POSTGAME NOTES: MISSOURI 38, ARKANSAS 0

PREGAME NOTES

- The Razorbacks wore white helmets, white jerseys and white pants against Missouri. It's the second time this season Arkansas has worn the uniform combination, last doing so against Eastern Illinois in the season opener on Sept. 1.
- Arkansas won the coin toss and deferred to the second half. Missouri received the ball to begin the game. Arkansas defended the northeast end zone. It was the fourth time this season Arkansas has won the toss & deferred, all away from Fayetteville.
- Arkansas' captains were seniors Hjalte Froholdt & Santos Ramirez and junior De'Jon Harris. The Razorbacks elected the quartet as team captains during Week 5 for the remainder of the season.
- Weather - 44 degrees, rainy, SSE 15 mph, barometric pressure 29.2

GENERAL NOTES

- Saturday marked the 10th meeting between the Razorbacks and the Tigers. Arkansas trails the all-time series, 3-7, with the first matchup coming in 1906.
- The game was the fifth-straight season Arkansas has played Missouri.
- The Razorbacks are now 1-3 with the Battle Line Trophy on the line - the trophy was introduced in 2015, winning the first contest in Fayetteville, 28-3.
- Arkansas is now 1-4 against the Tigers in games played in Columbia.
- The Razorbacks are 11-9 when playing on Nov. 23 - Friday was the first time Arkansas has played Missouri on Nov. 23.

- Hjalte Froholdt made his 37th consecutive start, the longest streak among current Razorbacks.
- Santos Ramirez & De'Jon Harris made their 23rd consecutive starts, tied for the most on the defensive side of the ball.
- Five seniors started for the Razorbacks on Friday, including four on defense. It was Foucha's first career start.

OFFENSIVE NOTES

- Connor Noland entered the game at quarterback with 9:54 remaining in the second quarter trailing 21-0.

DEFENSIVE NOTES

- Eighth time this season holding the opponent to seven or fewer points in the first quarter.

PLAYER NOTES

WR Jared Cornelius

- Finished with one catch for three yards.
- Back-to-back games with a catch.

FS Joe Foucha

- Tallied three tackles, all solo.
- First career start

WR La'Michael Pettway

- Led the team with three catches, totalling 29 yards on four targets.
- Eighth-straight game with a catch - ties the team lead.

WR Deon Stewart

- Caught two passes for 12 yards.
- Fourth-straight game with a reception.

CB Montaric Brown

- Recorded five tackles, all solo including a pass breakup.
- Career-high total tackles - entered the game with four (three solo).

QB Ty Storey

- 4-of-7, 24 yards, 1 INT

QB Connor Noland

- 5-17, 98 yards.
- Appeared in his fourth game this season, taking over at quarterback with 9:54 remaining in the second quarter.

LG Hjalte Froholdt

- Made his 37th consecutive start - the most by any current Razorback.

RB Devwah Whaley

- Rushed for 54 yards on 13 attempts.
- Caught two passes for 61 yards including a long of 43.
- Back-to-back games with a catch.
- Season-high receiving yards - most since career-high 69 vs. Florida (11/5/16).

DT Armon Watts

- Finished with seven tackles, including 1.0 for loss.
- Fourth game in five with a tackle for loss - recorded a TFL on Missouri's second drive of the game.

TE Cheyenne O'Grady

- Finished the game with one catch for 17 yards.
- Eighth-straight game with a reception - tied for team-lead

LB De'Jon Harris

- Led the team with eight tackles, seven solo, and a hurry.
- Seventh game to lead the team in total tackles - finishes the year with 118.
