#### NOW IT'S TIME FOR THE BREAKDOWN

University of Missouri football closes out the 2022 regular season on Friday, Nov. 25, 2022 against Arkansas for the Battle Line Rivalry, presented by Shelter Insurance, at 2:30 p.m. CT inside Faurot Field/Memorial Stadium. The game is set to air on CBS and the Tiger Radio Network.

#### THE BATTLE LINE RIVALRY

Friday's victor receives the massive Battle Line Trophy, which is made of silver and stands more than four feet tall and weighs more than 180 pounds. The trophy depicts the outline of the two states with the border of the two states being divided by interchangeable silver inserts with the words Battle Line in either gold or cardinal. The color of the Battle Line within the trophy will be reflective of the winner of the series' most recent game - gold for the five of the last six years, representing MU triumphs.

#### THE SERIES

The Tigers and the Razorbacks first met in 1906, in CoMo, with Mizzou taking the 11-0 decision. Since then, the two teams have tangled for a total of 13 games. MU holds the 9-4 edge over UA and won the last meeting in Columbia, 50-48, in 2020.

#### THE COACHES

ELIAH DRINKWITZ is in his third season as Mizzou's head coach. He led the Tigers to bowl appearances in each of his first two seasons, joining former head coach Warren Powers as the only two MU head coaches to achieve that feat. Additionally, only Powers won more games in his first two seasons at MU (1978-79, 15) than Drinkwitz (11). Prior to taking the Mizzou job, Drinkwitz was 12-1 as the head coach at Appalachian State in 2019. He had previous stops as the OC at NC State, Boise State and Arkansas State.

SAM PITTMAN is 18-16 in his third year at Arkansas, leading them to eight regular-season wins a year ago, their highest total in a decade. He's serving his second stint in Fayetteville after spending 2013-15 as the assistant head coach and OL coach. He was Mizzou's OL coach in 2000 and has also coached at Georgia, Tennessee and North Carolina during his 35-year career.

#### STREAKS, STORYLINES, SIDEBARS ...

- Mizzou honored 21 seniors before the New Mexico State game, offensive players Jack Abraham, Barrett Banister, DJ Bullard, Kibet Chepyyator, Tauskie Dove, Bobby Lawrence, Nathaniel Peat, Zeke Powell, Trenton Sederwall, Richard Taylor and Connor Wood; defensive players DJ Coleman, Tyrone Hopper II, Trajan Jeffcoat, Martez Manuel, Isaiah McGuire, Devin Nicholson, Darius Robinson, Jalani Williams and special Teamers Jake Hoffman and Sean Koetting. In accordance with Mizzou tradition, following the win, they each took a rock from the M in the north end of the stadium and were carried off the field by their teammates.
- The path forward for Mizzou is simple - win Friday and it would earn a bowl bid for the third-straight season. The Tigers last had three-straight bowl bids from 2009-11 - part of seven-straight postseason games between 2006-11.
- Mizzou announced a pair of contract extensions recently, adding two years to Head Coach Eliah Drinkwitz and three to Defensive Coordinator Blake Baker. Drinkwitz is locked up through the 2027 season while Baker is inked through 2025.
- WR Barrett Banister was named a semifinalist for the Wuerffel Trophy and K Harrison Mevis is a semifinalist for the Groza.
- DB Kris Abrams-Draine is tied for the top spot in the SEC in passes defended with 11, an average of 1.22 per game.
- The 2022 Tigers rank among the SEC's top four teams in scoring defense (4th, 21.4 ppg), rushing defense (4th, 86.3 ypg), passing defense (4th, 192.4 ypg) and total defense (4th, 304.1 ypg).
- Four of Mizzou's five SEC losses are by seven points or less and a combined 18 points, excluding Tennessee.
- With 61,047 fans packing Faurot vs. Kentucky, it marked the first back-to-back games with an attendance of 60,000 since 2015 (South Carolina and Florida). Mizzou has averaged 56,147 fans per game at home, an increase of nearly 10,000 fans per game from the Tigers' 2021 averages of 46,516 fans per game.
- Academically, the 2.92 team grade point average in Spring 2022 was football's highest in eighteen years, excluding the spring 2020 pass/fail period.

## MEDIA PARKING AND WILL CALL

- Media parking is located at Tiger Ave. Parking Structure (TAPS), at the corner of Tiger Ave. and Hospital Dr. The main entrance is on the east side of the building, directly across from the children's ER entrance. Staff will be managing will call at the bench outside the entrance.
- Home game credentials are available for pickup at the south entrance of Mizzou Arena, Fridays 9 a.m.-4:30 p.m. On game day, Media Will Call is located at the entrance of Tiger Ave. Parking Structure (TAPS) starting two hours out and until kickoff.

