• SEC Co-Players of the Week: Florida's Brendan Lawson started all four games for the Gators as they went 4-0 with two-game sweeps of FIU and No. 17 Miami. He batted .571/.667/1.071 while going 8-for-14 at the plate, leading Florida in every slash category. Lawson totaled a team-high 15 total bases on the week on top of two home runs, one double, 12 RBI and seven runs scored. He drove in multiple runs in three of four games. Texas' Temo Becerra led the charge in the Longhorns' 4-0 week by hitting .500 with eight runs scored, two doubles, three home runs, seven RBI and a 2.005 OPS. At the BRUCE BOLT College Classic, Becerra homered three times in as many contests and reached safely in eight of his 13 plate appearances. Against No. 9 Coastal Carolina, the redshirt senior mounted his first career multi-homer game, lifting a solo shot in the fourth and a two-run jack in the eighth.

• SEC Pitcher of the Week: South Carolina's Josh Gunther, making his first career start on the mound, pitched a gem, going seven innings and allowing just three hits with no runs, one walk and a career-best 10 strikeouts in South Carolina's 7-0 win over No. 15 Clemson on Feb. 27. Gunther, who threw 90 pitches in his gem, ended five of his seven innings with a strikeout and retired the final six batters of his night.

• SEC Freshman of the Week: Auburn's Mason McCraine hit .462 for the week with a home run and eight RBI to help the Tigers three wins and a series victory over Nebraska. McCraine went 4-for-5 with a home run and six RBI in the middle game vs. Nebraska, helping even the series with a two-run home run that ended the game in the seventh inning. He also collected a pair of two-RBI singles in each of the first two innings, accounted for half of the team's eight runs in the opening two frames.

• Twelve SEC teams are ranked across the major polls this week. LSU is No. 2 in each of the major polls, while Mississippi State and Texas are ranked as high as No. 3, Arkansas and Auburn are ranked as high as No. 6, Florida is No. 7, Georgia is No. 8 and Oklahoma is No. 10 to round out the top-10. High rankings for other SEC teams are: Ole Miss and Tennessee at No. 17, Texas A&M at No. 18 and Kentucky at No. 21.

• All 16 SEC teams will play a home series this weekend in what will be the final weekend before 10 consecutive week of conference play. Entering week 4 of the season, SEC teams have a cumulative non-conference record of 152-35 (813).

• The SEC has won six consecutive national championships by five different programs. Vanderbilt won in 2019, Mississippi State in 2021, Ole Miss in 2022, LSU in 2023 and Tennessee is 2024 and LSU again in 2025.

• Of the current SEC membership, 12 different programs have made a College World Series appearance since 2021.

• The SEC has claimed 11 national titles by seven different teams since 2009, and nine SEC teams have finished runner-up in that period.

• The top-10 national attendance leaders in 2025 were all from the SEC. LSU led the nation in total attendance (458,606) and average attendance (11,186), and Mississippi State had the nation's highest on-campus single game attendance (14,468).

Seeding

Teams shall be seeded based on winning percentage in regular season conference competition. Ties will be broken in the following manner:

1. Two-Team Tie. The following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken:

- A. Won-lost results of head-to-head competition between the two tied teams.
- B. Won-lost percentage of the two teams against all common opponents
- C. Won-lost percentage of the two teams versus the highest seed using common opponents only (and proceeding through the last seed, if necessary)
- D. Best cumulative winning percentage of all Conference opponents
- E. Coin flip by the Commissioner.

2. Three-Team Tie (or more). The following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken: (Note: If the three tied teams have three different records against each other, they shall be seeded in best-percentage order.) Otherwise, once the tie has been reduced to two teams, the two-team tiebreaker procedure will be used.

- A. If all tied teams are common opponents: Total won-lost percentage of games played among the tied teams.
- B. Won-lost percentage of the tied teams against all common opponents
- C. Won-lost percentage of the tied teams versus the highest seed using common opponents only, and proceeding through the lowest seed, if necessary. In the event of multiple ties, they shall be broken from first to last (e.g. a tie for first place will be broken before a tie for fourth place).
- D. Best cumulative winning percentage of all Conference opponents.
- E. If three or more teams still are tied, the Commissioner will conduct a draw.
