SHORT HOPS

- **Oklahoma State** begins the 2026 season against three ranked opponents in the **Shriners Children's College Showdown** at Globe Life Field in Arlington, Texas.
- **The Cowboys open** with No. 5 Arkansas before facing Bedlam-rival and 19th-ranked Oklahoma. They close out the tourney against No. 17 Vanderbilt.
- This marks the **second consecutive season** the Pokes have opened their season at the Shriners Showdown. They went 1-2 at the tourney a year ago.
- OSU is coming off a 30-25 season in which it **advanced to the finals of the NCAA Athens Regional**. The Cowboys finished seventh in the Big 12 with a 15-12 mark.
- The 2026 season marks **OSU's 14th under** the direction of **head coach Josh Holliday**.

- **Arkansas** is coming off a 50-15 season in which it advanced to the College World Series, and the Razorbacks begin 2026 ranked as high as fifth nationally.
- Head coach Dave Van Horn is in his **24th season as Arkansas head coach** and owns a 933-472 record at the school.
- **Oklahoma** was 38-22 last season and lost in the finals of the NCAA Chapel Hill Regional.
- In his **ninth season leading the Sooners**, head coach Skip Johnson sports a 267-175 record.
- **Vanderbilt**, ranked as high as No. 17, is coming off a 43-18 season; the Commodores lost in the NCAA Nashville Regional
- Head coach Tim Corbin brings a 964-461-1 record into his **24th season leading Vanderbilt**.

HEAD COACH JOSH HOLLIDAY



Head Coach | 14th Season | Oklahoma State, 2004

Josh Holliday returned home to Stillwater in 2012 poised to lead the Oklahoma State baseball program back to national prominence, and he has done just that over the last 13 seasons.

Holliday took over OSU baseball on June 8, 2012, when he was named the 15th head coach in program history. The Oklahoma State alumnus and native of Stillwater had served the previous three seasons as an assistant coach at Vanderbilt and established himself as one of the nation's top assistant coaches over a span of just over a decade.

Holliday's hire has paid huge dividends as he has led the OSU program back to national prominence in his first 13 seasons at the helm.

Since Holliday took over the reins, the Cowboys have never failed to make the postseason as he has guided them to 12 NCAA Regional appearances. During his tenure, the program has also celebrated five Big 12 Conference championships, including the program's first-ever regular season title, three NCAA Super Regional berths and a return to the College World Series for the first time since his playing days in 1999.

Over his 13 seasons, OSU has won 475 games, the second-highest win total among Big 12 teams during that span, and has finished first or second in the conference standings eight times. His win total ranks as the second highest in program history, trailing only Gary Ward's 953.

OSU's time under Holliday has also yielded 109 All-Big 12 Conference performers, 77 Major League Baseball Draft picks, 17 All-Americans, four Big 12 Newcomer of the Year winners, two Big 12 Pitcher of the Year honorees and a Big 12 Player of the Year.

The Cowboys have also raised their performance in the classroom under Holliday. OSU has earned the ABCA Team Academic Excellence Award each of the last six years, posting a team grade point average above 3.0 from 2020-25.

During his tenure, the program has counted over 100 graduates, and a dozen of those graduated with honors.

OSU has had 158 Academic All-Big 12 performers under Holliday, including a conference-record 20 in 2021. In 2024, Nolan Schubart became the sixth Cowboy in program history to earn Academic All-America honors, and Zach Ehrhard was named OSU's first-ever Big 12 Baseball Scholar-Athlete of the Year.

Holliday is the first former OSU player to serve as the program's head coach. A four-year letterwinner for the Cowboys from 1996-99, Holliday was a starter on Cowboy teams that made four NCAA Tournament appearances and reached the College World Series in 1996 and 1999.

During a career that spanned 256 games, which ranks second all time at OSU, Holliday compiled a career .311 batting average to go along with 53 home runs, 62 doubles and 237 RBIs. He was inducted into the OSU Baseball Hall of Fame in 2003.

