ARKANSAS RAZORBACKS at MISSISSIPPI STATE BULLDOGS

POSTGAME NOTES: NO. 21 MISSISSIPPI STATE 52, ARKANSAS 6

PREGAME NOTES

- The Razorbacks wore white helmets, cardinal jerseys and white pants against Mississippi State. It's the second time this season Arkansas has worn the uniform combination, last doing so against Ole Miss in Little Rock on Oct. 13.
- Arkansas won the coin toss and deferred to the second half. Mississippi State received the ball to begin the game. Arkansas defended the northeast end zone. It was the third time this season Arkansas has won the toss & deferred, all away from Fayetteville.
- Arkansas' captains were seniors Hjalte Froholdt, Dre Greenlaw & Santos Ramirez and junior De'Jon Harris. The Razorbacks elected the quartet as team captains during Week 5 for the remainder of the season.
- Weather - 63 degrees, sunny, N 0 mph

GENERAL NOTES

- Saturday marked the 29th meeting between the Razorbacks and the Bulldogs. Arkansas leads the all-time series, 16-12-1, with the first matchup coming in 1916.
- The game was the 27th-straight season Arkansas has played Mississippi State, dating back to the Razorbacks' first season in the SEC in 1992.
- Arkansas is now 7-7 against the Bulldogs in games played in Starkville.
- The Razorbacks are 9-8 when playing on Nov. 17, including a 2-2 record against MSU on the date.

- It was Dorian Gerald's first start of his career.
- Hjalte Froholdt made his 36th consecutive start, the longest streak among current Razorbacks.
- Santos Ramirez & De'Jon Harris made their 23rd consecutive starts, tied for the most on the defensive side of the ball.

OFFENSIVE NOTES

- Connor Limpert's 36-yard field goal with 0:32 remaining in the second quarter was the first score of the game for the Razorbacks. It was the sixth time this season Arkansas' first score of the game was a field goal.
- The Razorbacks kicked another field goal on the first drive of the second half to make it a 17-6 game, the sixth time this year Arkansas has scored on the first drive of the second half, fifth via field goal.
- Connor Noland entered the game at quarterback with 3:02 remaining in the third quarter, trailing 38-6.

DEFENSIVE NOTES

- Arkansas stood up inside the five-yard line on the first drive of the game, giving up a field goal to the Bulldogs after a 14-play, 81-yard drive of 6:33. It was the fourth time this season the Razorbacks have allowed a FG on the first drive of the contest.
- Fifth time this season the Razorbacks have held their opponents to three or fewer points in the first quarter.
- Eighth game with 17 points or fewer allowed at halftime.

SPECIAL TEAMS NOTES

- Connor Limpert's 36-yard field goal with 0:32 remaining in the second quarter was the first score of the game for the Razorbacks. It was the sixth time this season Arkansas' first score of the game was a field goal.
- Limpert added a 32-yarder with 11:19 remaining in the third quarter to pull the deficit to 17-6.
- Limpert's FGs were his 18th & 19th of the season, moving him into a tie for fifth in field goals made in a single season by a Razorback - Bruce Lahay (1981) and Steve Little (1977).
- Limpert has made a field goal in each of the last 12 games.

PLAYER NOTES

K Connor Limpert

- 2-for-3 FG - 43x, 36, 32
- His 36-yard field goal with 0:32 remaining in the second quarter was his 18th of the season, then followed on the next possession with a 32-yarder for his 19th of the year.
- Limpert's two field goals moved him into a tie for fifth in field goals made in a single season by a Razorback - Bruce Lahay (1981) and Steve Little (1977).
- He has made at least one field goal in each of the last 12 games.

WR La'Michael Pettway

- Led the team with four receptions for 83 yards, including a 47-yard catch in the third quarter, his second longest of the season.
- Seventh-straight game with a catch - ties the team lead.

TE Cheyenne O'Grady

- Finished the game with two receptions for 24 yards, including a 17-yard catch in the first quarter.
- Seventh-straight game with a reception - tied for team-lead

DL Dorian Gerald

- Finished the game with eight tackles, including 1.5 for loss.
- Had 1.0 TFL coming into today's game.

WR Deon Stewart

- Caught a team high six passes for 13 yards.
- Third-straight game with a reception.

LB Dre Greenlaw

- Recorded eight tackles in today's contest.

DE McTelvin Agim

- Tallied five tackles, including 0.5 for loss.
- Fourth-straight game with at least 0.5 tackle for loss

QB Ty Storey

- 16-of-28, 137 yards, 1 INT
- Has thrown for 100+ yards in each of the last seven games.

WR Mike Woods

- Had three catches for 15 yards, his third game this season with three or more receptions.
- Third-straight game with a reception.

WR Jordan Jones

- Fourth-straight game with a reception.

LG Hjalte Froholdt

- Made his 36th consecutive start - the most by any current Razorback.

QB Connor Noland

- 2-for-3, 8 yards.
- Appeared in his third game this season, taking over at quarterback with 3:02 remaining in the third quarter.

CB Jarques McClellion

- Broke up a pass to bring his season total to seven, which ties the team lead.

DT Armon Watts

- Finished the game with five tackles and a quarterback hurry, his third of the season.
