• SEC Players of the Week: Arkansas' Kuhio Aloy slashed a team-leading .600/.625/.1.267 with nine hits, including three home runs, and seven RBI to lead the Hogs to three wins last week, including an SEC series win vs. Ole Miss. The Razorback designated hitter swatted home runs in all three games against the Rebels and finished the weekend with a team-leading seven hits, including a double and his three homers, as well as with a team-high six RBI. Kentucky's Tyler Bell led his team to a series win over Tennessee with a team-best .538 average, posting a 1.231 slugging percentage and 1.831 OPS with 16 total bases. He led UK with three doubles, six runs, seven hits and two home runs, homering from the right side of the plate Saturday and the left side on Sunday.

• SEC Pitchers of the Week: LSU's Zac Cowan pitched a combined 10.0 shutout innings over two victories last week, as he earned a relief win over Southeastern Louisiana on Tuesday and a win over South Carolina as a starter on Sunday. Cowan threw a total of 155 pitches over 10.0 innings in the two victories, allowing no runs on four hits with two walks and 14 strikeouts. Texas' Dylan Volantis registered a co-career-best 12 strikeouts and scattered three singles across six scoreless innings against No. 10 Mississippi State. After the Bulldogs notched a two-out infield hit in the first, Volantis retired 10 of the next 11 batters he faced.

• SEC Freshman of the Week: Kentucky's Braxton Van Cleave batted .500 with a 1.000 slugging percentage and 1.500 OPS for the week, leading the team in RBI and tying for the lead in hits and home runs. He had seven hits in the series win over Tennessee, homering in two of the three games, and set a new career high with three hits on Sunday. Van Cleave recorded multiple hits in all three games of the series.

• Georgia leads the SEC standings by 2.5 games over Texas and Texas A&M with two weeks remaining in the regular season. The next nine teams in the standings are separated by just 3.0 games.

• A total of 10 SEC teams are ranked entering the week. Texas is the highest-ranked SEC team in the major polls at No. 3, while Auburn and Georgia are ranked as high as No. 5, Texas A&M is No. 7 and Mississippi State is No. 10. Other SEC teams in the national rankings include No. 13 Florida, No. 14 Arkansas, No. 16 Oklahoma, No. 17 Alabama and No. 20 Ole Miss.

• SEC teams entering the week ranked No. 1 statistically in the NCAA include:

- » Georgia with 131 home runs and a .622 slugging percentage
- » Auburn with a 4.09 strikeout-to-walk ratio, 1.13 WHIP and fewest walks allowed/nine innings (2.62)
- » Kentucky with 116 HBP.

• The SEC announced Monday that it will implement a challenge system for balls and strikes on an experimental basis for each game of the upcoming 2026 SEC Baseball Tournament, similar to the process implemented in Major League Baseball games this season. The system will permit teams to challenge an umpire's strike or ball call via an automated ball tracking system that monitors the exact location of each pitch, relative to the specific batter's zone. For the SEC Tournament, each team will have three challenges to start the game. If a challenge is successful, the team will retain the challenge. If the original call is confirmed, the team will lose the challenge. Upon a challenge, the pitch location will be compared against the electronic strike zone. The result will then be displayed on the stadium videoboard and broadcast.

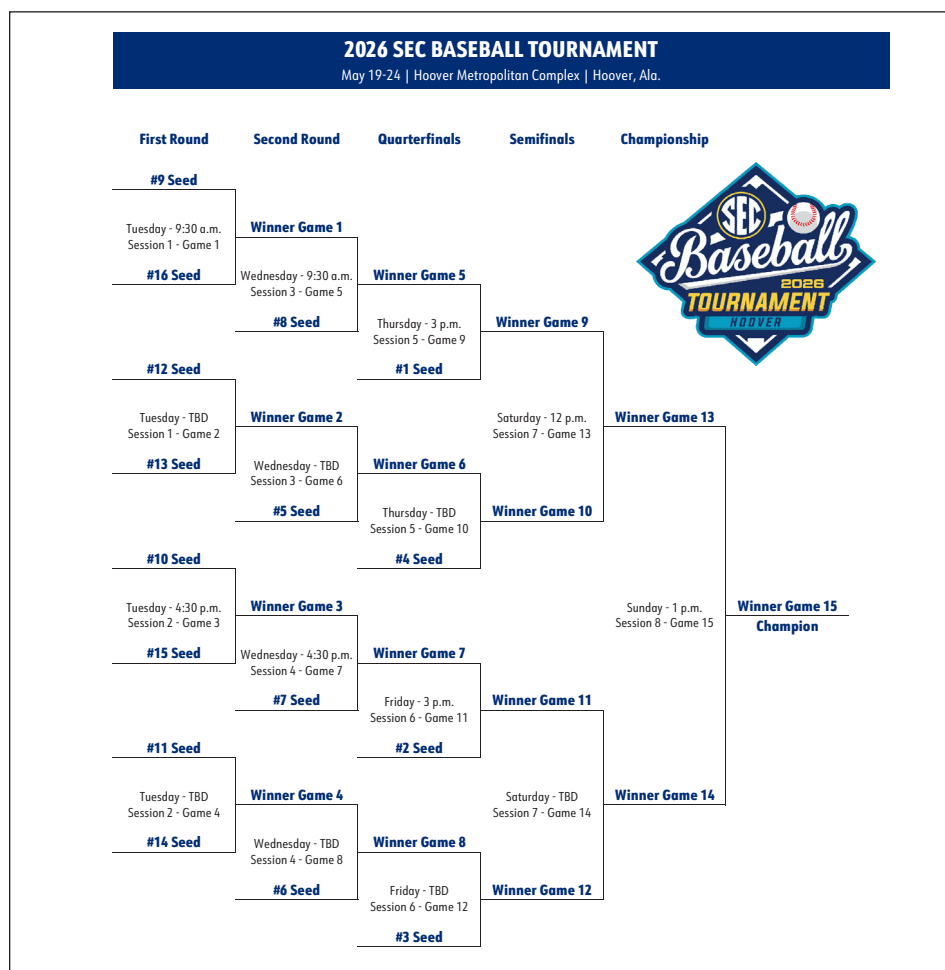

Seeding

Teams shall be seeded based on winning percentage in regular season conference competition. Ties will be broken in the following manner:

- 1. Two-Team Tie.** The following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken:
 - A. Won-lost results of head-to-head competition between the two tied teams.
 - B. Won-lost percentage of the two teams against all common opponents
 - C. Won-lost percentage of the two teams versus the highest seed using common opponents only (and proceeding through the last seed, if necessary)
 - D. Best cumulative winning percentage of all Conference opponents
 - E. Coin flip by the Commissioner.
- 2. Three-Team Tie (or more).** The following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken: (Note: If the three tied teams have three different records against each other, they shall be seeded in best-percentage order.) Otherwise, once the tie has been reduced to two teams, the two-team tiebreaker procedure will be used.
 - A. If all tied teams are common opponents: Total won-lost percentage of games played among the tied teams.
 - B. Won-lost percentage of the tied teams against all common opponents
 - C. Won-lost percentage of the tied teams versus the highest seed using common opponents only, and proceeding through the lowest seed, if necessary. In the event of multiple ties, they shall be broken from first to last (e.g. a tie for first place will be broken before a tie for fourth place).
 - D. Best cumulative winning percentage of all Conference opponents.
 - E. If three or more teams still are tied, the Commissioner will conduct a draw.
