• The Southeastern Conference Baseball Tournament returns for the 28th consecutive time to the Hoover Metropolitan Complex in city of Hoover, Ala., May 19-24. The 2026 SEC Baseball Tournament will feature all 16 SEC teams in a single elimination format. Seeds 9-16 will play on the opening day of the tournament, and the winners advance to play seeds 5-8 on Wednesday. Teams seeded Nos. 1 and 4 will begin play Thursday, while Nos. 2 and 3 open play Friday. A total of 15 games will be played throughout the tournament.

• Vanderbilt won the SEC Tournament last year with a 3-2 triumph over Ole Miss in the championship game. The SEC Tournament champion has advanced to the College World Series 16 times in the last 32 seasons.

• Six different SEC teams can claim a top-10 ranking entering the SEC Tournament. Georgia is the SEC's highest ranked team at No. 4, Texas is No. 5, Auburn is No. 6, Florida is No. 9 and Texas A&M is No. 9. Other ranked SEC teams include No. 13 Alabama, No. 14 Mississippi State, No. 17 Ole Miss and No. 20 Tennessee.

• Georgia's Daniel Jackson was named SEC Player of the Year, Florida's Aidan King is the SEC Pitcher of the Year, Texas' Anthony Pack Jr. is the SEC Freshman of the Year, Texas' Aiden Robbins is the SEC Newcomer of the Year, Texas A&M's Gavin Grahovac is the SEC Scholar-Athlete of the Year, and Georgia's Wes Johnson is the SEC Coach of the Year.

• Georgia clinched the SEC title in week 9 of the conference slate and finished with a 23-7 league mark. It is the Bulldogs' first SEC crown since 2008.

• SEC teams entering the week ranked No. 1 statistically in the NCAA include:
 » Georgia with 147 home runs
 » Auburn with a 3.76 strikeout-to-walk ratio and 2.79 walks allowed per nine innings.

• The SEC leads all conferences with a cumulative winning percentage of .794 (309-80) in non-conference games, and the SEC also has more Quad 1 wins (159) than any other conference.

• The SEC has eight teams with an RPI in the top-15: (3) Auburn, (4) Texas, (6) Alabama, (10) Florida, (11) Texas A&M, (12) Mississippi State, (14) Georgia and (15) Ole Miss.

• A total of 89 players formerly from the SEC's 16 universities were named to Major League Baseball opening day rosters. That is 17 more than any other conference.

• The SEC will implement a challenge system for balls and strikes on an experimental basis for each game of the upcoming 2026 SEC Baseball Tournament, similar to the process implemented in Major League Baseball games this season. The system will permit teams to challenge an umpire's strike or ball call via an automated ball tracking system that monitors the exact location of each pitch, relative to the specific batter's zone. For the SEC Tournament, each team will have three challenges to start the game. If a challenge is successful, the team will retain the challenge. If the original call is confirmed, the team will lose the challenge. Upon a challenge, the pitch location will be compared against the electronic strike zone. The result will then be displayed on the stadium videoboard and broadcast.

2026 SEC Baseball

2026 SEC Tournament Nuggets

- This year marks the 49th Southeastern Conference Baseball Tournament and the 29th held in Hoover, Ala. It's been played in Hoover every year since 1998.
- There have been 634 games played and 6,671 runs scored (10.5 runs per game).
- The 8.2 runs per game average last year was the lowest since the last year of the "dead bat" BBCOR era in 2013 at 7.3 runs per game.
- The No. 1 seed has won four of the last six tournaments (Vanderbilt 2019, Arkansas 2021, Tennessee 2022, 2024). Vanderbilt was a 4-seed in 2023 and 2025.
- Three coaches make their SEC Tournament debut this year in Tennessee's Josh Elander, South Carolina's Monte Lee, and Mississippi State's Brian O'Connor.
- Last year, Vanderbilt secured its second tournament title in the last three years and fifth overall.
- The last four tournament champions have come from the Volunteer state with Tennessee winning in 2022 and 2024 and Vanderbilt win 2023 and 2025.
- LSU is the last team to win back-to-back tournament championships in 2013-14.
- 23 regular-season champions have won the tournament title, including five of the last eight (Vanderbilt 2017, 2019, Arkansas 2021, Tennessee 2022, 2024)
- The last tournament champion with a losing SEC record in the regular season was LSU (14-16) in 2010.
- Since 2015, 7 different teams have won the tournament title (Tennessee and Vanderbilt are the only multiple winners in that span).
- Vanderbilt head coach Tim Corbin holds the tournament record with 50 victories.
- Ole Miss head coach Mike Bianco is tied with Paul Mainieri for the fourth-most wins with 38. LSU's Skip Bertman is third with 32 and MSU/UGA's Ron Polk is second with 46.
- Five Tourney MVPs have come from the non-championship team. The last was Arkansas'

