• SERIES HISTORY

Central Arkansas and Arkansas will be playing for the 6th time in the past five years when they match-up on Tuesday night. The Hogs have won all six games and all of the games have been played in Fayetteville except one. That one, was played at Dickey Stephens Park and was the closest game between these two teams as the Hogs won 2-1.

• So FAR this SEASON

Bellarmine- The Bears won their home opening ASUN series against Bellarmine, 2-1. In Game 1, the Bears hit 4 home runs on their way to a 17-12 win. Jagger Schattle and Zeb Allen both had one HR, while Nate Negre had 2 as well as a double and ended up with 7 rbi in the game. Sila Cowgill threw 5 relief innings for the win. In Game 3, Hunter Alexander go the win throwing 5.2 innings in relief striking out 5 batters while giving up just 2 earned runs. Negre scored 2 runs on 3 hits including 2 doubles and another HR, totaling 4 rbi in the game. Negre's big weekend earned him aSUN Player of the Week honors.

At La Tech- The Bears suffered a heartbreaker in their mid-week game with the Bulldogs. Jacob Pannell started the game on the mound, threw 5.1 strong innings giving up 4 runs, on 3 hits and striking out 6 batters. Jake Jones pitched the Bears out of a jam, he came in in the 8th with 1 out and the bases loaded and struck out the 2 batters that he faced. Zeb Allen hit another home run. Keon Moseni delivered a pinch hit, two out, double in the 7th inning to tie the game 4-4.

EKU- The Bears won the 1st game in the 3 game series with EKU. Zeb Allen had 5 hits in the series including 2 homeruns, he also had 6 rbi, slugged 1.000 and stole another base. Parker Gwyn had 6 hits in the series and scored 4 runs while batting .545 with a double and a triple, he also had 4 rbi and slugged .818. Braxton Haywood got a win on the mound and had the lowest era on the weekend of anyone that pitched an inning or more. Hunter Alexander recorded a save in the win while throwing on Friday and Sunday with a 1.46 WHIP.

ORU- The Bears got a midweek win over the Golden Eagles. The Bears had a big 2nd inning, the Golden Eagles had a big 4th inning and tied the game in the 6th before the Bears pulled ahead in the 8th. Zeb Allen hit another home run while Landon Carter scored two runs and had an rbi. Patrick Fernandez pitched 3 innings without allowing a run, and stuck out 4 batters. Braxton Haywood closed out the game throwing 2 scoreless innings, striking out 5 batters and didn't allow a hit.

Little Rock 3-game Series- The Bears won game one of the series, LR won games 2 and 3. In the win, Parker Gwyn had a great day at the plate going 3-4 scoring 2 runs, with 2 rbi on a 2-run home run. Jagger Schattle also had 2 rbi in the game with a solo home run and driving home a run with a double. Denver Hamilton got the win and is now 3-0 on the season after pitching 5 innings giving up just 1 earned run and striking out 4 batters.

At Vanderbilt- The Bears took the midweek game at the SEC member, 5-4. This was the 2nd time in a row that the Bears beat Vandy, the last time was in '23. Zeb Allen went 3-4 with 2 RBI. Starting pitcher Pat Fernandez threw 4.1 strong innings allowing 3 hits and 2 runs while striking out 3 batters. Hunter Alexander earned the save retiring Vandy in order in the 9th.

SDSU 3 game series- The Bears won the series 2-1. In game 1, the Bears won 5-1. Denver Hamilton got the win throwing 6.1 innings of 4 hit ball, striking out 5 batters. Hunter Alexander pitched 1 inning, giving up nothing. Zeb Allen hit a 2 run home run and had 4 RBI on the day. The Jackrabbits won game 2, 8-5. Landon Carter hit 1 home run and had 2 RBI's in the game. Zeb Allen had 2 runs and 2 hits in the game. Game 3, Bears won 9-3. Jagger Schattle hit a 2 run home run, Zach Adams scored 2 runs on 3 hits with 2 RBI. Caide White threw 4.2 innings recording 4 strikeouts, Hunter Alexander got the win on the mound throwing 3 innings with 4 strikeouts. **This was Coach Nick Harlans 100th win as UCAs Head Coach.**

At Oklahoma State 1 game- The Bears had a mid-week game at Oklahoma State this week, competed well but the Cowboys had a big fourth inning and earned the win. Jack Runsick had a double, an RBI and scored a run. Tobin Cantrill threw 2 innings in relief, with 2 strikeouts, no hits and no runs.

