• SEC Players of the Week: LSU's Cade Arrambide batted .600 in three games last week with four homers, eight RBI, six runs, three walks and a .692 on-base percentage. Arrambide became just the fourth player in SEC history to hit four homers in a game in the Tigers' series-clinching win at Tennessee on Sunday. He was 5-for-6 on the day with seven RBI, three solo homers and a grand slam that highlighted LSU's 10-run outburst in the top of the 12th inning. Georgia's Tre Phelps led the Bulldogs to their first SEC road sweep over a top five opponent since at least 1990 as the Bulldogs swept No. 4 Mississippi State as part of a 4-0 week. Phelps hit .421 for the week (8-for-19) with three home runs, eight RBI, and six runs scored. He set the tone for the Mississippi State series with a three-run home run early in game one.

• SEC Pitcher of the Week: Texas A&M's Aiden Sims tossed a seven-inning shutout in the series-clinching win against Vanderbilt. In 7.0 innings pitched, Sims struck out eight batters, allowing just three hits and two walks, limiting hitters to a .125 batting average against in the contest. The win marked Sims' third consecutive conference win.

• SEC Freshmen of the Week: Texas' Anthony Pack Jr. reached safely in 10 of his 13 plate appearances in the series win at South Carolina. Pack Jr. slashed .727/.769/.909 and mounted eight hits across the three-game set. The rookie tallied three consecutive multi-hit performances, delivering the game-winning two-run double in the series-securing 4-1 victory on Saturday. Missouri's Blaize Ward hit .615 for the week (8-for-13) with a triple, six RBI and a pair of runs scored, notching three multi-hit games. In the series win over No. 24 Kentucky, Ward hit .667 (6-for-9) with a pair of RBI and two multi-hit games, including a 3-for-3 performance in the series-clinching win over the Wildcats on Sunday.

• A total of 11 SEC teams are ranked in the national polls entering Week 9 of the 2026 season. Texas is the SEC's highest ranked team at No. 2, followed by Georgia at No. 4, Alabama at No. 7 and Mississippi State at No. 8. Other ranked SEC teams include: No. 10 Auburn, No. 13 Oklahoma, No. 15 Texas A&M, No. 18 Florida, No. 22 Arkansas, No. 24 LSU and No. 25 LSU. Fourteen different SEC programs have been ranked at some point during the season.

• The end of this weekend's series will mark the midday point of the regular season SEC schedule. Georgia enters the fifth week of SEC play with a one-game lead over Texas in the SEC standings.

• SEC teams entering the week ranked No. 1 statistically in the NCAA include:

- » Florida with 7 shutouts
- » Georgia with 93 home runs and .633 SLG pct.
- » Auburn with a 4.42 strikeout-to-walk ratio, 1.09 WHIP and fewest walks allowed/nine innings (2.59)
- » Auburn's Jake Marciano with a 0.68 WHIP.

• The top-10 national attendance leaders in attendance this season are all from the SEC. LSU leads the nation in total attendance (255,315), while Mississippi State is first in average attendance (11,560). Other SEC schools ranked in the top-10 are Arkansas, Ole Miss, Texas, Tennessee, South Carolina, Florida, Texas A&M and Auburn.

• A total of 86 baseball players from current Southeastern Conference universities are listed on 2026 Major League Baseball Opening Day rosters. Twenty-nine Major League clubs had at least one former SEC player on the Opening Day roster. Florida has 12 former players on MLB rosters, while LSU has 11 and Vanderbilt as eight.

Seeding

Teams shall be seeded based on winning percentage in regular season conference competition. Ties will be broken in the following manner:

1. Two-Team Tie. The following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken:

- A. Won-lost results of head-to-head competition between the two tied teams.
- B. Won-lost percentage of the two teams against all common opponents
- C. Won-lost percentage of the two teams versus the highest seed using common opponents only (and proceeding through the last seed, if necessary)
- D. Best cumulative winning percentage of all Conference opponents
- E. Coin flip by the Commissioner.

2. Three-Team Tie (or more). The following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken: (Note: If the three tied teams have three different records against each other, they shall be seeded in best-percentage order.) Otherwise, once the tie has been reduced to two teams, the two-team tiebreaker procedure will be used.

- A. If all tied teams are common opponents: Total won-lost percentage of games played among the tied teams.
- B. Won-lost percentage of the tied teams against all common opponents
- C. Won-lost percentage of the tied teams versus the highest seed using common opponents only, and proceeding through the lowest seed, if necessary. In the event of multiple ties, they shall be broken from first to last (e.g. a tie for first place will be broken before a tie for fourth place).
- D. Best cumulative winning percentage of all Conference opponents.
- E. If three or more teams still are tied, the Commissioner will conduct a draw.