Alabama - 4-seed

Appearances: 34th in 2026

Tournament Record: 55-52

Tournament Titles: 7 (last in 2003)

Tournament Finals: 8 (last in 2010)

Last Semifinal: 2010

Seeds in UA's last five appearances (includes 2026): 11-9-7-9-4

Head Coach Rob Vaughn: 1-2 (3rd appearance)

Notes: Alabama is the No. 4 seed for the sixth time and the first time since 2009. It's the second top 4 seed in their last 13 SECT appearances (2009 & 2026).

- Posted 18 SEC wins for the first time since going 18-11 in 2009.
- Its 34 SEC wins over the last two years are the most since posting 34 in 2008 and 2009.
- It's the first time to post back-to-back winning SEC records since a six-year span from 2005-10.
- Alabama has won two tourney games three times in its last five tournaments.
- Alabama has surrendered at least 10 runs in five of its last seven tournament losses.

Chad Spanberger in 2017.

- The last three tournaments have drawn at least 159,000 in attendance which ranks in the top four all time.
 - Last year's semifinals (UT-VU; OM-LSU) drew 14,775 for the fourth-largest session record in tournament history.
- The most home runs hit in the tournament was set in 2024 with 46 (2.7 HR/game).
- The tournament champion has advanced to the College World Series 13 times in the last 29 seasons.
 - CWS champions who won SEC Tournament: Tennessee '24; Vanderbilt '19; LSU '09; LSU '00; LSU '93
- There has been one no-hitter in the tournament and that occurred May 25, 2017, when Arkansas defeated Auburn 12-0 in seven innings.
- The last pitcher to win a 9-inning complete game was Texas A&M's Matt Kent against Vanderbilt on May 21, 2015.
- The last time both pitchers threw complete games in the same game was May 22, 2002, with Auburn's Colby Paxton and LSU's Lane Mestepey.
- There's been 54 extra-inning games, including three 17-inning affairs with the last coming in 2019 between Miss State and LSU. The most extra-inning games were five in 2013.
- There's been 40 run rule games. LSU owns the best mark at 13-1, followed by Vanderbilt at 8-2.
- Since 1989, there's been 11 walk-off home runs, including two in 2024 by Mississippi State's Connor Hujsak vs. Ole Miss and LSU's Steven Milam vs. South Carolina.

Arkansas - 7-seed

Appearances: 20th in 2026

Tournament Record: 40-48

Tournament Titles: 1 (last in 2021)

Seeds in AR's last five appearances (includes 2026): 3-2-2-2-7

Head Coach Dave Van Horn: 28-33 (21st appearance, 1 title in 2021)

Notes: Arkansas is the No. 7 seed for the seventh time. It's the first time it hasn't been a top 4 seed since being a No. 5 seed in 2015. It's the lowest seed it's been since No. 7 in 2014.

- Arkansas saw its string of three straight 20-win SEC campaigns end with a 17-13 mark this year.
- Arkansas has posted at least 17 SEC wins in nine consecutive years. It's the longest streak since LSU did it for 10 years from 1996-2005. The Tigers won 18+ every year in that span.
- Arkansas has lost its last four tournament games.
- Arkansas has won at least one game in eight of its last 11 tournaments and posted multiple victories seven times in the span.
- The pitching staff has posted 10+ Ks in three straight and 11 of their last 17 tourney games.
- Five of their last eight tourney games have been decided by one run.
- Has not scored more than six runs in its last eight tourney games.