NWS 4 game series- Bears won games 1, 2 and 4. Demons won game 3 in 15 innings. Zeb Allen batted .450 with 9 hits, 1 HR and 4 RBI, slg% .600 and went 2-2 on stolen base attempts in the series. Jayden Sloan hit a grand slam in game 4 and made a game saving diving catch in center field in game 2. Nate Negre scored 5 runs and had 6 hits in the series. On the mound. All four starting pitchers went at least 6 innings. Hamilton, Meeler, and Fernandez got wins but Caide White had the lowest ERA at 2.84. H. Alexander closed two games earning 2 saves. Jones had a good outing in relief throwing 4 innings of 1 hit baseball.

At ULM 4 game series- The Bears and Warhawks split the series 2-2. Several Bears had an impact offensively last weekend. Parker Gwyn led the Bears in several offensive categories with a .538 AVG, 1.394 OPS, .769 SLG% and .625 OB%. Nate Negre led the team in hits with 8 and stolen bases with 2. Jayden Sloan led the team in runs scored with 6 and walks with 4. Jack Runsick led the team with 6 RBI while Zeb Allen led the team in home runs with 2. The Bears also had several good pitching performances with Caide White leading

the staff going 5.2 innings, just allowing 4 hits and striking out 5 batters. Caden Meeler pitched 5 innings giving up 6 hits in his start, while Hunter Alexander pitched 2.1 innings giving up no runs, just 2 hits and striking out 4 batters.

• LAST SEASON

The Bears, in their fourth season under head coach Nick Harlan, finished 20-35 overall and 12-18 in the Atlantic Sun Conference. The Bears finished in 4th place in the Gold Division of the ASUN Conference. The Bears qualified for the ASUN tournament for the 2nd year in a row.

Three players made the All ASUN team for their efforts in the 2025 season. Third baseman Bryce Ceremenelli and left fielder Zeb Allen were both third-team All-ASUN selections, while shortstop Nathan Negre was named to the ASUN All-Freshman team. Ceremenelli earned All-ASUN honors despite a season-ending knee injury against Lipscomb on April. 19. At the time of the injury, the senior from Norco, Calif., was the No. 2 hitter in the conference with a .395 average. He also finished the regular season as the team-leader in hits (60) and on-base percentage (.461) despite missing the final 14 games. Ceremenelli had just one error on the season and had a .990 fielding percentage. Ceremenelli had 19 multi-hit games and had a streak of 24 consecutive games reaching base. Ceremenelli, was also named to the ASUN All- Academic team as well, he graduated summa cum laude last spring with a degree in family and consumer science. Allen, a sophomore from Fort Smith, Ark., is a two-time selection, having been named to the third team last season as well as to the All-Freshman team. Allen started all 52 games this season and hit .298 with 59 hits, a team-high 16 doubles and a team-best .556 slugging percentage. He also tied for the lead in triples (4) and home runs (9) and had 15 stolen bases to lead the Bears. Allen had 16 multi-hit games and 11 multi-RBI games. Negre, a freshman shortstop from Aurora, Mo., started 49 games and hit .298, with 59 hits and 36 runs batted in. His 22 multi-hit games led the Bears.

Notable games/series in 2025: The Bears swept UAPB in two games during the season, winning by seven in Conway and then later in the season winning by 10 in eight innings. The Bears won 4 series during the '25 season, at home against ECU and Lipscomb and winning both series against Bellarmine in Conway and Louisville. The Bears swept ECU for the series win in Conway. Little Rock won the I-40 Showdown with the Little Rock Trojans.

• 2026 PRESEASON HONORS

Junior Zeb Allen was named to the Preseason All ASUN team. Allen was named third team All ASUN in 2025 and 2024 as well as being named to the All-Freshman team in 2024.

