



2016 REVIEW





AUSTIN ALLEN became the first quarterback in school history and one of just four in the SEC since 2000 to throw multiple touchdown passes in each of the first seven games of a season, joining Kenny Hill (Texas A&M, 2014), Andre Woodson (Kentucky, 2007) and Rex Grossman (Florida, 2001).

ALLEN DELIVERED AS QB1

In his first season as the Razorbacks' top signal-caller, **QB AUSTIN ALLEN** immediately made his mark by leading the SEC with 3,430 passing yards, including a league-best 2,291 in conference play. He finished with 25 touchdown passes, which ranked second in the conference, completed 61.1 percent of his passes (245 of 401) and boasted a 146.04 passer rating.

His 3,430 passing yards and 25 touchdown passes each ranked fifth in single-season school history. Of his 25 touchdown passes, 19 came inside the red zone, which led the SEC and tied for 10th in the FBS. He also tied for the FBS lead with 15 touchdown passes against ranked opponents.

The Fayetteville product threw for 200-plus yards in 11 games, including four 300-plus yard performances in SEC play.

RW3 TOPS 1,000-YARDS RUSHING

RB RAWLEIGH WILLIAMS III became the 13th player in Arkansas history to eclipse 1,000 yards rushing in a season. Williams captured the SEC regular-season rushing title with 1,326 yards and finished the year with 1,360.

Arkansas has had a 1,000-yard rusher in four straight seasons by three different players. Williams also became the seventh different running back to run for 1,000 yards in **HC BRET BIELEMA'S** 11-year head coaching career. Bielema has had a 1,000-yard rusher in each of his 11 seasons as a head coach.

In addition, Williams became the sixth different running back to run for 200 yards in a single-game under Bielema in his 11 seasons as a head coach. Bielema is 10-0 all-time when he has a player run for 200 or more yards.

DOUBLE TROUBLE

Arkansas has been one of the most balanced offenses in the nation over the last two seasons under **OC DAN ENOS**. In fact, Arkansas and Boise State were the

only two FBS teams to have a 3,000-yard passer and 1,300-yard rusher in each of the last two seasons. Even more impressive, Arkansas was the only school that accomplished the feat with two different quarterbacks and two different running backs.

The combo of a 3,000-yard passer and 1,300-yard rusher has been accomplished three times in Arkansas' program history (2010, 15, 16) with two coming under Enos the last two years.

Arkansas was one of 14 FBS programs with a 3,000-yard passer and 1,300-yard rusher in 2016 and one of just nine FBS programs with a different 3,000-yard passer in 2015 and 2016.

QB BRANDON ALLEN (2015) and **QB AUSTIN ALLEN** (2016) each passed for 3,000 yards in the last two seasons. The only other time two different Arkansas quarterbacks threw for 3,000 yards in consecutive seasons came in 2010 (**RYAN MALLETT**) and 2011 (**TYLER WILSON**).

Arkansas was one of just four FBS programs with a different 1,300-yard rusher in 2015 and 2016. It was just the second time Arkansas had a 1,300-yard rusher in back-to-back seasons and the first time two different players accounted for 1,300 yards rushing in consecutive seasons. **RB DARREN MCFADDEN** rushed for over 1,300 yards in 2006 and 2007.

RW3'S CAREER NIGHT

RB RAWLEIGH WILLIAMS III had a career performance at Mississippi State on Nov. 19, rushing for 205 yards and four TDs on 16 carries and passing for a TD. He became the fourth player in Arkansas history to run for over 200 yards in an SEC game.

Williams was also the first non-QB in college football in 2016 to rush for four TDs and pass for a TD in a game and one of two FBS running backs to run for four TDs and pass for another since 2000. The other was former Wisconsin RB James White (2012 vs. Nebraska in BIG Championship Game), who also played for **HC BRET BIELEMA** at the time.

Williams set career-highs for rushing yards and TDs in the first half against Mississippi State with 191 yards and four touchdowns on just eight carries. He had a hand in five of Arkansas' first six TDs in the game with four coming on the ground and the fifth coming on a 1-yard TD pass on 4th-and-goal in the third quarter. He eclipsed 100-yards rushing in his first four attempts (122), marking the first time that an Arkansas running back has rushed for more than 100 yards in the first quarter since **RB KNILE DAVIS** on Nov. 20, 2010.

IN GOOD COMPANY

RB RAWLEIGH WILLIAMS III was one of just two players in the SEC to run for 200 yards and four TDs in a game in 2016. In fact, he became one of only seven players in the conference to accomplish that feat since 2000.

Williams also joined **RB JAMES ROUSE** as the only two players in Arkansas history to rush for 200 yards and four TDs in a game and became the first to do so in an SEC game. Rouse tallied 219 yards rushing and four TDs on 19 carries on Nov. 28, 1987 against New Mexico.



Senior **DAN SKIPPER** finished his career with 47 consecutive starts and became just the sixth offensive lineman in program history to earn All-SEC status in two different seasons.

RAGNOW NAMED COLLEGE FOOTBALL'S BEST OFFENSIVE LINEMAN AND BEST RUN BLOCKER

OL FRANK RAGNOW was named the nation's best offensive lineman, best run blocker and a first-team All-American by Pro Football Focus (PFF) for the 2016 season. He helped pave the way for the Razorbacks to manufacture 428.4 yards of total offense per game, highlighted by five games with both 200 yards rushing and passing.

Ragnow graded out as the top center in the nation by PFF twice in 2016 after his performances during wins over then-No. 11 Florida and at Mississippi State. He graded out as a top three center in five of 12 regular-season games and earned an 80 percent grade or higher from PFF seven times. According to PFF, Ragnow didn't allow a sack for the second straight season and decreased his total number of pressures allowed from 19 in 2015 to just 12.

Ragnow also was named SEC Offensive Lineman of the Week on Sept. 18, 2016, for his efforts in his start at right guard against Texas State. He graded out at a career-best 92 percent and helped Arkansas rush for 226 yards and three scores in the 42-3 win. The Victoria, Minnesota, product has made 26 straight starts heading into his senior campaign with 14 starts at right guard and 12 at center.

ZERO TO 100

Prior to 2016, **WR JARED CORNELIUS** had never totaled 100 or more yards receiving in a single game. After logging 100-plus yards through the air in Weeks 4, 5 and 6, Cornelius matched a 20-year-old school record of three straight 100-yard receiving games. Cornelius totaled a career-high 146 yards on five receptions against No. 1 Alabama in Week 6 to join former Razorbacks **WR ANTHONY LUCAS** (1996) and **WR MIKE REPPOND** (1971) as the only three players in school history to accomplish that feat. His three games over the century mark through the air tied for fourth in the SEC.

SKIPPER ADDED ALL-AMERICA TO LIST OF HONORS

OL DAN SKIPPER was named to the 2016 AFCA FBS Coaches' All-America Team by the American Football Coaches Association. Skipper, who earned second-team status, finished his collegiate career with 47 consecutive starts on the offensive line – the second-longest streak in program history – with 26 coming at left tackle, 13 at right tackle and eight at left guard.

THE ULTIMATE GOAL

Last fall, Razorbacks who graduated from the university and earned a degree but still competed for their respective teams in their final year of NCAA eligibility were honored with a special patch on their jersey that brings to light their academic achievement on a national stage. An initiative championed by Vice Chancellor and Director of Athletics Jeff Long, the new patch features the traditional red and white SEC logo with a "stole" wrapping underneath it emblazoned with the all-important word, "Graduate."