Auburn – 6-seed

Appearances: 32nd in 2026

Seeds in AU's last five appearances (includes 2026): 12-5-5-6-6

Head Coach Butch Thompson: 5-11 (8th appearance)

Notes: Auburn is the No. 6 seed for the second straight year and the fourth time in tournament history.

- Auburn posted back-to-back 17-win SEC campaigns for the first time since 1999 and 2000 when it won 18 and 17, respectively.
- Auburn has won at least 16 SEC games in four of the last five years which is its best run since four straight 16+ win seasons from 1997-2000.
- Auburn lost its last three tournament games and is 1-7 in its last eight. Its last win was a 10-4 opening round win in 2023. The Tigers scored 4 or few runs in each of those losses.
- Auburn last won two tourney games in 2018 and has won two games in the tourney one other time this century in 2003.
- Auburn has homered in its last six tournament games for 10 total in that span. It's the longest streak in its tournament history.

Florida – 5-seed

Appearances: 45th in 2026

Tournament Titles: 7 (last in 2015)

Tournament Finals: 15 (last in 2022)

Last Semifinal: 2023

Seeds in UF's last five appearances (includes 2026): 7-1-9-10-5

Head Coach Kevin O'Sullivan: 32-25 (18th appearance, 2 titles in 2011, 2015)

Notes: Florida is the No. 5 seed for the first time in tournament history. This is its highest seed since No. 1 in 2023. It was No. 9 and No. 10 the last two years.

- Florida finished with 18 SEC wins, its most since a 20-10 mark in 2023.
- The Gators have finished .500 or better in SEC play 16 of the last 19 seasons.
- Florida has reached the semifinals in 7 of the last 11 tourneys and the finals four times in that span
- Gators are 10-6 over the last five tourneys.
- They have homered in eight of their last nine tournament games with 20 in that span.
- Pitching staff has struck out 10+ in the seven of the last eight tournament games.

Georgia – 1-seed

Appearances: 31st in 2026

Tournament Record: 31-52

Tournament Titles: 0

Tournament Finals: 3 (last in 1989)

Last Semifinal: 2019

Seeds in UG's last five appearances (includes 2026): 6-11-6-5-1

Head Coach Wes Johnson: 0-2 (3rd appearance)

Notes: Georgia is the No. 1 seed for the fourth time in tournament history and the first time since 2008. It was No. 1 in 1987 and 2001. The last time it was a top 4 seed was as a No. 3 seed in 2019.

- The Bulldogs posted a program-record 23 SEC wins this season. It was their first 20-win SEC campaign since 21-9 in 2019.
- Georgia posted three consecutive winning seasons in conference play for the first time since (17-13, 18-12, 23-7). It's the first time Georgia finished .500 or better in league play in three consecutive seasons since 1985-87 (11-11, 14-13, 18-8).
- Georgia has lost six straight tourney games and seven of its last eight. Its lone win in that span was a 4-1 win over LSU in the opening round in 2021.
- Georgia hasn't won two tournament games since 2019 when it started 2-0.
- They have won three tourney games in their last 11 tourney appearances since 2012.
- The Bulldogs have not scored more than four runs in their last 25 tournament games (shut out 6 times in that span).
- The last time they scored more than four was a 6-3 opening round win over Ole Miss in 2009.

Kentucky – 13-seed

Appearances: 27th in 2026

Tournament Record: 26-43

Tournament Titles: 0

Tournament Finals: 3 (last in 1995 SEC Eastern Division)

Last Semifinal: 2022

Seeds in UK's last five appearances (includes 2026): 12-8-3-13-13

Head Coach Nick Mingione: 5-10 (7th appearance)

Notes: Kentucky is the No 13 seed for the second straight year. This is its fifth double-digit seed in its last seven appearances. It was the No. 3 seed in 2024.