- Photographers and videographers are required to wear disposable vests while capturing on the field. Vests are distributed via Media Will Call at TAPS starting two hours out and until kickoff.

## PRESS BOX

- The Memorial Stadium / Faurot Field press box (6th floor, west side) opens to working media 90 minutes prior to kick off. The space is accessible using the elevator at Gate 5W.
- Mizzou Athletics will provide a meal, drinks and snacks during the game.

## FIELD ACCESS (NON-PHOTO/VIDEO)

- Pregame field access for non-photo/video personnel begins 90 minutes out and ends at 15:00 prior to kickoff.
- Non-photo/video personnel can access the field with 5:00 left in the fourth quarter but must get back to the 3rd floor concourse SW corner to access the post-game press conference.

## FIELD ACCESS (PHOTO/VIDEO)

- Photographers and videographers are required to wear disposable vests. Vests are distributed at Media Will Call located at TAPS (opens two hours out).
- The on-field photo/video work room is located in the SW corner/tunnel of Memorial Stadium / Faurot Field.
- Field access for photo/video personnel with professional camera equipment in hand begins 90 minutes out. One shooter per media outlet allowed on the field. Tripods are prohibited. Storage for equipment is available in the field-level photo/video work room.
- All on-field photographers and videographers must remain outside of the team boxes at all times.
- Pre-game stand-ups are allowed in stadium with prior approval and only in the north concourse. In- and post-game stand-ups on the field and in the stadium are prohibited. Those wishing to do in- and post-game stand-ups should find a location outside of the stadium.

## POSTGAME INTERVIEW PROCEDURES

- In-game interviews are prohibited. Postgame interviews on the field are prohibited.
- Postgame interviews with Mizzou head coach Eliah Drinkwitz and student-athletes will be held in SEZ defensive meeting room following a brief cooling-off period.
- The SEZ defensive meeting room is available for set-up post-game only. Access to the space prior to 00:00 is prohibited.
- With 2:00 left in the 4th quarter, Mizzou Strat Comm staff will meet in the SW corner on the third floor concourse by the Centene Corporation sign to escort media to the press conference. Those on the field need to get to the 3rd floor SW corner to access the post-game press conference. A staffer will direct the group in when the clock hits 0:00.
- Visiting team post-game media availability is at the direction of the visiting communications staff. The visiting team post-game interview room is in the SE corner tunnel (labeled 020), across from the visiting locker room.

**LAST TIME VS. THE HOGS**

- Tyler Badie ran a career-high 41 times for 219 yards and a TD in the Tigers' 34-17 loss at No. 25 Arkansas.
- The Razorbacks used a handful of big plays, a strong second half and a stifling defense of Mizzou's passing game in their first win in the series since 2015.
- On Missouri's final drive, Badie rushed nine times for 51 yards including a five-yard touchdown that produced the final score. He ran for a new single-season school record with 1,604 yards.

**IF YOU BUILD IT, THEY WILL COME**

- Mizzou leads the SEC with a 17% increase in its football attendance this season.
- The Tigers have averaged 54,328 fans at Faurot Field's first five home games this year, an increase over the 2021 average of 46,516 fans.
- The crowds of 60,618 vs. Vanderbilt and 61,047 vs. Kentucky The 61,047 marked the first back-to-back games with an attendance of 60,000 or more since 2015 (South Carolina and Florida).

**COOK-ING WITH THE AGGIES**

- QB Brady Cook finished 19-of-27 for 251 yards with three touchdowns and zero interceptions vs. NMSU.
- The performance marked Cook's second-consecutive, three-TD outing and his third overall.

**FALLING FOR THE FIRST TIME**

- TE Ryan Hoerstkamp snagged his first target, reception, and TD, all on the same play - a 32-yard score against New Mexico State.
- RB Tavorus Jones saw action for the third time in his freshman season. His first play on the field vs. NMSU resulted in a 32-yard reception, the first of his career.
- QB Sam Horn took his first career snaps in the fourth quarter vs. NMSU. He rushed for 10 yards in the game.

