TCU NOTABLES

- TCU enters the season as a ranked team for the 17th consecutive year.
- TCU is ranked as high as No. 9 (Baseball America, NC-BWA) and as low as No. 11 (Perfect Game).
- TCU was picked to win the Big 12 after garnering 13 of 14 first place votes.
- Four Horned Frogs - Chase Brunson, Noah Franco, Tommy LaPour and Sawyer Strosnider - were tabbed Preseason All-Conference.
- Strosnider was voted the Preseason Player of the Year, LaPour the Preseason Pitcher of the Year and Lucas Franco the Preseason Freshman of the Year.
- TCU returns 69% of its offensive production from last year and 50% of its innings pitched.
- Baseball America ranked the incoming class No. 13, the highest rated class in the Big 12.
- TCU welcomed 15 newcomers including nine transfers and six freshmen.
- Trever Baumler earned a spot on the All-Cape Cod League team this summer.

NEUTRAL SITE/GLOBE LIFE FIELD

- TCU has played at least one regular season game in Globe Life every year since it opened.
- The Horned Frogs have played 30 games in Globe Life over the last four seasons.
- TCU is 20-10 all-time at Globe Life Field.
- TCU is 7-5 in regular season tournaments at Globe Life.
- TCU owns a record of 43-29 in Major League Ballparks.
- TCU is 27-14 in neutral site contests under the guidance of head coach Kirk Saarloos.
- TCU is 33-16 in MLB parks under Saarloos.
- Since Kirk Saarloos' arrival on campus, TCU is 78-43 (.645) in neutral site contests.

SERIES NOTABLES

- TCU and Vanderbilt will be meeting for the eighth time on Friday. Vandy leads the all-time series 4-3.
- TCU is opening the season against Vanderbilt for the second time (2023 at Globe Life Field).
- TCU won that contest 11-4.
- All previous seven meetings have come at neutral sites, three of which have come in a Big League Park - two at Dodger Stadium (2015, 2018) and one in Globe Life Field (2023).
- TCU is 2-1 against Vanderbilt in MLB Stadiums.
- TCU and Vanderbilt also met twice in the 2015 CWS with Vandy winning both contests.
- TCU and Arkansas will be meeting for the 75th time.
- Arkansas leads the all-time series, 46-28.
- Prior to 2019, the Frogs and Razorbacks had played just once (2006) since 1995 when they were in the conference foes in the SWC.
- Since, the teams have play seven times with Arkansas holding a 4-3 series lead.
- Three of the last five meetings have been in Arlington (2021, 2023 & 2025).
- Arkansas is 2-1 in those contests.
- TCU and Oklahoma are meeting for the 113th time.
- Oklahoma leads the series 70-42.
- The Sooners and the Frogs are meeting as non-conference foes for the first time since the 2015 season when they played a midweek contest in Fort Worth.
- TCU's last non-conference regular season weekend game against Oklahoma was in 1996 in Norman.
- TCU is 20-18 against OU with Kirk Saarloos on staff.
- TCU is 0-1 against Oklahoma at Globe Life Field (2024 Big 12 Championships).
- Oklahoma won six of the 11 conference series while both were in the Big 12 (2013-24).

FROG HOPS

- With four regular season crowns and four tournament trophies, TCU's eight Big 12 championships are the most of any program in the league since TCU joined in 2013.
- The eight total championships are the second most in league history.
- TCU was ranked in the preseason for the 17th straight season.
- Bill Mosiello put together a 60-51 record as the head coach at Ohio State (2023-24). TCU's 34 athletes hail from 14 states spanning the continental USA.
- TCU has sold out of reserved seating for the 16th straight season.
- Assistant coach Dave Lawn announced the 2026 season will be his last. His coaching career began in 1989 at Nevada.
- Lawn's coaching career spans 38 years, 32 of which were at the D1 level: Nevada (1989-90, 2014-15), Cal (1991-00), USC (2001-07), Arizona (2016-22) and TCU (2023-present).

A SEASON TO REMEMBER

Sawyer Strosnider put together a season for the ages in his debut campaign, posting the first quadruple-double in the NCAA since Utah Valley's Chris Benson accomplished the feat in the 2010 season. He totaled 13 doubles, 10 triples (a school record), 11 home runs and 10 stolen bases.

Strosnider is the 11th player since 1990 to accomplish the feat. Notable players to have done it are Jay Patton (1993, Georgia Tech), Todd Walker (1993, LSU), Nomar Garciaparra (1994, Georgia Tech), Bubba Crosby (1997, Rice), Chris Burke (2001, Tennessee) and Rickie Weeks (2001 and 2002, Southern).

HOME AWAY FROM HOME

Globe Life Field opened in 2020. Since its opening, TCU has utilized the indoor friendly combines as a defacto home away from home. The Horned Frogs have played 30 games in Globe Life over the last five seasons.

Twice TCU has opened the season at Globe Life (2021, 2023). The 2026 season will mark the third time TCU will open the season in the venue. TCU also hosted Nebraska in 2022 and played Baylor in a weather-rescheduled game in 2023. The 2024 season saw the Frogs take part in the Kubota College Baseball Series and last season, TCU played in the College Baseball Showdown.

Additionally, Globe Life served as the host for the Big 12 Championships for four seasons. The Frogs are 20-10 all-time at the ballpark.

