### #5 Georgia Bulldogs (30-8, 11-4) vs. No. 14 Arkansas (25-13, 8-7) UGA's Ike Cousins Head Baseball Coach: Wes Johnson (3rd season, 116-42)

#### Seven-Game Road Stretch Starts With No. 14 Arkansas Thursday

Georgia (30-8, 11-4 SEC), ranked as high as No. 5 in the national polls this week, begins a season-long seven-game road stretch Thursday at No. 14 Arkansas (25-13, 8-7 SEC). First pitch will be at 8 pm ET and be available on ESPNU and the Georgia Bulldog Sports Network.

Georgia has a 1.5 game lead in the SEC standings after dropping its first series in league play this past weekend to No. 21 Florida in Athens. Still, Georgia's 11-4 SEC record is its best through the first half of a 30-game slate since 2009 when it went 11-4. In 2019, Georgia finished the second half of SEC action with an 11-4 mark to post its best 30-game league record of 21-9.

In the Wes Johnson era, the Bulldogs in SEC play went 17-13 in 2024 (7-8/10-5) and 18-12 (10-5/8-7) in 2025 to earn national top eight seeds for the NCAA Tournament. Johnson, an Arkansas native, worked for Razorback head coach Dave Van Horn as his pitching coach during the 2017-18 season. Last week, Arkansas posted a road sweep of then No. 8 Alabama. They are 15-8 at home. Georgia is 6-1 on the road this year including winning series at #5 MSU and No. 21 Texas A&M.

In the series history versus UA, Georgia trails 38-30 dating to 1987. Georgia's last visit came in 2021, and it went 1-2. Last year, Georgia won a series 2-1 in Athens on a 12th-inning walk-off solo home run by Henry Hunter.

#### Georgia Leads Nation In Home Runs And SEC In Batting Average

Although it didn't hit a home run in the Florida series, Georgia smacked a couple in a 12-10 win over ETSU this past Tuesday to bring NCAA-leading total to 100. Georgia ranks in the top 10 nationally in Slugging Percentage (.622) and Runs (364), On Base Percentage (.447) and an SEC-best Batting Average (.324). Also, Georgia has a .983 Fielding Percentage.

Georgia junior C **Daniel Jackson** has a team-high 16 home runs (including three grand slams) followed by junior 3B **Tre Phelps** with 14, senior SS **Kolby Branch** is next with 13. Branch ranks tied for seventh in Georgia history with 43 home runs and has 49 for his career.

\*Georgia is averaging an NCAA-leading 2.63 Home Runs per Game (HR/G) in 2026. The 2025 squad averaged 2.40 HR/G while the 2024 team averaged 2.52 HR/G. Georgia's past two squads ranked 1-2 in school history in HR, Last season, the Bulldogs had a school-record eight players with double-digit HR as the team finished with 144. In 2024 when Georgia set a school mark with 151 HR, the Bulldogs had six players with 10+ HR including an NCAA-best 37 by Golden Spikes Award winner Charlie Condon who was the third overall pick in the MLB Draft that year (Colorado Rockies).

Georgia's first game in 2026 that it didn't hit a home run came on March 29th against USC, and it still won 9-7. Before that, the last time Georgia scored at least nine runs in a win without a home run came in 2024, a 10-0 run-rule in seven innings over UNC Asheville. With their penchant for home runs in 2026, the Bulldogs are 2-2 without hitting one, 2-3 when they register just one big fly and 26-3 when they crank two or more.

#### Phelps, Jackson & Lujo Rank Among SEC Batting Leaders

\*Junior 3B **Tre Phelps** (.393-14-39) is the SEC batting average leader. He leads the nation in Hit-By-Pitches (24) and is fifth in Runs Scored (51). Phelps has been named to the Golden Spikes Award Midseason Watch List. Phelps had an 11-game hitting streak end this past Tuesday.

\*Junior C **Daniel Jackson** (.384-16-52, 18 SB) ranks in the top 10 nationally in Home Runs, Total Bases (114) and third in the SEC in batting. Recently, he was named to the Midseason Watch Lists for the Buster Posey Collegiate Catcher of the Year and the Golden Spikes Award.

Earlier this year, Jackson had a team-best 21-game hitting streak while Phelps carried one over from last year that stretched to 27, one game shy of the school record.

\*Sophomore OF/INF **Rylan Lujo** (.365-5-23) is putting together quite a year as he ranks third on the team in batting behind the Golden Spikes Watch List duo of **Tre Phelps** and **Daniel Jackson**. Lujo has been ever better in SEC action, posting a league-best .442 mark (19-for-43) to go with three home runs and 11 RBI plus is 4-for-5 in stolen bases.

\*Graduate **Caden Aoki** (4-0, 2.55 ERA, 3 SV) and Scott have excelled out of the Bulldog bullpen.

\*UA has a 4.01 ERA with 378 strikeouts and 130 walks. Opponents are hitting .233.

## Wes JOHNSON

*Ike Cousins Head Baseball Coach  
 3rd Season at UGA  
 (Arkansas Monticello '94)*



In his first two seasons directing the University of Georgia baseball program, Wes Johnson has led the Bulldogs to 86 wins and a pair of NCAA Tournaments as a national top eight seed. On May 21, 2025, it was announced UGA and Johnson had agreed to a contract extension through 2031.

