## STARTING 9

- Missouri State (17-9, 6-3 Conference USA) returns to Hammons Field at 6 p.m. Tuesday for a matchup against 17th-ranked Arkansas (19-10, 4-5 SEC).
- Missouri State is ranked 11th in the NCAA RPI through March 29. The Bears have played the 15th-toughest schedule, with opponents combining for a .626 winning percentage, and are projected to finish 37th in that metric as remaining opponents have a combined .595 winning percentage.
- The Bears have homered in 179 of the last 212 games, including 24 of 26 this season, and rank 7th nationally with 475 long balls since the beginning of the 2022 season, when head coach Joey Hawkins took over as hitting coach. Mo State ranks second in Conference USA and 8th nationally this year with 53 homers. The current roster has combined for 155 round-trippers in their time at Mo State.
- According to TruMedia, Missouri State hitters rank 11th nationally in hard hit % with 47.3 percent of batted balls at 95 mph or better, and 12th with an average exit velocity on batted balls of 90.4 mph. The Bears are one of the two highest-rated non-Power Four school in both categories.
- Junior **Caden Bogenpohl** ranks 15th nationally with 30 walks this season after drawing 53 and 55 (season record) his first two years. His 138 career free passes are 2nd in school history, 16 behind Bill Mueller's mark of 154. Bogenpohl also ranks tied for 13th at Mo State with 37 career home runs. Bogenpohl ranks 5th among active Division I players in career walks and 29th in home runs.
- Senior **Taeg Gollert** is 2nd among active NCAA players (all divisions) with 66 doubles and has a pair of Missouri State program records in his sights. His doubles total ranks 2nd in program history, just 1 behind Brayden Drake's record of 67, and his 102 career extra-base hits currently place him 4th, which is 14 behind Jason Hart's record of 116. Gollert also ranks 13th among active Division I players with 220 hits and 24th with 156 RBIs.
- Missouri State is 30-7 at home under Joey Hawkins and boasts a .334 batting average and .636 slugging percentage with 88 total home runs and a 10.2 scoring average in those 37 games. The Bears are 11-0 at Hammons Field and own the fifth-longest active home winning streak nationally.
- Max Knight** and **Curry Sutherland** headline Missouri State's two-way threats this season. Knight has made starts at 1B, LF, RF, DH and P this year, and has 18 homers and 64 RBIs as a Bear while going 9-2 with 5 saves and 88 strikeouts in 67 innings. Sutherland owns career totals of 21 homers and 66 RBIs while throwing 25 innings with 28 Ks.
- Missouri State is in its first season in Conference USA in 2026 after a 35-year run in the Missouri Valley Conference. The Bears went 488-347 (.584) with seven regular season championship and five tournament titles in The Valley from 1991-2025.

## LEADING OFF

Missouri State (17-9, 6-3 Conference USA) returns to Hammons Field at 6 p.m. Tuesday for a matchup against 17th-ranked Arkansas (19-10, 4-5 SEC).

The Bears remain at home for Easter weekend, taking home Sam Houston at 6:30 p.m. Friday, 2 p.m. Saturday and 1 p.m. Sunday.

## SERIES HISTORY

MoState is 31-59 all-time against Arkansas with a 14-22 record in Springfield. The Bears won the last meeting at Hammons Field, 8-4 in April 2023, in what was the Razorbacks' only true road midweek game since their previous visit to Springfield in 2019

Since the beginning of the 2015 season, Missouri State owns a 10-9 record against Arkansas, joining Florida, LSU and Vanderbilt as the only programs nationally above .500 against the Hogs (minimum 10 meetings) over that span.

## HAWK AT HOME

Missouri State is 30-7 at home under Joey Hawkins and boasts a .334 batting average and .636 slugging percentage with 88 total home runs and a 10.2 scoring average in those 37 games. Mo State is also 10-0 in home weekend series (3+ games) under Hawkins and 6-0 in conference series.

In 2026, the Bears are 11-0 at Hammons Field, batting .346 and slugging .688 with 30 homers and an 11.1 scoring average.

The 11-0 home start is the program's best since a 13-0 start to the 2001 home schedule and is the fifth-longest active home winning streak in the nation. The 1969 club also won its first 13 home games.

## STEALS RECORD

Missouri State stole 10 bases in its March 8 victory against Memphis, tying a school single-game record set twice previously, in 1985 and 1986. Jax Ryan swiped three bags, Jackson Beaman and Charlie Carter stole two each, and Caden Bogenpohl, Taeg Gollert and Logan Fyffe each had one.

## PRESEASON PREDICTIONS

Missouri State is picked to finish sixth in Conference USA this season with Caden Bogenpohl and Max Knight receiving preseason all-conference recognition in a vote of the league's coaches. DBU is the favorite, followed by Louisiana Tech, Kennesaw State, Jacksonville State, Western Kentucky and the Bears.

Additionally, Bogenpohl is a preseason All-America selection according to Baseball America (Third Team) and Perfect Game (Third Team) and is PG's CUSA preseason player of the year.

## NON-CON SUCCESS

MSU has been solid against non-conference competition over the last decade, compiling a 178-135 (.569) record in regular-season games versus non-league foes since the start of the 2015 season. The Bears have won 86 of their last 124 regular-season non-conference home games.

