The Opening Kick

- The Golden Flashes embark on a new era of football as Kenni Burns was named the 23rd coach in program history in December of 2022
- Burns comes to Kent State from Minnesota, where he served as the assistant coach and running backs coach under PJ Fleck
- Coach Burns has instilled a new mantra for the team as the Kent GRIT era takes over
- GRIT is an acronym for Grow Respond with Integrity Together
- Coaches Colin Ferrell (AHC, D-Line), CJ Cox (Passing Game, CBs) and Matt Johnson (Co-OC/QBs) were on the staff last season
- Dave Duggan takes over as Defensive Coordinator and joins Kent State from Troy University
- The Flashes have 19 new transfers on the roster
- The Flashes have 11 new starters on offense this year, the top returners are RB-Gavin Garcia (211 rush yards) and WR-Trell Harris (136 yards)
- Kent State lost 92 percent of its rush yards from a season ago, the Flashes to get Xavier Williams back after missing the 2022 season, Williams has rushed for 1430 yards and 10 TDs in his career
- The Flashes also lost 92 percent of its receiving yards from last season.
- Purdue transfer Mike Alaimo was named OB 1 out of fall camp with Tommy Ulatowski set to back him up.
- Alaimo appeared in three games for the Boilermakers, tossing a touchdown in the bowl game against LSU...Threw for 2,800 yards and 23 touchdowns in high school career for St. Joseph's Regional in New Jersey
- Against UCF, Alaimo developed quick chemistry with wide receiver Chrishon McCray...McCray led the team in receiving against the Knights with 61 yards and also had a 75 yard catch brought back
- Alaimo also looked to sophomore Trell Harris, Harris grabbed four balls in week one and was targeted nine times...Harris is the leading receiver from last season
- Defensively, the Flashes turned to linebacker Devin Nicholson, the Mizzou transfer had a game-high 13 stops including 11 solo and two for loss against the Knights
- The Flashes forced John Rhys Plumlee into three turnovers in week one with DI Miller and Nick Giacolone picking Plumlee off and CI West recording a strip sack that was recovered by Stephen Daley



A NEW ERA

Kent State named Kenni Burns the 23rd coach in program history in December of 2022. Burns comes to the Flashes from Minnesota where he served as associate head coach and running backs coach. He also has stops in Wyoming, North Dakota State and Western Michigan.

KENT GRIT

Coach Kenni Burns has instilled a new mantra in the program as the Kent GRIT era is officially underway. Burns GRIT mentality goes beyond the toughness that will be indicative of the Golden Flashes but carries over into day-to-day life. GRIT is returning starters entering this season an acronym for Grow Respond with Integrity Together.

RUNNING TO THE TOP

Coach Kenni Burns was a running back at Indiana and is the leading rusher at Sacred Heart Griffin High School in Springfield, Illinois. He is one of five reported coaches to have been a collegiate running back. He joins Thomas Hammock (NIU RB and HC), Dino Babers (Syracuse HC, Hawaii RB), Stan Drayton (Allegheny RB, Temple HC) and Kalani Sitake (BYU RB and HC). Georgia HC Kirby Smart and South Carolina HC Shane Beamer were running back coaches before getting head coaching positions.

NFL EUROPE

Defensive coordinator Dave Duggan spent 2004-2007 with the Cologne Centurions of NFL Europe including a 10-9 record as head coach in 2006 and 2007. He is the only reported college coach that was a head coach in NFL Europe. Kentucky AHC Vince Marrow coached for two NFL Europe teams, Clemson CB Coach Mike Reed won the 1999 world cup with Frankfurt while Indiana's WR coach Anthony Tucker played for Amsterdam.

POMP AND CIRCUMSTANCE

The Flashes have excelled in the classroom as a team, posting the highest term and cumulative GPA in program history this past spring. Twenty-one Golden Flashes have earned their undergraduate degree with five earning the honor from Kent State. All 21 Golden Flashes will wear a MAC graduate patch on their uniform to denote the accomplishment.

X GONNA GIVE IT TO YA

Xavier Williams returns to the Golden Flashes backfield after missing the 2022 season with an injury suffered in the 2021 MAC Championship game. The graduate student has improved each of his previous four seasons in the backfield, averaging nearly six yards per carry in his career. His best season came back in 2021 where he averaged 6.5 yards per carry and rushed for 812 yards in 13 games.

STEPPING UP

The Golden Flashes are one of six teams who will be replacing the top passer, rusher and receiver from last year. In addition to the return of Williams, Gavin Garcia will take on a bigger role. Garcia flashed during his time on the field as a freshman in both the run and the return game. Garcia averaged six yards a touch in 35 carries last year and had a long of 52 in kick returns.

On the receiving end, Trell Harris is the leading returning wide receiver. Harris earned more playing time as his freshman campaign carried on and caught at least one pass in each of the final four games of the season, highlighted by a five-catch performance in the OT win over Buffalo to end the season.

The Flashes return zero starters on offense, and three regular starters on defense. That mark ties Colorado for fewest