THE LONG GAME

The return of associate head coach Bill Mosiello in 2025 reunited one of the most successful coaching duos in program history. Head Coach Kirk Saarloos and Mosiello spent nine seasons side-by-side in the dugout from 2014-22. John Dilaura's arrival to the group in 2019 gives the trio five years of experience working alongside each other.

As a trio, they have put together a record of 163-93 (.637). TCU has won two conference regular season and one tournament title, while appearing in the postseason four times.

Saarloos and Mosiello were side-by-side in the dugout for their 10th season together in 2025 and it resulted in a return to the postseason.

Together, they have helped guide TCU to a 394-185 (.680) record. Along the way, the squad has four regular season Big 12 titles and three Big 12 tournament crowns. The team has appeared in eight of nine postseasons and made four straight College World Series appearances from 2014-17.

WINS UPON WINS UPON WINS

Since Saarloos arrived on campus, TCU has produced 500 wins and owns a .660 winning percentage. The 500 wins rank 11th nationally and are the second-most in the state of Texas.

TCU has been victorious in 110 of 166 series played and tallied 55 series sweeps. TCU's 2,488 program victories in 128 years of existence rank tied for 39th all-time (Missouri). The Frogs are 2,488-1,811 (.579) all-time.

ELITE COMPANY

After missing out on the NCAA Tournament for just the third time since 2004 in 2024, the Frogs made their return to the postseason last year. TCU has been in 18 of the last 21 postseasons. The Frogs are one of just 13 programs to have appeared in 18 of the last 21 NCAA postseasons.

The Frogs are one of 10 programs to appear in at least eight Super Regionals since 2009. Additionally, TCU's six appearances in the CWS since 2010 are tied for the second-most in the NCAA.

Since Saarloos' arrival, TCU is one of 22 programs to appear in nine of the last 12 postseasons.

SPEED FACTOR

TCU continues to be one of the most prolific base-stealing teams in the nation. The Frogs have stolen 100 or more bases in three of the last five seasons. Since 2015, TCU has ranked in the top 10 nationally in stolen bases four times.

The Frogs are one of just 12 teams to have stolen at least 1,100 bases over the last 13 years. The 1,156 stolen bases rank ninth in the nation and third among Power 4 teams.

It's not just raw numbers that are impressive, the Horned Frogs have produced a high success rate, converting on 80% of their attempts over the last eight years (1156-of-1450). No base is safe with the Frogs around. Over the last 11 seasons, TCU is 205-of-250 (82%) in stealing third.

STINGY STAFF

The Frogs' 3.73 ERA since 2013 is fifth nationally. TCU led the nation with a 2.22 ERA in 2014 and ranked second in 2015 with a 2.45 ERA. The TCU pitching staff has produced four of the top 10 lowest ERAs in program history. Additionally, the TCU pitching staff is tied for the eighth-most shutouts (66) nationally over the last 13 years.

TCU has limited opponents to two or fewer runs 275 times in the 758 games played since Saarloos' arrival on campus. The staff has surrendered 5+ runs just 305 times in those contests.

K-ZONE

Over the last 13 seasons, TCU pitchers have struck out batters at a high rate. In 758 games, they have tallied double-digit strikeouts 322 times. TCU set a school record with 36 double-digit strikeout games in 2024.

They have produced eight of the top 10 season strikeout totals and boast a 9.14 strikeouts per nine average with Saarloos on staff.

The Frogs have ranked in the top 25 nationally in strikeouts per nine seven times. On three occasions, they have ranked in the top 10.

2026 SCHEDULE NOTES

TCU's 54-game slate will see the Horned Frogs play 28 home games, 21 road games and four contests at a neutral site. The Horned Frogs will open the season in a tournament for the first time since the 2023 season.

TCU's longest homestand of the season will be eight games comes with the opening of the home schedule on Feb. 27. The Frogs' longest stretch away from home will be the first eight games of the season.

The schedule features 24 games against teams that appeared in the 2025 NCAA Tournament. Nine weekend opponents appeared in the tournament a year ago.

2026 OPPONENT NOTABLES

Three weekend opponents appear in the Top 25 all-preseason polls. Arkansas (Feb. 14), UCLA (Feb. 20-22) and Vanderbilt (Feb. 12). Three other teams make an appearance in at least one poll: Arizona (April 10-12), Oklahoma (Feb. 15) and West Virginia (May 14-16).

Seven other opponents are receiving votes. Those are: Arizona State (March 13-15), Dallas Baptist (March 24; April 21), Kansas (March 10), Kansas State (April 3-5), Oklahoma State (May 1-3), Texas Tech (March 27-29) and Tulane (March 6-8).

FROGS PICKED TO WIN THE BIG 12

In a vote of Big 12 coaches, TCU was picked to finish first in the 14-team league, garnering 13 of 14 first place votes for 169 points. The Horned Frogs have been picked to finish fourth or higher every year since joining the league. It's the sixth time TCU has been picked to win the league.

EXTRA, EXTRA

TCU has played 50 extra inning games since Kirk Saarloos arrived in 2013 and holds a 30-20 mark in those games. TCU is 11-3 in extra inning games with Saarloos as the head coach.

TCU played in six extra inning games in 2025 and was 4-2 in those contests. Prior to the loss to DBU, the Frogs had won seven straight extra inning games dating back to a 10th-inning loss to Missouri on Feb. 19, 2023.

The Frogs' longest extra inning game was 22 innings in the 2014 NCAA Regional against Sam Houston State.