**THUNDER & LIGHTNING**

- WR Luther Burden III and RB Cody Schrader accounted for four TDs vs. New Mexico State.
- Burden grabbed two receiving TDs, his third multi-TD game in 2022. He ran his season tally to five - the most by a freshman since Dorial Green-Beckham snagged the same total in 2012.
- Schrader punched in two scores, a two-yarder in the second quarter followed by a five-yard touchdown on the initial possession of the second half, reaching seven rushing touchdowns on the year.

**FIRST-HALF FORCE**

- For the sixth time this season, Mizzou held an opponent under 120 yards of total offense in the first half.
- New Mexico State had 112 yards before the break, joining Vanderbilt (120), Kentucky (119), South Carolina (104), Abilene Christian (51) and Florida (33) in first-half offensive struggles against the Tigers defense.

**SIMPLY RED**

- Mizzou's defense did not allow New Mexico State into the red zone until the 5:35 mark of the third quarter.

**NO-FLY ZONE**

- New Mexico State completed 38% of its passes - the lowest completion pct. versus the Tigers since Kentucky completed just 35% of its passes against Mizzou in 2020.

**SUDDEN CHANGE**

- Daylan Carnell earned his second career interception, and first pick six of his career, early in the fourth vs. NMSU.
- The 42-yard INT return was the second of the season for the Tigers, and the longest since Jarvis Ware took an interception 59 yards to the house in 2020 against Florida.

**THE RARE DOUBLE**

- QB Brady Cook had 106 yards rushing and 217 yards passing at Tennessee - the first Tiger to hit that mark since James Franklin vs. Oklahoma in 2011 (103 r, 291 p).
- Cook set career bests for carries (16), yards (106) and longest rush (40). He also went over 2,000 yards passing for the season.
- Chase Daniel accomplished the feat in 2008 against Kansas (103 r, 288 p) and Brad Smith did it five times.
- Cook's 106 yards on the ground are the most by a Mizzou quarterback since Nov. 2, 2013 when Maty Mauk racked up 114 yards against Tennessee, which was also the last time a Mizzou quarterback broke triple digits in rushing yards.

**THIRD & BANISTER**

- WR Barrett Banister racked up 91 yards on seven catches vs. NMSU. He has broken his career high in receiving yards for the second week in a row, after his 73 yards at Tennessee bested his previous high.
- He has 36 catches on the season - his fourth-straight season with 27 or more catches, the first Tiger to accomplish the feat since Chase Coffman (2005-08).
- Banister also has a catch in 43 of 50+ career games.

**WALK THE LINE**

- The Tennessee game marked the sixth different starting five for the offensive line this season.
- In Knoxville and vs. NMSU, the Tigers started LT Javon Foster, LG Xavier Delgado, C Connor Tollison, RG Connor Wood and RT Armand Membou.
- Foster and Tollison have been the constants, starting the first 11 games.
- Delgado missed the ACU game and was replaced by Luke Griffin.
- Wood has started five games at RG and five at RT.
- At RG, Mitchell Walters had four starts and EJ Ndoma-Ogar had two - starting at South Carolina before being injured against Kentucky.
- RT Zeke Powell was injured in the Auburn game and was replaced by Wood and later Membou.
- Hyrin White was injured in the spring and will not play this season.

**YOUTH OF THE NATION**

- WR Luther Burden III and OL Armand Membou both have earned starts as true freshmen this season with Burden starting seven games and Membou two.
- They're the first true freshman players to earn starts for Mizzou since Evan Boehm (2012).

**ON THE HOT SEAT**

- First-time starters in 2022 include: Taj Butts (RB), Kibet Chepyator (TE), Jayden Jernigan (DT), Mehki Miller (WR), EJ Ndoma-Ogar (OL), Tyler Stephens (TE), Connor Tollison (C), Mitchell Walters (RG) and Kristian Williams (DT).
- First Division I snaps in 2022 include: Luther Burden III (WR), Tyler Jones (DB), Armand Membou (OL), Mehki Miller (WR), Jack Stonehouse (P) and Ja'Marion Wayne (DB).

**MCGUIRE SNAGS SEC HONOR**

- DL Isaiah McGuire was tabbed as the SEC Defensive Lineman of the Week following the win at South Carolina.
- McGuire tied his career bests with three tackles for a loss and two sacks, finishing the game with five total stops. As a team, the Tigers had 11 TFLs and four sacks, holding the Gamecocks to 104 yards in the first half.

**AHEAD BY A CENTURY**

- Seven Tigers have double-digit receptions with six hitting the century mark in total yards through 11 games: Dominic Lovett (50, 716), Luther Burden III (36, 299), Barrett Banister (36, 403), Cody Schrader (17, 142), Mookie Cooper (16, 181), Tauskie Dove (15, 226) and Nathaniel Peat (10, 66).