Holliday's name is prominent throughout the OSU record book. He is OSU's all-time leader in base on balls with 225 and also ranks in the top five on the Cowboys' career lists in games, at bats, runs, hits, doubles, total bases, RBIs and hit by pitches. He also ranks seventh all-time in homers.

Holliday was a three-time All-Big 12 performer (1997-99) and two-time All-American (1998-99).

Close Calls

- OSU is 97-71 (.577) in **games decided by one run** under Josh Holliday; the Cowboys were 4-7 in one-run games last season.

K Kounter

- In the first 110 seasons of Cowboy Baseball, no OSU pitching staff recorded **600 strikeouts** in a season, but the Pokes reached that mark in three consecutive seasons from 2022-24. Last year's staff posted 514 Ks.
- In 2022, the Cowboys shattered the **program record for strikeouts in a season with 679**, besting the previous mark by 91. The total ranked fifth nationally, and OSU was seventh in the NCAA in strikeouts per nine innings at 10.7.
- In 2023, OSU led the Big 12 and was ninth in the NCAA with **627 strikeouts**; its 10.7 strikeouts per nine innings ranked seventh nationally.
- In 2024, the Cowboys racked up **663 strikeouts** to rank eighth nationally, and OSU was sixth in the NCAA with 11.0 strikeouts per nine innings.

Century Mark

- OSU eclipsed the **100 home run mark** in 2023 and 2024 and **just missed the mark last season** with 98 round trippers, a total that ranked second in the Big 12 and 22nd nationally.
- OSU **returns 52 percent** of its home run production as seven of the Cowboys' returners combined for 51 homers in 2025.

Get Hot At The Right Time

- OSU had an impressive late-season surge to end 2025. Entering its game at Cincinnati on April 27, OSU's record stood at 18-21. But the Pokes picked up an 8-1 win in that game against the Bearcats, which **sparked them to a 10-2 record over their last 12 games** to earn another NCAA Regional berth.
- Over that span, OSU **swept home series against UCF and Arizona State** and took 2-of-3 at Baylor before going 1-1 at the Big 12 Championship.

- OSU was the No. 3 seed at the Athens Regional and **knocked off host and No. 7 national seed Georgia** to reach the finals before losing to Duke.

Less Is Mo

- Whether as a starter or reliever, **Mario Pesca** was one of the Cowboys' top pitchers in his first season in Stillwater in 2025. As a senior, he's looking to play an even bigger role - in a smaller body; Pesca **dropped over 30 pounds** in the offseason moved.
- In **23 appearances last season**, including eight starts, Pesca went 7-3 with a 4.46 ERA and 60 strikeouts in 66 2/3 innings.
- The righty **moved into the starting rotation** over the last six weeks of the season and in those **six starts**, he went 4-2 with 26 strikeouts in 34 1/3 innings. By comparison, in 15 stints out of the bullpen, he was 3-1 and tallied 28 strikeouts in 25 1/3 innings
- Pesca spent his first two seasons at St. John's, where he earned All-Big East First Team honors in 2024 as a sophomore.

Bruegge's Back

- Thanks to what has been dubbed the Diego Pavia Rule, **Colin Brueggemann** is back for his fourth season in an OSU uniform in 2026. Brueggemann played the 2022 season at Johnson County CC before beginning his Cowboy career in 2023.
- Brueggemann has played in 156 career games with 142 starts and is a .285 hitter with 35 homers, 35 doubles and 140 RBIs. He's been an **All-Big 12 performer all three seasons**, earning second-team plaudits in 2023 and 2024 and honorable mention accolades in 2025.
- In 2025, Brueggemann **led the Cowboys** with 18 multiple hit and 14 multiple RBI games and ranked second on the club in homers, doubles and RBIs.

