth he has worked in a communications role with the West Coast League since 2016, most recently as the league's deputy commissioner. King has twice been honored as the Idaho Sportscaster of the Year (2017, 2023) by the National Sports Media Association for his work with the Vandals.

Nathan Choate begins his second year as the Washington State Head Baseball Coach after being named the 18th head baseball coach in program history June 23, 2023.

In his first season leading Washington State Baseball, Choate guided the Cougars to the Round Rock Classic title after posting wins over No. 24 Kentucky and Kansas in Texas while four players were named to the All-Tournament Team led by first baseman Joev Kramer who was named the Round Rock Classic MVP. Choate also saw his club sweep Arizona State for the second time in program history and recorded their first win at UCLA since 2014 and first win at Stanford since 2016. The Cougar defense reached new heights under Choate, turning the second-most double plays (50) in the Pac-12 Conference and posted a .976 fielding percentage, the third-best mark in program history. Choate saw three players earn All-Pac-12 honors led by ace righthander Grant Taylor who finished the season with 99 strikeouts, the seventhmost in WSU single-season history while his 76 strikeouts in conference play led the league.

In the classroom, the Cougars earned ABCA Academic Excellence accolades after setting program records with a 3.32 team GPA in the fall semester and a 3.29 overall team GPA for the school year. WSU also set a program record with five CSC Academic All-District selections while 17 were named to the WSU President's Honor Roll and 12 earned Pac-12 Spring Academic Honor Roll honors.

Choate arrived at WSU after leading Loyola Marymount to a West Coast Conference title this past season while guiding the Lions to new heights in his four seasons leading the program. Choate was named the 2023 WCC Coach of the Year after leading LMU to their first outright regular season title in 25 years with a 29-24 mark including an impressive 21-6 record in conference play, four games ahead of secondplace Portland, and swept four WCC series. Choate coached a pair of Lions to All-America honors while five players earned All-WCC honors in addition to the WCC Pitcher of the Year, Defensive Player of the Year and Freshman of the Year.

"WSU Baseball is our oldest and most storied program. Coach Nathan Choate is the exact fit we need to lead us into the next chapter of WSU Baseball," Chun said. "What he accomplished at LMU speaks for itself. His values and principles are aligned with WSU. We are excited to welcome Nathan, Lori and the Choate Family to Washington State University."

Choate's 2023 LMU club tallied road wins at Vanderbilt and Oklahoma State, claimed six WCC Pitcher of the Week honors, one WCC Player of the Week and the pitching staff finished their season ranked sixth nationally in walks per nine innings and 26th nationally in walk to strikeout ratio. Choate coached three all-conference pitchers in 2023 led by ace

with 93 strikeouts and a 2.17 ERA while Khadim Diaw earned Freshman All-America honors after hitting .314 with eight home runs, 11 doubles, two triples, 33 RBI, 47 runs scored and 66 hits. In the classroom, the Lions closed the 2023 season with a 3.18 team GPA including 24 players with a 3.0 or higher.

Throughout his coaching career, Choate has accumulated 25 players drafted in the MLB Draft, seven of which have been selected in the top-10 rounds, 10 All-Americans, two College World Series appearances, three Team USA pitchers, four Freshman All-Americans, two Big West Freshman Pitchers of the Year, two WCC Pitchers of the Year and nine All-Conference Pitchers. In the 2017 season with San Diego his team finished sixth in the country in strikeouts and his 2019 Lion pitching staff to the 14th best ERA in the nation.

"My family and I couldn't be more excited to join the Washington State University family. Thank you to President Schulz, Pat Chun and Mitch Straub for the opportunity to lead the baseball program," Choate said. We look forward to earning the respect of past, current, and future Cougs, as well as the Pullman Community. Go Cougs!"

The 2021 season saw the Lions open up with 14 straight games against the Pac-12, winning two weekend series including a three-game sweep of Utah and a road series win at Washington. In addition to his success against the Pac-12, the Lions won six of the nine weekend series versus the WCC. On the offensive end, LMU led the conference in triples with 15 and were among the WCC leaders in stolen bases and stolen bases per game. On the mound, Choate produced one of the most lethal end of game pitchers in Holden Christian who was named to the 2021 ABCA/Rawlings NCAA Division I West All-Region Second Team, finishing the year with three wins, four saves, and an ERA of 0.97. The Lions pitching staff had 342 strikeouts and four members posted an ERA of 3.43 or below.

In 2020, his first season at the helm of the Loyola Marymount Lions, Choate went 8-8 winning three of his first four weekend series including a sweep of San Jose State. Under Choate's direction the Lions pitching staff posted an ERA of 4.07 had a strikeout-to-walk ratio of 2.61, which ranked third in the WCC.

Offensively, LMU led the WCC and ranked 25th nationally in stolen bases with 32 and set the school record for steals in a game with eight at UC Davis on March 1, 2020. Choate's aggressiveness on the bases was aided by the Lions discipline at the plate resulting in 84 free passes which also led the conference.

Choate's first win came in his first game leading LMU when they beat the Washington Huskies 7-1. In 2020 he also took part in the second-longest game in NCAA history in both

Diego Barrera who earned All-America honors after going 8-2 time and length with a 24 inning, six hour and thirty minute contest on Feb. 28 - 29 at UC Davis. In the game LMU set the school record for at-bats with 79 and Trevin Esquerra tied the NCAA record and set the Lions record for at-bats with 11.

In 2019 the Lions finished with a 34-25 overall mark, won their first five series and secured a berth into the WCC Championship Tournament where they beat WCC regular season champions BYU before posting back-to-back victories over Saint Mary's to clinch their first WCC Championship Tournament Title. The Lions beat No. 24 Baylor and No. 11 UCLA in the NCAA Tournament before falling to the Bruins in the deciding game of the Los Angeles Regional. The Lions were able to nab six All-WCC selections with Codie Paiva being named WCC Pitcher of the Year.

Prior to his hiring in 2019, Choate spent the previous two years as the pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at WCC-rival San Diego. While with the Toreros, Choate helped guide USD to a combined 58-50-1 record. In his first season with San Diego in 2017, Choate's staff struck out 9.7 batters per nine innings to record the sixth-best rate in the nation and lead the WCC. Torero ace, Nick Sprengel, went 9-1 to tie a program record for win percentage and was named to the All-WCC First team. Chris Murphy was named to the Freshmen All-American team after striking out 11.61 batters per nine innings - the fifth-best rate in a single-season in program history. In his two seasons, five Torero pitchers were selected in the MLB Draft, including right-hander Paul Richan by the Chicago Cubs in the second round of the 2018 June Draft.

Before coming to USD, Choate had been the pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at Grand Canyon University for five years. While at GCU, he helped lead the 'Lopes to a DII World Series appearance and a WAC Championship while the school was transitioning to DI. Considered one of the top recruiters in the nation, Choate also spearheaded a top-35 ranked recruiting class in 2015.

Prior to his time at Grand Canyon, Choate spent four years at UC Riverside, where he served as the Highlanders' pitching coach and recruiting coordinator, helping 11 pitchers get drafted by MLB clubs, including Joe Kelly and Matt Andriese. Before UCR, Choate was the pitching coordinator for UC Irvine, which finished fourth at the 2007 College World Series.

Choate pitched collegiately at Cal Poly for two seasons, where he was awarded the Jim Newkirk Fireman's Award, given to the team's best relief pitcher, in his junior and senior seasons. He also pitched two seasons at Santa Ana Junior College in 1998 and 1999, helping the Dons to a third-place national finish in 1999.

Choate and his wife Lori have four children, Kamdyn, Chance, Kyla and Kacey,