Johnson, a renowned pitching coach, was named the Ike Cousins head baseball coach at the University of Georgia on June 5, 2023. At the press conference announcing his hire, UGA's J. Reid Parker Director of Athletic Josh Brooks noted Johnson had a proven track record of developing student-athletes and that his teams at every level had achieved impressive results. Brooks added he was confident Johnson would make Georgia Baseball one of the premier programs in the country.

Johnson made an immediate impact. In his first year, he directed the Bulldogs to their most successful season since reaching the College World Series (CWS) Finals in 2008. The 2024 Bulldogs earned a No. 7 National Seed for the NCAA Tournament, captured the NCAA Athens Regional, hosted an NCAA Super Regional and came within one game of reaching the CWS.

Georgia posted a 43-17 record (17-13 SEC) as Johnson established school records for most overall wins and most SEC wins by a first-year baseball coach, and Georgia finished with a top 10 national ranking for the first time in a full season since 2008. He became the first Georgia baseball coach to host and win an NCAA Regional in his first season along with serving as a Super Regional host. In a preseason poll, SEC coaches projected Georgia would finish sixth in the Eastern Division and instead the Bulldogs placed third and had the fifth best mark in the 14-team league.

In 2024, Georgia featured one of the nation's elite players in All-America Charlie Condon, a first round selection of the Colorado Rockies and the third overall pick in the MLB Draft, the highest in school history. He earned the Dick Howser Trophy, which is widely considered the Heisman Trophy of college baseball, and USA Baseball's Golden Spikes Award as the nation's top amateur player. Condon received a then record \$9.25 million signing bonus. Also, sophomore Kolten Smith and freshman Tre Phelps received invitations to the USA Baseball Collegiate National Team Training Camp. Corey Collins joined Condon as an All-American and became the first SEC player to lead the NCAA in on base percentage, posting a .574 mark.

In 2025, Georgia raced out to another impressive start that featured a 17-game winning streak and a program-best 28-2 mark through 30 games. The Bulldogs were a consensus top 10 ranked team, including reaching as high as No. 1 during the season. They captured seven SEC series in going 18-12 in league play and entered the NCAA Tournament with the nation's No. 2 RPI and the No. 7 overall national seed. The Bulldogs played host to their second straight NCAA Regional and concluded the season with a 43-17 mark. The Bulldogs blasted an NCAA-best 144 home runs and finished second nationally in On Base Percentage at .411. A total of 10 Bulldogs were selected in the 2025 MLB Draft.

For the second consecutive season, the Bulldog pitching staff established a school record for strikeouts and lowered the team ERA. Also, the Bulldogs set a school record with a .983 fielding percentage. Robbie Burnett and Ryland Zaborowski were named semifinalists for the Dick Howser Trophy plus Burnett was a semifinalist for the Golden Spikes Trophy. Four Bulldogs earned All-SEC honors in first team third baseman Slate Alford and second team pitcher Brian Curley plus Burnett (outfield) and Zaborowski (utility). For the second year in a row, Georgia produced the SEC batting champion as Zaborowski hit .370 after Condon led the SEC and NCAA in 2024 with a .443 clip. Five Bulldogs made the CSC Academic All-District team including Burnett who became the first Bulldog to be named a first team Academic All-American.

## SEC Review

The Bulldogs dropped their SEC opening game to then No. 21 Tennessee but since then have gone 11-3 in league action and sit in first place by 1.5 games. They won their first four SEC series (2-1 over #21 UT, 2-1 @ #21 Texas A&M, 3-0 over USC, 3-0 @ #5 MSU) and then dropped one at home to No. 21 UF (2-1).

The second half of the SEC slate features trips to No. 14 Arkansas, No. 9 Auburn and Ole Miss and home series against LSU and Missouri. LSU and Ole Miss have been in and out of the top 25 this season.

## Reviewing The Bulldog Roster Construction

\*Georgia is in its third season under the leadership of Ike Cousins head baseball coach **Wes Johnson**. He became the fastest in school history to reach 100 baseball wins, needing just 137 games. David Perno is the only other UGA baseball coach to earn 100 wins in his third season in 2004 (175th game).

\*Georgia's 2026 roster has 15 returnees, five freshmen, one hitter from junior college and 20 players from the portal. Georgia had 17 players from 2025 sign pro contracts including 10 draft picks.

## Excellent Progress In The Johnson Era

Georgia has made an impressive jump in its performance at the plate and on the mound era with the arrival of **Wes Johnson** and his staff in 2024. Johnson serves as the the pitching coach while assistant head coach **Will Coggin** and **Nick Ammirati** direct the offense and **Brock Bennett** is the recruiting coordinator. Georgia has posted strong starts and kept that momentum going into SEC play. In 2025, Georgia entered conference with a 19-1 mark and on a 16-game winning streak. In 2024, the Bulldogs were 17-1 when SEC play began. Both teams finished 43-17. In 2026, Georgia was 15-3 at the start of SEC.

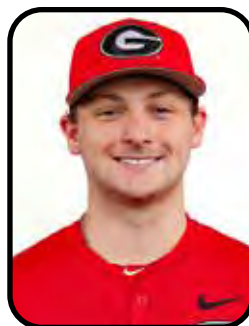

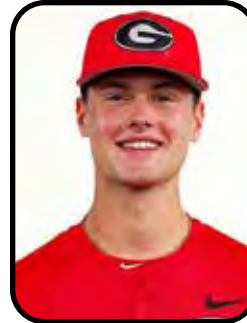