Regional Ritchie

- Kollin Ritchie **saved his best for the biggest stage** in his sophomore season as he had a NCAA Regional to remember in Athens.
- In the four Regional games, **Ritchie hit .538** (7-for-13) with five home runs, a double, four walks and 10 RBIs. He also had a **highlight-reel catch in center field** to rob Duke of a home run in the Regional final.
- Ritchie homered in five of OSU's last six games of the 2025 season. He **reached base safely in the final 16 games** and ended the year on a six-game hitting streak.
- Ritchie graduated from **Atoka High School**, whose mascot is the **Wampus Cats**. What exactly is a Wampus Cat? Descriptions vary - just go ahead and Google it (trust me!).
- Former World Champion Bull Rider**, the late Lane Frost, also attended Atoka High School. Atoka, which is in southeastern Oklahoma and has a

population of just under 3,000, is also home to Reba's Place, a steakhouse and live music venue owned by **country music star Reba McEntire**.

Senior Southpaws

- In lefties **Drew Blake and Brennan Phillips**, the Cowboys have a pair of hurlers who have combined for **115 career appearances**. The duo has 142 strikeouts in 133 innings and to go along with 10 wins.
- Blake **ranks eighth all time** at OSU with 75 career appearances.

One Last Ride

- Returning for his fifth season with the Cowboys, **Aidan Meola** will look to avoid the injury bug that has limited him to 109 games over parts of four seasons.
- Meola started OSU's first 13 games last season before **suffering a shoulder injury** that required season-ending surgery.
- Meola **played a career-high 43 games in 2024**, hitting .329 with 12 doubles, 10 homers and 47 RBIs to earn All-Big 12 honors.
- The **youngest son of hall of fame soccer goalie Tony**, Meola owns a **career .314 batting average** with 15 homers and 83 RBIs.

New Faces

- OSU's 2026 roster **includes 26 newcomers** - 16 freshmen, seven JUCO transfers and three D1 transfers.
- The list of newcomers includes players from **13 different states**, including five from California, four from Illinois and three from Missouri.
- Five Cowboys were named among the **nation's Top 100 Freshmen for the 2026 class** according to *D1Baseball*. Those included Danny Wallace, Terrance Bowen, Remo Indomenico, Quinn Schambow and Sebastian Norman.
- Indomenico and Norman also made **Perfect Game's Top 100 Freshmen list**, as did Parker Jennings and Zane Burns.
- Five Cowboys were on the **2025 MLB Draft Top 100 Freshmen On Campus** list - Indomenico, Schambow, Bowen, Norman and Danny Wallace.

Size Them Up

- Eleven players on the OSU roster, 10 of those pitchers, stand **6-foot-5 or taller**; Hunter Watkins is the tallest at 6-9.

• OSU's 2026 roster includes **two players** who were MLB Draft picks. **Kollie Ritchie** was a 19th-round pick of Baltimore in 2023, while **Noah Wech** was also chosen in the 19th round of the 2024 draft by Milwaukee.

Pro Pokes

• **39 former Cowboys** were on professional baseball rosters during the 2025 season.

World Series Champion Cowboy

• **Justin Wroblewski** became the fifth former Cowboy to **play for a World Series champion** when he achieved the feat with the Los Angeles Dodgers in 2025.

• Wroblewski made **four relief appearances in the Fall Classic** and tossed five shutout innings while striking out six.

• The southpaw was the **ninth former OSU player** to play in a World Series.

• Wroblewski **pitched for the Pokes in 2021**, making eight starts and going 3-2 with 50 strikeouts in 40 2/3 innings prior to a season-ending injury.

Bursting Onto The Scene In The Big Apple

• **Nolan McLean** was a late season call up of the New York Mets in 2025, and he made the most of the opportunity.

• A right-handed pitcher, **McLean went 5-1 with a 2.06 ERA** and 57 Ks in 48 IP in eight starts.