• AROUND THE ASUN

UCA will open its fifth season of ASUN Conference play on March 13th at Eastern Kentucky. In the Preseason Coach's Poll, the Bears were picked to finish in 4th place in the ASUN Gold Division while Austin Peay was picked to finish in 1st place in the ASUN Gold Division and Stetson was picked to finish in 1st place in the ASUN Graphite Division. The Bears did receive one Gold Division first place vote in the poll.

• THE SCHEDULE

To begin the season, UCA will play two four-game series against two schools from Louisiana. First at ULM and then Northwestern State in Conway. The 2026 schedule presents another challenging slate, highlighted by Power Four matchups against Oklahoma State, Vanderbilt, and Arkansas. The Bears will also renew the I-40 Showdown with Little Rock, featuring two games in Conway and one in Little Rock, along with 10 three-game conference series against ASUN opponents.

• THE SQUAD

UCA returns 22 players from last season, and have added 22 players. Of those 22 new players, five are freshmen and 17 are transfers. The roster has 21 players from Arkansas.

Key returning pitchers: Caide White- red shirt last season. Hunter Alexander- Closer. Pitching Newcomers: Denver Hamilton- Transfer from Seminole State CC. JB Williams- Transfer from Northeast Miss CC. Caden Meeler- Freshman. Patrick Fernandez- Transfer from Los Angeles Pierce College. Key returners in the field: Jagger Schattle at 1st base. Nate Negre at shortstop. Sam Reynolds in Center field or 1st base. Zeb Allen in Left field. Casey Shipley at Catcher.

• COACHING STAFF

UCA head coach Nick Harlan returns for his fifth year as the leader of the Bears and his 13th overall in the UCA program. Harlan was the Bears' associate head coach and pitching coach since 2013 and took over for the retired Allen Gum in May 2021. Gum finished as the winningest coach in school history.

Harlan, first new head coach for the Bears since 2011, came to UCA in 2013 after serving previously as the head coach at his alma mater, York (Neb.) College, where he put together a 363-181 record from 2004-13. He led the Bears to a 24-29 record (18-12 in the ASUN) in his first season as the head man in 2022.

UCA Assistant Coaches: Former UCA All-Conference pitcher Cody Davenport is the Associate Head Coach and pitching coach in his fifth season coaching the Bears. Former UCA player Lance Spigner (1986-89) is the Assistant to the Head Coach after a long and successful high school and junior college coaching career and is in his third career coaching at UCA. Heath Holliday is new to the staff and will assume the recruiting coordinator, hitting and catching coach roles. Kollin Kendrick will serve as Director of Analytics and Operations in his third season with the program.

• ASUN RANKINGS

UCA ranked ninth in the 12-team ASUN in pitching last season, with a team ERA of 7.25. FGCU was the ASUN Tournament champion while Austin Peay won the Gold Division and Stetson won the Graphite Division. Stetson led the league in pitching with a 4.34 ERA. The Bears were 4th in batting with a .279 average. Austin Peay was head and shoulders above everyone else with a .333 average. Second place was Stetson at .285.

UCA was the 2nd best defensive team in the conference with a .972 fielding percentage (55 errors in 55 games). UCA lead the league in hit by pitch with 100.

Individually, Bryce Ceremenelli was 2nd in batting average at .395. Zeb Allen was hit by a pitch 22 times, good for 2nd place in the league. Nate Negre was 1st in sacrifice bunts (7), Zeb Allen and Nate Negre tied for 5th in triples (4).

Charlie Christensen was 6th in innings pitched at 80. Hunter Alexander was second in saves with 2. Hunter Alexander and Charlie Christensen were tied for 16th in wins with 4.

• UPGRADES AT THE BEAR

After 31 years at UCA Steve East retired from his role as Associate Athletic Director and Media Relations contact. At the end of his final season calling/stating games for the Bears in 2025, UCA honored Steve by naming the Press Box at Bear Stadium in his honor.

Bear Stadium debuted a new video board for the 2024 season. The video board replaced the old scoreboard at the same location in left-center field. A booth for visiting radio/TV/overflow media was also added on the third-base side of the concourse level, opposite the ESPN+ booth which was added on the first-base side in 2023.