**RANKED ROAD DUB**

- By knocking off No. 25 South Carolina 23-10, Mizzou registered its first win over a ranked opponent since defeating No. 17 LSU, 45-41, in 2020.
- The ranked victory on the road is the first since a 2018 win over No. 13 Florida, 38-17, in Gainesville.

**KA-DEFENSE**

- Vanderbilt's leading receiver, Will Sheppard, who came into the game with eight receiving touchdowns on the season - was targeted 15 times, but covered mostly by Kris Abrams-Draine, he caught just three passes for 28 yards. Abrams-Draine had five tackles and broke up three passes - two of them in the end zone. In all, Mizzou defenders broke up 10 passes and held Vanderbilt to 49 percent passing.
- Mizzou's pass defense held Vanderbilt's quarterbacks to a 49 percent completion rate, marking the second time an opposing team has completed less than half its passes against the Tigers this year.

**THE AMERICAN DREAM**

- Cody Schrader is living the Tiger tale. A transfer from Division II Truman State and native of St. Louis, he joined the Missouri program in January, 2022.
- In 2021, he led all of Division II with 2,074 rushing yards on 300 carries and 24 TDs..
- Schrader earned his first DI start on Sept. 1 and opened the second quarter with a 5-yard TD.

**LOOKIN' AT LUTHER**

- In the 17-14 Homecoming win vs. Vanderbilt, Luther Burden III - the SEC Freshman of the Week - scored both of Mizzou's touchdowns with a 35-yard reception and a 10-yard rush in the first half.
- With his two scores, Burden becomes the first true freshman Tiger to score multiple TDs in multiple games since Damarea Crockett in 2016.
- He totaled a career-high 66 receiving yards on four receptions and one carry for 10 yards vs. Vandy.

**DROB GETS IT DONE**

- With 1:23 to play, and 3rd-and-11, Vandy tight end Ben Bresnahan caught a pass from quarterback Mike Wright that at first was ruled a first down at the MU 43-yard line.
- After video review, he was ruled short of the first down and on fourth down and less than a yard to go, Darius Robinson stopped running back Ray Davis for no gain. Missouri then ran out the clock to secure the win.

- University of Missouri football is headed back to St. Louis for the first time since 2010.
- The game against Memphis, scheduled for Sept. 23, 2023 at Liberty Bowl Memorial Stadium, will be played in St. Louis at The Dome at America's Center (66,965).
- The Tigers last played in St. Louis in 2010, a 23-13 win over Illinois in the Arch Rivalry Series, which ran from 2002-10. Mizzou went 6-0 in that series.
- The football game kicks off a new partnership with the St. Louis Sports Commission which will host multiple Mizzou athletic events in the St. Louis area during the 2023-24 season – the Mizzou To The Lou Series.
- As part of the series, the St. Louis Sports Commission plans to offer Mizzou student-athletes a Name, Image and Likeness (NIL) opportunity – the chance to serve as ambassadors for the series of athletic events, promoting the events throughout the St. Louis area, surrounding communities and state.

**FUTURE LOOKS GOOD**

- The Southeastern Conference recently announced Mizzou's 2023 football schedule which features three-straight home games to start the season and a nonconference game in St. Louis against Memphis.
- The Tigers will welcome LSU, South Carolina, Tennessee and Florida to Faurot Field and travel to Vanderbilt, Kentucky, Georgia and Arkansas.

**NEW KIDS IN THE BLOCK M**

- The Tigers were joined by 49 newcomers in the offseason, including 31 true freshmen and 18 transfers. Division I newcomers (14) include: Marcus Clarke (Miami), Jayden Jernigan (Oklahoma State), Tyrone Hopper (North Carolina), DJ Coleman (Jacksonville State), Ty'Ron Hopper (Florida), Nathaniel Peat (Stanford), Jack Abraham (Mississippi State), Dreyden Norwood (Texas A&M), Joseph Charleston (Clemson), Bence Polgar (Buffalo), Tyler Stephens (Buffalo), Josh Landry (Baylor), Ian Mathews (Auburn) and Kristian Williams (Oregon).
- Cody Schrader is a transfer from Division II Truman State. Demariyon 'Peanut' Houston (Nebraska / Hutchinson C.C.), Micah Manning (Iowa Western C.C.) and MyKai Lee (Coffeyville C.C.) arrived in Columbia from the JUCO ranks.