• He was the first MLB pitcher to **win his first four career starts** since 2014 and the **second pitcher in MLB history** to go 4-0 with a sub-1.50 ERA and 25-plus strikeouts over his first four career starts.

• McLean was a **two-way standout for the Cowboys in three seasons in Stillwater** from 2021-23, hitting .270 with 36 homers in 139 games and going 3-4 with 11 saves and a 4.55 ERA in 39 appearances on the mound. He **signed with the Mets in 2023** after they drafted him in the third round.

Orange Blood

• Baseball — and Oklahoma State — is a **family affair for Josh Holliday**. Josh's father, Tom, served as an OSU assistant coach for 19 years then took over as the Cowboys' head coach from 1997-2003, leading the program to a College World Series appearance in 1999 (and coaching Josh in his final three college seasons). Tom spent four decades as a collegiate coach and was inducted into the OSU Cowboy Baseball Hall of Fame in 2016.

• **Josh's younger brother, Matt**, was a Major League Baseball standout from 2004-18 who was named to seven All-Star teams in 15 career seasons with the Rockies, Athletics, Cardinals and Yankees. Matt was on the OSU staff as a volunteer assistant from 2019-22.

• Josh's nephews, and Matt's two oldest sons, both signed to play at OSU. **Jackson** ended up as the No. 1 overall pick in the 2022 MLB Draft and plays for the Baltimore Orioles. **Ethan** was the No. 4 overall pick of the Colorado Rockies in the 2025 MLB Draft.

• Josh's uncle, **Dave Holliday**, was an OSU assistant coach from 1982-87 before becoming a MLB scout, and his cousin, **Heath Holliday**, is a former OSU catcher and staff member who is now an assistant coach at Central Arkansas.

- OSU began the 2026 season **14th on the NCAA's all-time Division I wins list** with 2,861. The Cowboys are one of only 20 programs in Division I history to reach 2,800 victories, and of those, only three — Florida State, Miami (FL) and Florida — have played fewer seasons than OSU's 113.

- The Cowboys have made **50 NCAA Regional** appearances in program history, which is tied for the third most all time.

- Oklahoma State's **20 College World Series** appearances is the sixth most in NCAA history. The Cowboys rank eighth all time in CWS wins with 40.

- The Cowboys have advanced to the **CWS championship game** six times and won the **1959 NCAA title**.

- OSU ranks in the top 10 all time in **CWS games played** (78). They made an NCAA record seven consecutive CWS appearances from **1981-87**.

- OSU's **161 wins** in the NCAA Tournament ranks eighth all time.

- The OSU trophy case includes **35 conference championships** over three conferences - the Missouri Valley, Big Eight and Big 12.

- From 1981-1996, OSU won **16 consecutive Big Eight Conference championships**, which stands as an NCAA record.

- OSU Cowboys have earned **152 All-America honors**, with **27 Cowboys** earning first-team All-America status.

- Thirteen Cowboys have earned **All-America honors multiple times**. Pete Incaviglia and Robin Ventura were three-time All-Americans.

- OSU's **237 All-Big 12 selections** is the most of any program in Big 12 Conference history. Of those, **61 Cowboys** have earned All-Big 12 First Team honors.

- OSU had inductees into the **College Baseball Hall of Fame** in each of the hall's first three years of existence - Robin Ventura in 2006, Pete Incaviglia in 2007 and Gary Ward in 2008. Tom Borland joined the hall in 2013.

- Arguably the two greatest hitters in college baseball history donned OSU uniforms. ***Pete Incaviglia** (1983-85) was named College Baseball Player of the Century by *Baseball America* and holds the NCAA records for career home runs (100), season home runs (48) and season RBIs (143). ***Robin Ventura** (1986-88) was named College Baseball Player of the Decade for the 1980s by *Baseball America* and holds the NCAA record with a 58-game hitting streak set in 1987. He was named the Golden Spikes Award winner in 1988.