Four years ago, Bear Stadium featured new turf with purple foul territory, along with a new outfield fence and new bullpens for both home and visiting teams. The visiting bullpen is no longer in the field of play, but instead located just outside the right-field wall. That wall has been moved in to 305 in the right-field corner to accommodate the new bullpen. UCA's bullpen has been moved out from behind the hitting facility and is now located beyond the home dugout between the field and the hitting facility.

• SEASON OPENERS

The Bears are now 9-10 in their past 19 season openers since moving to NCAA Division I in 2007. Last season the Bears started the season at home, host-

ing Northwestern State. The Bears won the first game of the series before losing the second game in extra innings as well as dropping the 3rd game of the 3 game series.

• NOTABLES

- The Bears have brothers on the 2026 roster for the fourth year in a row. Last year catcher Carter Alexander joined his brother Hunter Alexander on the Bears' roster. Hunter was UCA's closer last season, while Carter was a freshman. Both played at Bigelow (Ark.) High School. Both are back on the roster again in 2026.
- The Bears had six games with 14 hits last season. They had double-figure hits 26 times.
- UCA stole a season-high 5 bases twice, vs. Evansville and Bellarmine.
- UCA received a season high 13 walks from Eastern Michigan pitchers on Feb. 22, 2025.
- UCA played 8 one-run games and finished 4-4 in those outings.
- The Bears were 2-3 in extra-inning games, The Bears were shutout 2 times and shutout their opponent 2 times.
- In games where they score 10+ runs, UCA was a perfect 11-0.
- UCA's longest win streak in '25 was 5 games, longest losing streak 7 games.
- UCA played in front of crowds of 10,742 at Arkansas in Fayetteville. The UCA at ASU game drew 1072.
- The Bears competed in the Southland Conference from 2007-2021. While in the SLC, UCA had a 204-232-2 record, and went 121-110 over the final eight seasons.

• DIVISION I POSTSEASON HISTORY

The Bears reached the Southland Conference championship game in 2019 for the fourth time since 2013, losing to McNeese 4-2 in the title game after playing a 10-inning game earlier in the day (6-3 win over Southeastern Louisiana). There was no tournament in 2020 due to covid-19. UCA lost out by one percentage point in making the field for the 2021 tournament.

UCA won the 2013 SLC Tournament as the seventh seed after losing its opener to Texas A&M-Corpus Christi, then winning five consecutive elimination games, shutting out third-seeded Southeastern Louisiana 4-0 in the title game. The Bears were runnerup in 2014 as the tournament host at Bear Stadium, and again in 2017 and 2019.

After the 2013 championship, the Bears advanced to their first NCAA Regional at Starkville, Miss. UCA went 3-3 in the regional, beating every team there (Mercer, South Alabama, MSU) before losing to the Bulldogs in the final.

• GOVERNOR'S I-40 SHOWDOWN

The Bears and Little Rock Trojans will compete in the fifth year (2020 canceled due to covid-19) of the "Governor's I-40 Showdown" in a year-long battle between the schools who are just 25 miles apart. The teams will compete for points in each sport that both schools sponsor, amounting to 15 contests with a total of 41 points available.

• IN THE SHOW

Former Bear pitcher Gavin Stone made his MLB debut on May 3, 2023 for the Los Angeles Dodgers, starting against the Philadelphia Phillies. He was in just his third season of professional baseball. He was a fifth-round draft choice in 2020. His final game at UCA was a no-hitter against Southeastern Louisiana. UCA won 2-0 with Stone striking out 13 and walking one, facing 28 batters. He has been tabbed as the Dodger's fifth starter to open the 2024 season. He was part of the Dodgers' rotation for most of the season in 2024 before a late-season injury cut his season short.

Former Bears' pitcher Tyler Cleveland has earned a non-roster invite to 2025 spring training with the Seattle Mariners. He split the 2024 season between Modesto (A) and Everett (A+) in the Mariners' organization.

Lefty pitcher Noah Cameron split time between the Northwest Arkansas (AA) and Omaha (AAA) organizations (KC Royals) last season and was named the International League Pitcher of the Month in August 2024.