## BEARS IN THE PRO RANKS

Missouri State has had 23 players selected in the first 12 rounds of the Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft since 2010. In 2025, Drake Baldwin became the 24th Bear to play in the majors when he got the 2025 Opening Day start at catcher for Atlanta, eventually becoming the second MoState alum to earn National League Rookie of the Year honors (Ryan Howard, 2005)

Drake Baldwin (Braves), Jake Burger (Rangers), Pierce Johnson (Reds) and Drew Millas (Nationals) began the 2026 season on Big League rosters.

Overall, the Bears have produced 163 players who have gone on to sign professional contracts over 62 years as a varsity program.

## PROS ON STAFF

Head coach Joey Hawkins and two Mo State assistants have played or coached professional baseball, or both.

Hawkins reached as high as Double-A in the St. Louis Cardinals organization as a player and coached there from 2019-21, serving as hitting coach for High-A Peoria prior to coming to Missouri State as an assistant in the summer of 2021.

Associate head coach Geoff Jimenez worked in the minor leagues for both Philadelphia and Seattle, and came back for his second stint at MSU after working as assistant hitting coach for Double-A Arkansas in 2022.

Pitching coach Deck McGuire was the 11th overall pick in the 2010 MLB Draft and pitched in the big leagues for Cincinnati, Toronto and the Los Angeles Angels as well as in the Korean Baseball Organization, where he threw the 14th no-hitter in league history as a member of the Samsung Lions.

## BEARS ON AIR

Missouri State baseball returns to the radio airwaves in southwest Missouri this season with games broadcast on KBFL 96.9 FM and 1060 AM in Springfield. Additionally, a 30-minute weekly episode of Inside the Den with head coach Joey Hawkins airs on those same stations on Wednesdays at 7 p.m. beginning March 18.

The full schedule plus postseason competition will be live on The Jock with the exception of dates that conflict with Missouri State men's and women's basketball games and select other live sporting events on the station.

All games will continue to be on the Varsity Network app provided by Learfield as well. Fans can download the app for iPhone or Android use for instant access to free game day audio streams and receive push notifications to remind them of games starting or upcoming audio broadcasts.

## CUSA TOURNAMENT FORMAT

The Conference USA Baseball Championship takes place from May 20-24 in Kennesaw, Ga. The top nine teams following the regular season will advance to play a two-game pool play style tournament with a single-elimination semifinal round and championship game.

From May 20-22 each of the nine qualified teams will play two games, with the three pods split up as follows;

- Seeds 1, 6 and 9
- Seeds 2, 5 and 8
- Seeds 3, 4 and 7

## HEAD COACH JOEY HAWKINS

Joey Hawkins was named Missouri State's third head baseball coach on June 4, 2024. Hawkins played shortstop for the Bears from 2012-15 and was a team captain his final two seasons, returned to his alma mater as hitting coach and recruiting coordinator in June 2021 and was promoted to associate head coach one year later.

Hawkins was the fourth-youngest Division I head coach at 31 years old at the time of his hire.

Since Hawkins took over as hitting coach in 2022, the Bears rank seventh nationally with 475 home runs, including four of the top eight single season totals in program history and three of the top eight in Missouri Valley Conference history at the time the Bears departed the league following the 2025 campaign. A total of 14 Bears have combined for 21 seasons of double-digit home runs under his tutelage. In addition to its long ball prowess, MoState has also posted three of the top five seasons in school history in terms of walks drawn under Hawkins' watch.

Hawkins has mentored a total of 10 players to 15 all-conference selections, including seven all-league picks as a head coach. Five Bears have earned specialty awards under his tutelage, including MVC Player of the Year citations for Spencer Nivens (2023) and Nick Rodriguez (2025), one MVC Freshman of the Year (Zack Stewart, 2023), one MVC Newcomer of the Year (Max Knight, 2025) and one MVC Defensive Player of the Year (Tyler Epstein, 2025). Rodriguez, Knight, Stewart and Caden Bogenpohl each earned All-America honors as well.

Eight of Hawkins' pupils at Missouri State - four hitters from his time as an assistant and four more players as a head coach - have signed pro contracts through 2025, including a pair of top five round draft picks in Drake Baldwin and Nivens. Baldwin made his MLB debut with Atlanta on Opening Day in 2025 and went on to win National League Rookie of the Year honors that same season.

A fan favorite during his time as a Missouri State player, Hawkins spent four seasons with the Bears from 2012-15 and was the MVC Defensive Player of the Year as a senior. He owns the top two single seasons in school history for sacrifice bunts and assists, holds MSU's career sacrifice record with 62, and led the NCAA in that category during the Bears' historic 2015 campaign that saw the team earn the No. 8 national seed and win the Springfield Regional on the way to a school-record 49 victories.

After college, Hawkins was drafted by St. Louis in the 40th round and spent two years playing professionally, advancing to the Double-A Springfield Cardinals in 2016.

Hawkins began his collegiate coaching career in 2017 as the recruiting coordinator and hitting coach at Jefferson College and joined the Division I ranks at Saint Louis University later that year in the same capacity.

Hawkins returned to professional baseball in the St. Louis Cardinals organization in 2019, beginning as a hitting coach in the Gulf Coast League, worked as a hitting coordinator at the Cardinals' alternate site facility in 2020 with some of the organization's top prospects, and served as hitting coach for the High-A Peoria Chiefs to start the 2021 season.