**STAYING IN THE SHOW ME STATE**

- The 2022 Tigers' roster features 48 student-athletes from the state of Missouri, including nine from the 573, 24 from the St. Louis area and 11 from the Kansas City area.

**JACK ATTACK**

- Jack Stonehouse took over punt duties vs. ACU. He punted twice on the day, neither of which were returnable, including a 53 yarder and a touchback.
- At Auburn, he punted eight times for an average of 48 yards, booting three over 50 yards, including 60- and 68-yard punts while dropping five inside the 20.
- Stonehouse's 68-yard punt - tied for No. 14 nationally - is the longest by a Tiger since Corey Fatoney booted a 69-yard punt in the 2018 Liberty Bowl against Oklahoma St.

**IN THE THICC OF IT**

- Harrison Mevis is 18-of-23 on the season, including 6-of-6 from 40-49 and 4-of-5 from 50+. He's connected on all 29 point-after attempts.
- He was tabbed as a semifinalist for the Lou Groza Award for the third-straight season.
- He knocked through a 38-yard field goal vs. Vandy to close the first half, tying him with Grant Ressel for fourth on Mizzou's all-time career list with 52 fgm.
- Against then-No. 1 Georgia, he hit 5-of-5 field goals, including two from 40+ and two from 50+. His final make of the game, a 56-yarder – the national leader – matched his career long from 2021 (Boston College).
- Also against the Bulldogs, he became the first Mizzou kicker to make four 40+-yard attempts in a single game. He's the only Tiger to accomplish five made field goals in a game twice, and one of four to do it at all.
- Against ACU, he nailed a 52 yarder in the fourth quarter vs. ACU, the seventh 50-yard field goal of his career. He surpassed Tom Whelihan (1984-87) for sole possession of the top spot on Mizzou's all-time career 50-yard field goals list.

**LATEST FROM LOVETT**

- WR Dominic Lovett leads the squad with 50 receptions for 716 yards and three TDs.
- Lovett had a career day at South Carolina, hauling in 10 catches for 148 yards, setting career bests. It was the most yards by a Mizzou receiver since Jonathan Johnson racked up 185 yards in the 2018 Liberty Bowl against Oklahoma State.
- At Auburn, Lovett racked up 102 receiving yards on the Auburn defense. He is the first Mizzou player to have consecutive 100-yard receiving performances since Emanuel Hall in the first two games of 2018.
- Against ACU, Lovett hauled in his first career receiving TD on a 79-yard dot from Brady Cook, MU's longest play from scrimmage since Drew Lock connected with Johnathon Johnson for an 85-yard score in the 2018 Liberty Bowl against Oklahoma State.
- Lovett finished with seven receptions for 132 yards. He tacked on his second TD of the day on a 13-yard score in the waning moments of the third quarter.

**HOP TO IT**

- Through 11 games, Ty'Ron Hopper totals 57 tackles, 11.5 tackles for a loss of 37 yards, including 2.5 sacks for 20 yards, and one interception for 15 yards.
- Against LA Tech, he snagged the first interception of his career in his first game in Black and Gold.

**WELCOME WILLIAMS**

- A transfer from Oregon, Kristian Williams earned the first start of his career vs. Abilene Christian. He also got the nod at DT at Auburn and vs. Georgia.
- Williams recorded his first career sack with a loss of two yards on Auburn's Robby Ashford.

**FIRST-DOWN BANISTER**

- WR Barrett Banister has hauled in 27+ receptions in three-straight seasons and is one of three MU players with a reception in five seasons, joining Lamont Downer (1974-78) and George Shorthose (1980-84).
- Against ACU, Banister surpassed 100 career grabs, the 25th Tiger to hit the milestone.

**TO THE HOUSE**

- Luther Burden III took a 78-yard punt return to the house vs. ACU, the first time Mizzou's initial score was a punt return since the 1939 contest against Oklahoma.
- He is the seventh Tiger in program history to record a rushing, receiving, and punt-return score in the same season, last accomplished by Marcus Murphy in 2014.
- Burden's return was the first for the Tigers since Richaud Floyd in 2019, and the longest since Floyd had an 85-yarder vs. Idaho in 2017.

**LBIII DEBUT**

- The first true freshman starter on offense in the season opener since Evan Boehm (2012), wide receiver Luther Burden III earned his first collegiate score on a five-yard reception after making a pair of LA Tech defenders miss and splitting another pair.
- He punched in a second score early in the third quarter, this time a one-yard rush off a direct snap. He's one of just five Tigers all-time to score twice in their collegiate debut (Jeremy Maclin, 2007; Devin West, 1995; Tracey Mack, 1980; Johnny Roland, 1962).

