LEADING OFF

- UAPB heads to Little Rock at 17-21 overall and 10-5 in SWAC play — one of the top records in the conference — to face No. 16 Arkansas in a mid-week Power Four matchup at Dickey-Stephens Park.
- Ryland Morin has been the Golden Lions' best starter in 2026 — going 4-1 with a 3.05 ERA and 37 strikeouts in 41.1 innings, emerging as one of the premier arms in the SWAC.
- Blake Coleman and Zach Wieder are both hitting .336 on the season, with Coleman adding 33 RBI and 4 home runs and Wieder contributing 32 RBI in 37 starts.
- Aaron Grant leads the team with a .357 average, 35 RBI and 4 home runs — delivering some of the most consistent production in the lineup all season long.
- Jalen Porter paces the staff with 36 strikeouts and has logged 36.2 innings pitched, while Kenney Fabian leads in innings at 48.1 IP with 33 punchouts.
- Reagan James has been a lockdown presence out of the bullpen — going 3-2 with 29 strikeouts in 38.0 innings and a save, one of the most dependable relievers in SWAC play.
- UAPB's offense is batting .297 as a team with 287 runs scored in 38 games — averaging over 7.5 runs per contest and proving to be one of the most productive lineups in the conference.
- Nick Hockemeyer is batting .361 in limited action, providing a major spark off the bench and in the starting lineup when called upon this spring.
- The Golden Lions' 10-5 SWAC record places them firmly in the conversation for a conference tournament berth as the second half of league play heats up.