Considered one of college baseball's top facilities, O'Brate Stadium has drawn in fans in droves on game days.

- OSU has averaged over 5,000 fans in three of the last four seasons, ranking among the national leaders each year.
- In 2022, the first season O'Brate Stadium was open to fans at full capacity, OSU ranked eighth nationally in average home attendance at 5,580. Over the last three seasons, OSU has ranked 11th, 12th and 17th.
- In terms of total attendance, OSU has ranked in the top 25 nationally in each of the last four years.
- In 2024, OSU set back-to-back attendance records against Oklahoma, drawing 8,067 fans on April 5 before 8,230 fans came through the gates the following day.

- Oklahoma State began play in its new baseball complex, O'Brate Stadium, in 2021. Work on the \$75 million project (\$60 million in began in February 2018 and was completed during the spring of 2020).
 - Named after serial entrepreneur Cecil O'Brate, who gave \$35 million toward the project
 - Inspired by Boone Pickens Stadium, the home of the Cowboys includes 3,500 permanent seats, 11 suites and 420 premium seats in dedicated club and suite areas. Seating can be expanded to 8,000 as needed.
 - The concourse area encompasses the entire playing field. Highlights of the concourse area are tailgating tents (dubbed "corrals"), refreshment areas down both the right field and left field lines, a dedicated student section with special loge seating and terrace seating in the outfield.
 - A 2,000-square foot video board allows for top-of-the-line graphics and video content to further enhance the game day experience, and fans benefit from a large parking lot that accommodates about 600 vehicles beyond center field.
 - The playing surface is natural grass and features a top-of-the line drainage system.
 - An artificial turf infield is used for practice and is one-third of a maximum-efficiency "training triangle" area that also includes an indoor facility and a weight room that allows the Cowboys to practice year-round, regardless of weather conditions, without having to utilize the ballpark's main playing surface.
 - Several notable cutting-edge technology features for swing training and pitching development are built into the complex, including the TrackMan system, which measures pitch velocity, exit speed, launch angle, distance and more. Additionally, pitchers benefit from specialized equipment built for arm care and injury prevention.
 - Situated along the left-field line, the clubhouse and team room areas provide plush accommodations for the Cowboys, starting with a 7,400-square-foot locker room and player lounge space that has top-of-the-line lockers for each player. In that same area are a nutrition center that includes a sports performance pantry and fueling station and a tiered-seated classroom that seats 50.
 - The operations center houses a sports medicine area with state-of-the-art hydrotherapy equipment, a modern weight room and a baseball-specific laundry center and equipment room. Former players have a dedicated space within the operations center that includes lockers they can utilize when returning to campus to continue their professional baseball training while finishing out their academic degree programs.
- "Our vision was to build a facility that would allow us to develop players at the highest level, teach leadership concepts and principles, embrace the team concept and provide a first-class experience for our loyal fans and alumni ... The end result was exactly what we wanted. We accomplished our goal, and it is beyond anything I could have envisioned." Josh Holliday*




The home of Cowboy Baseball bears the name of the late Cecil O'Brate, who gave \$35 million toward the project; O'Brate passed away at the age of 95 in January 2024

Born in Enid, Okla., O'Brate attended Oklahoma State (then Oklahoma A&M) from 1946-48 and went on to a career as a self-made serial entrepreneur. He is the owner, developer, and operator of multiple businesses in numerous and diverse industries such as agriculture, banking, manufacturing, energy, hospitality, real estate, alternative energy, medicine, and food science.

"OSU has always had a special place in my heart," O'Brate said. "My time at what was then Oklahoma A&M provided a strong foundation for the successes I have achieved over the years. I am honored to give back to the university that gave me my start 70 years ago. When I look at OSU today, I see a university that continues to enrich and inspire students. These students will carry the traditions and heart of OSU out into the world. For that reason, I am proud to give to OSU and the new generations of Cowboys. Go Pokes!"