- Kentucky finished with back-to-back 13-win SEC campaigns after going 22-8 in 2024.
- The last time the Wildcats started 2-0 in the tournament was in 2014.
- Kentucky reached the semifinals in 2014 and 2022.
- Kentucky is 1-5 in its last six tournament games with the lone win coming against Arkansas in 2024, 9-6.

LSU – 14-seed

Appearances: 40th in 2026

Tournament Record: 95-51

Tournament Titles: 12 (last in 2017)

Tournament Finals: 20 (last in 2024)

Last Semifinal: 2025

Seeds in LSU's last five appearances (includes 2026): 4-3-11-3-14

Head Coach Jay Johnson: 7-6 (5th appearance)

Notes: LSU is the No. 14 seed which is its lowest in tournament history. It was the 11-seed in 2024. This is the sixth time LSU has been an 8-seed or lower.

- The Tigers only missed two tournaments since 1985 (2007 & 2011).
- The pitching staff has posted 10+ strikeouts in six straight tournament games.
- LSU has won at least one tournament game in the last four tournaments. The last time it went one-and-done was 2021.

Ole Miss – 9-seed

Appearances: 29th in 2026

Tournament Record: 47-46

Tournament Titles: 3 (last in 2018)

Tournament Finals: 7 (last in 2025)

Last Semifinal: 2025

Seeds in OM's last five appearances (includes 2026): 5-9-12-7-9

Head Coach Mike Bianco: 38-33 (22nd appearance, 2 titles in 2005, 2018)

Notes: Ole Miss is the No. 9 seed for the fourth time overall and third in its last eight appearances.

- Ole Miss posted back-to-back .500 or better SEC campaigns for the first time since three straight from 2018-21.
- The Rebels reached the finals in 2018, 2019 and the semifinals in 2021 and 2025.
- They are 14-8 in their last 22 tourney games since 2018.
- Ole Miss hasn't scored more than 5 runs in its last 10 tourney games.
- Ole Miss has homered in its last three tournament games.

Mississippi State – 8-seed

Appearances: 38th in 2026

Tournament Record: 68-60

Tournament Titles: 7 (last in 2012)

Tournament Finals: 11 (last in 2012)

Last Semifinal: 2013

Seeds in MSU's last five appearances (includes 2026): 4-3-5-11-8

Head Coach Brian O'Connor: 0-0 (1st appearance)

Notes: Mississippi State is the No. 8 seed for the first time.

- MSU has finished .500 or better in SEC play for three straight seasons after back-to-back 9-21 campaigns. They have finished .500 or better 11 times in the last 14 seasons.
- Hit 2 HRs last 11 tournament games. They have not hit multiple home runs in a tournament game since slugging two against South Carolina in the 1998 opening round game.
- Has not scored more than five runs in its last nine tournament games. The last time it did was a 6-5, 17-inning win over LSU in 2019.

Seeding

Teams shall be seeded based on winning percentage in regular season conference competition. Ties will be broken in the following manner:

- 1. Two-Team Tie.** The following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken:
 - A. Won-lost results of head-to-head competition between the two tied teams.
 - B. Won-lost percentage of the two teams against all common opponents
 - C. Won-lost percentage of the two teams versus the highest seed using common opponents only (and proceeding through the last seed, if necessary)
 - D. Best cumulative winning percentage of all Conference opponents
 - E. Coin flip by the Commissioner.

- 2. Three-Team Tie (or more).** The following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken: (Note: If the three tied teams have three different records against each other, they shall be seeded in best-percentage order.) Otherwise, once the tie has been reduced to two teams, the two-team tiebreaker procedure will be used.
 - A. If all tied teams are common opponents: Total won-lost percentage of games played among the tied teams.
 - B. Won-lost percentage of the tied teams against all common opponents
 - C. Won-lost percentage of the tied teams versus the highest seed using common opponents only, and proceeding through the lowest seed, if necessary. In the event of multiple ties, they shall be broken from first to last (e.g. a tie for first place will be broken before a tie for fourth place).
 - D. Best cumulative winning percentage of all Conference opponents.
 - E. If three or more teams still are tied, the Commissioner will conduct a draw.