Former UCA pitcher Ty Tice is currently a free agent after stints with the Toronto Blue Jays, Atlanta Braves, Arizona Diamondbacks and Washington Nationals organizations.

Former Bear Jonathan Davis is currently a free agent who played for the Blue Jays Yankees, Brewers, Tigers and Marlins. He has 205 career games in MLB.

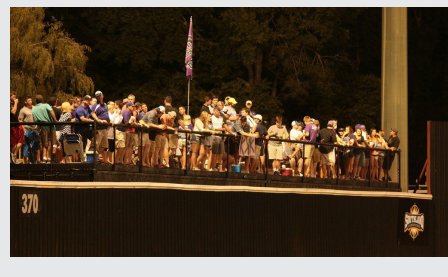
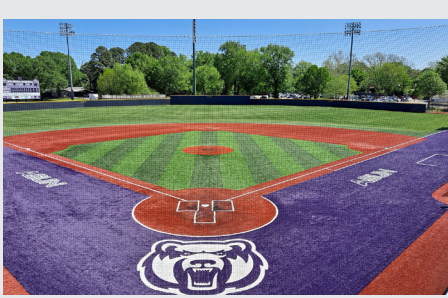

HEAD COACH NICK HARLAN

Nick Harlan was hired at the University of Central Arkansas as the associate head coach and pitching coach in August 2013, and was then named head coach in May 2021 after the retirement of Allen Gum.

Harlan joined the Bears after nine seasons as the head coach at his alma mater York College in York, Neb. One year under Harlan's leadership, UCA pitchers put together a great effort and notched a 3.58 ERA while helping the Bears earn a spot in the Southland Tournament Championship Game.

During his time at UCA's pitching coach, the Bears had six pitchers taken in the Major League Baseball Draft, including most recently, left hander Noah Cameron in 2021 by the Kansas City Royals. The others were Jeffery Enloe in 2013, Ty Tice in 2017, Tyler Gray in 2017 and 2018, Cody Davenport in 2019 and Gavin Stone in 2020. Tyler Cleveland was also drafted by the Seattle Mariners in 2022.

Harlan believes baseball is a great platform to teach disciplines that will build character and encourage young men to live with purpose. He believes that creating a culture of selflessness and accountability for consistent effort and competitiveness from his pitching staff will lead to success on the field and in life. "If we focus on the process of being the best men, teammates, and pitchers every day, we will make a greater impact on the people around us and give our team a chance for success." Harlan said.

Harlan was hired in 2004 as the head coach at York College. During Harlan's tenure (325-170 record) the Panthers won 5 conference championships, and earned 5 regional berths. During that time the Panthers were ranked as high as 8th in the country and in the top 25 for four consecutive years. In 2013, the Panthers earned a #1 seed in the Joliet, Ill regional, winning the regional and advancing to the NAIA World Series. York won a school-record 45 games in 2010.

Harlan was a two time MCAC Coach of the Year and in 2013 was named the York College Young Alumnus of the Year. In 2013 the NAIA awarded York College baseball with the Hank Burbridge Champions of Character award. The award is given to one team in the nation who exemplifies the 5 core values of the NAIA: Integrity, Respect, Responsibility, Sportsmanship, and Servant Leadership.

In 2003 Harlan was given the opportunity to go back to his alma mater as an assistant coach for one year under head coach Jerry Laird. Harlan began his coaching career in 2002 as an assistant coach under head coach Jedd Soto at Feather River Community College in Quincy, CA where he helped lead the Golden Eagles to their first California Final Four appearance and were awarded the California Pepsi Team Scholar Award for a cumulative team grade point average of 3.4. During this time he also served as an Associate Scout for the Philadelphia Phillies under Scott Ramsey.

Harlan was born in Oroville, California where he graduated from Oroville High School. He earned his Bachelor's Degree from York College.

Harlan married the former Lindsay Spivey, a UCA alum, on July 26, 2014 in Little Rock, AR. Nick and Lindsay share a home with their daughter Hazel Grace, son Walker Spivey and their dog Jesse.