**JOURNEYMAN JACK**

- Graduate QB Jack Abraham is one of only 23 players in the nation in at least their seventh CFB season, one of 14 in the Power Five, and one of two in the SEC.
- Abraham spent the 2021-22 season at Mississippi State, and earned a medical redshirt. He played in 27 games at Southern Miss (2018-20) and threw for 2,949 yards at NW Mississippi CC in 2017.
- His collegiate career started as an early enrollee at Louisiana Tech in Spring 2016, where he redshirted.

**HEAD OF THE CLASS**

- In addition to 11 graduates on the roster, 18 Tigers will finish their undergraduate degrees in fall 2022 or spring 2023: Brady Cook (business, F22), Chad Bailey (general studies, S23), Chuck Hicks (F22, general studies), Cody Schrader (S23, general studies), Daniel Robledo (F22, general studies), Darius Robinson (S23, hospitality management), Devyn Butler (S23, general studies), EJ Ndoma-Ogar (S23, communications), Jalani Williams (F22, sport management), Jayden Jernigan (F22, general studies), Joseph Charleston (F22, general studies), Justin Efebera (S23, journalism), Nathaniel Peat (S23, general studies), Realus George, Jr. (F22, general studies), Trajan Jeffcoat (F22, general studies), Trenton Sederwall (S23, business administration), Xavier Delgado (F22, health sciences) and Zeke Powell (S23, agriculture).

**HEAD COACH**  
**ELIAH DRINKWITZ**  
THIRD YEAR • ARKANSAS TECH '04



A winner at every stage of his career, Eliah Drinkwitz – considered one of college football’s top offensive minds – was introduced as the University of Missouri’s 33rd head football coach in December 2019. The 2022 campaign will mark his third at the helm of the program and his fourth season as a head coach.

Drinkwitz – 11-12 at MU (third season) and 23-13 overall as a head coach (fourth season) – advanced to bowl games in his first two seasons with the Tigers, joining former head coach Warren Powers (1978, 1979) as the only two MU head coaches to achieve the feat. Additionally, only Powers won more games in his first two seasons at MU (1978-79, 15-9) than Drinkwitz.

Mizzou’s 2021 Armed Forces Bowl vs. Army West Point averaged 2.57 million viewers – up 14% from the 2020 edition of the game (Mississippi State-Tulsa: 2.25M), up 48% from Tulane-Southern Miss in 2019 (1.74M) - and was the most-watched edition of the game since 2018 (Army-Houston: 2.58M). In comparison, the National Basketball Association’s Warriors-Knicks game where Steph Curry broke the 3-point record (Dec. 14, 2021) totaled 2.35 million viewers.

The 2021 season saw Tyler Badie set a new school record for single-season rushing yards (1,604). His 14 touchdowns in 12 games are good for ninth on Mizzou’s single season and top-10 list. He was a CoSIDA Academic All-American, the Southeastern Conference Football Scholar Athlete of the Year (Mizzou’s first-ever), first-team All-SEC and was named to multiple All-America teams.

Under Drinkwitz’s leadership, Mizzou produced its highest-ranked recruiting classes ever: 2021 No. 20, 2022 No. 19 (per Rivals), including the No. 1 wide receiver in the 2022 class. He joined Warren Powers as the only head coaches in Mizzou history to earn a bowl bid in their first season patrolling the sidelines in

Columbia. Drinkwitz joins Frank Broyles, Dan Devine and Powers as the only first-year Mizzou head coaches to reach five victories in year one of their Tiger tenures.

In his seven seasons as an offensive coordinator and/or head coach, Drinkwitz has produced six 1,000-yard rushers, four 3,000-yard passers and four 1,000-yard receivers. Three of those years (2015, 2017, 2018) his offenses produced at least one in each category.

Drinkwitz took over the Tiger program following an impressive 2019 season at Appalachian State that saw the Mountaineers win the Sun Belt Conference title en route to a 12-1 record. His Mountaineers set a Sun Belt record with their 12 wins, and also set the mark for the best regular season in conference history (11-1).

Drinkwitz’s team also made history in 2019 with a pair of Power 5 road wins (at bowl-eligible North Carolina, and later at South Carolina) – making them the first-ever Sun Belt team to register two Power 5 wins in a season. In all, the Mountaineers claimed an FBS-best six road wins en route to becoming the first-ever 12-win team among North Carolina’s FBS members.
